Mayor Small Issues Statement After Superior Court Rules Against Restraining Atlantic Avenue Road Diet

Atlantic City, N.J. (December 22, 2023) – City of Atlantic City Mayor Marty Small, Sr. is issuing the following statement after Superior Court of New Jersey Judge Michael J. Blee, today, ruled there was not enough support in the request by the Atlantic City Casino Association and AtlantiCare to restrain the ‘Road Diet’ project from moving forward:

“Some very powerful people have been trying to stop this project since its inception, but the Small administration has been standing up to all of them. People keep wanting to make this about traffic flow, but this project is being done in the name of safety for the residents and visitors of the Great City of Atlantic City, not to mention the taxpayers don’t have to spend a dime to get their streets paved and traffic lights synchronized. Atlantic Avenue is one of the most dangerous streets in the state, and we are making every effort to fix that. I’m happy to say striping will continue along Atlantic Avenue as we enter the new year, so we can ensure cleaner and safer streets in Atlantic City in 2024.”
