Atlantic City Anti-Violence Division's Job Fair Assists More Than 600 Individuals Seeking Employment

Atlantic City, N.J. (March 12, 2025) – The City of Atlantic City's One Neighborhood Evolution Anti-Violence Division organized a Job Fair on Tuesday, March 11, 2025 at All Wars Memorial Building that helped more than 600 individuals ages 18 and older connect with 40 companies in the area. Job seekers gained valuable networking connections and were given on-the-spot interviews with potential employers, consisting of Atlantic City Casinos, local dining establishments and other area businesses, organizations and service providers. Some participants received immediate job offers, while many others successfully secured follow-up interviews.

The Job Fair also featured resume and interview workshops led by the City of Atlantic City's Human Resources Department to give job seekers the guidance needed to further elevate their careers. The Anti-Violence division partnered with the Atlantic County Probation Department, the Atlantic/Cape May Superior Court System, and Volunteers of America for this Job Fair. A goal of this event was to reduce violence through economic empowerment and by creating opportunities.

One Neighborhood Evolution strives to give Atlantic City residents, in particularly the youth, opportunities they may not otherwise have. For example, at the start of the month, they brought a group of Atlantic City children to the Barclays Center in Brooklyn, New York for the Lamont Roach vs Gervonta "Tank" Davis boxing match. The Anti-Violence division also has a Lift Warrant event scheduled for April 9th from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM at All Wars Memorial Building (1510 Adriatic Avenue) where individuals with outstanding matters in Atlantic City Joint and Atlantic County Central Municipal Courts will have the opportunity to see a judge.
