Dear Venice Park neighbors and residents,

This letter is to notify you that the City of Atlantic City, through the Engineer's Office and South State Inc., will begin to implement major infrastructure improvements in Venice Park with the commencement of construction on the First Venice Park Bridge (over Penrose Avenue) on Monday, December 6. As part of this project, the first bridge will be closed to vehicular and pedestrian traffic as the bridge will be replaced in its entirety.

What does this mean?

- Beginning Wednesday, December 1, message boards and detour signs will be placed within the vicinity of the bridge to remind motorists of the upcoming bridge closure.
- Beginning Monday, December 6, the bridge will be closed to all vehicular and pedestrian traffic. Additionally, Ohio Avenue, from East Riverside Drive to Horace Bryant Jr. Drive, will be closed for the duration of the construction. Residents will be directed to use the detour route:
 - **Detour Route Traveling East on Ohio Avenue:** Motorists will be directed to the Eastbound service road on Eastbound Route 30 and to Huron Avenue.
 - **Detour Route Traveling West on Ohio Avenue:** Motorists will be directed to the MLK/Route 30 Intersection to Route 30 in order to access the Westbound service road adjacent to Route 30 Westbound and Gramercy Avenue.
