RECOGNITION ON A JOB
WELL DONE



Officers Rebecca Seabrook and Salvatore Rando - Alpha 2 Platoon (Commanded by Lieutenant Jody Hersh)

Officer Rando was flagged down by a boardwalk ambassador in reference to a male that appeared to be in distress in the ocean at Hartford Avenue.

Officer Rando immediately responded to the beach and located the male, Darren Brathwaite, in waist high water. Brathwaite appeared distraught and refused initial commands to exit the water.

Officer Seabrook responded and removed her duty belt and entered the water in an effort to engage Brathwaite. After a brief conversation, Brathwaite exited the ocean. Based on their conversation, an investigation determined that Brathwaite was wanted for attempted murder in Brooklyn, NY from a domestic violence incident that had recently occurred.

The officers are to be recognized for a job well done!

Sergeant Daniel Arra and Officer Louis Scarlata, Christian Feliciano, William Palmer - Bravo 1 Platoon- (Commanded by Lt. Robert Macready)

Bravo 1 officers were dispatched to a suicidal male that was armed with sharp object threatening to hurt himself and others. Officer Palmer initially began a dialogue with the male who was holding a razor blade to his neck. Sergeant Arra, a CNT member, responded to the scene and took over the conversation with the male.

As Sergeant Arra attempted to keep the male calm, he demanded the officers shoot him and began walking towards the officers refusing their orders to stop. Officer Scarlata deployed his non-lethal taser, briefly incapacitating the male, allowing the officers to disarm him. The male was ultimately unharmed and was transported by ambulance to AtlantiCare Regional Medical Center, City Division, for further evaluation and treatment.

Detectives Chris Dodson and Alberto Valles and Officers Troy Grams, Latray Butcher, Adrian Nunez-Santos, and K9 Narco

Officers were conducting surveillance in the area of the first block of south Texas Avenue when they observed Antoyane McCall holding a clear plastic bag of suspected cocaine.

The officers converged on McCall who put the cocaine in his pocket. The cocaine, along with heroin, were recovered and McCall was placed in custody.

McCall's vehicle was parked in the street and found to be unregistered with the State of New Jersey. Officer Nunez-Santos and K9 Narco, a narcotic detection canine, were summoned to the scene. K9 Narco gave a positive indication for the presence of narcotics in the vehicle. A search of the vehicle revealed narcotic paraphernalia used in the manufacturing of distribution of cocaine and heroin and additional narcotics. In total, detectives recovered more than 18 grams of cocaine, 510 bags of heroin, less than two grams of fentanyl, 255 Oxycodone pills, and more than \$10,000 in cash.

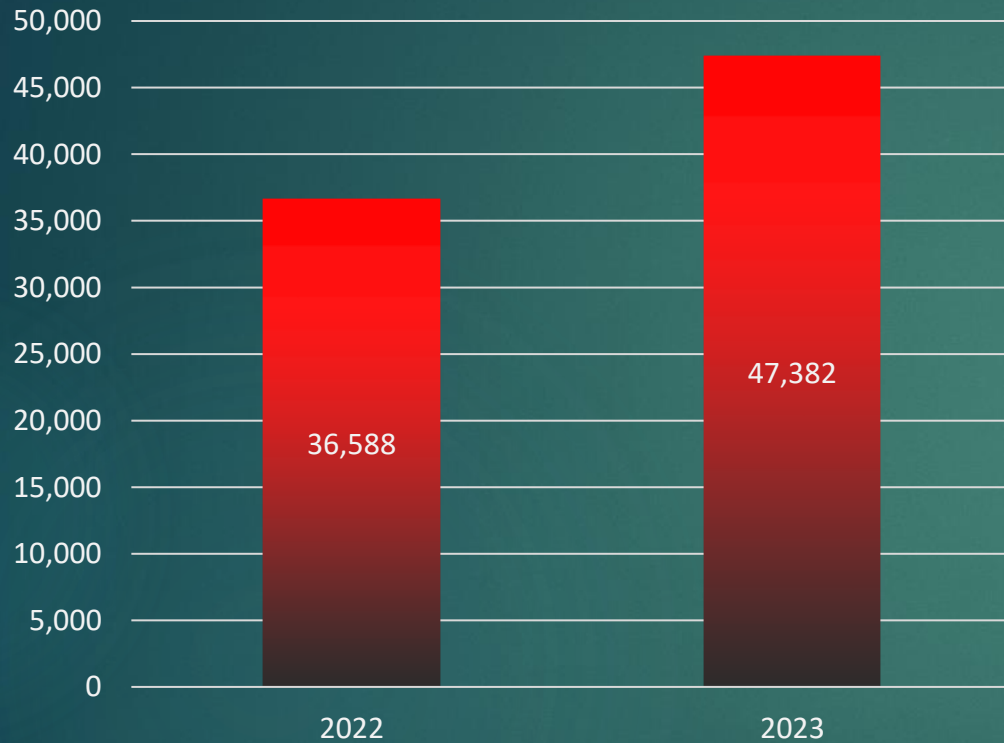

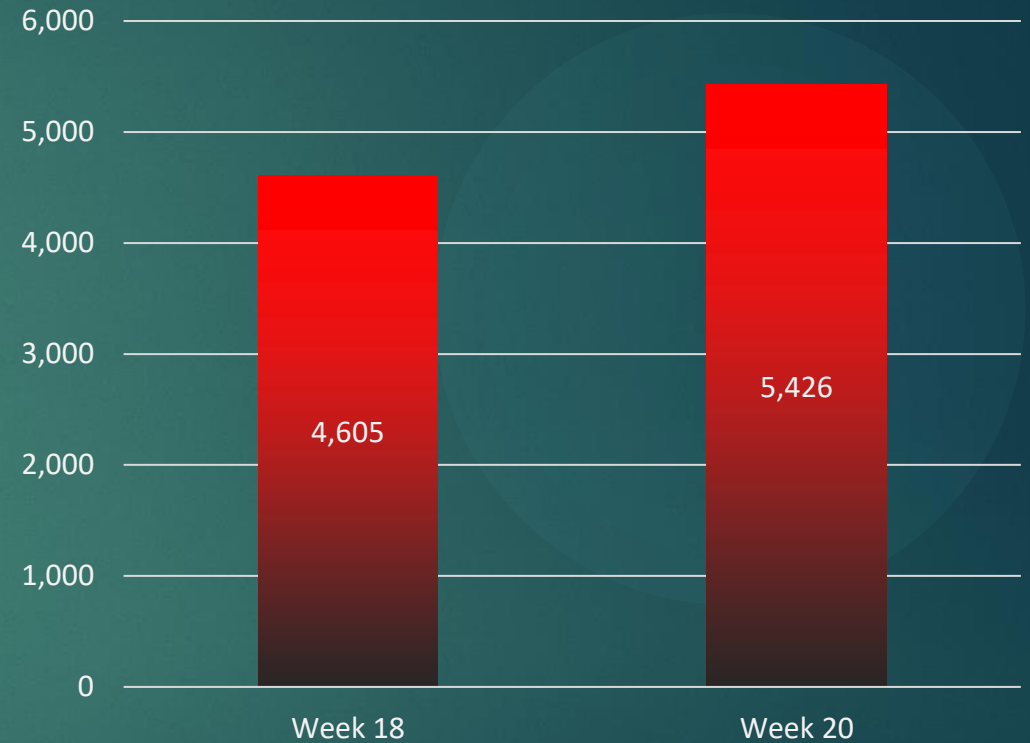
Calls for Service Overview

CFS (Year to Date Comparison)



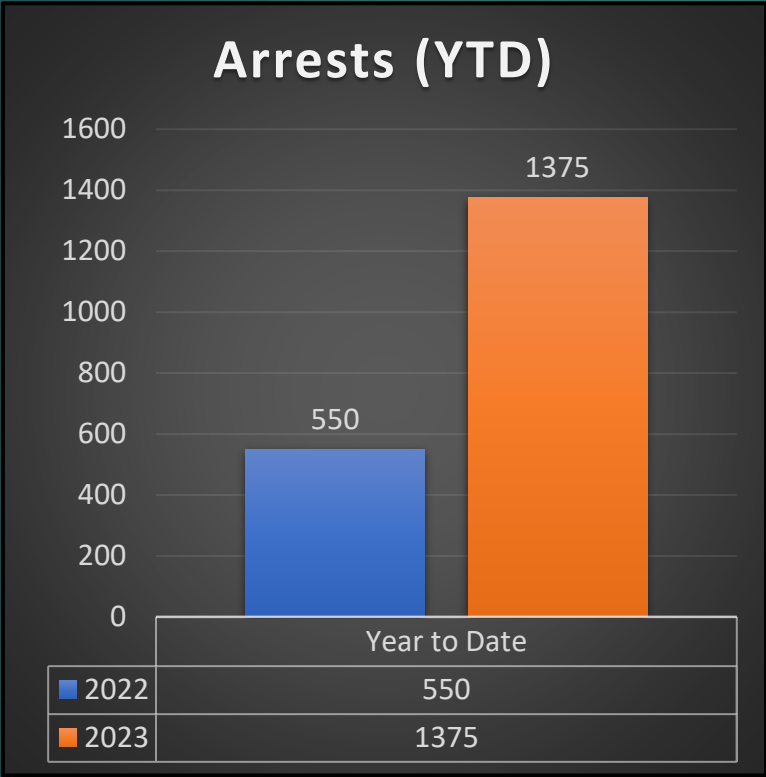
Calls for Service are up **30%** in 2023 vs 2022 YTD.

CFS (2 Week Comparison)

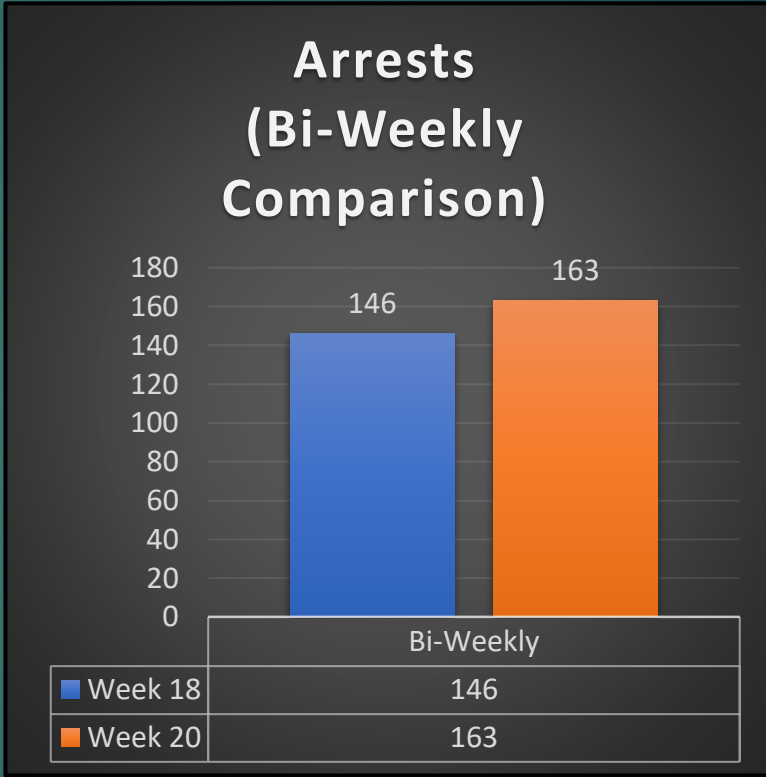


Calls for Service are up **18%** from Week 18 vs Week 20

Arrests Overview



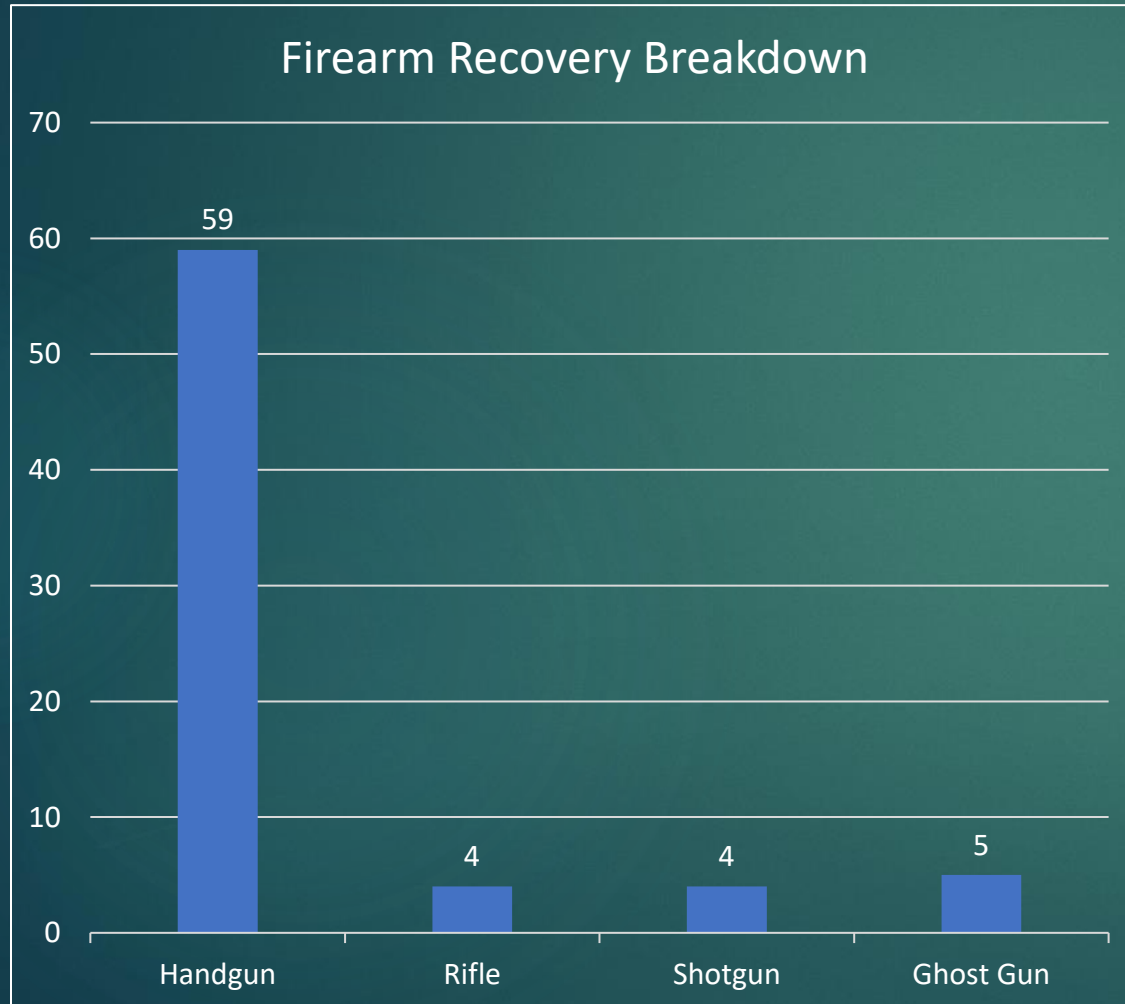

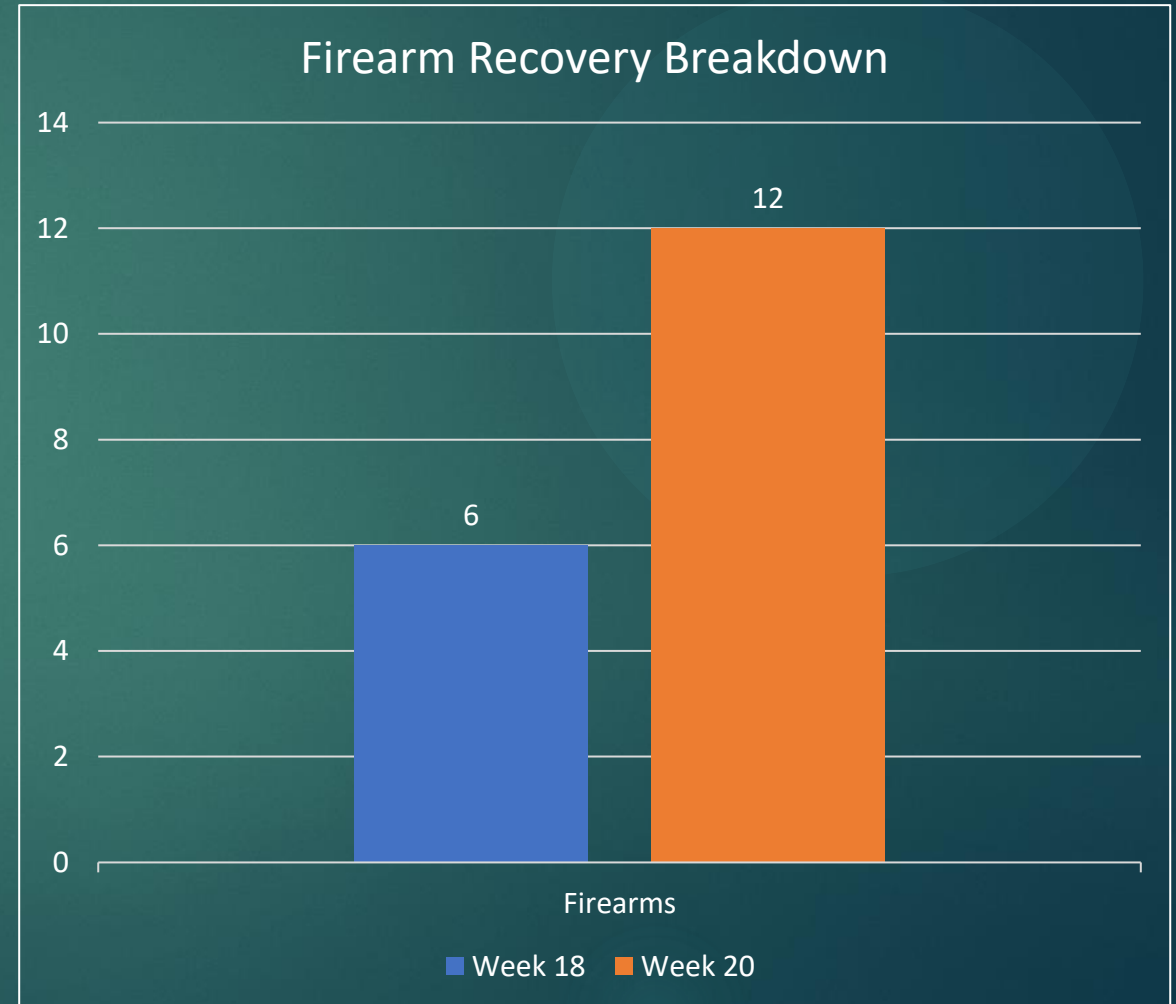
↑ 12% Increase

Geographic Location



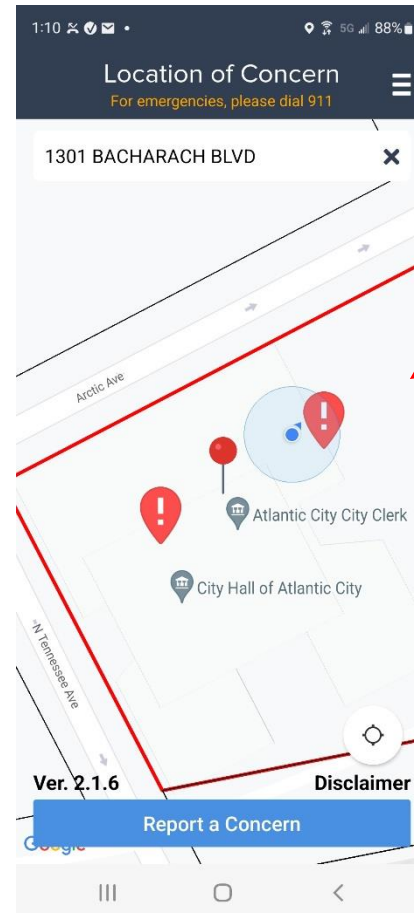
