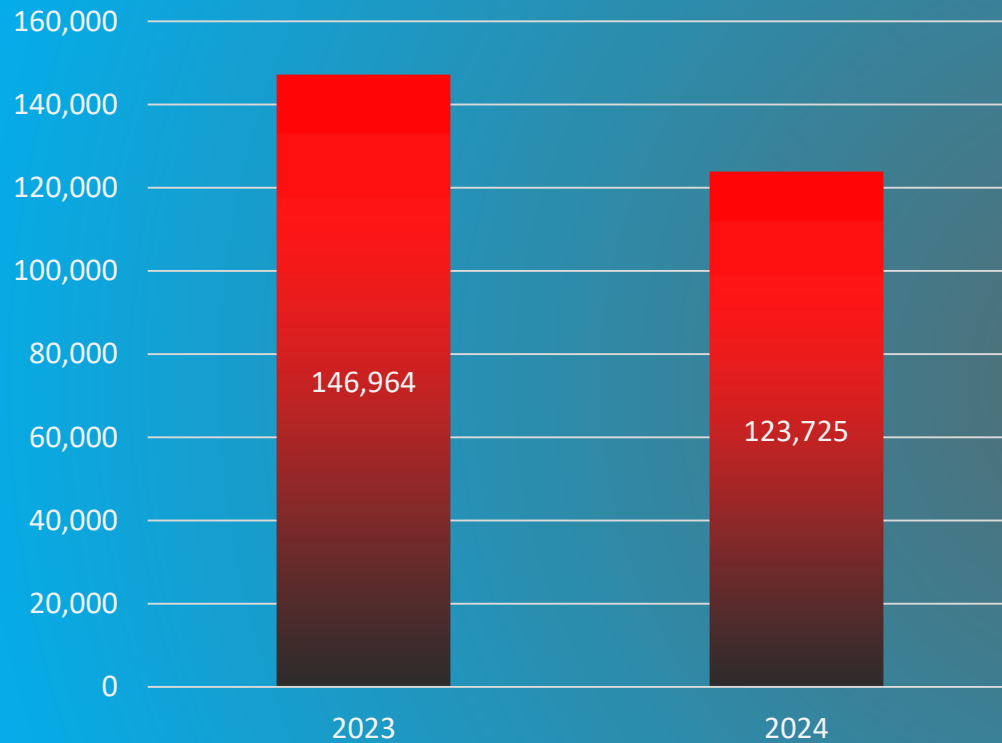

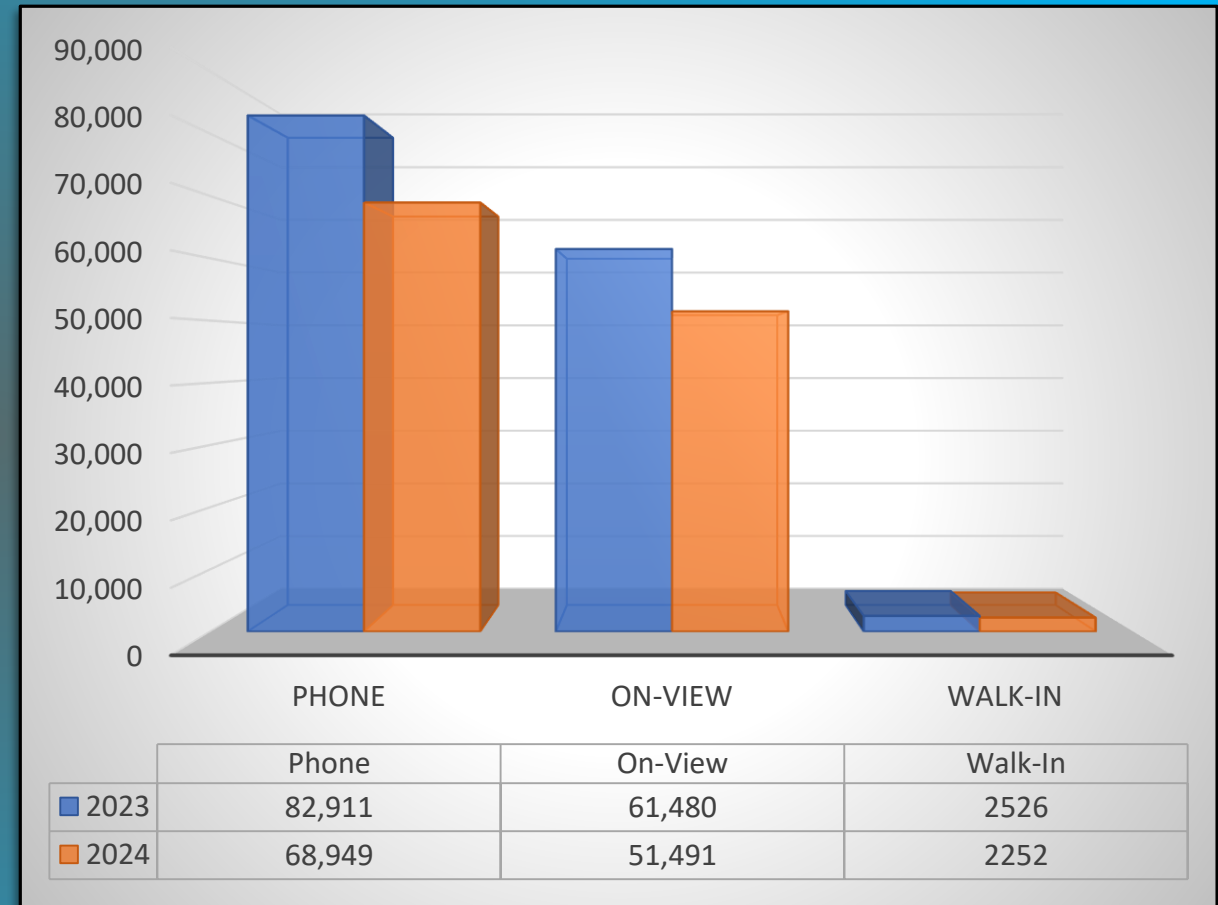

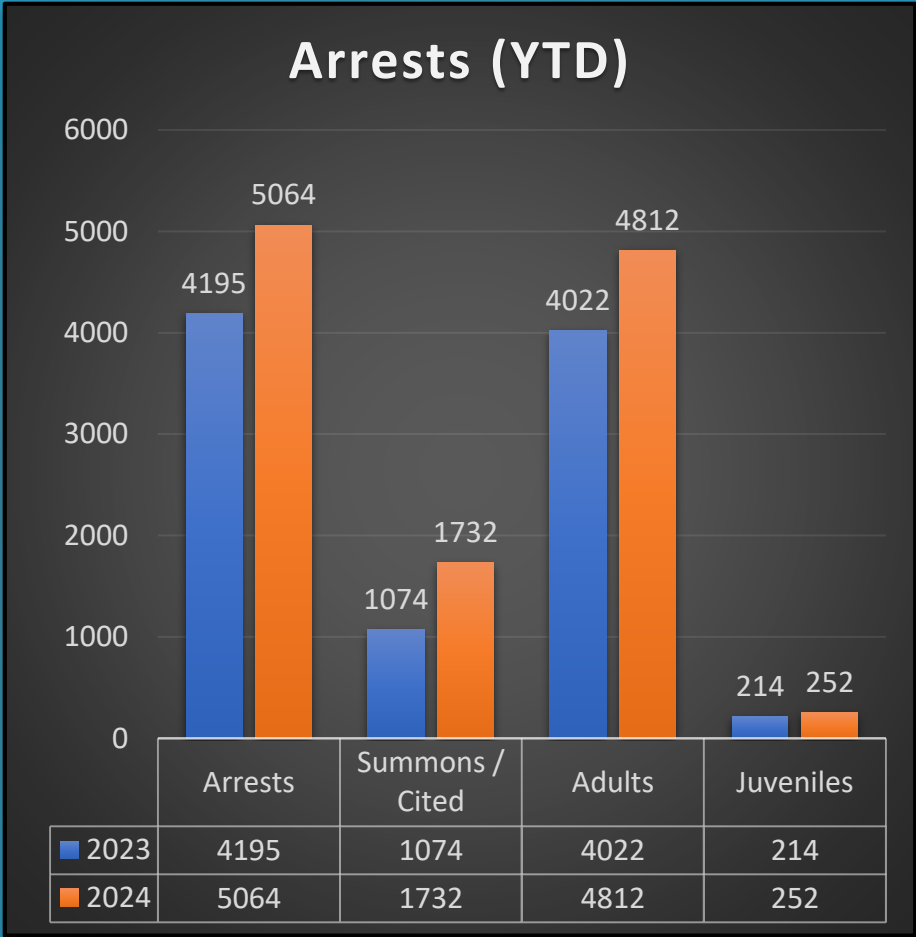
CFS (Year to Date Comparison)

Arrests Overview

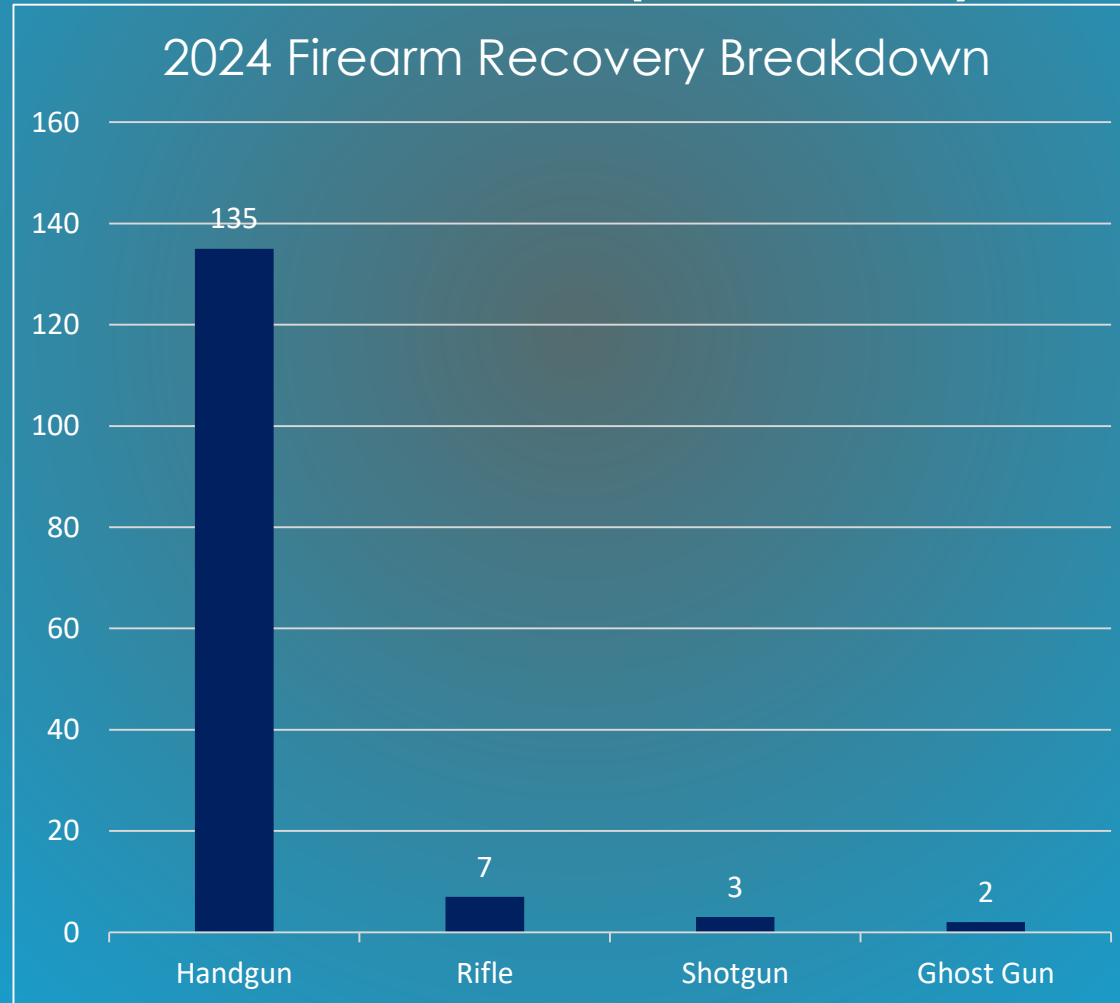

**RECOGNITION ON A JOB WELL
DONE**

Officers Michael Regalbuto and Glen Robinson- Charlie 1 Patrol (Commanded by Lt. Howard Johnson)

On November 29, patrol officers responded to the 1300 block of Baltic Avenue in reference to a suspect entering the home of a woman causing her to lock herself in the bathroom. The suspect and the victim had been involved in a relationship. While inside the residence, the suspect destroyed the victim's belongings. Officers also learned that he assaulted the victim the day prior.

On December 14, Officers Regalbuto and Robinson located the suspect in the 1500 block of Atlantic Avenue. The suspect saw the officers and began to walk away before he began to run. The officers chased the suspect until he attempted to board a New Jersey Transit bus. The officers began to wrestle with the suspect before he was ultimately placed in custody. Officers located a loaded handgun in his pocket.

Officers Regalbuto and Robinson are to be recognized for a job well done!

Bravo 2 Patrol (Commanded by Lt. William Tracy)

On December 16, patrol officers responded to a residence on Brooklyn Avenue for a report of an armed home invasion. Officers arrived to a chaotic scene and found three suspects and victims running in the area. One suspect was observed running and identified by a witness as being involved. He was arrested by Officers La'Tray Butcher and Devin Verdell. A second suspect was arrested by Captain Donnell Holland and Officer Thomas Egan. The final suspect was taken into custody after fleeing from Officer John Bell. Officer Bell initially observed a suspect attempting to hide next to a vehicle. Lampkin led officers on a foot pursuit before being apprehended.

K9 Officer Ryan Mullin and his K9 partner, Rocko, one of the department's explosive detection K9 teams, conducted a search of the area. During the search, K9 Rocko came to a stop where one suspect was observed concealing himself. A loaded handgun was recovered.

Officers learned that a suspect confronted a victim outside the residence while armed with a handgun ordering to be let inside. An occupant unknowingly opened the door and a suspect forced his way into the residence, threatened the occupants, including a teenager, and stole personal belongings. That suspect was later found in possession of these items.

All officers are to be recognized for a job well done!

Officers Moustafa Maarouf and Robert Reynolds, and K9 Carlo-Charlie 1 Patrol (Commanded by Lt. Howard Johnson) and Detective Eric Evans

On December 20, Officer Maarouf conducted a motor vehicle stop in the first block of south Florida Avenue. While speaking to the driver, Officer Maarouf observed a powdery substance believed to be narcotics on his jacket. K9 Officer Reynolds, and his K9 partner, Carlo, who is trained to detect the odor of drugs, assisted in this investigation. K9 Carlo displayed a positive indication for drugs in the vehicle.

Officers searched the vehicle locating a bag of heroin and an empty bag that was believed to contain drugs. Also recovered was multiple handguns in parts, ammunition, several knives and machetes, and assorted add-ons for the handguns including weapon mounted lasers. Once further analyzed, the driver was in possession of three total handguns. He has a criminal history that does not allow him to be in possession of weapons.

A continuing investigation by Detective Evans led to a residential search warrant where an additional handgun was located in the suspect's residence.

All are to be recognized for a job well done!

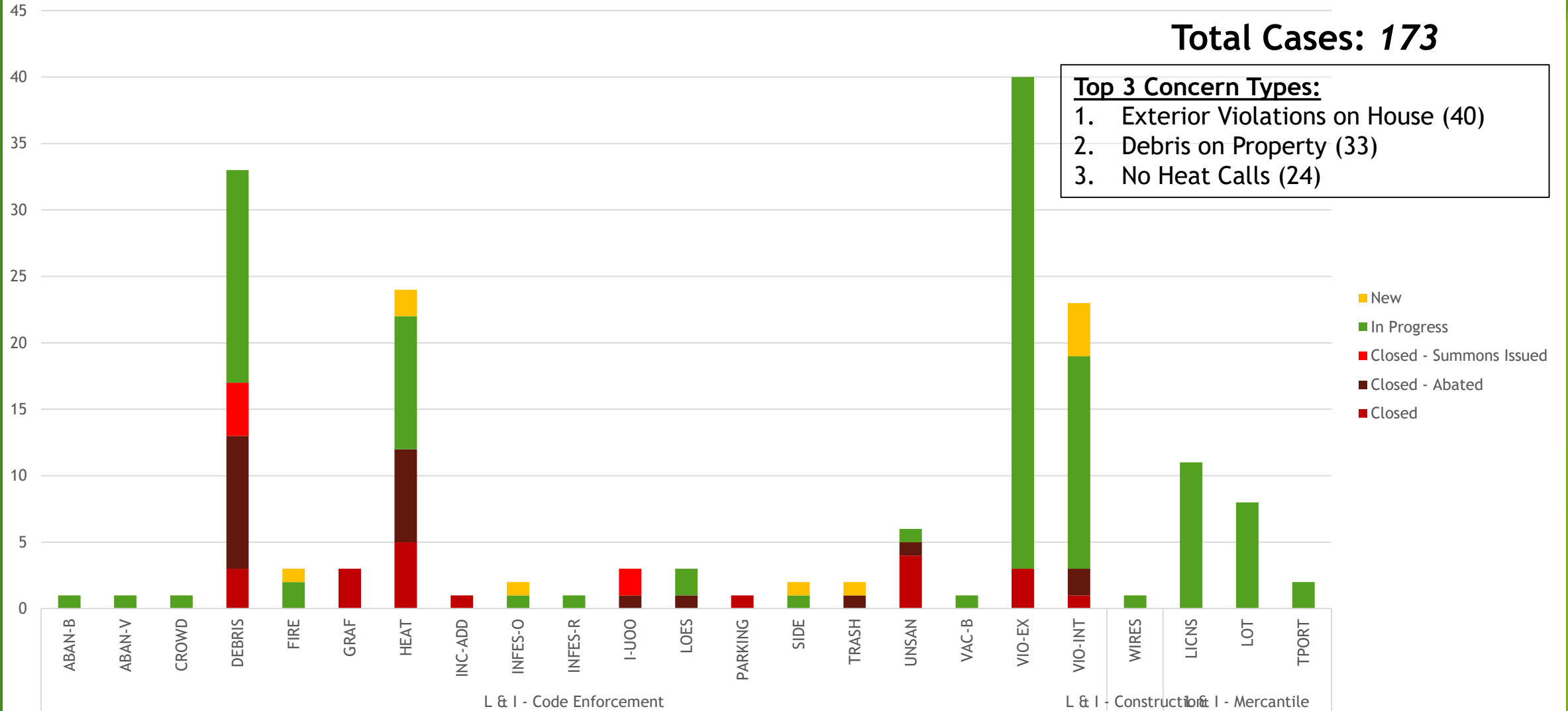

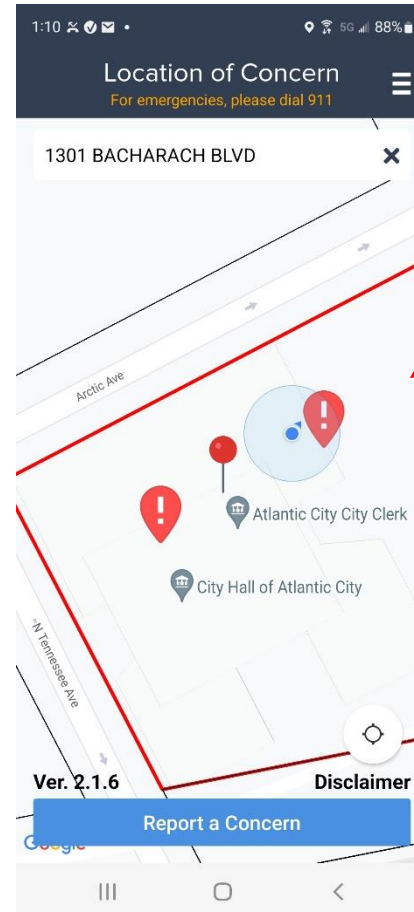

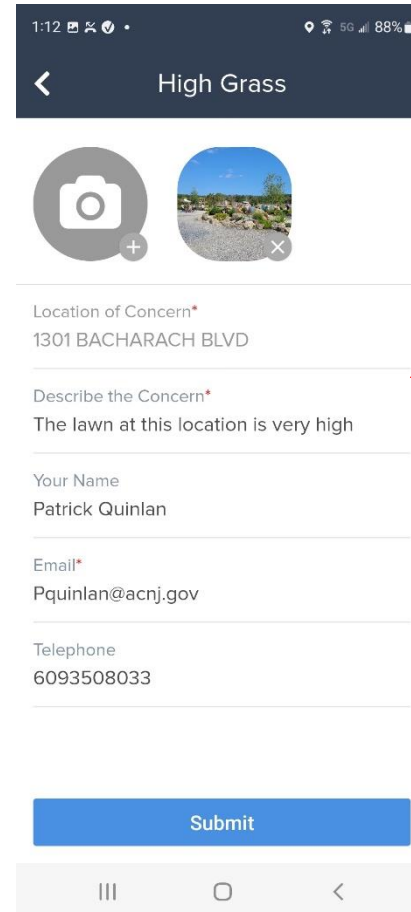
