AMENDATORY AGREEMENT NO. 3

THIS AMENDATORY AGREEMENT, made and entered into by and between the **CITY OF ATLANTIC CITY**, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey, with its principal offices located at 1301 Bacharach Boulevard, Atlantic City, New Jersey 08401, hereinafter referred to as "**CITY**", and **GOLD MEDAL ENVIRONMENTAL OF NJ, INC.** with offices located at 309 Salina Road, Sewell, New Jersey 08080, hereinafter referred to as "**CONTRACTOR**", pursuant to Resolution No. 184 adopted by the Council of the **CITY** on March 18, 2026, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 488 adopted July 27, 2022, the **CITY** entered into an Agreement with **CONTRACTOR** for **SOLID WASTE & RECYCLING COLLECTION SERVICES** in the amount of **EIGHT MILLION SIX HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED TWENTY-NINE DOLLARS (\$8,671,629.00)** and by Resolution No. 326 of 2025, the City exercised the first option to extend the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 848 adopted November 21, 2023 City Council approved a **CHANGE TO THE SCOPE OF WORK TO INCLUDE TRASH REMOVAL SERVICES AT BUZBY HOMES AND A 31 UNIT DWELLING AT 3939 VENTNOR AVENUE FOR TWENTY (20) MONTHS FROM DECEMBER 1, 2023 THROUGH JULY 31, 2025** in the amount of **TEN THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED ELEVEN DOLLARS AND SIXTY CENTS (\$10,911.60)** known as **AMENDATORY AGREEMENT No. 1**; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary **TO CHANGE THE SCOPE OF WORK TO INCLUDE REFUSE AND RECYCLING PICK-UP FOR THE HIGH GATE APARTMENT BUILDING, 655 ABSECON BOULEVARD, FOR NINE (9) MONTHS FROM NOVEMBER 1, 2024, THROUGH JULY 31, 2025**, in the amount of **ELEVEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED ELEVEN DOLLARS**

AND SEVENTY-FIVE CENTS (\$11,211.75) to be known as AMENDATORY AGREEMENT No. 2.

WHEREAS, it is again necessary to amend the scope of work to include REFUSE AND RECYCLING PICK-UP FOR THE OCEAN VILLAS CONDOS LOCATED AT 118/132 S. PROVIDENCE AVENUE (19 UNITS) during the term, in the amount of NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-NINE DOLLARS AND FIFTY-TWO CENTS (\$989.52) to be known as AMENDATORY AGREEMENT No. 3.

WHEREAS, with the exception of the modifications contained herein, all other terms, conditions and provisions of the Agreement between the parties shall remain in full force and effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties agree that the Agreement authorized by Resolution No. 488 adopted by the Council of the CITY on July 27, 2022 is hereby amended to include the above referenced change in scope outlined in Resolution No. 184 adopted by Council on March 18, 2026, in the amount of **NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-NINE DOLLARS AND FIFTY-TWO CENTS (\$989.52)** for a new total not to exceed **EIGHT MILLION SIX HUNDRED NINETY-FOUR THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE DOLLARS AND EIGHTY-SEVEN CENTS (\$8,694,741.87)** to be known as **AMENDATORY AGREEMENT No. 3.**

CONTRACTOR represents that it is in compliance with all laws of the State of New Jersey, all Ordinances of the City of Atlantic City, including Ordinance No. 24 of 1993, Executive Order No. 1 of 1993, and will remain so for the term of this Agreement and all extensions and amendments hereto, failure to continue in compliance shall be deemed a breach of the Agreement, and all extensions and amendments hereto.

CONTRACTOR cannot assign its rights or obligations under the Agreement without the prior written consent of the **CITY.**

The Amendatory Agreement No.3 is effective as of the date of complete execution hereof.

EXHIBIT A
MANDATORY EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY LANGUAGE
N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. (P.L. 1975, C. 127)
N.J.A.C 17:27

During the performance of this contract, the contractor agrees as follows:

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex. Except with respect to affectional or sexual orientation and gender identity or expression, the contractor will ensure that equal employment opportunity is afforded to such applicants in recruitment and employment, and that employees are treated during employment, without regard to their age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex. Such equal employment opportunity shall include, but not be limited to the following: employment, upgrading, demotion, or transfer; recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff or termination; rates of pay or other forms of compensation; and selection for training, including apprenticeship. The contractor agrees to post in conspicuous places, available to employees and applicants for employment, notices to be provided by the Public Agency Compliance Officer setting forth provisions of this nondiscrimination clause.

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable will, in all solicitations or advertisements for employees placed by or on behalf of the contractor, state that all qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex.

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, will send to each labor union with which it has a collective bargaining agreement, a notice, to be provided by the agency contracting officer, advising the labor union of the contractor's commitments under this chapter and shall post copies of the notice in conspicuous places available to employees and applicants for employment.

The contractor or subcontractor where applicable, agrees to comply with any regulations promulgated by the Treasurer pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq., as amended and supplemented from time to time and the Americans with Disabilities Act.

The contractor or subcontractor agrees to make good faith efforts to meet targeted county employment goals established in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-5.2.

The contractor or subcontractor agrees to inform in writing its appropriate recruitment agencies including, but not limited to, employment agencies, placement bureaus, colleges, universities, labor unions, that it does not discriminate on the basis of age, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex; and that it will discontinue the use of any recruitment agency which engages in direct or indirect discriminatory practices.

The contractor or subcontractor agrees to revise any of its testing procedures, if necessary, to assure that all personal testing conforms to the principles of job-related testing, as established by the statutes and court decisions of the State of New Jersey and as established by applicable law and applicable Federal court decisions.

In conforming with the applicable targeted employment goals, the contractor or subcontractor agrees to review all procedures relating to transfer, upgrading, downgrading and layoff to ensure that all such actions are taken without regard to age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex, consistent with the statutes and court decisions of the State of New Jersey, and applicable Federal law and applicable Federal court decisions.

The contractor shall submit to the public agency, after notification of award but prior to execution of a goods and services contract, one of the following three documents:

Letter of Federal Affirmative Action Plan Approval

Certificate of Employee Information Report

Employee Information Report Form AA302 (electronically provided by the Division and distributed to the public agency through the Division's website at www.state.nj.us/treasury/contract_compliance)

The contractor and its subcontractors shall furnish such reports or other documents to the Division of Public Contracts Equal Employment Opportunity Compliance as may be requested by the office from time to time in order to carry out the purposes of these regulations, and public agencies shall furnish such information as may be requested by the Division of Public Contracts Equal Employment Opportunity compliance for conducting a compliance investigation pursuant to **Subchapter 10 of the Administrative Code at N.J.A.C. 17:27.**

Council Members RANDOLPH, SHABAZZ, KURTZ & BAILEY present the following Resolution:

RESOLUTION TO AMEND CONTRACT WITH GOLD MEDAL ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES FOR ADDITIONAL REFUSE AND RECYCLING SERVICES FOR OCEAN VILLAS CONDOS FROM APRIL 1, 2026 THROUGH JULY 31, 2026 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$989.52

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 488 of July 27, 2022, the City of Atlantic City entered into an agreement with **GOLD MEDAL ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES FOR SOLID WASTE TRASH REMOVAL AND RECYCLING COLLECTION SERVICES** for a three (3) year period from August 1, 2022 to July 31, 2025, with the option of two (2) additional one-year extensions at the discretion of the City; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 848 adopted November 21, 2023, City Council approved a change to the scope of work to include **TRASH REMOVAL SERVICES** at **BUZBY HOMES** and a 31-unit dwelling located at **3939 VENTNOR AVENUE** for twenty (20) months from **DECEMBER 1, 2023**, to **JULY 31, 2025**, in the amount of **TEN THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED ELEVEN DOLLARS AND SIXTY CENTS (\$10,911.60)** to be known as **AMENDATORY AGREEMENT NO. 1**; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 742 adopted October 23, 2024, City Council approved a change to the scope of work to include **REFUSE AND RECYCLING PICK-UP FOR THE HIGH GATE APARTMENT BUILDING LOCATED AT 655 ABSECON BOULEVARD** for nine (9) months from **NOVEMBER 1, 2024** to **JULY 31, 2025**, in the amount of **ELEVEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED ELEVEN DOLLARS AND SEVENTY-FIVE CENTS (\$11,211.75)**, to be known as **AMENDATORY AGREEMENT NO. 2**; and

WHEREAS, it is again necessary to amend the scope of work to include **REFUSE AND RECYCLING PICK-UP FOR THE OCEAN VILLAS CONDOS LOCATED AT 118/132 S. PROVIDENCE AVENUE (19 UNITS)** from April 1, 2026 through July 31, 2026, in the amount of **NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-NINE DOLLARS AND FIFTY-TWO CENTS (\$989.52)** to be known as **AMENDATORY AGREEMENT No. 3**.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED City Council of the City of Atlantic City is authorizing the Mayor to execute and the City Clerk to attest to an agreement to amend the scope of work to include **REFUSE AND RECYCLING PICK-UP FOR THE OCEAN VILLAS CONDOS LOCATED AT 118/132 S. PROVIDENCE AVENUE (19 UNITS)** for four (4) months, from April 1, 2026 through July 31, 2026, to be known as **AMENDATORY AGREEMENT No. 3** in the amount of **NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-NINE DOLLARS AND FIFTY-TWO CENTS (\$989.52)**, approved and adopted by the City Council, said agreement to be approved as to form and execution by the City Solicitor.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Certificate from the Chief Financial Officer has been attached to this Resolution, showing the availability of funds from Account No. 06-01-26-305-400-294 to satisfy the aforesaid award of contract.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-14.5 the above contract is contingent upon the availability of sufficient funds in the 2026 Temporary and Permanent Budgets, and State approval. In the event said funds are not appropriated for this contract it will then become null and void.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED Public Notice of this Resolution shall be published in THE PRESS at least once pursuant to the requirements of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et seq., as amended.
