Concern: Is it possible to do something about all the disturbances that are going on in front of the complainant's properties?

A:

ACPD: The ACPD along with various other City departments have engaged in a concerted effort to clean up the area of Texas to Florida Avenue in reference to numerous complaints. The action taken by the ACPD includes proactive enforcement in the area, distribution of tip411 flyers door to door, and frequent checks of the surrounding area including alleyways. There have been 21 arrests over the last 14 days. In addition, the ACPD has conducted 268 keep a checks in the area over the same time period.

Sergeant Brian Shapiro – At-Risk Initiative

Attorney General Matthew J. Platkin presented Sergeant Brian Shapiro and the Atlantic City Police Department with a 2023 Excellence in Policing Award at an event held on May 12, 2023. The award for Outstanding Community Partnership honors a county prosecutor's office or police department that has implemented or strengthened a community partnership or collaboration with community stakeholders to advance public safety.

Sergeant Shapiro recognized that there were vulnerable populations in Atlantic City who were in need of various health services, and he saw that there was a lack of coordination between different organizations that were trying to help. To address this issue, Sergeant Shapiro took the lead in creating a weekly meeting where representatives from the police department, casinos, businesses, courts, and other law enforcement agencies could come together and share information about the various services that were available to at-risk populations. By coordinating these efforts, Sergeant Shapiro ensured that individuals who needed help were able to connect with the appropriate resources more quickly and efficiently.

In addition, Sergeant Shapiro was recently recognized as the CIT- NJ Center of Excellence Coordinator of the Year for 2022 for his amazing efforts.

Sergeant Brian Shapiro is to be recognized for a job well done!

Detectives Christopher Dodson and Eric Evans – Special Investigations Section (Commanded by Lt. Richard Andrews)

Since May 15, the detectives have been the lead investigators in proactive enforcement targeting areas of frequent complaints from residents and business owners. As a result of their efforts, eight individuals have been arrested on a variety of charges and the following has been recovered.

- ▶ Three handguns
- ▶ 21 grams of cocaine
- ▶ 70 bags of heroin
- ▶ 212 grams of marijuana

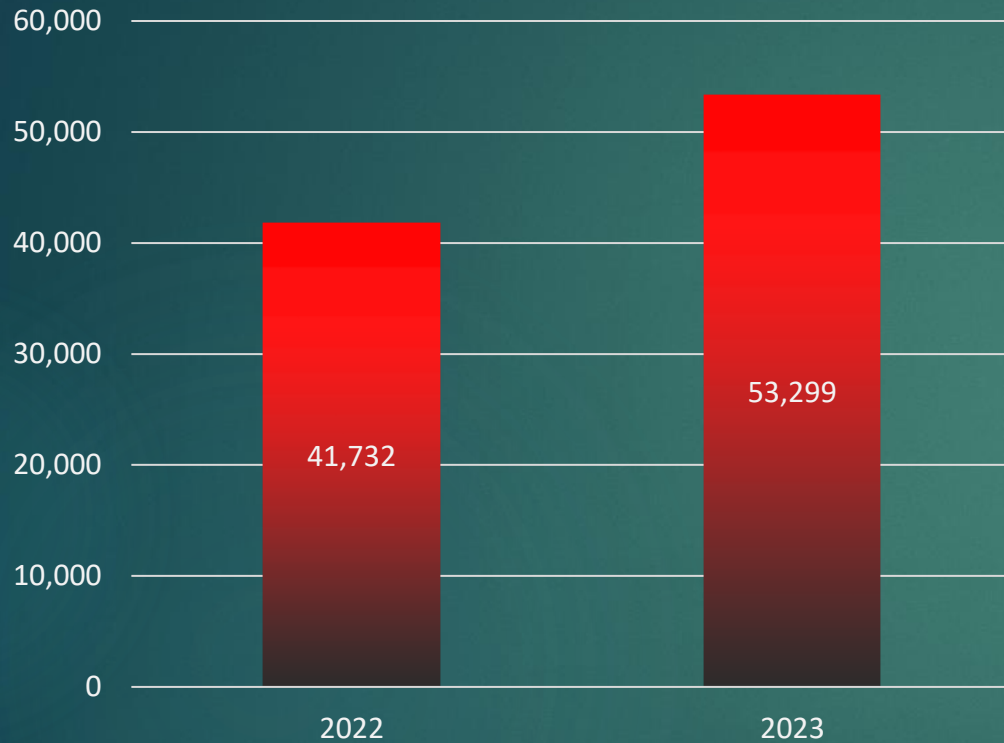

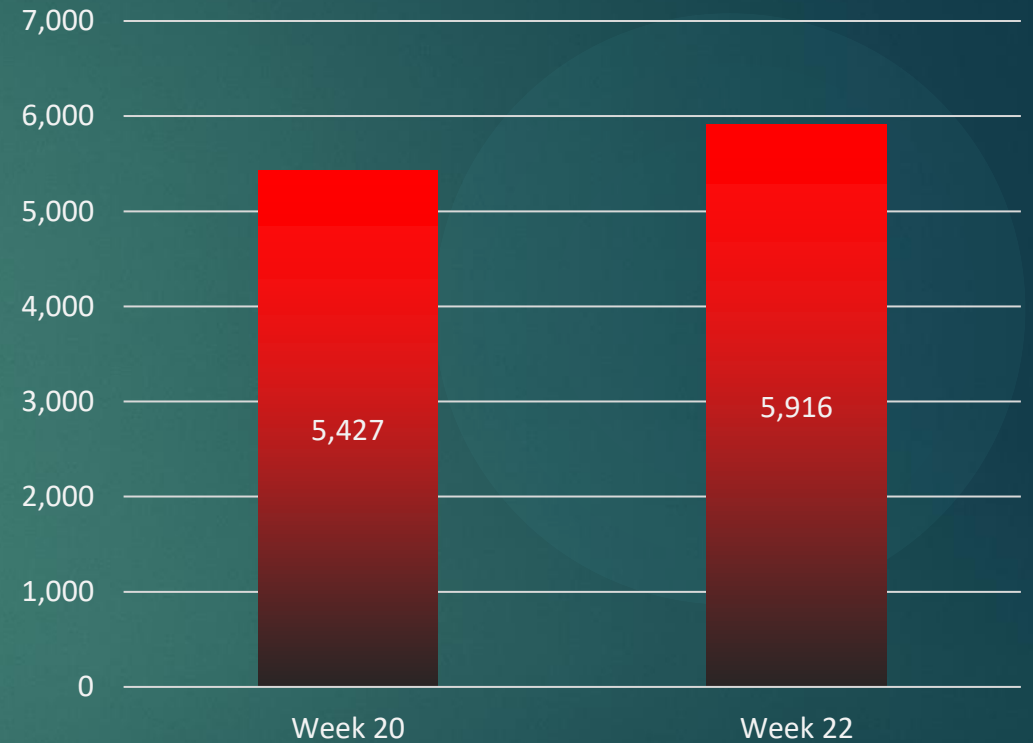
Calls for Service Overview

CFS (Year to Date Comparison)



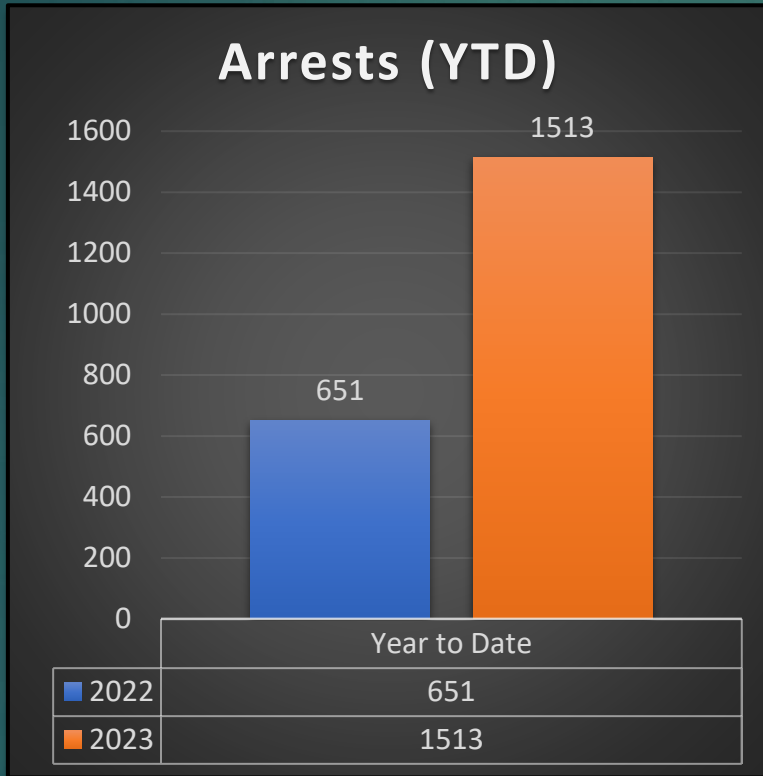
Calls for Service are up **28%** in 2023 vs 2022 YTD.


CFS (2 Week Comparison)

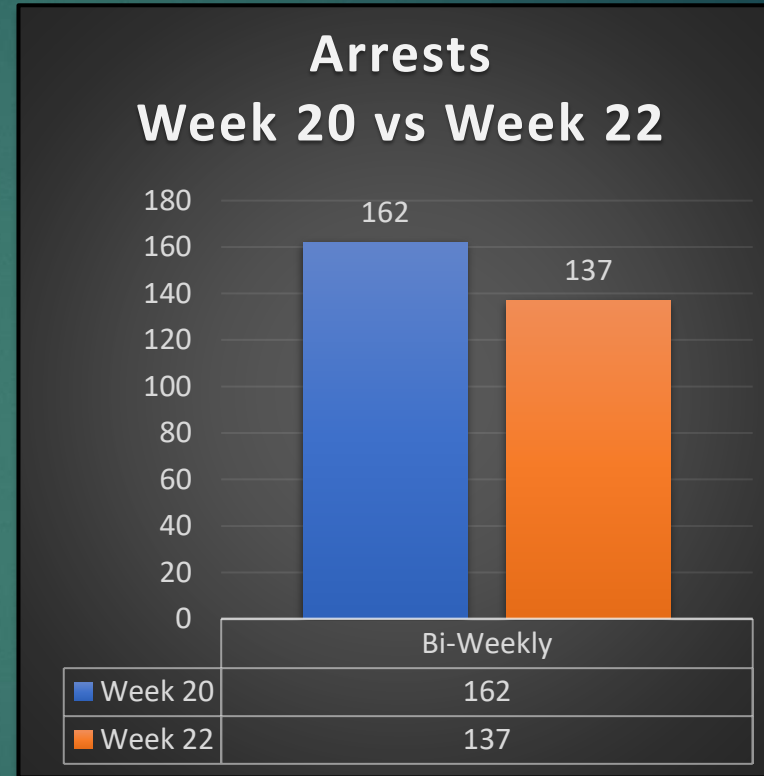



Calls for Service are up **9%** from Week 20 vs Week 22

Arrests Overview

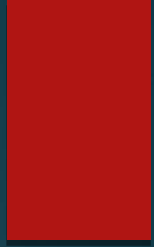
