

AMENDATORY AGREEMENT NO. 2

THIS AMENDATORY AGREEMENT, made and entered into by and between the **CITY OF ATLANTIC CITY**, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey, with its principal offices located at 1301 Bacharach Boulevard, Atlantic City, New Jersey 08401, hereinafter referred to as "**CITY**", **BLANEY DONOHUE & WEINBERG, P.C.**, located at 2123 Dune Drive, Suite 11, Avalon, NJ 08202, a hereinafter referred to as "**COUNSEL**", pursuant to Resolution No. 892 adopted by the Council of the **CITY** on December 17, 2025, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 840 of 2024, the **CITY** entered into an Agreement with **COUNSEL** for **LABOR AND MUNICIPAL DEFENSE MATTERS** in the amount of **TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$25,000.00)**; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 662 approved on September 17, 2025, it was necessary and in the best interest of the City of Atlantic City to ensure fair and competitive compensation for legal services to maintain the quality and effectiveness of its legal representation during labor negotiations to increase the hourly rate from \$130 per hour to \$185 per hour; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for **ADDITIONAL LABOR COUNSEL SERVICES** in the amount of **TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$20,000.00)** to be known as **AMENDATORY AGREEMENT NO. 2**; and

WHEREAS, with the exception of the modifications contained herein, all other terms, conditions, and provisions of the Agreement between the parties shall remain in full force and effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties agree that the Agreement authorized by Resolution No. 840 adopted by the Council of the City on December 18, 2024, is hereby amended to include the above referenced additional labor counsel services outlined in Resolution No. 892 adopted by Council on December 17, 2025 in the amount

of **TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$20,000.00)** for a new total not to exceed **FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$45,000.00)** to be known as **AMENDATORY AGREEMENT No. 2.**

COUNSEL represents that it is in compliance with all laws of the State of New Jersey, all Ordinances of the City of Atlantic City, including Ordinance No. 24 of 1993, Executive Order No. 1 of 1993, and will remain so for the term of this Agreement and Amendatory Agreement No. 2, and failure to continue in compliance shall be deemed a breach of the Agreement and this Amendatory Agreement No. 2.

COUNSEL cannot assign its rights or obligations under the Agreement without the prior written consent of the **CITY.**

Amendatory Agreement No.2 is effective as of the date of complete execution hereof.

Council Members MARSHALL, RANDOLPH, SHABAZZ & BAILEY present the following Resolution:

RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AN AGREEMENT WITH BLANEY DONOHUE & WEINBERG, P.C. FOR LABOR MATTERS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000.00

WHEREAS, the City of Atlantic City has a need to retain legal counsel for Labor matters and the City has advertised for and received Qualifications under a fair and open process; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated term of this contract is from January 1, 2026, to December 31, 2026, in the amount of **FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$50,000.00)**; and

WHEREAS, **BLANEY DONOHUE & WEINBERG, P.C.**, have indicated their firm will provide legal services for Labor matters as directed by the City Solicitor from January 1, 2026, to December 31, 2026; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 666 of 2024, the City of Atlantic City entered into an Agreement with **BLANEY DONAHUE & WIENBERG, P.C.** in the amount **TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND (\$25,000.00)** for Labor matters; and

WHEREAS it is necessary to continue additional Labor matters in the amount of **TWENTY-THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$20,000.00)** from account 5-01-20-155-100-291 to be known as **AMENDATORY AGREEMENT No. 2**; and

WHEREAS, the rate of **ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$185.00)** shall apply to all new and ongoing labor negotiation matters as determined appropriate.; and

WHEREAS, the vendor must comply with the New Jersey Campaign Contribution and Expenditures Reporting Act, codified at N.J.S.A. 19:44A-1 et seq., and N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5; and

WHEREAS, **BLANEY DONOHUE & WEINBERG, P.C.** has completed and submit a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that **BLANEY DONOHUE & WEINBERG, P.C.** has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the City of Atlantic City and/or City Council in the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit **BLANEY DONOHUE & WEINBERG, P.C.** from making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor is duly authorized to execute and the City Clerk to attest a contract to be approved as to form and execution by the City Solicitor, which contract shall provide for the purchase of legal services, in Labor matters from **BLANEY DONOHUE & WEINBERG, P.C.** at the rate of **ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$185.00)** for all new and ongoing labor negotiation matters as determine appropriate, **ONE HUNDRED THIRTY DOLLARS (\$130.00)** for **EACH HOUR** expended by an attorney for civil actions pursuant to Resolution No. 225 of 2014, and **THIRTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$35.00)** for **EACH HOUR** expended by a paralegal on behalf of the City, for a term not to exceed (1) year, commencing January 1, 2026 and ending December 31, 2026 for a total sum not to exceed **FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$50,000.00)**; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Atlantic City that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute and the City Clerk to attest to an **AMENDATORY AGREEMENT NO. 2** with **BLANEY DONOHUE & WEINBERG, P.C.** in an amount not to exceed **TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$20,000.00)** to be known as **AMENDATORY AGREEMENT NO 2**; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Certificate of Funds from the Chief Financial Officer are attached to this Resolution, showing the availability of funds, and specifying the line-item appropriation from the 2025 and 2026 Budget to satisfy the aforesaid amount(s) owed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-14.5, the award of the aforesaid Agreement is contingent upon the availability of sufficient funds in the 2025 and 2026 Temporary and Permanent Budgets specifying the line-item appropriation and in the event said funds are not appropriated for this Agreement, this award will have no effect and will then be null and void.
