Prescription Drug Drop Off Box

The Atlantic City Police Department and The New Jersey Division of Consumer Affairs is joining the effort to halt the abuse and diversion of prescription drugs.

For too many New Jerseyans, addiction begins in the medicine cabinet. Our effort to halt the abuse and diversion of prescription drugs therefore begins at home – and allows consumers to dispose of their unused, unwanted or expired medications safely and securely, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and 365 days a year in the Project Medicine Drop Box located in lobby of The Atlantic City Police Department Public Safety Building, 2715 Atlantic Avenue Atlantic City, NJ.

For safety reasons, the Project Medicine Drop boxes can only accept solid medications such as pills, patches, inhalers, and similar objects. The boxes cannot accept liquids, medical waste, or syringes.
