UPDATE ON ROAD PAVING

Paving on these roads is underway as of this week:

Concern: What is the progress on the tree removal request on 1501 N Ohio Ave?

A:

Planning & Development: Our office has contacted the City's Shade Tree Committee to perform a site visit at 1501 Ohio Ave. Upon their observation and report, we will contact Public Works to schedule a mutually convenient schedule/date to abate the concern.

Q:

Concern: Can we have a follow-up on the lights being out on Connecticut Ave?

A:

Public Works: After assessing the decorative lights on the Connecticut Avenue Center Island, 23 fixtures were out, 2 of these fixtures having broken glass. This lighting (SITIP corridor lighting) was installed in 2010 - Revel Casino. These fixtures are discontinued and we are working with a vendor to locate the parts for it. As of April 3, 2023, the vendor located the bulbs and globes and it will take about 10 days to receive them and make the corrections.

Concern: Can we have more trash cans/lids so that people are not putting their cans out without lids on W Riverside Dr?

A:

Public Works: As of March 31, 2023, they still have not arrived

Concern: Can we have a follow-up on the demolition of houses on New Jersey Ave?

A:

Licensing & Inspections: Asbestos report was received on Friday, March 31st. The property is now set to go out to bid for demolition.

Q:

Concern: Can letters be sent out to new Airbnb residents so they know when to put their trash out?

A:

Licensing & Inspections: Yes. We currently send the property owner a flyer giving them Trash Collection Information:

Chapter 143-27 – Collection devise to be used

Chapter 143-30 – Collection practices and regulations

Their license lists the minimum number of trash containers they are required to have:

1 to 6	1
7 to 11	2
More than 12	3

Q: Concern: Can you address the speeding that is occurring on Maryland Ave?

A: ACPD: Approximately 10 hours of traffic enforcement have been completed utilizing grant funds. As a result, 16 summonses have been issued.

Q:

Concern: Can you check the traffic lights on Arctic Ave so they are synced up and do not take too long?

A:

ACPD: In reference to the traffic light synchronization on Arctic Avenue.

Intersections traveling east on Arctic Avenue were timed starting at Indiana Avenue and ending at Delaware Avenue. Most intersections have an approximate time of 55 seconds on green and 40 seconds on red.

The intersections of Virginia and Arctic and Maryland and Arctic Avenues are unsynchronized. Virginia and Arctic Avenue intersection heading east, the red light takes approximately 1 minute and 20 seconds and 20 seconds on green. Maryland and Arctic Avenue intersection heading east, the red light takes approximately 50 seconds and 30 seconds on green. A request was made to DPW to sync and adjust.

Public Works: We are in the planning stages of the ITS Master Plan for the installation of fiber, traffic signal and synchronization of lights throughout the city.

ACPD: One unregistered vehicle was issued a summons and the owner had it removed.

On March 20, Officers Downey and Seabrook responded to the area of North Carolina Avenue on Boardwalk in regards to a male walking around with a hammer and breaking windows. Officers located the suspect, an individual with known mental health issues and frequent contacts with police, still in possession of the hammer. The officers were able to effectively de-escalate the situation and take the suspect into custody without incident.

Officers were advised that the male had broken windows at two locations on the Boardwalk and possibly several more along Tennessee Avenue. After an investigation, the suspect was charged accordingly.

In keeping with our mission of the At-Risk Initiative program, the suspect was offered social services.

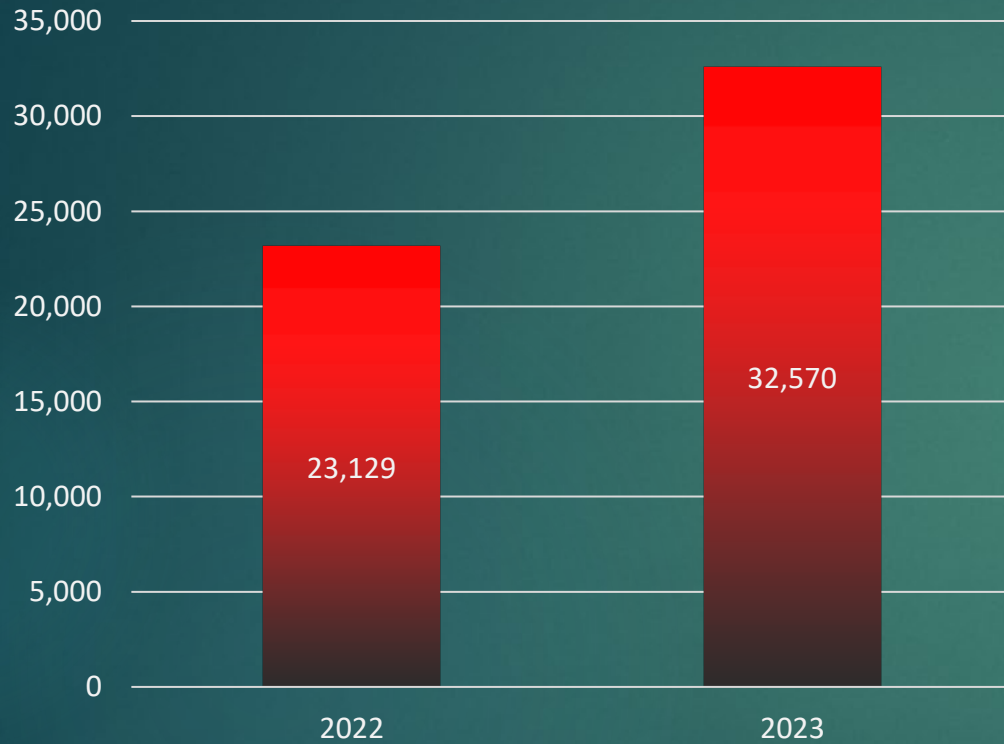

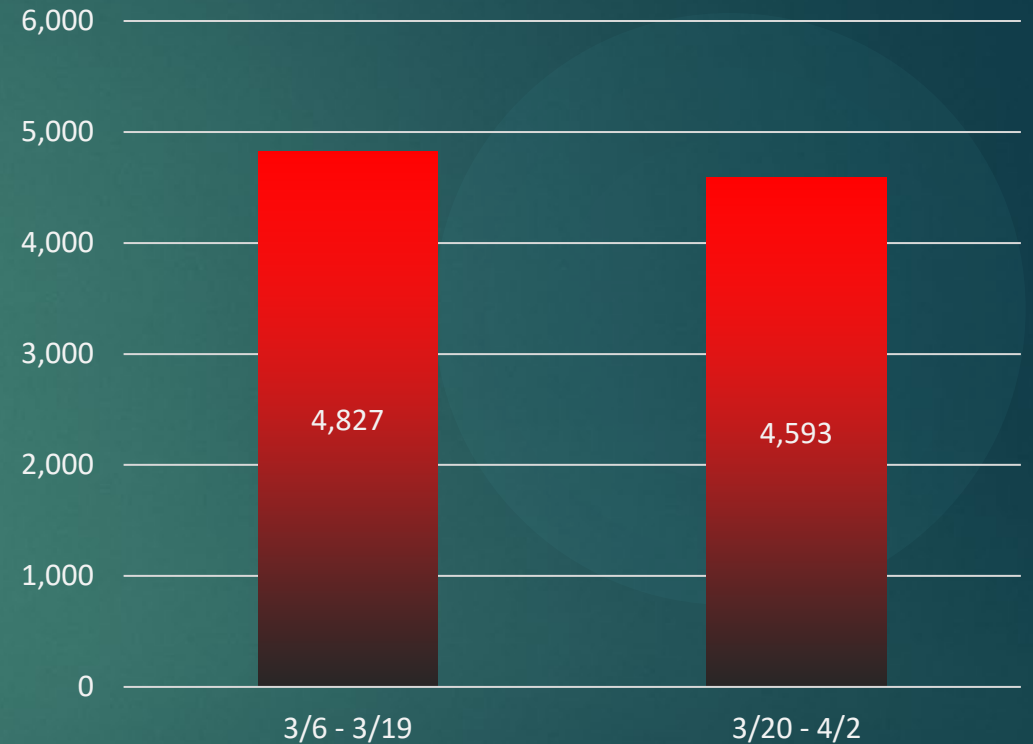
Calls for Service Overview

CFS (Year to Date Comparison)



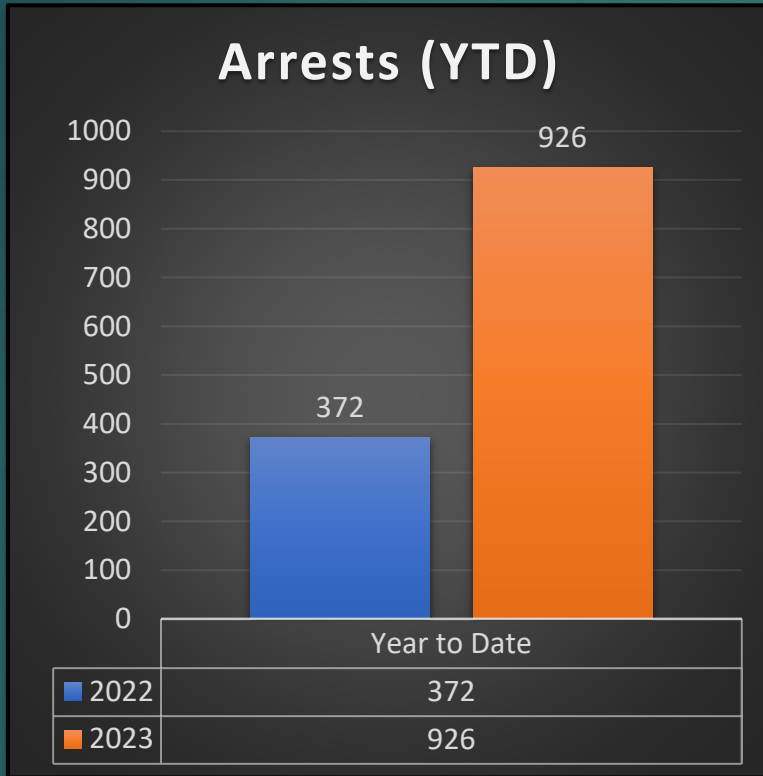
Calls for Service are up **41%** in 2023 vs 2022 YTD.

CFS (2 Week Comparison)

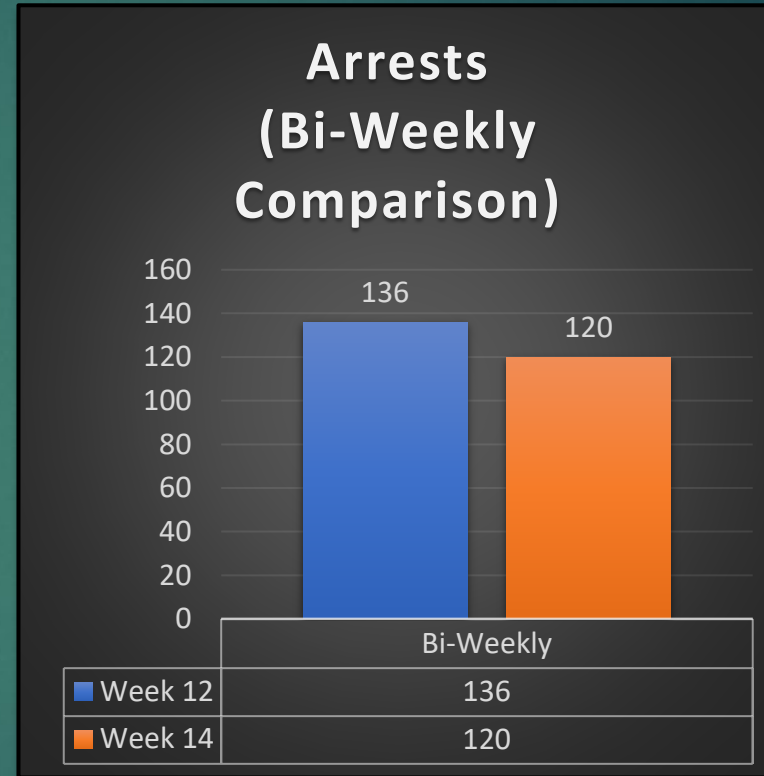


Calls for Service are down **-5%** from Week 12 vs Week 14

Geographic Location



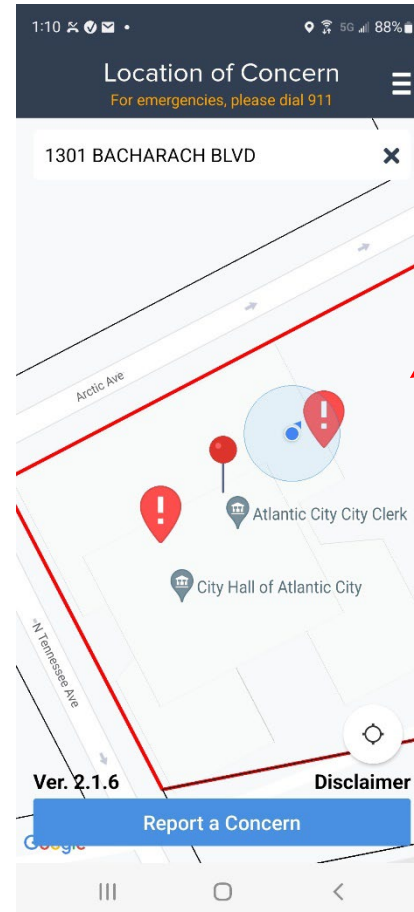
