

AGREEMENT OPTION NO. 1

THIS AGREEMENT OPTION, made and entered into by and between the **CITY OF ATLANTIC CITY**, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey, with its principal offices located at 1301 Bacharach Boulevard, Atlantic City, New Jersey 08401, hereinafter referred to as "**CITY**", and **GOLD MEDAL ENVIRONMENTAL OF NJ, INC.**, with offices located at 309 Salina Road, Sewell, New Jersey 08080, hereinafter referred to as "**CONTRACTOR**", pursuant to Resolution No. 326 adopted by the Council of the **CITY** on May 21, 2025, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 488 adopted July 27, 2022, the City entered into an Agreement with **CONTRACTOR** for **SOLID WASTE & RECYCLING COLLECTION SERVICES** for a period of three (3) years with an option of two (2) one (1) year option periods; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 848 adopted November 21, 2023 City Council approved a **CHANGE TO THE SCOPE OF WORK TO INCLUDE TRASH REMOVAL SERVICES AT BUZBY HOMES AND A 31 UNIT DWELLING AT 3939 VENTNOR AVENUE FOR TWENTY (20) MONTHS FROM DECEMBER 1, 2023 THROUGH JULY 31, 2025** in the amount of **TEN THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED ELEVEN DOLLARS AND SIXTY CENTS (\$10,911.60)** known as Amendatory Agreement No. 1; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 742 adopted October 23, 2024 City Council approved a **CHANGE TO THE SCOPE OF WORK TO INCLUDE REFUSE AND RECYCLING PICK-UP FOR THE HIGH GATE APARTMENT BUILDING, 655 ABSECON BOULEVARD, FOR NINE (9) MONTHS FROM NOVEMBER 1, 2024 THROUGH JULY**

31, 2025 in the amount of **ELEVEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED ELEVEN DOLLARS AND SEVENTY-FIVE CENTS (\$11,211.75)** known as Amendatory Agreement No. 2; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interest of the City to exercise the **FIRST ONE-YEAR OPTION** provision of the Agreement and extend the Agreement with the current contract terms which includes the additional services provided in Amendatory Agreement No. 1 and Amendatory Agreement No. 2. from **AUGUST 1, 2025 THROUGH JULY 31, 2026**, for **SOLID WASTE & RECYCLING COLLECTION SERVICES** in the amount of **THREE MILLION TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO DOLLARS AND EIGHTY CENTS (\$3,279,922.80)** as outlined in the attached proposal, incorporated herein and made a part of this Agreement to be known as **AGREEMENT EXTENSION No. 1**.

WHEREAS, with the exception of the modifications contained herein, all other terms, conditions and provisions of the Agreement between the parties shall remain in full force and effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties agree that the Agreement authorized by Resolution No. 488 adopted by the Council of the **CITY** on July 27, 2022, is hereby amended to include the above referenced first one (1) year option in the amount of **THREE MILLION TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO DOLLARS AND EIGHTY CENTS (\$3,279,922.80)**, to be known as **AGREEMENT OPTION No. 1**.

CONTRACTOR represents that it is in compliance with all laws of the State of New Jersey, all Ordinances of the City of Atlantic City, including Ordinance No. 24 of 1993 and Executive Order No. 1 of 1993, and will remain so for the term of this Agreement and Agreement

Option No. 1, and failure to continue in compliance shall be deemed a breach of the Agreement and this Agreement Option No. 1.

CONTRACTOR cannot assign its rights or obligations under the Agreement without the prior written consent of the CITY.

The Agreement Option No.1 is effective as of August 1, 2025.

RESOLUTION TO EXERCISE THE FIRST ONE-YEAR EXTENSION OF THE TWO-YEAR CONTRACT EXTENSION OPTION FOR GOLD MEDAL ENVIRONMENTAL OF NJ, INC. FOR SOLID WASTE & RECYCLING COLLECTION SERVICES

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 488 of July 27, 2022, the City of Atlantic City entered into an agreement with **GOLD MEDAL ENVIRONMENTAL OF NJ, INC. FOR TRASH REMOVAL SERVICES FOR SOLID WASTE & RECYCLING COLLECTION SERVICES** for a (3) year period from August 1, 2022 to July 31, 2025, with the option of (2) one-year extensions at the discretion of the City; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 848 adopted November 21, 2023, City Council approved a change to the scope of work to include **TRASH REMOVAL SERVICES** at **BUZBY HOMES** and a 31-unit dwelling located at **3939 VENTNOR AVENUE** for twenty (20) months from **DECEMBER 1, 2023, to JULY 31, 2025**, in the amount of **TEN THOUSAND NINE DOLLARS AND FIFTY CENTS (\$10,911.60)** to be known as **AMENDATORY AGREEMENT NO. 1**; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 742 adopted October 23, 2024, City Council approved a change to the scope of work to include **REFUSE AND RECYCLING PICK-UP FOR THE HIGH GATE APARTMENT BUILDING LOCATED AT 655 ABSECON BOULEVARD** for nine (9) months from **NOVEMBER 1, 2024 to JULY 31, 2025**, in the amount of **ELEVEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED ELEVEN DOLLARS AND SEVENTY-FIVE CENTS (\$11,211.75)**, to be known as **AMENDATORY AGREEMENT NO. 2**; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interest of the City to exercise the extension option provision of the contract and extend the contract for the first one-year extension (Year 4 Option) from August 1, 2025 through July 31, 2026. This Year 4 Option includes the additional services provided in **Amendatory Agreement No. 1 and Amendatory Agreement No. 2**.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED City Council of the City of Atlantic City is authorizing the Mayor to execute and the City Clerk to attest to an agreement exercising the first one-year extension provision (year 4 option) of the agreement entered into between the City of Atlantic City and **GOLD MEDAL ENVIRONMENTAL OF NJ, INC. FOR SOLID WASTE & RECYCLING COLLECTION SERVICES** in the amount of **THREE MILLION TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO DOLLARS AND EIGHTY CENTS (\$3,279,922.80)**, approved and adopted by the City Council, said agreement to be approved as to form and execution by the City Solicitor.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Certificate from the Chief Financial Officer has been attached to this Resolution, showing the availability of funds from Account No. 05-01-26-305-400-294 (\$1,366,634.50) and Account No. 06-01-26-305-400-294 (\$1,913,288.30) to satisfy the aforesaid award of contract.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-14.5 the above Contract is contingent upon the availability of sufficient funds in the 2025 and 2026 Temporary and Permanent Budgets, and State approval. In the event said funds are not appropriated for this Contract it will then become null and void.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED Public Notice of this Resolution shall be published in THE PRESS at least once pursuant to the requirements of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et seq., as amended.
