2024 JUSTICE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM AWARD

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

This agreement is made and entered into between the City of Atlantic City, NJ and the County of Atlantic, NJ acting by and through their governing bodies, witnessed the:

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice has a 2024 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program (JAG) that is available to municipalities: 03

WHEREAS, the City of Atlantic City did apply for the grant;

WHEREAS, the Department of Justice, through the JAG, has made a total eligible Joint Allocation of \$59,776 available to the above-named jurisdictions;

WHEREAS, each governing body, in performing governmental functions or in paying for the performance of governmental functions hereunder, shall make that performance or those payments from current revenues legally available to that party; and

WHEREAS, Each governing body finds that the performance of this Agreement is in the best interests of both parties, that the undertaking will benefit the public, and that the division of costs fairly compensates the performing party for the services or functions under this agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlantic City agrees to provide the County of Atlantic \$0.00 from the JAG award; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlantic City and the County of Atlantic believe it to be in their best interests to reallocate the JAG funds

NOW THEREFORE, the COUNTY and CITY agree to the follows:

SECTION 1

The City of Atlantic City agrees to accept \$59,776 of JAG Funds

SECTION 2

The City of Atlantic City agrees to use the \$59,776 of JAG funds in compliance with the JAG guidelines for the length of the award; a period from the first fiscal year of the award through the following three years:

SECTION 3

The County of Atlantic agrees to allow the City of Atlantic City to retain the full amount of the \$59,776 of JAG funds.

SECTION 4

Nothing in the performance of the agreement shall impose any liability for claims against any of the parties to this agreement other than claims for which liability may be imposed by the laws of the State of New Jersey.

SECTION 5

Each party to this agreement will be responsible for its own action in providing services under this agreement and shall not be liable for any civil liability that may arise from the furnishing of the services by the other parties.

SECTION 6

The parties of this Agreement do not intend for any third party to obtain a right by this virtue of this Agreement:

SECTION 7

By entering into this Agreement, the parties do not intend to create any obligations express or implied other than those set out herein; further, this Agreement shall not create any rights in any party not a signatory hereto.

AUTHORIZATION TO APPLY FOR AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR THE BJA FY25 BODY-WORN CAMERA POLICY AND IMPLEMENTATION PROGRAM TO SUPPORT LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES-50% MATCH

WHEREAS, the US Department of Justice is accepting applications for the BJA FY25 Body-Worn Camera Policy and Implementation Program to Support Law Enforcement Agencies; and

WHEREAS, this program is available to units of local government; and

WHEREAS, the 2025 Body-Worn Camera Policy and Implementation Program supports publicly funded law enforcement and correctional agencies in establishing or expanding body-worn camera (BWC) programs; and

WHEREAS, a fifty percent match is required; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlantic City carefully considers grant programs that assist the City in achieving projects and programs that are priorities for the community; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that City Council of the City of Atlantic City formally authorizes a grant application for the above stated grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to submit a grant application on behalf of the City of Atlantic City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the grant agreement on behalf of the City of Atlantic City and that their signature constitutes acceptance of the terms and conditions of the grant agreement and approves the execution of the grant agreement.
