THE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION MUST INCLUDE **ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:**

- **Complete Scholarship Application Packet-** Each participant is only allowed **ONE SUBMISSION with all materials submitted together.** Packets submitted with missing documents will be **disqualified.**
- **Resume-** Should be formatted as a resume, no longer than one page, single spaced using font size 12
- **High School Students-** Your school acceptance letter **AND** latest high school transcript, *unofficial copies are acceptable.* Transcripts **must be included** in the application. Do not have your school mail them separately.
- **College/Graduate Students-** Proof of current Atlantic City residency **AND** latest transcript. For newly accepted graduate students, please provide acceptance letter.
- **A Two-Page Essay** using ***MLA format (sample attached).*** This includes **Times New Roman in 12-point font, double-spacing, 1" page margins on 8.5" by 11" paper, and ½" indent for new paragraphs.** Essays must be typed in a Microsoft Word document or equivalent. Please answer one of the following prompts according to your current education level:

- **Graduating High School Seniors and Trade School Applicants:**

Atlantic City is a city of resilience, opportunity, and transformation. How has your personal journey and specific life experiences shaped your decision to pursue higher education?

- **Current College Students (Undergraduate):**

Your college experience often shapes your perspective on the world and your role in it. How has your college education shaped your perspective of life thus far?

- **Graduate & Doctoral Students:**

Atlantic City faces unique economic, social, and environmental challenges. What do you consider to be the single most important societal problem in our community? With your advanced degree, how do you plan to address this issue and create sustainable change?

- **Two Letters of Recommendation** - One of those letters must be from an educator or staff attesting to your character
- **In-Person or Zoom Interview May Be Required**
- **Additional Significant Information** you would like the Committee to consider.
