### **Update on Penrose Ave Properties:**

1517 and 1519 Penrose Ave: Numerous code violations from February 3, 2023 inspection. Still haven't abated violations. Summons have been issued. Demolition hearing is scheduled for March 14, 2023.

### **Update on North New Jersey Ave Properties:**

226 North New Jersey Ave: Request for an Asbestos Inspection has been sent to our consultant. The property will be inspected this week. Once the report is received, this property will be advertised to be demolished.

### **Update on Ontario Ave and High Gate Properties:**

1810 Ontario Ave: Owner failed to abate the violations. A Summons for failure to comply has been issued.

High Gate Apartments: Several issues with the management of the property. No inspections for occupancy permits will be scheduled until management resolved several outstanding issues.

### **Concern Regarding Resident on Bellevue Ave:**

132 and 134 South Bellevue Ave: The 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> floor apartments were closed due to no heat and no fire escape. Tenants on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor of each property were allowed to stay because they had heat and did not require a fire escape. The tenants on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> floors of each property made arrangements with the landlord to either vacate the property at the owner's expense who paid for the tenants to stay in a hotel while other tenants accepted cash payment to vacate. The landlord received six tickets for no occupancy permits for all six apartments.

Code Enforcement Inspectors have visited these property on numerous occasions. Additionally, two Summons have been added to the violations list as no Sales Permit Inspection was requested at the time of the owners transfer of these properties. The Code Enforcement has worked very diligently in dealing with this owner.

**A:** Director Lewis is working with representatives from CRDA/SID to identify the appropriate specification and bulbs needed to make the corrections. Because the old specs are outdated, we may need to identify a more cost-efficient way for the lighting replacement in the center median on Connecticut Ave.

In the event of multiple dwellings, the Department of Public Works will not collect solid waste where there exists more than 10 dwellings units.

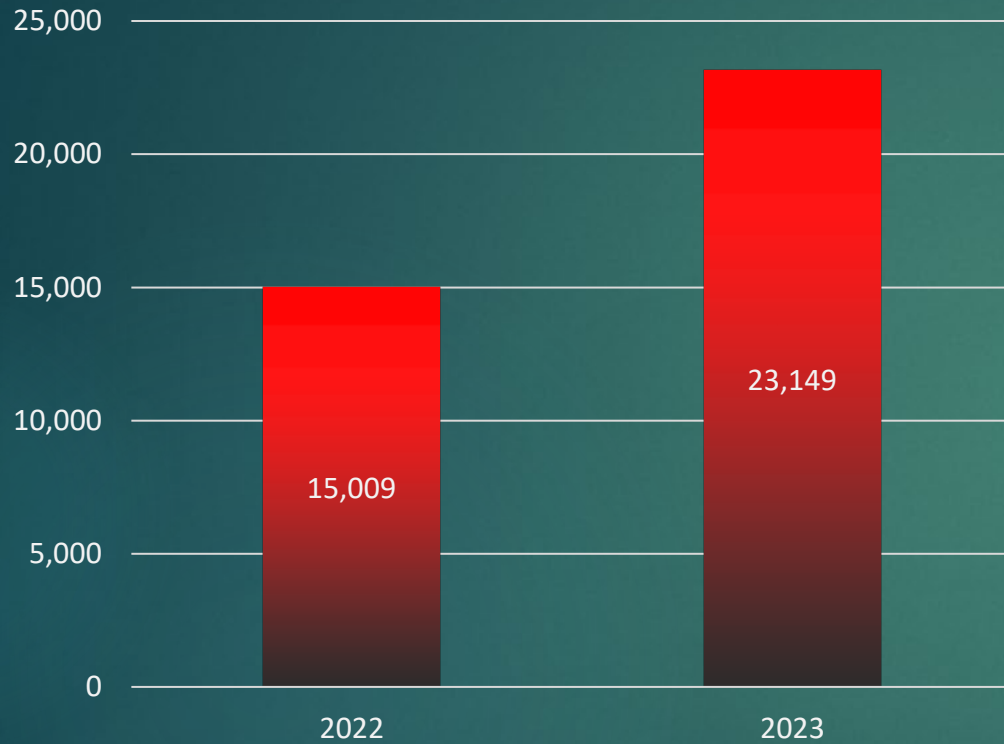

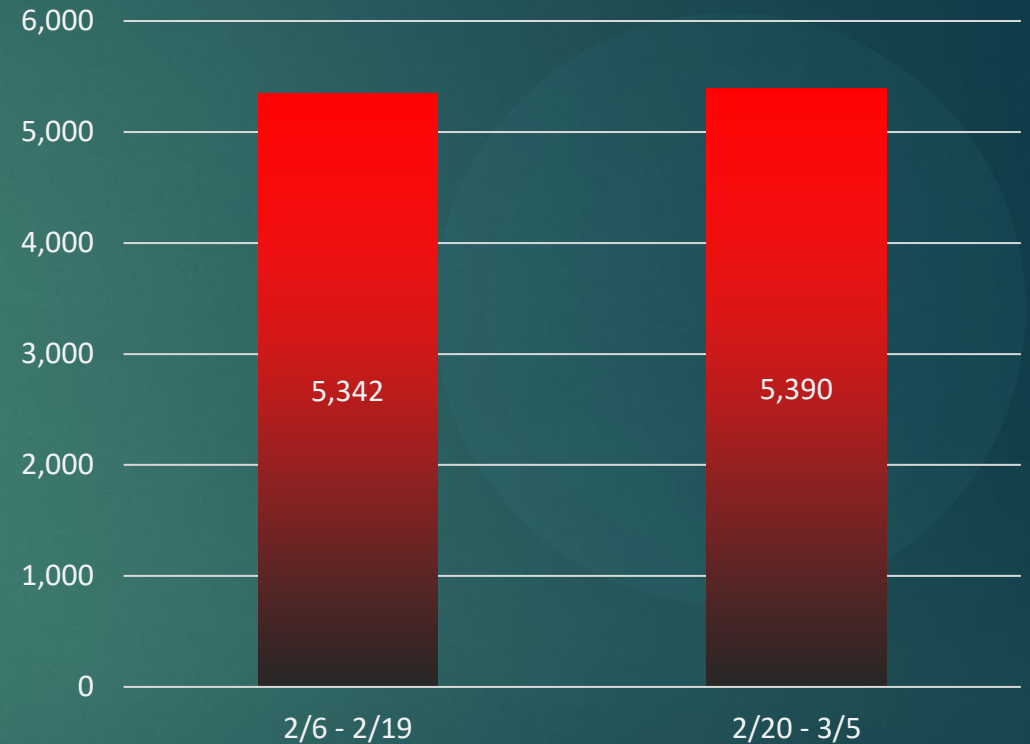
# Calls for Service Overview

Calls for Service are up **1%** from the bi-weeks of Feb 6 vs Feb 20

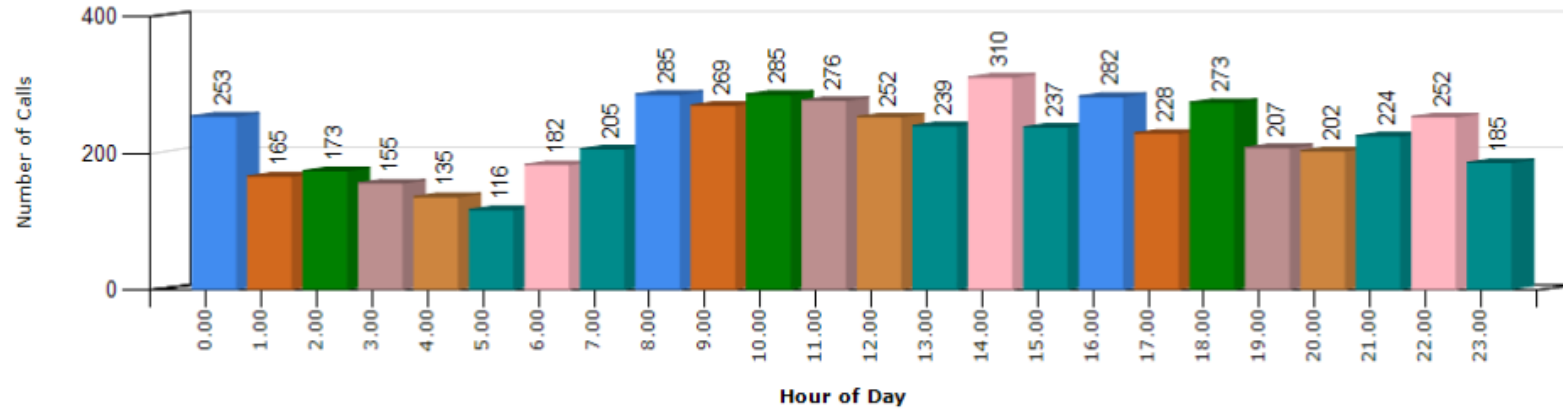

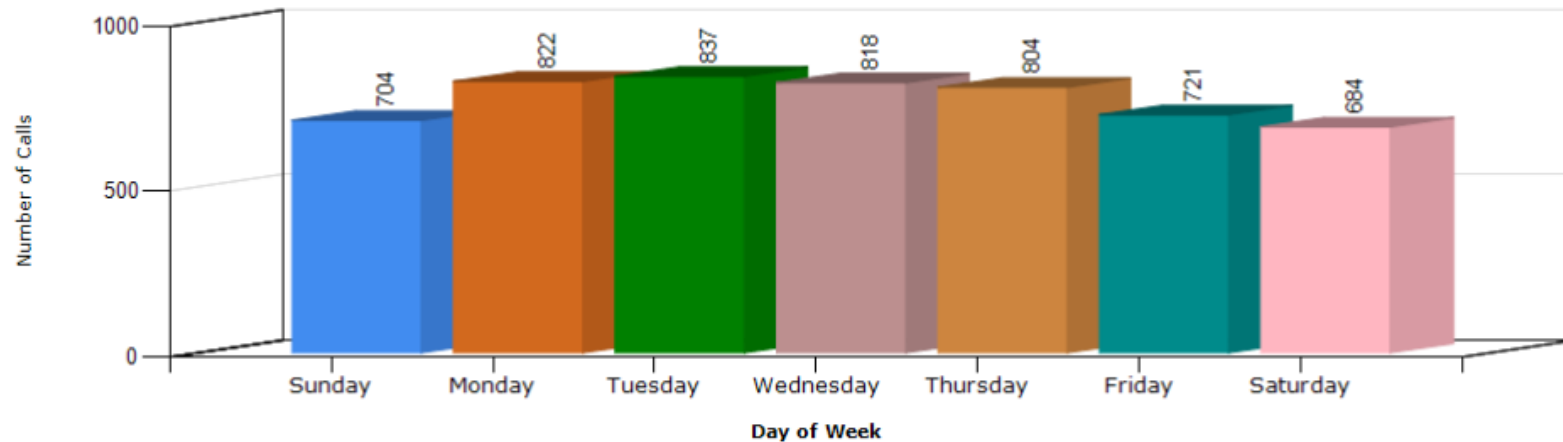

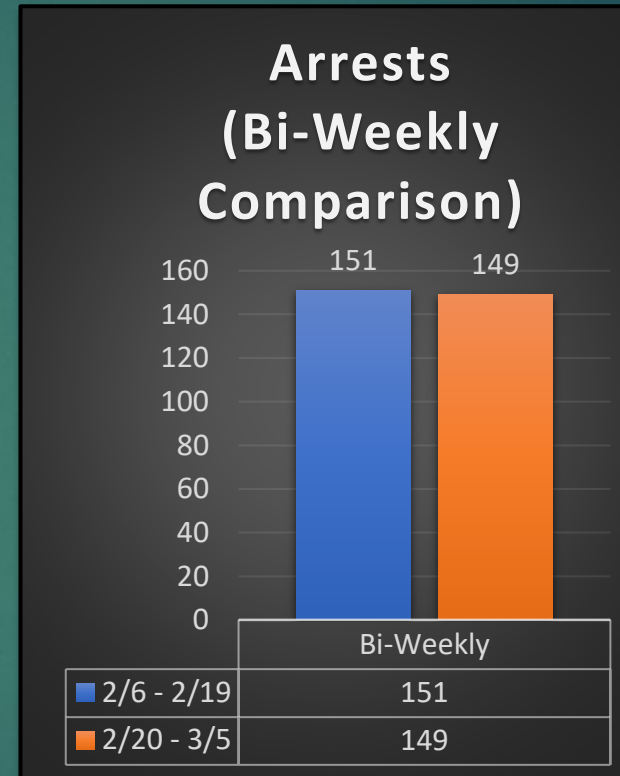
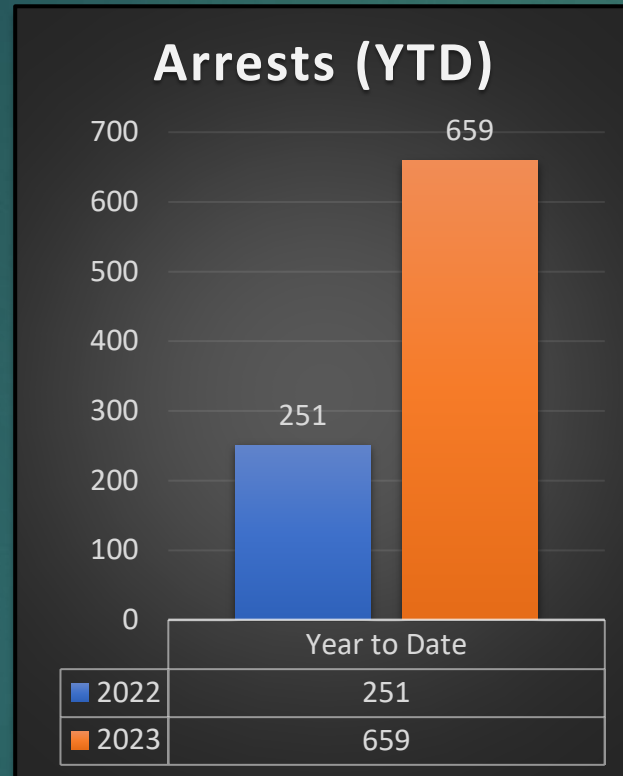
Number of Calls by Day of Week

# Arrests Overview



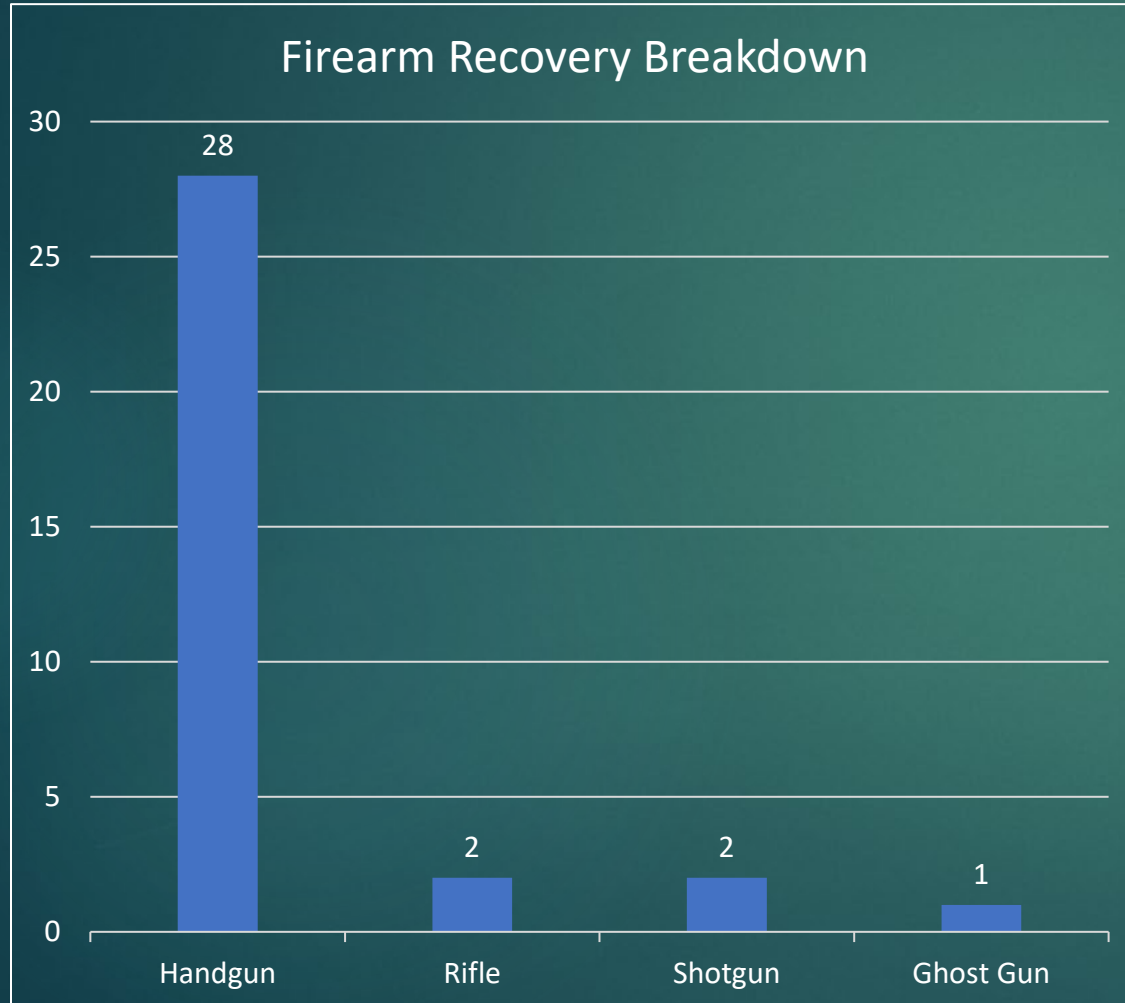

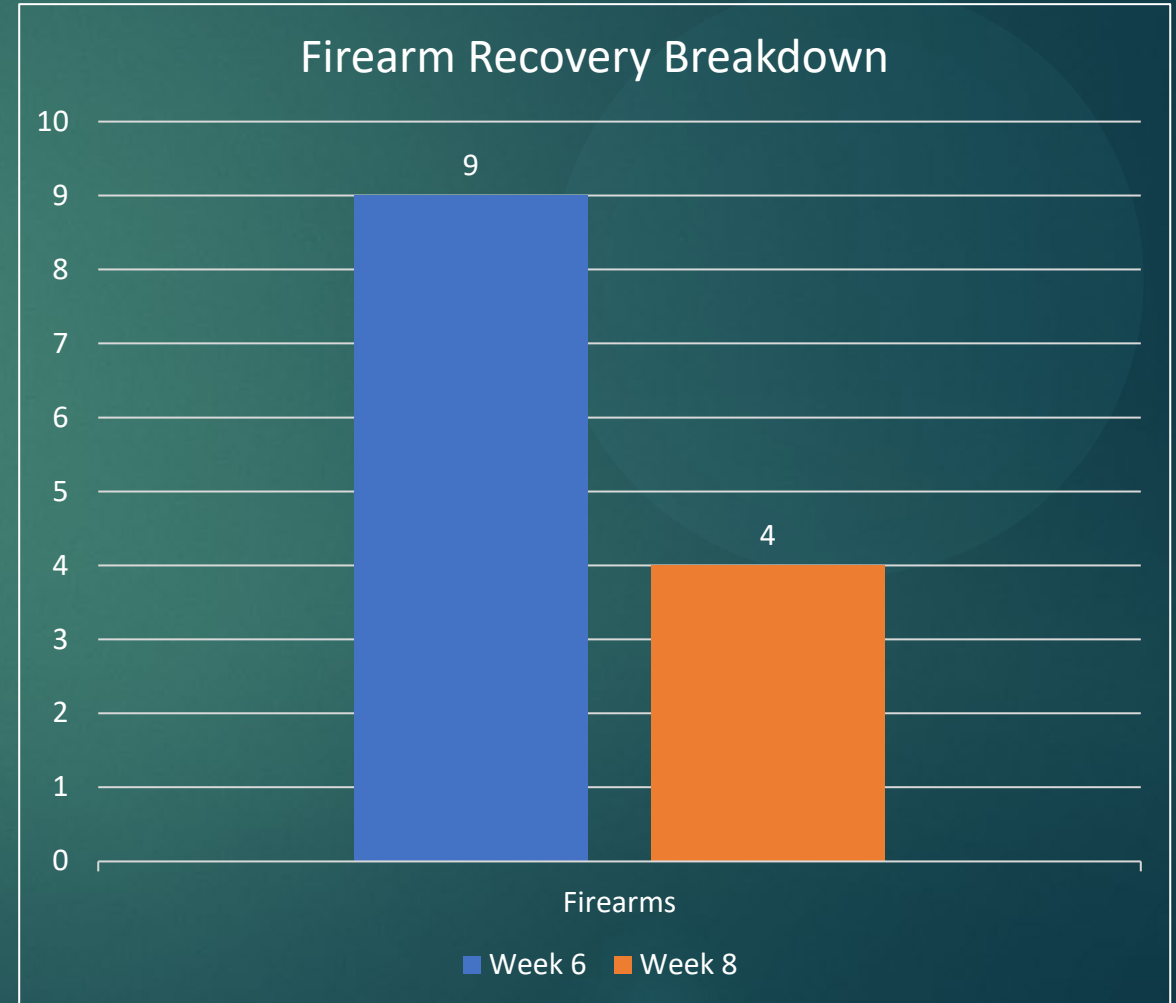

# Information for Residents- Tax Season Scams

- The IRS will never call to demand immediate payment using a specific method such as a prepaid debit card, gift card or wire transfer. Generally, the IRS will first mail a bill to any taxpayer who owes taxes.
- Threaten to immediately bring in local police or other law enforcement groups to have the taxpayer arrested for not paying.
- Demand that taxes be paid without giving taxpayers the opportunity to question or appeal the amount owed.
- Call out of the blue about an unexpected tax refund.
