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Q:

Concern: Can we have an update on the concern of leftovers being left out on Fairmount Ave and what measures are taking place, or can take place to keep this issue from reoccurring?

A:

Health & Human Services: A visit was made to the complainant's address on 4/18 at approximately 2:40pm by Harold Reaves. At the time of the visit there was no one home, so he left his card in the door. He talked to the next door neighbor and asked if he had witnessed any food left unattended in the area lately and was informed that there hadn't been any for some period of time. The man himself, however, did have a box of canned goods on his own porch that had been apparently delivered to him by his sister. The rest of the street was further inspected and nothing unusual was observed.

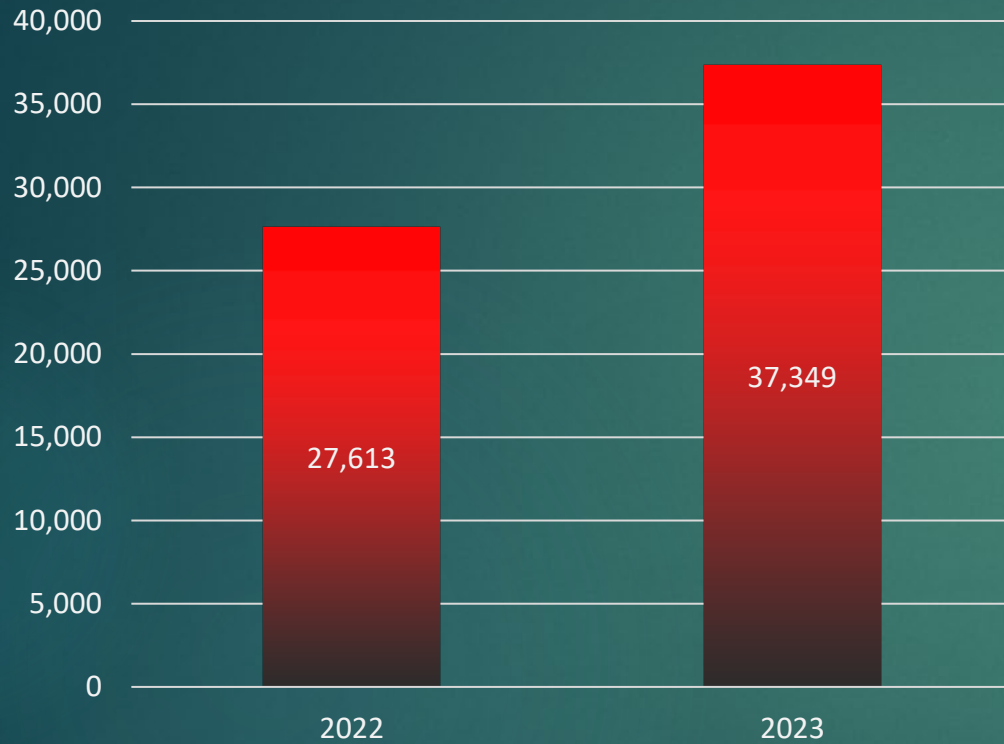

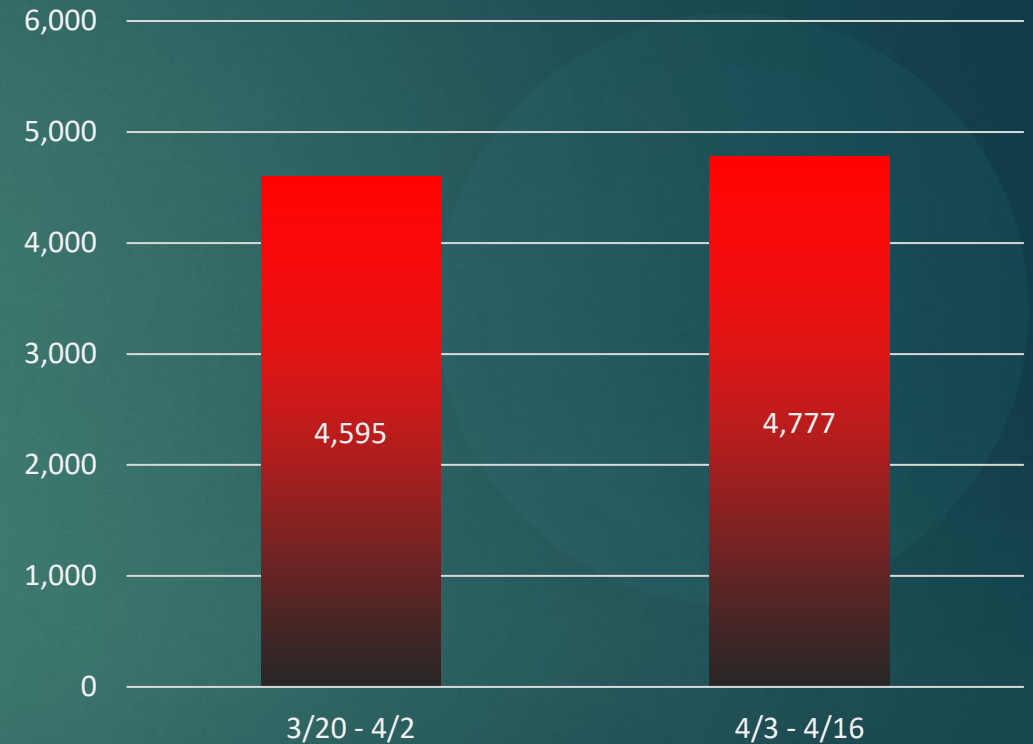
Calls for Service Overview

CFS (Year to Date Comparison)



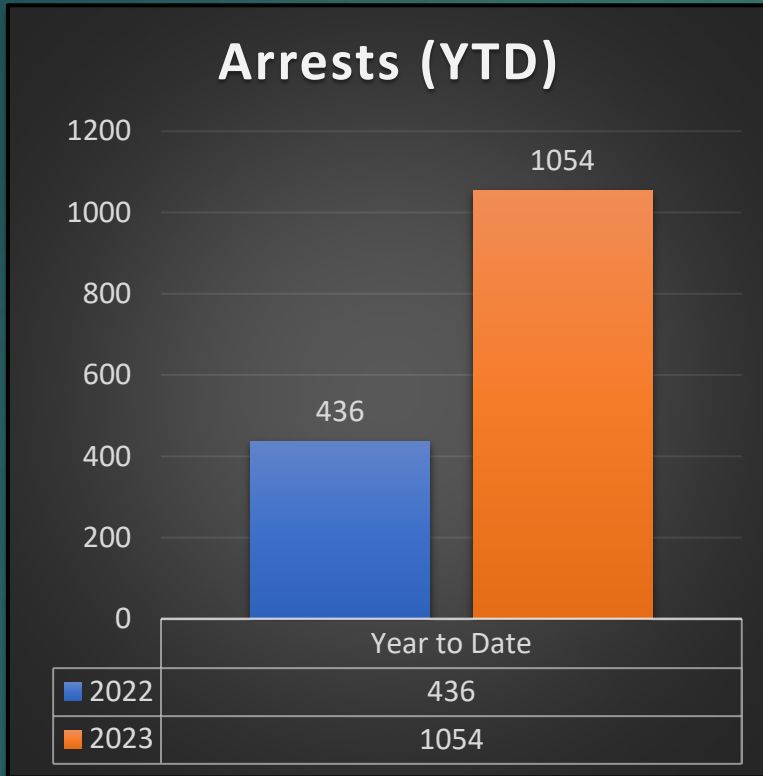
Calls for Service are up **35%** in 2023 vs 2022 YTD.


CFS (2 Week Comparison)

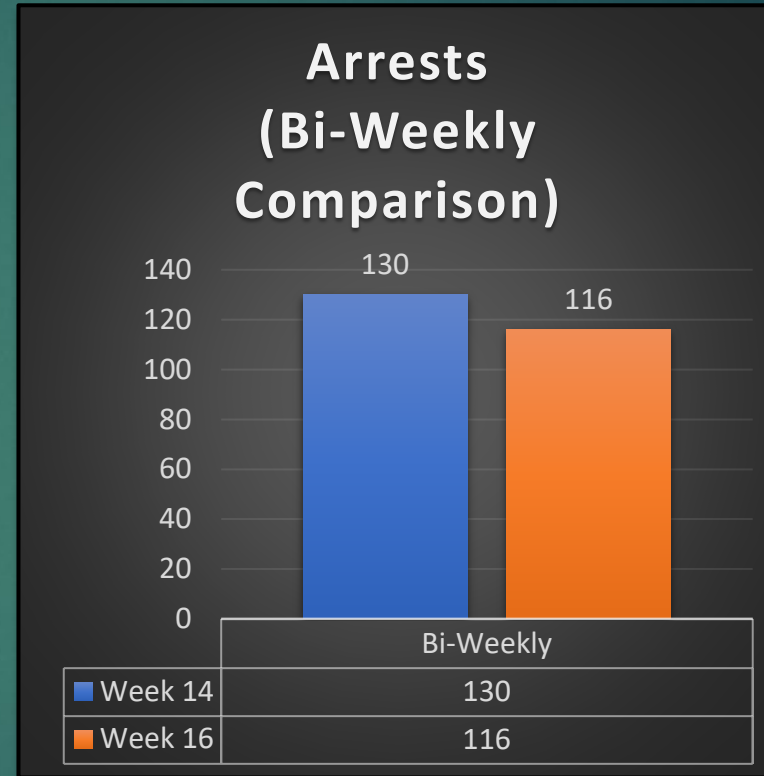


Calls for Service are up **4%** from Week 14 vs Week 16

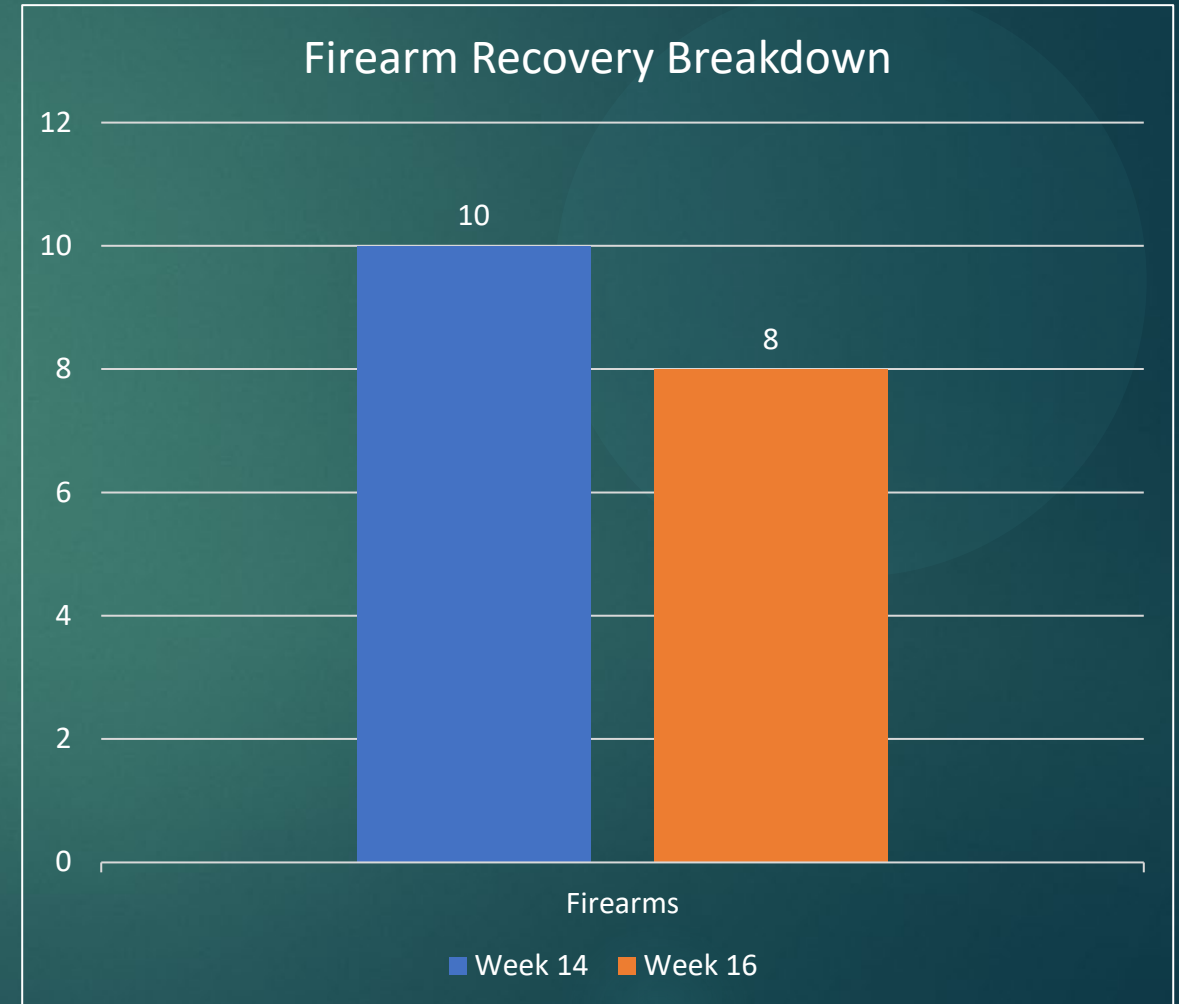
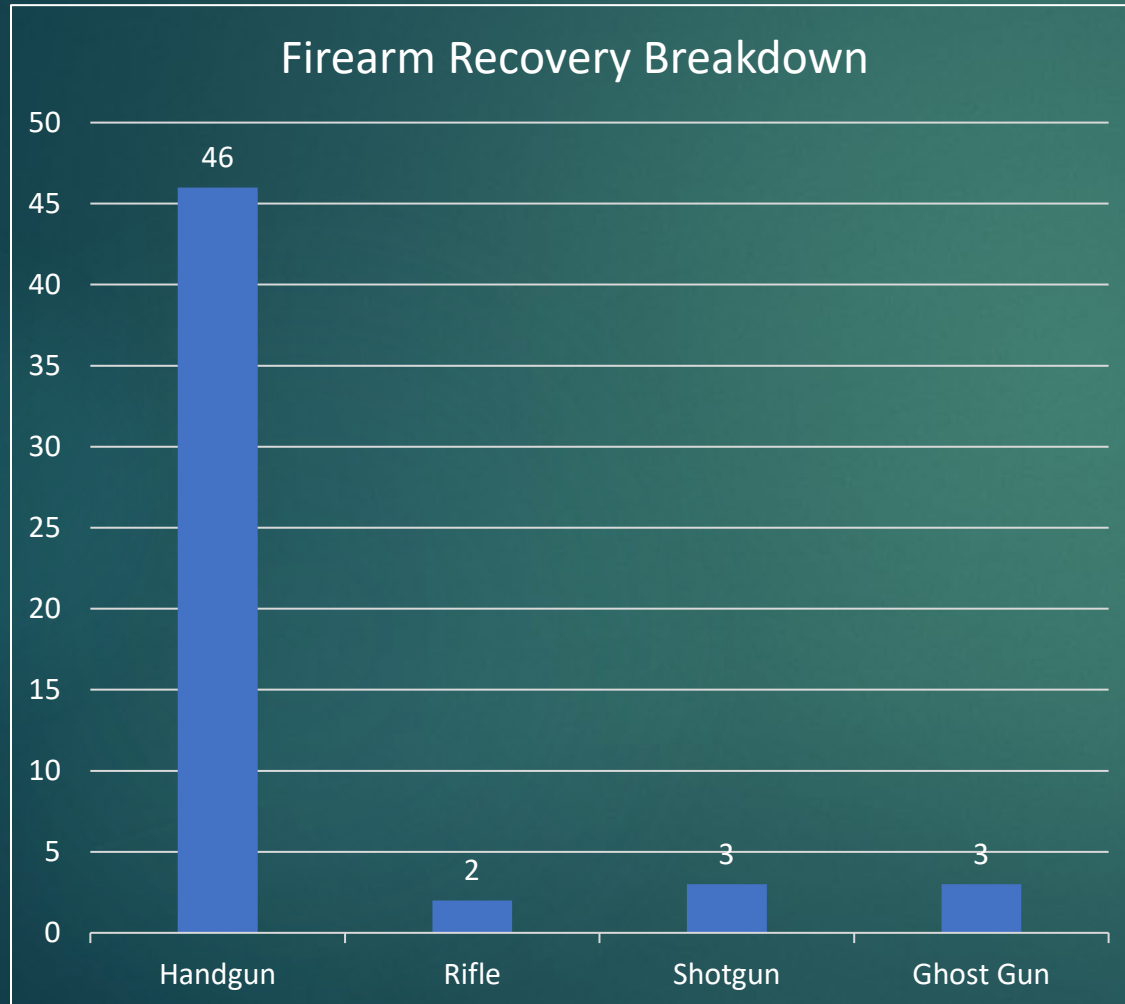

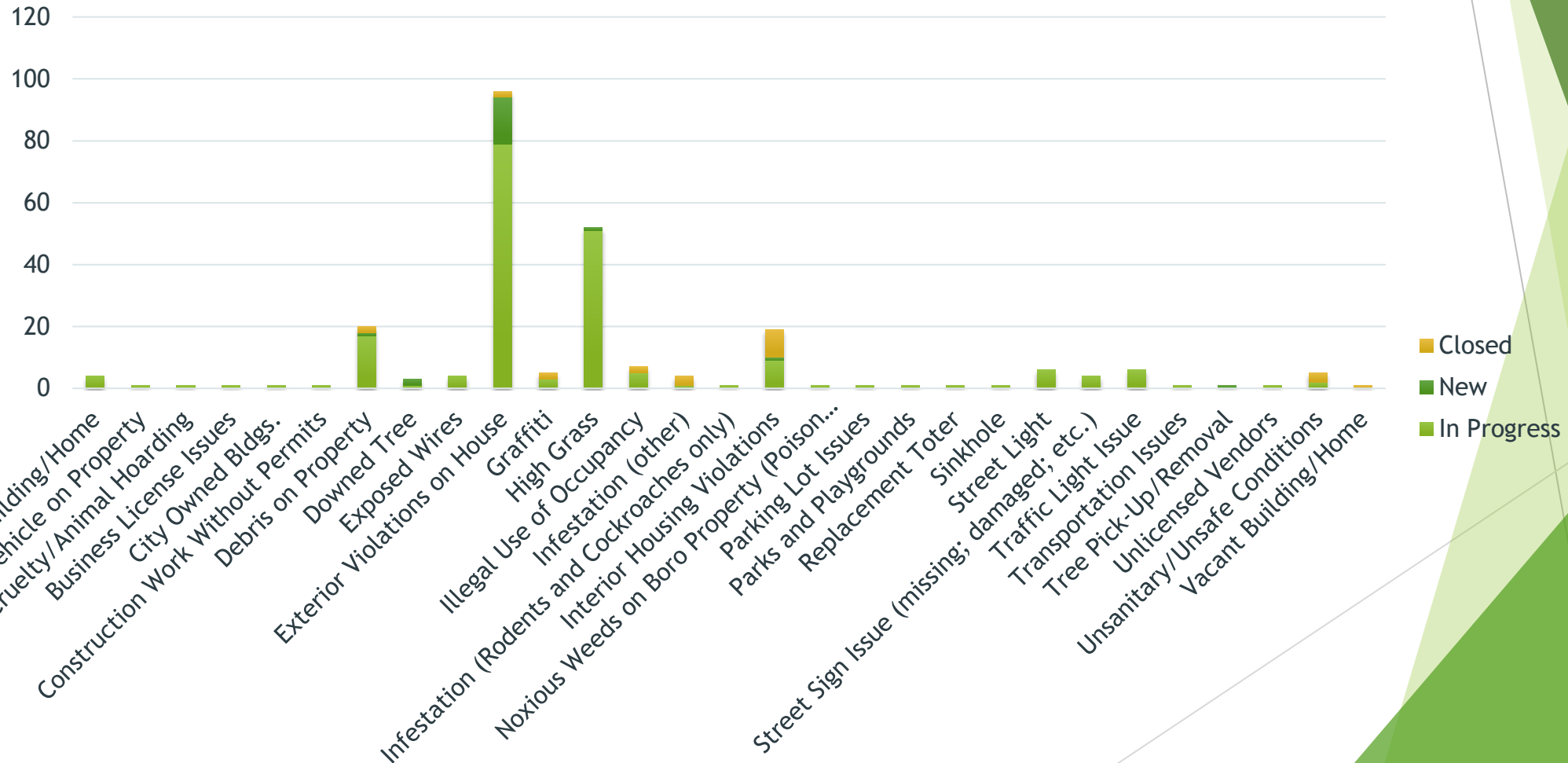
250 Total Report-A-Concern Cases were Received
