NJDEP MS4 (**Watershed Inventory Report**)
Fact Sheet
March 2026

Atlantic City (and all NJ municipalities) are permitted to manage and treat municipal stormwater under **NJMS4 (Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4))** municipal permits, including but not limited to stormwater design, collection, treatment, infrastructure and maintenance activities required per its permit.

To meet its permit obligations, Atlantic City (and all municipalities) were required to prepare and file an **MS4 (Watershed Inventory Report)** with the NJDEP. An interim draft of this WIP Phase 1 assessment report was completed for Atlantic City and filed prior to the January 1, 2026 regulatory deadline.

This current (draft) report will be modified to include additional storm water infrastructure data (also obtained for Atlantic City) and review comments and input from the NJDEP, Atlantic City staff and the public.

As part of the permit process, two (2) semi-annual public meetings are required to make the public aware, and to solicit questions or comments regarding the WIP plan.
