THIS ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT, made and entered into by and between the **CITY OF ATLANTIC CITY**, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey, with its principal offices located at 1301 Bacharach Boulevard, Atlantic City, New Jersey 08401, hereinafter referred to as "**CITY**", and **PAULUS, SOKOLOWSKI, & SARTOR, LLC**, with offices located at 3 Mountainview Road, Warren, New Jersey 07059, hereinafter referred to as "**PS&S**".

WHEREAS, the **CITY** and **MARATHON ENGINEERING & ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES, INC. ("MARATHON")** entered into multiple agreements for various projects in the City, some of which are still active; and

WHEREAS, **MARATHON** after having its assets purchased by **PS&S**, is no longer a going concern, and would like to assign those agreements to **PS&S** whereby **PS&S** shall step into the shoes of **MARATHON** and assume all liabilities and obligations of **MARATHON** as set forth in the agreements and all amendments thereto; and

WHEREAS, **CITY** is amenable and agrees to such assignment and agrees that **MARATHON** and **PS&S** have provided all the required information outlined in the Assignment provision of the agreements; and

WHEREAS, with the exception of the modifications contained herein, all other terms, conditions and provisions of the active agreements shall remain in full force and effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties agree that the agreements between **CITY** and **MARATHON** are hereby assigned to **PS&S** upon complete execution hereof.

PS&S represents that it is in compliance with all laws of the State of New Jersey, all Ordinances of the City of Atlantic City, including Ordinance No. 24 of 1993, Executive Order No. 1 of 1993, and will remain so for the term of all active agreements, and failure to continue in compliance shall be deemed a breach of the agreements.

PS&S cannot assign its rights or obligations under the agreements without the prior written consent of the CITY.

This Assignment Agreement is effective as of the date of complete execution hereof.

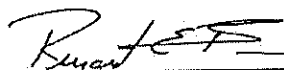

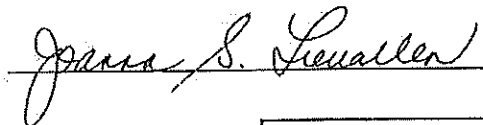
