Mayor Small Activates Cold Blue Alert, Urges Residents to Be Vigilant for Neighbors in Need of Shelter

ATLANTIC CITY, N.J. (January 14, 2022) – Mayor Marty Small, Sr. announced today a Code Blue Alert for the City of Atlantic City, which is in effect from 8 p.m. tonight, January 14, through 12 p.m. Sunday, January 16.

Based on the forecast from the National Weather Service (NWS), the expected temperatures during this time period will fall below 32 degrees. Code Blue Alerts are activated when the NWS forecast, including wind chill, is or will be 32 degrees or below.

Atlantic City remains committed to ensuring residents' access to shelter during the winter season. As such, the Atlantic City Rescue Mission will open its doors tonight through Sunday, January 16, to ensure there is a warm, safe place for anyone seeking shelter from the cold. Residents are encouraged to be vigilant for neighbors in need of shelter and to continue checking on youth and elderly residents during the colder months.

The Atlantic City Office of Emergency Management also encourages pet owners to bring their pets indoors during the activation of a Code Blue Alert. Exposure to cold temperatures for an extended period of time can be life-threatening.
