**Public Synopsis of Disciplinary Action**

The Atlantic City Police Department reports there has been **NO MAJOR DISCIPLINE** taken against any officer with this agency from June 15, 2020 through December 31, 2020.

Major discipline is defined as employment termination, demotion, or suspension for more than 5 (five) days due to a disciplinary violation.

This is being reported in accordance with paragraph 9.11.2 of the Attorney General Guideline, *Internal Affairs Policy & Procedures*;

**9.11.2 On a periodic basis, and at least once a year, every agency shall submit to the County Prosecutor and publish on the agency's public website a brief synopsis of all complaints where a termination, reduction of rank or grade, and/or suspension more than five days was assessed to an agency member. This synopsis shall include the identity of each officer subject to final discipline, a brief summary of their transgressions, and a statement of the sanction imposed.**
