**Atlantic City Office of Emergency Management Reminds  
Public of Air Space Restrictions During Practice and Show  
Day for the 2021 Atlantic City Air Show “A Salute to  
Those Who Serve”**

(ATLANTIC CITY) – As a safety precaution for the 2021 Atlantic City Air Show “A Salute to Those Who Serve,” the Atlantic City Office of Emergency Management (ACOEM), would like to remind the public that drones, parasailing, kite flying, and/or the flying of any other device is prohibited within a 10-mile radius of the Air Show space during practices on Tuesday, August 17, and the actual Air Show on Wednesday, August 18.

Any drones or other devices used in violation of this restriction will be confiscated and their operators arrested.

The restriction has been standard practice for the past 18 years and continues with the compliance of all municipalities from Longport to Brigantine.

The exact restricted area runs from 23<sup>rd</sup> Street in Longport to South Roosevelt Boulevard in Brigantine.

**Practice and Air Show times are as follows:**

Practice: Tuesday, August 17, from 10:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Show day: Wednesday, August 18, from 10:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
