Police Investigating Physical Altercation at Harrah's Resort

The Atlantic City Police Department is investigating a physical altercation that resulted in a man sustaining a facial laceration.

On July 13, 2026, at 3:54 AM, patrol officers responded to Harrah's Resort Atlantic City in reference to a physical altercation involving a knife. Upon arrival, officers learned that the victim was transported to AtlantiCare Regional Medical Center, City Division, to be treated for non-life-threatening injuries prior to police arrival.

Officers learned that the victim and Keontay Long became involved in a verbal dispute that escalated into a physical altercation. During the incident, the victim was assaulted by Long, Kevan Winkle, and Tori Sylvanus and sustained a laceration to his face after Long used a knife.

Following the incident, Long and Winkle fled the area, while Sylvanus remained on scene. Harrah's security identified and located Long and Winkle and detained all three until police arrived. The knife was also recovered.

ARRESTED: Tori Sylvanus, 27, of Brooklyn, NY.

CHARGES: Simple Assault

ARRESTED: Kevan Winkle, 25, of Brooklyn, NY.

CHARGES: Aggravated Assault, Possession of a weapon, Possession of a weapon for Unlawful Purpose, and Conspiracy.

ARRESTED: Keontay Long, 26, of Brooklyn, NY.

CHARGES: Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon, Aggravated Assault, Possession of a Weapon, Possession of a Weapon for Unlawful Purpose (two counts), and Conspiracy.

These charges are merely an accusation and not proof of guilt. In all criminal cases, a charged defendant is presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
