Small Administration Announces Launch of Cannabis Committee Town Hall Meetings

Residents encouraged to participate in discussions on cannabis legislation in Atlantic City

(ATLANTIC CITY) – Yesterday, the Small Administration hosted the City’s first-ever Cannabis Town Hall Meeting. The meetings are hosted by the Atlantic City Cannabis Committee, which was established to engage the community in discussions on New Jersey’s recently enacted cannabis legislation and its impacts on Atlantic City. The committee will host five additional town hall meetings between June 15 and June 21. Committee members will moderate discussions on the six cannabis licenses available and give residents an opportunity to provide feedback on possible cannabis retail and consumption in their neighborhoods.

The Atlantic City Cannabis Committee town hall meetings will take place at 5 p.m. in all six wards on the following dates:

- June 14 – Uptown School Park, outside (Ward 1)
- June 15 – Red Klotz Liquor Store, parking lot (Ward 2)
- June 16 – New York Avenue School Park, outside (Ward 3)
- June 17 – Lagoon Park in Venice Park (Ward 4)
- June 18 – Sovereign Avenue Skate Park (Ward 5)
- June 21 – Stockton Campus Boardwalk (Ward 6)

“My administration is committed to keeping residents informed on the potential sales, distribution, and cultivation of cannabis within Atlantic City,” said Mayor Marty Small, Sr. “The town hall meetings will serve as the first platform for residents to provide feedback on cannabis legislation passed in New Jersey.”
