RECOGNITION ON A JOB  
WELL DONE

## **Officers John Bell and Cuong Sam – Bravo 2 Patrol (Commanded by Lt. William Tracy)**

Officer Bell was patrolling the 600 block of Kentucky Avenue when he observed a group of individuals and observed a laser beam being pointed at a residence. Officer Bell approached the group to investigate, as it is common for firearms to be equipped with a laser sight.

Upon his initial interaction with the group, one juvenile male began to flee. The juvenile dropped a handgun which was recovered by Officer Bell. The juvenile was apprehended by Officer Sam and arrested. The recovered handgun was loaded and had a laser sight.

Officer Bell and Sam are to be recognized for a job well done!

## **Detective James Barrett – Special Investigations Section (Commanded by Lt. Richard Andrews)**

Detective Barrett began an investigation into the distribution of narcotics from a residence in the 100 block of north Iowa Avenue. After obtaining a court authorized search warrant the target of the investigation, Felix Beltran, was located and arrested on an active warrant. During the search of the residence, detectives recovered numerous prescription pills, paraphernalia used in the distribution of narcotics, 24 catalytic converters, and tools used to remove catalytic converters.

Detectives were able to link five of the catalytic converters to a theft that occurred at a local business on the same date. The five were returned to the business. Detectives are working to identify other catalytic converter thefts in Atlantic County and could file additional charges.

Detective Barrett is to be recognized for a job well done!

**Officers Jesse Oliver-Logan, William Luengas-Gonzalez and Michael Kragh- Bravo 1 Patrol (Commanded by Lt. Howard Johnson) and Detective Eric Evans- Special Investigations Section**

Detective Evans passed along information to Officer Oliver-Logan that a wanted man, Yahsin Cheeks, was in the area of Virginia and Magellan Avenues. Cheeks had an active warrant for his arrest stemming from a shooting investigation that was conducted by the Violent Crimes Unit in July 2022.

Officer Oliver-Logan located Cheeks who immediately fled on foot. Officer Oliver-Logan gave chase and with assistance from Officers Luengas-Gonzalez and Kragh, Cheeks was apprehended. He was arrested after a brief struggle. During the pursuit, Cheeks discarded a satchel which was recovered and contained a loaded handgun.

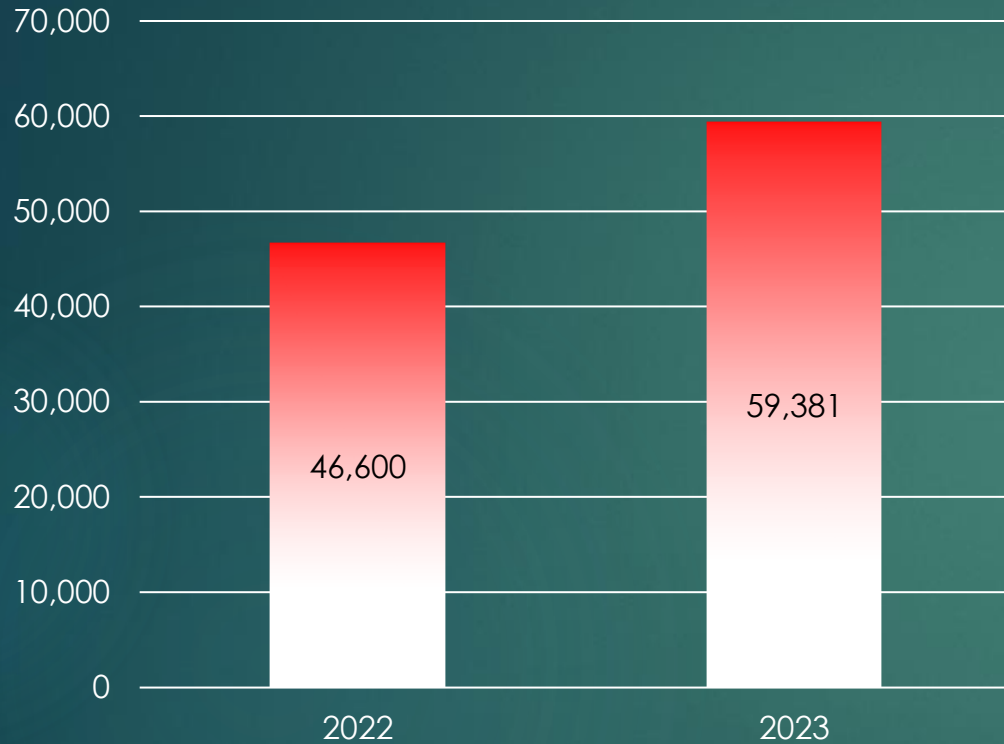

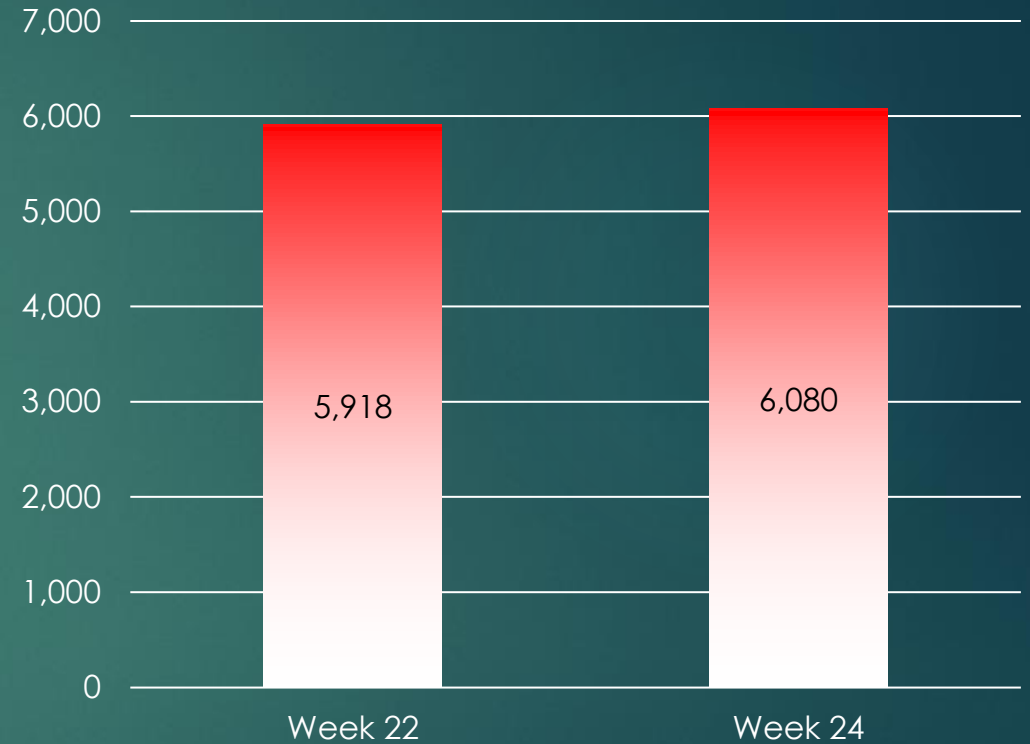
# Calls for Service Overview

## CFS (Year to Date Comparison)



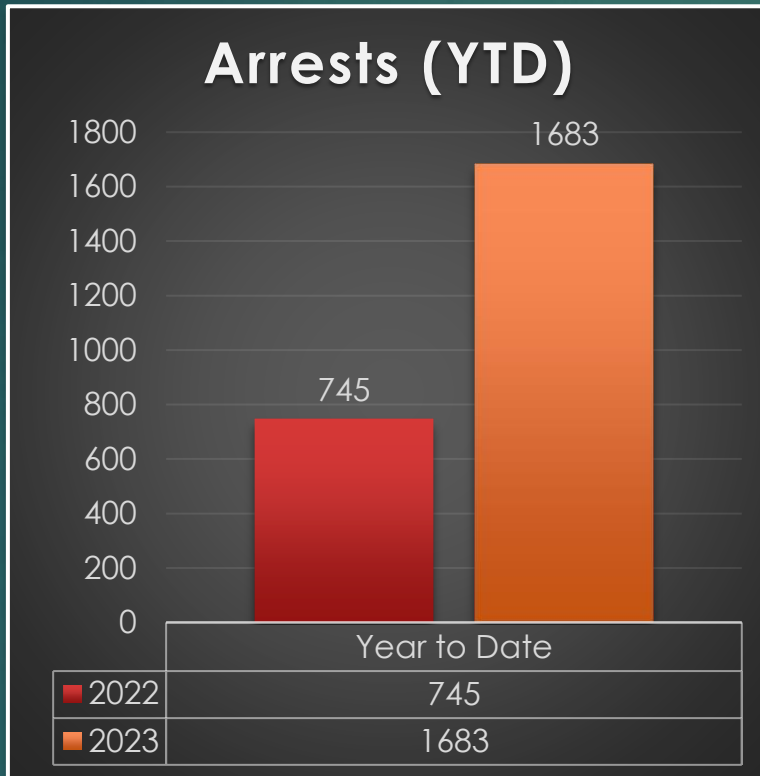
Calls for Service are up **27%** in 2023 vs 2022 YTD.


## CFS (2 Week Comparison)

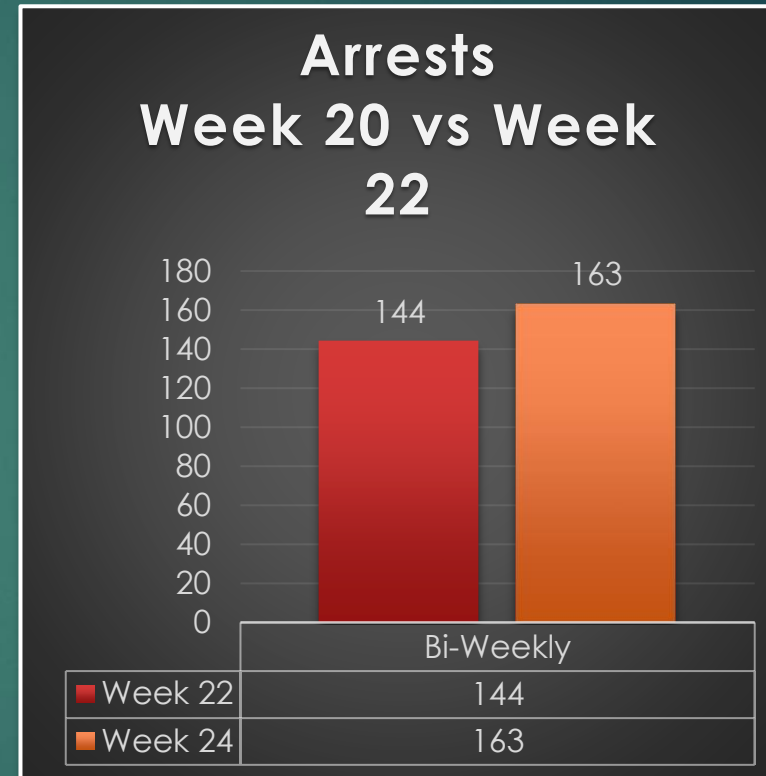



Calls for Service are up **3%** from Week 22 vs Week 24

# Arrests Overview



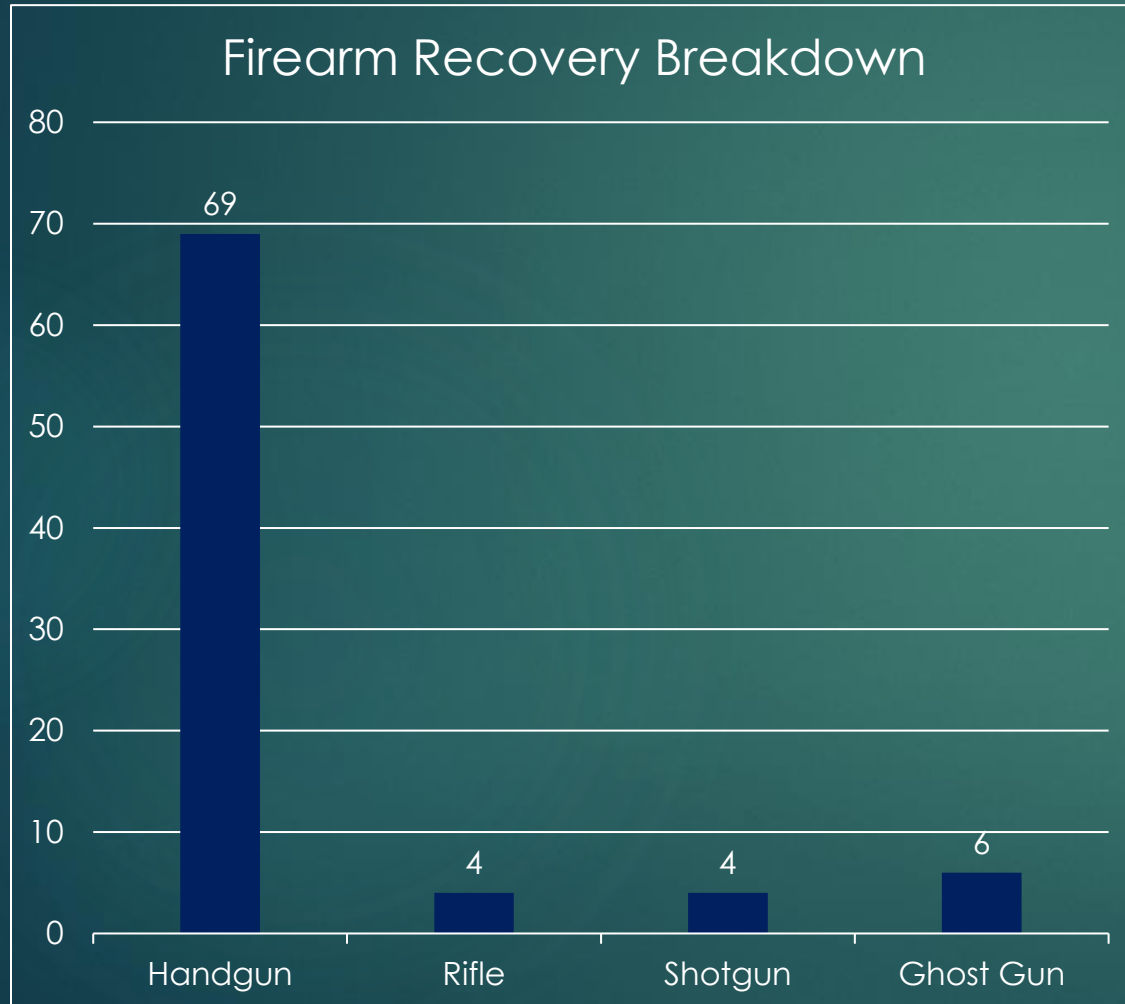

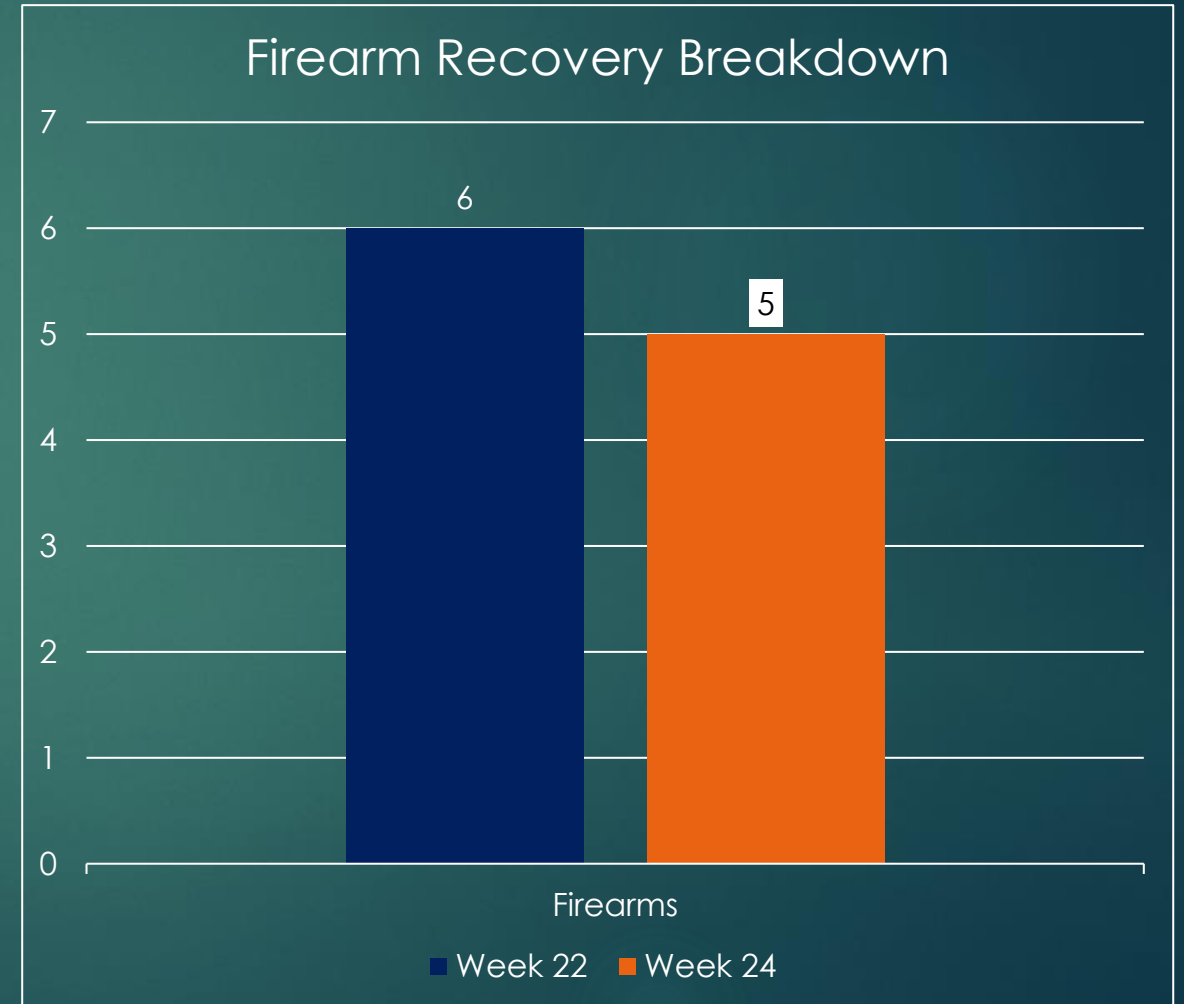
