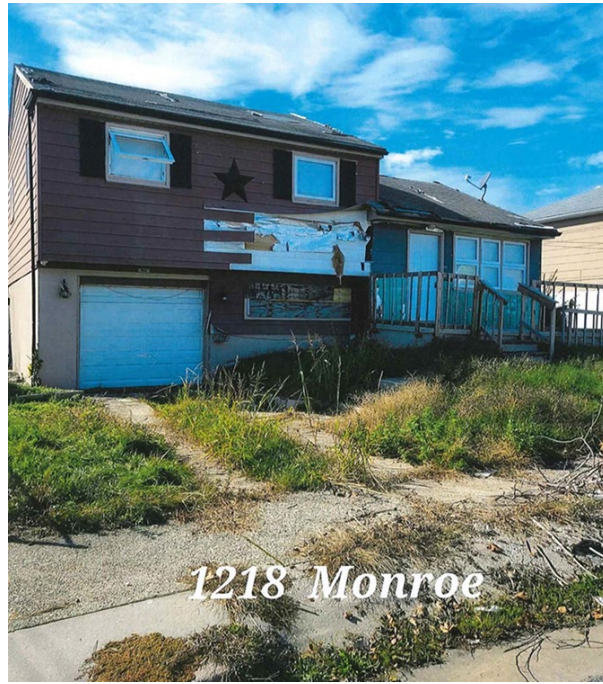

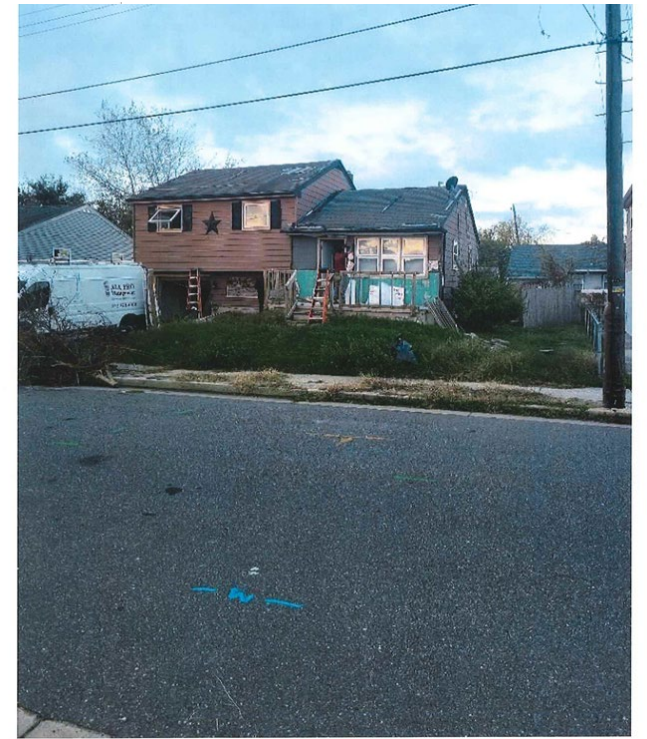
226 North New Jersey Ave: Request for an Asbestos Inspection has been sent to our consultant. Demolition will be advertised as soon as we receive this report.

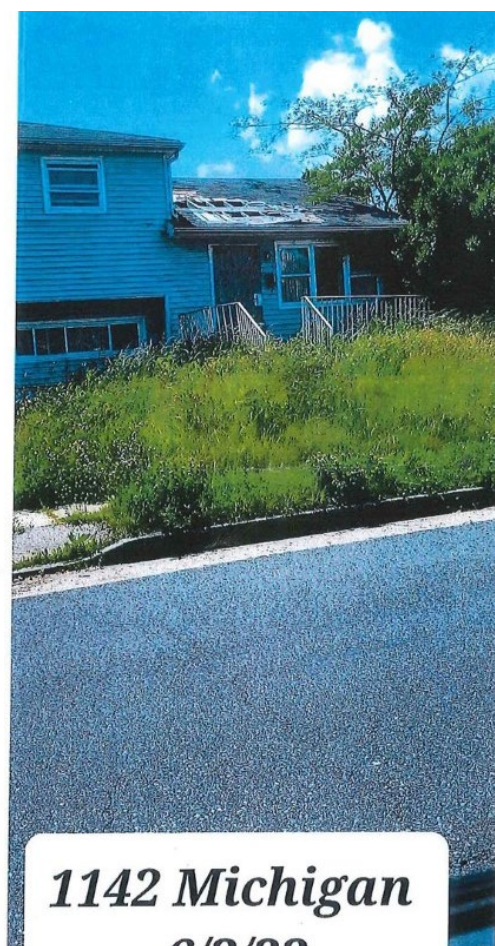

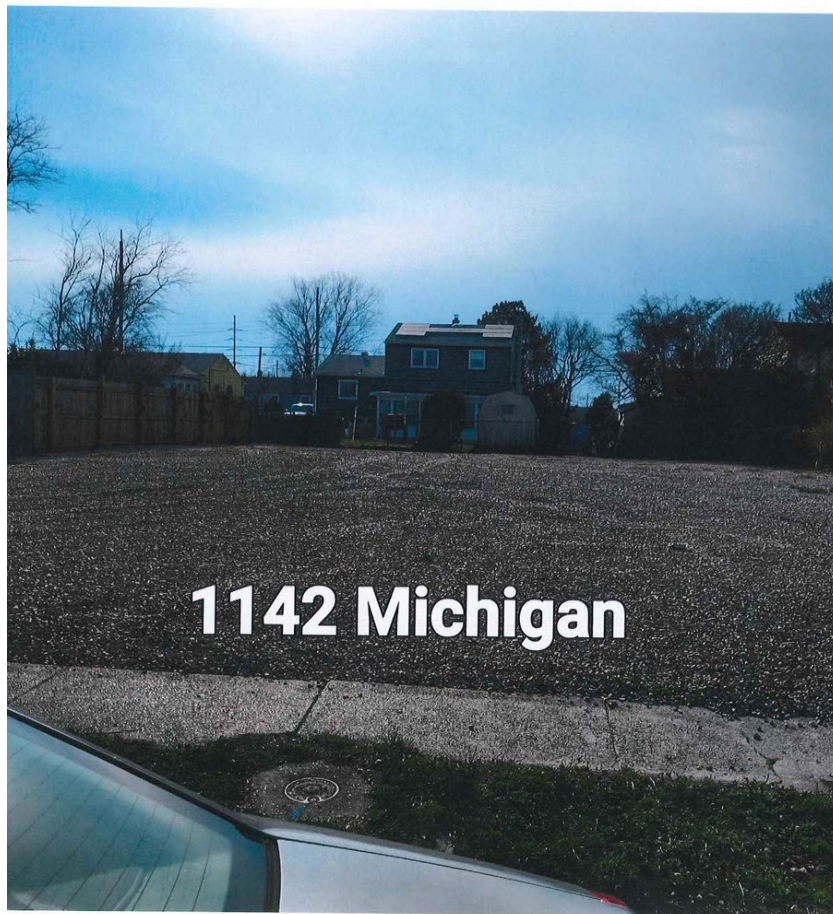

Q:

Concern: Is there a way to restrict/discourage people from taking unwanted food from the food bank and leaving it on the street?

A:

Chief Harold Reaves spoke with Ms. Diane Bey regarding her complaint. She showed him pictures and location where people left unwanted food in several areas near her home. She stated that the food was from the food bank located at the Bangladesh Community Center. He told her that he would contact the food bank director to address her concerns. On February 15th he spoke with Mohammed Islam (Mercantile Department) regarding the issue of the food. He stated that they can't control what individuals do on several blocks away from the center. He did state that he and his people would ask those receiving a food box to give back food items back to the center that they don't want instead of leaving food on the street. If someone is caught putting food on the ground will be subjective to a possible fine

Officers Zayon Pitts, Jonathan Revolus and Julian Monsalve - Bravo 1 Platoon (Commanded by Lt. Robert Macready)

Bravo 1 Platoon officers responded to the 100 block of north Delaware Avenue in reference to a ShotSpotter alert. Officer Pitts arrived and located a crime scene and determined a home had been struck by gunfire. The home was occupied by three residents at the time of the shooting. Suspect description was obtained and broadcast to officers.

Officers Revolus and Monsalve observed a suspect fleeing the area and gave chase. The male, a 16-year-old juvenile, was apprehended in the 500 block of Drexel Avenue and was taken into custody without further incident. A handgun was recovered near where the juvenile was apprehended. There were no reported injuries as a result of the shooting.

All officers are to be recognized for a job well done!

Sergeants TJ Moynihan and Mohammad Kaiser and Officers Jonathan Walsh, Jamar Dabney, Danish Mohammad, Eric Knuttel, and Courtney Campbell - Alpha 2 Patrol (Commanded by Lt. Frank Timek)

Alpha 2 Patrol officers responded to the 3500 block of Pacific Avenue for a reported robbery. Officer Walsh met with the victim who needed medical attention. Sergeant Kaiser was able to assist in needed translation that ultimately led to the location of the suspects.

All of the officers responded to a nearby apartment complex and established a perimeter. One suspect peaked outside a door when Officer Dabney saw her. The officers entered the building and quickly located the suspects who were taken into custody. The officers recovered the victim's belongings.

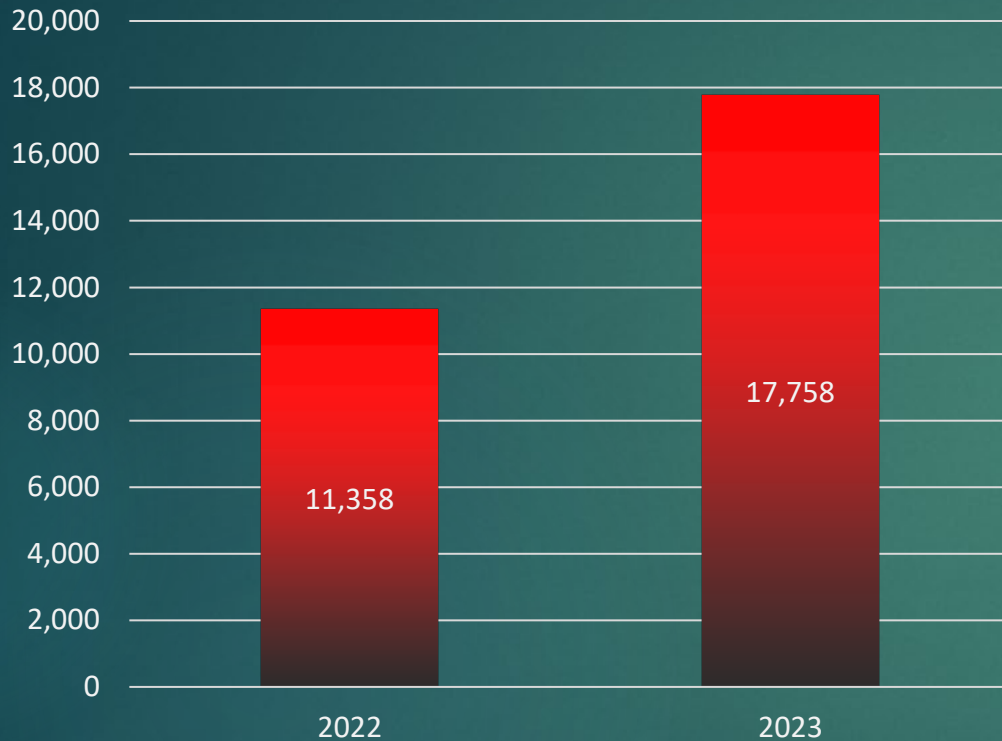

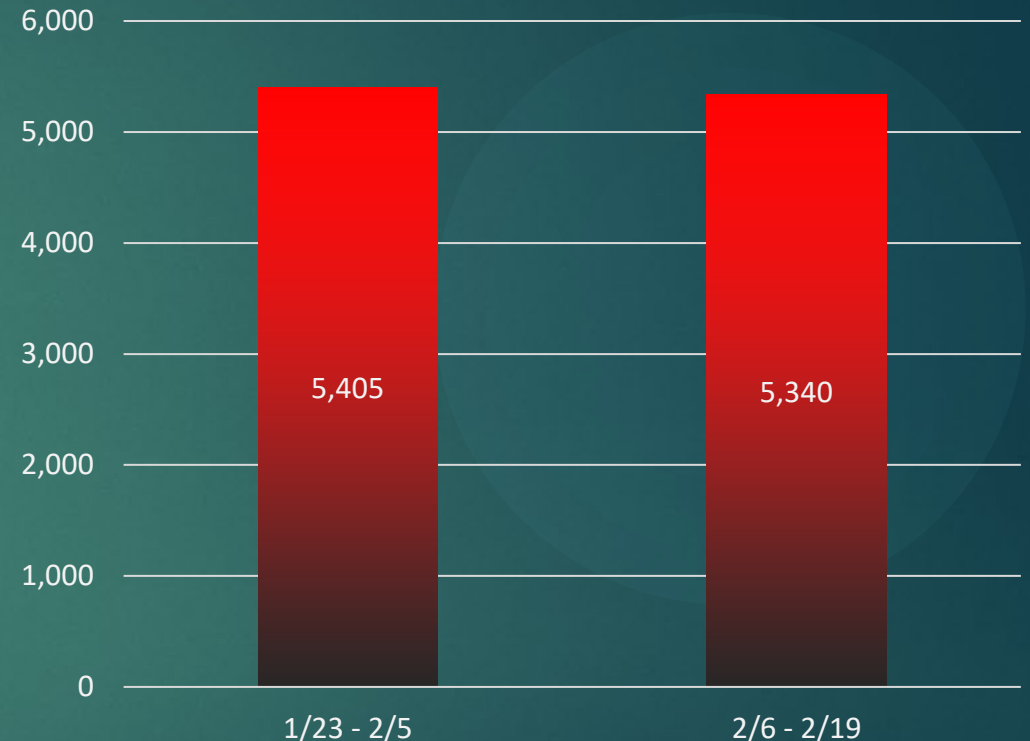
Calls for Service Overview

CFS (Year to Date Comparison)



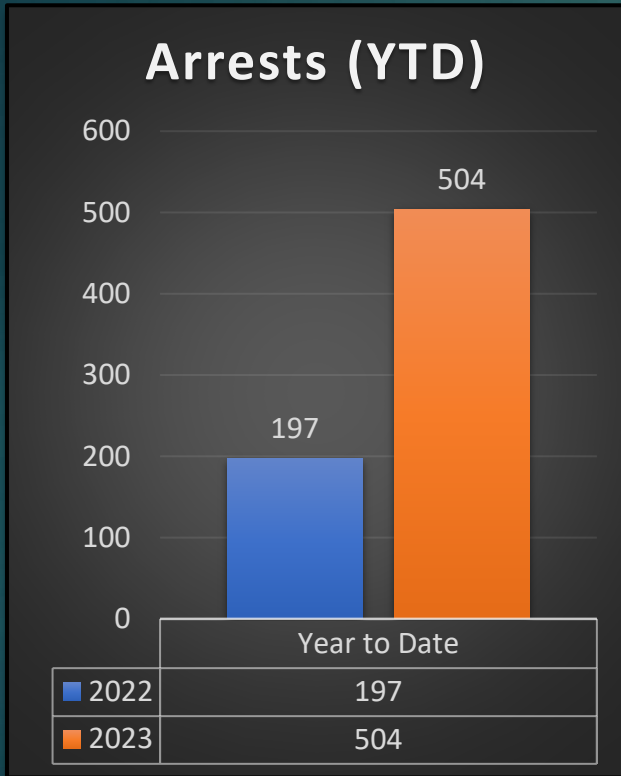
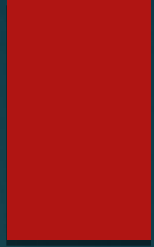
Calls for Service are up **57%** in 2023 vs 2022 YTD.

CFS (2 Week Comparison)

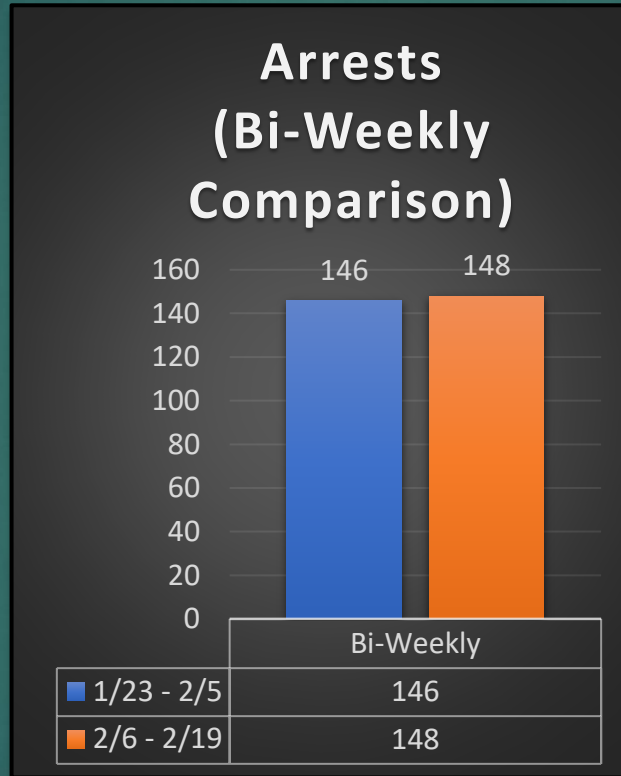

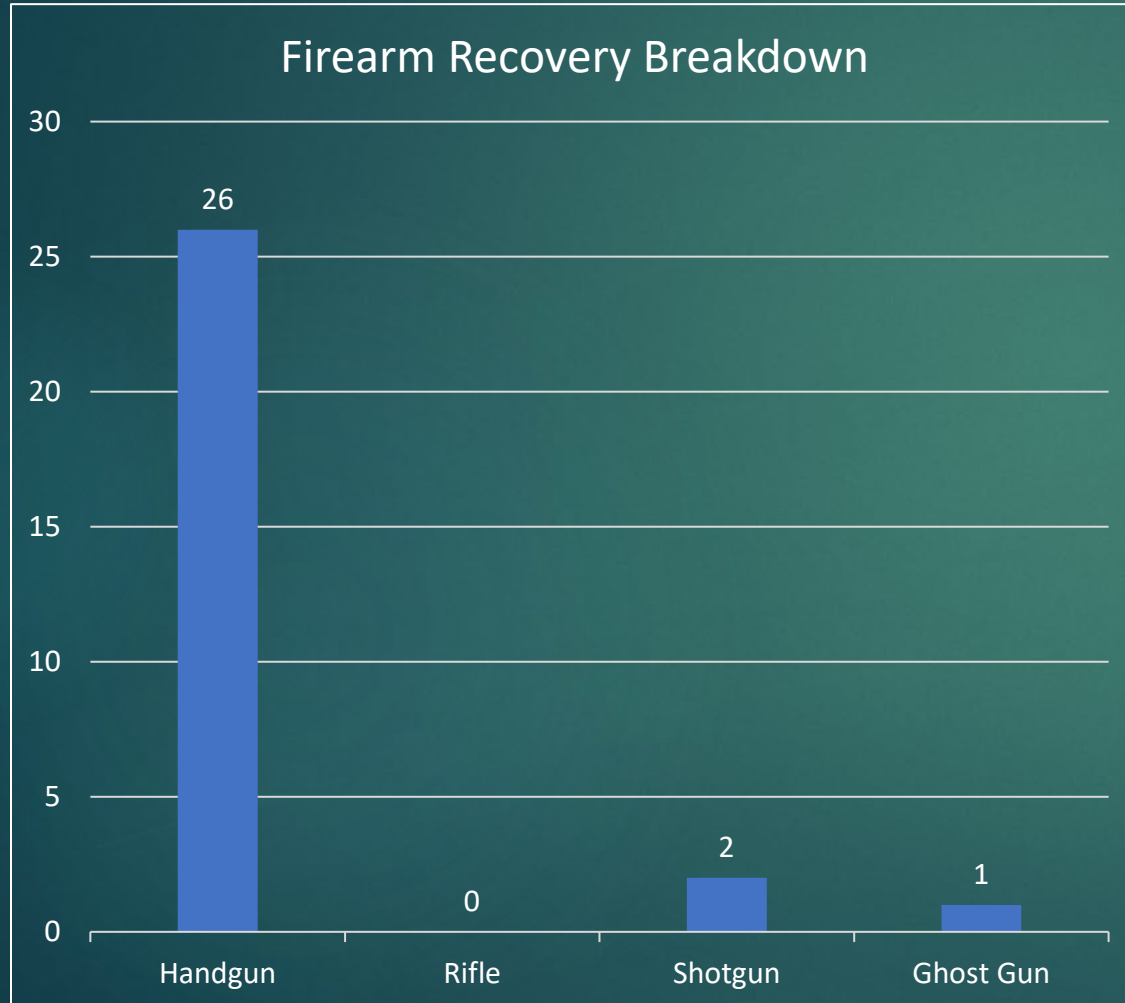

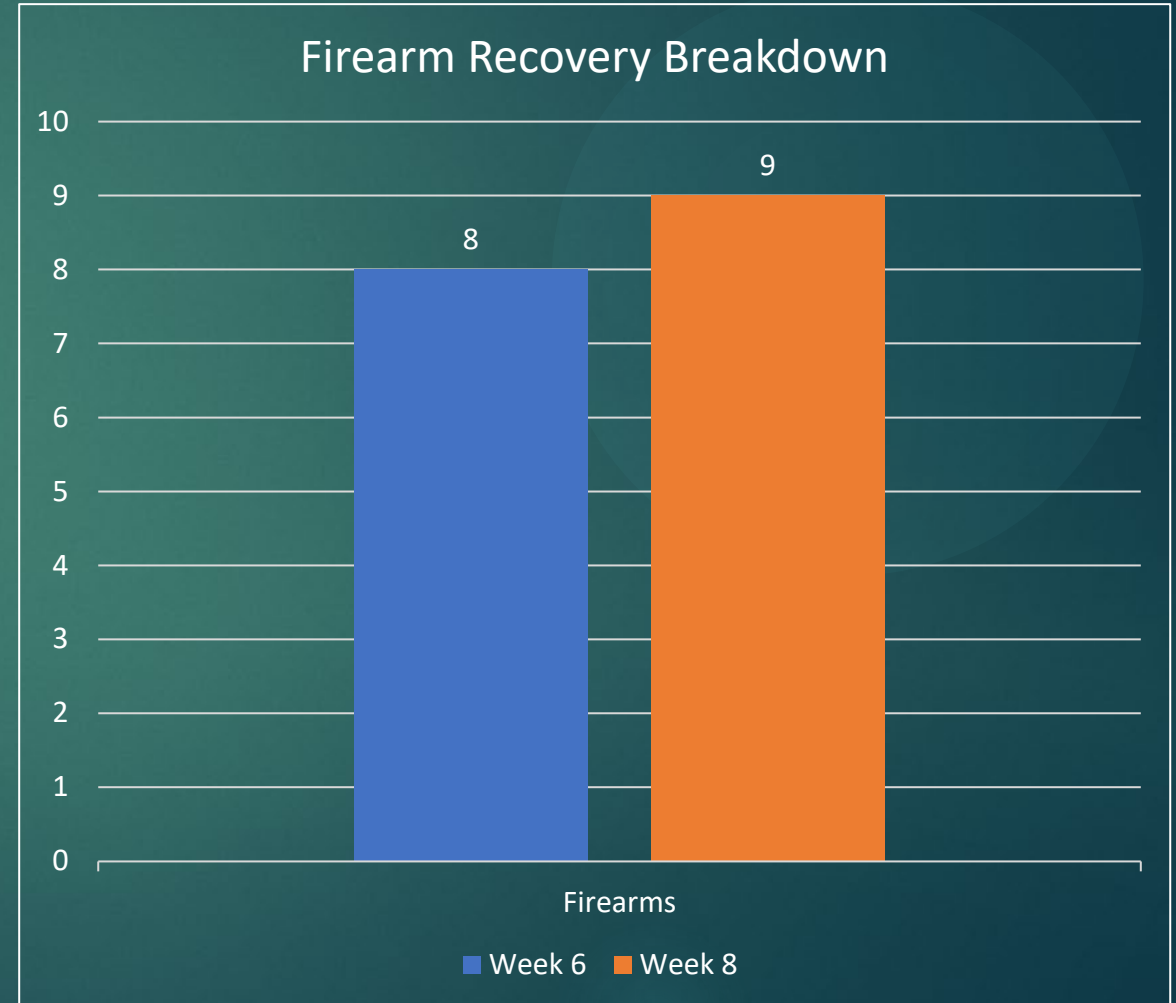
