**Q:** **Concern:** Is there a list of Cos to make sure landlords go through the proper processes when getting a new tenant?

**A:** Since the pandemic, there have been issues with Landlords failing to request inspections for rental permits. Code Enforcement Inspectors will strictly enforce this code and issue summons with requests of maximum fines in Court for these violations.

Further, the Code Enforcement Division has been requesting rent rolls from properties that are non-compliant with obtaining Occupancy Permits.

Additionally, Code Enforcement inspectors are in the process of reviewing property files to determine the status of occupants. A non-tolerance policy has been implemented and Court Summons will be issued.

## Shawn Steuber- Surveillance Center, Officers Michael Peters and Dylan Imbrenda

On March 18 at 1:55 AM, a shooting occurred in the 1900 block of the Boardwalk. Retired ACPD Officer Shawn Steuber, who is assigned to the Surveillance Center, was able to quickly locate a fleeing suspect and provide a detailed description to responding officers.

Approximately 13 minutes later, Officers Peters and Imbrenda, who were assigned to DWI patrol, located the suspect in the 1400 block of Atlantic Avenue. The suspect attempted to run but was quickly apprehended without further incident. He was in possession of a loaded handgun and ultimately charged with murder.

## **Bravo Platoon Squad 2 (Commanded by Lt. William Tracy) and Criminal Investigations Section- Bravo Shift (Commanded by Capt. Daniel Corcoran)**

On March 7, patrol officers responded to an alley in the rear of the 2900 block of Atlantic Avenue in reference to a report of shots fired. Responding officers arrived to find several witnesses who indicated they saw the shooting and observed several suspects run into an apartment building in the 2900 block of Atlantic Avenue. Officers on scene were able to determine that the suspects entered an apartment on the fourth floor of the building and established a perimeter. Several individuals were detained as part of the investigation.

An apartment was secured while Detective Brian McKinney applied for a residential search warrant. Upon approval of the search warrant by the court, the search conducted resulted in the recovery of a handgun loaded with hollow point bullets. Two males were charged with various offenses.

## **Alpha Platoon Squad 2 (Commanded by Lt. Jody Hersh), Criminal Investigations Section- Alpha Shift (Commanded by Capt. Daniel Corcoran), and ACPD Emergency Response Team (Commanded by DC Bridget Pierce)**

On March 5, patrol officers responded to the 100 block of north Maryland Avenue in reference to a ShotSpotter alert. Responding officers arrived to locate a crime scene in the area and several witnesses that said they observed the shooting.

An investigation conducted by officers and detectives of the Criminal Investigations Section, revealed the suspects entered the rear of a residence in the 900 block of Baltic Avenue. Officers immediately secured the perimeter of the residence.

The Atlantic City Emergency Response Team was activated and responded to the scene. The Atlantic City SWAT team ultimately cleared the residence and located two juveniles inside who were detained for investigative purposes. The residence was secured while detectives applied for a residential search warrant. Upon approval of the search warrant by the court, the search conducted resulted in the recovery of two loaded handguns. Both juvenile suspects were charged with various offenses.

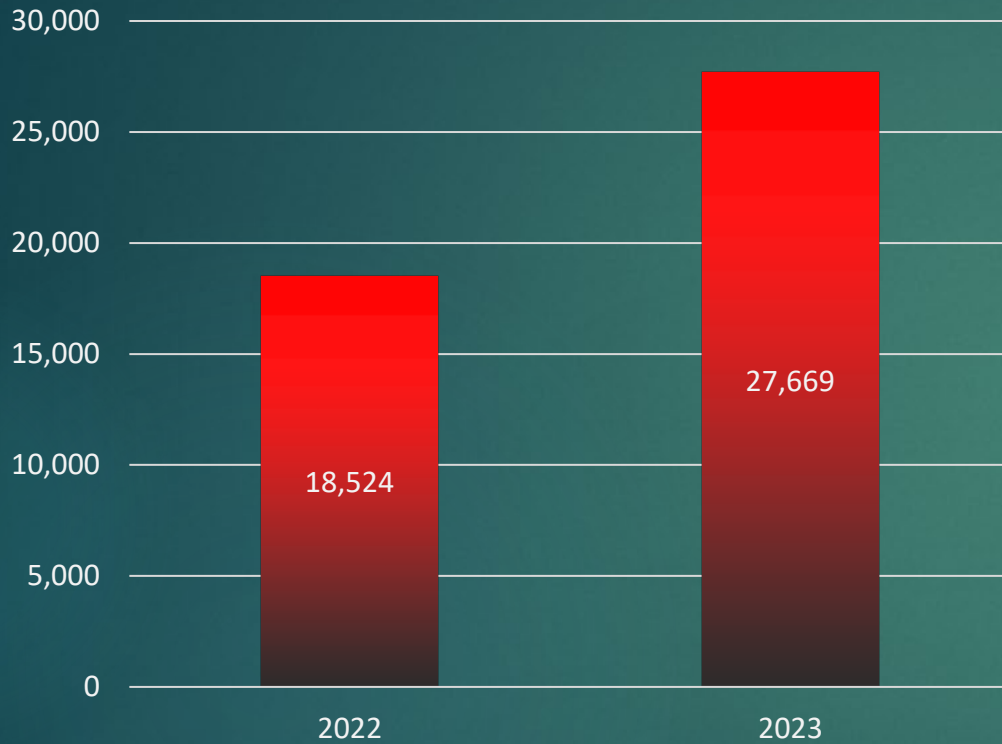

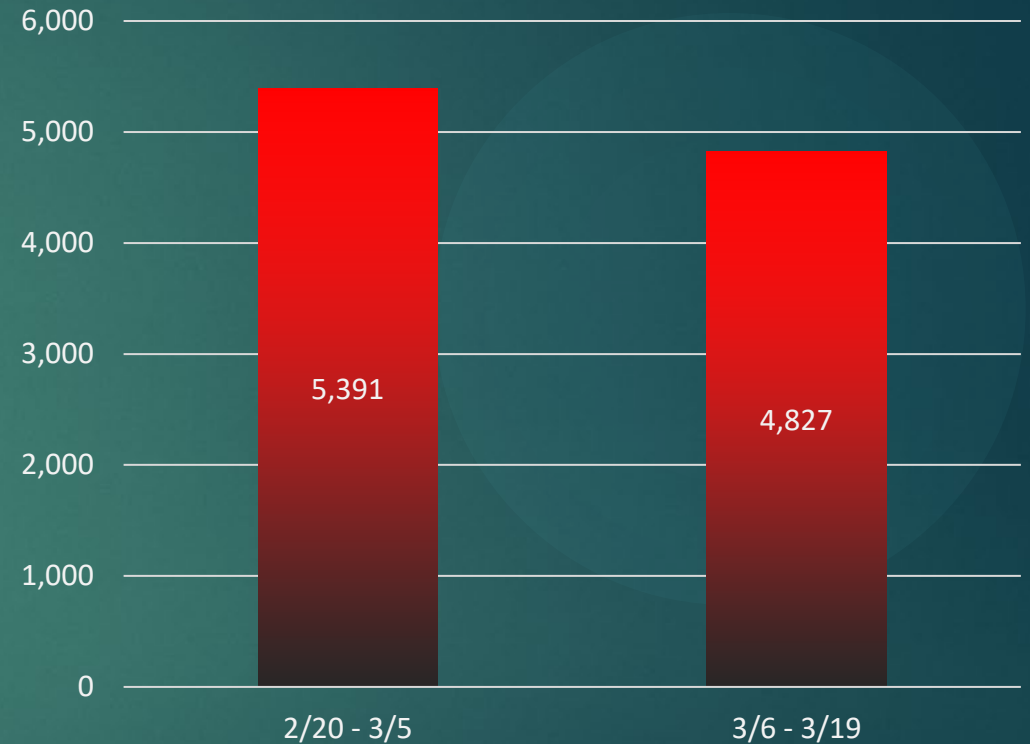
# Calls for Service Overview

CFS (Year to Date Comparison)



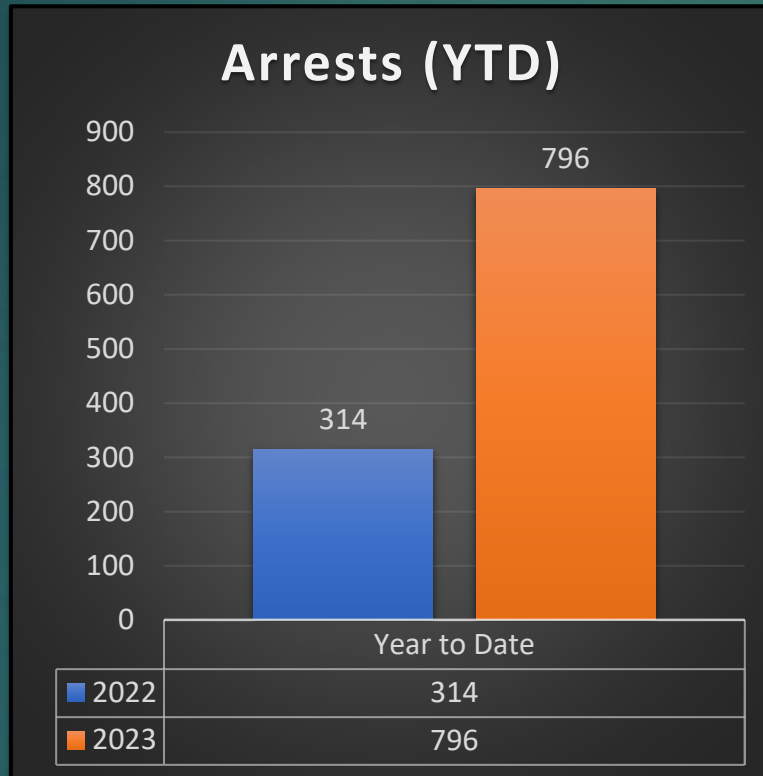
Calls for Service are up **49%** in 2023 vs 2022 YTD.


CFS (2 Week Comparison)

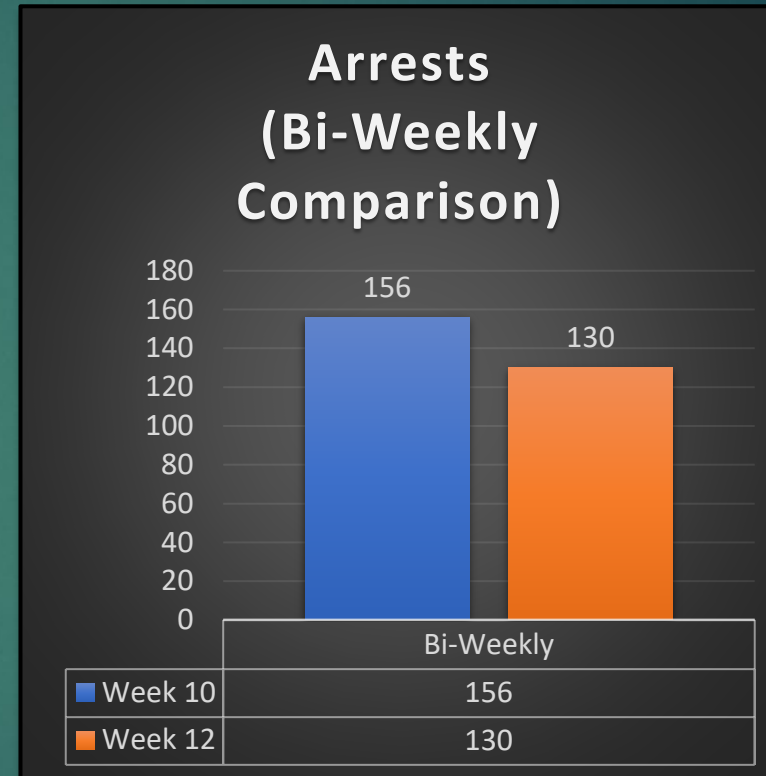



Calls for Service are down **-10%** from Week 10 vs Week 12

# Arrests Overview



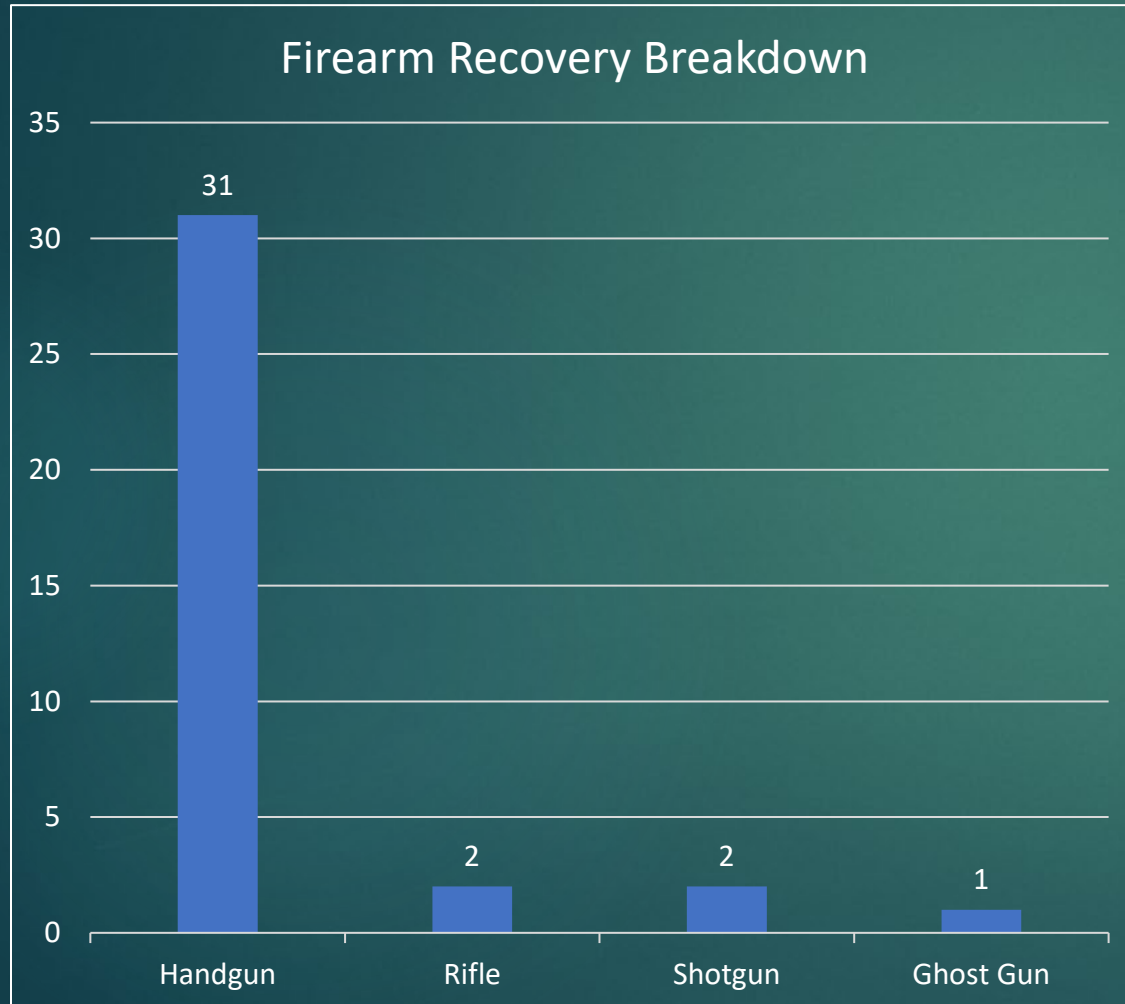

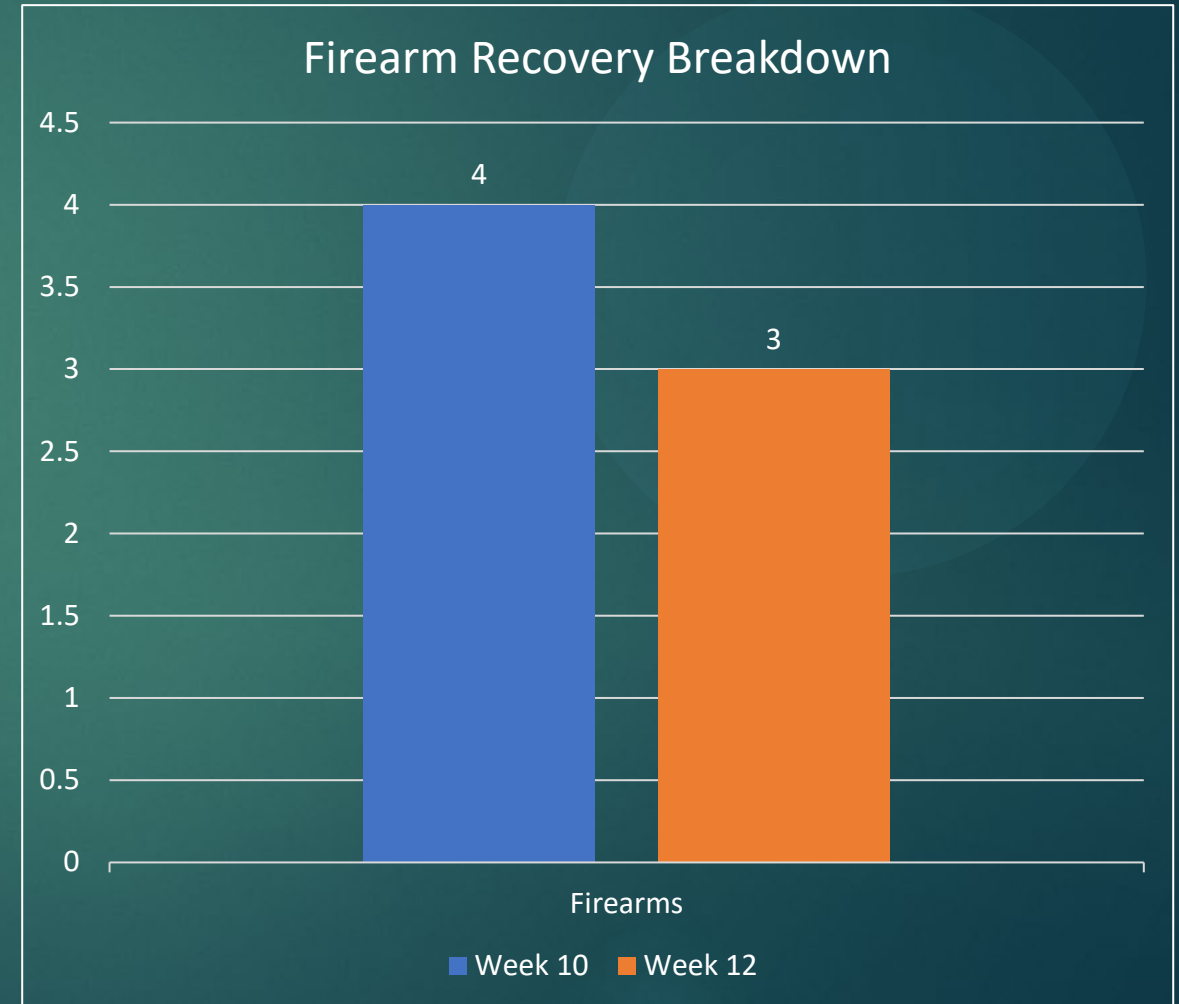
