# Detectives N. Berardis, C. Smith, & K9 Officer A. Nunez-Santos (Commanded by Lt. Richard Andrews)

On July 6, 2023, detectives of the Special Investigations Sections conducted a surveillance operation around the 2500 and 2600 blocks of Pacific Avenue in reference to complaints regarding the distribution and possession of narcotics.

Detectives Nicholas Berardis and Christopher Smith observed a drug transaction take place between three men. All three men were arrested, and all three were found in possession of cocaine. A vehicle being operated by one of the Suspects was searched after Officer Adrian Nunez-Santos's K9 partner, Narco, who is trained in the detection of narcotics, provided a positive indication for the presence of drugs in the vehicle. The detectives recovered two handguns; one being reported stolen from Georgia. In total, more than 24 grams of cocaine was recovered.

Detectives Berardis, Smith, and Nunez-Santos are to be recognized for a job well done!

# Officer J. Walsh, Sgt. M. Tracy, & Responding Units (Commanded by Lt. F. Timek)

On July 5, 2023, patrol officers responded to the 300 block of Rosemont Place in reference to a woman being held against her will, and the suspect was armed with a handgun. Additionally, information was provided that the suspect was having a mental health episode.

Shortly after officers arrived, the victim ran out of the residence. Officers took up a tactical position around the residence to contact the suspect. The suspect exited the home onto a balcony where Officer Jonathan Walsh engaged him in conversation. After a discussion, the suspect agreed to leave the residence. He surrendered shortly after and was taken into custody without incident. The suspect was found in possession of cocaine.

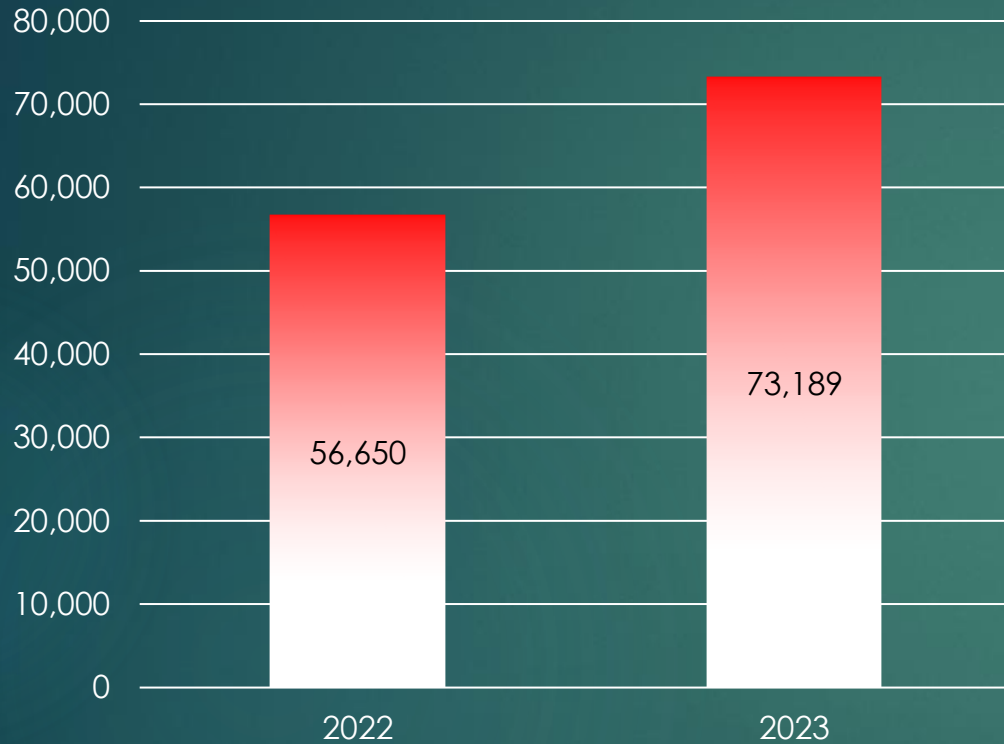
It was learned that the suspect pointed a handgun at the victim during an argument. A court ordered search warrant was authorized for the residence. During the search, Sergeant Michael Tracy located two handguns.

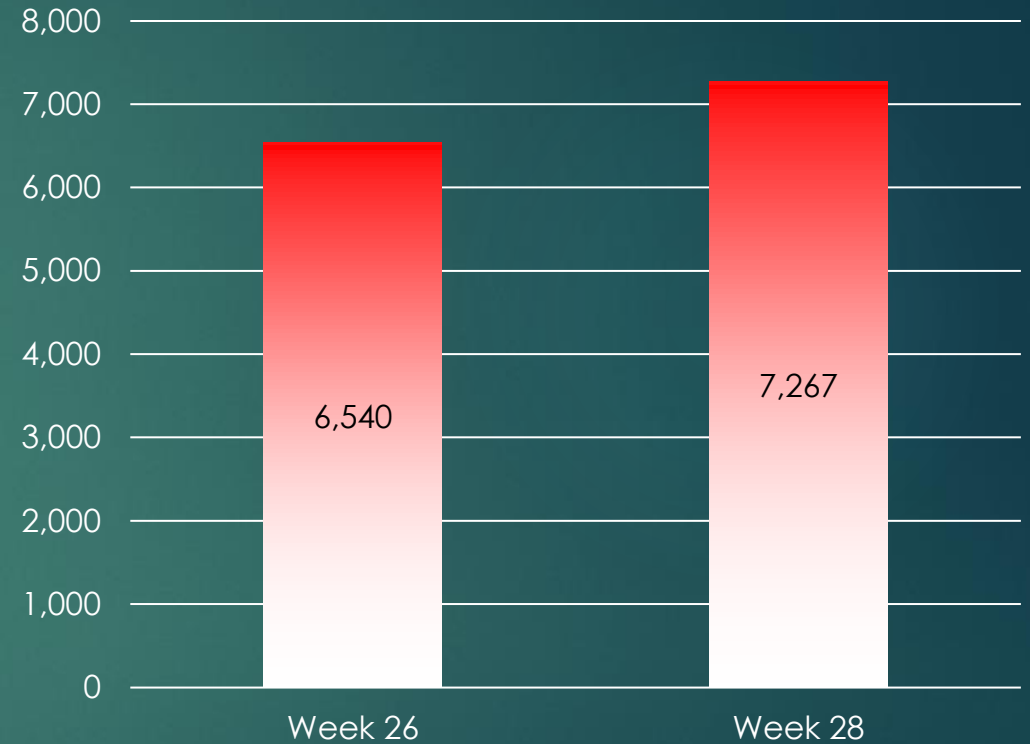
# Calls for Service Overview

## CFS (Year to Date Comparison)



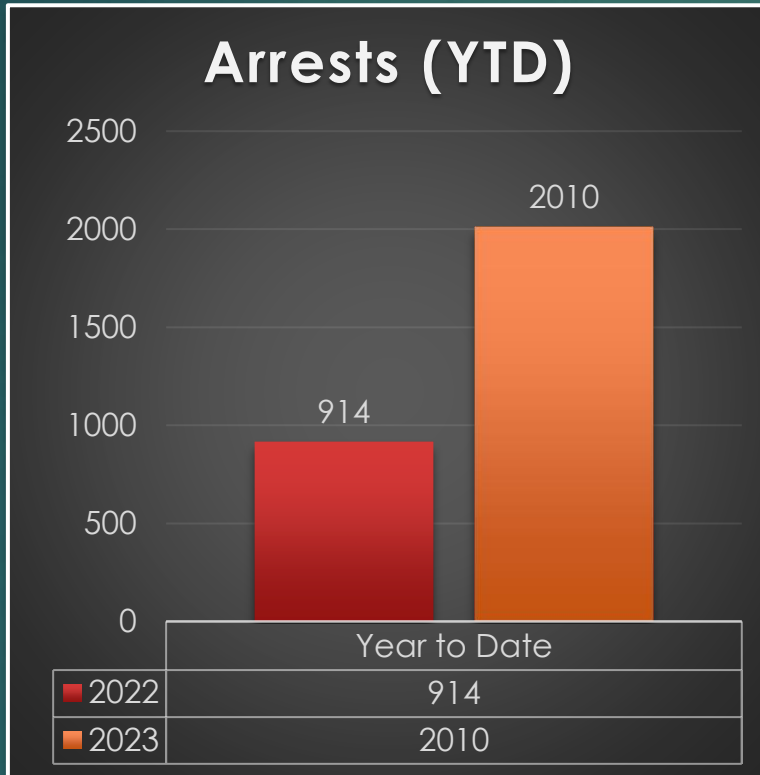
Calls for Service are up **29%** in 2023 vs 2022 YTD.


## CFS (2 Week Comparison)

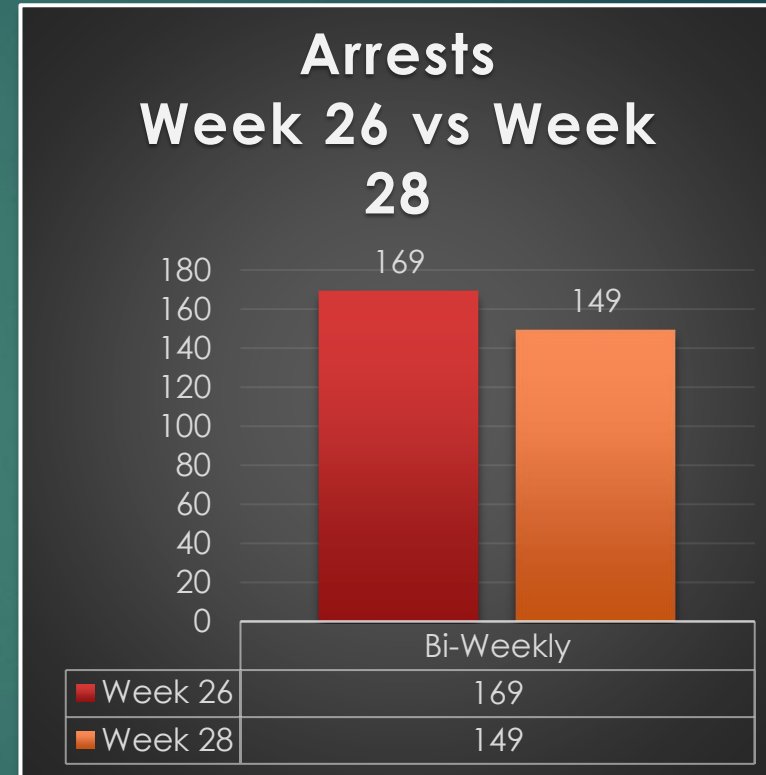


Calls for Service are up **11%** from Week 26 vs Week 28

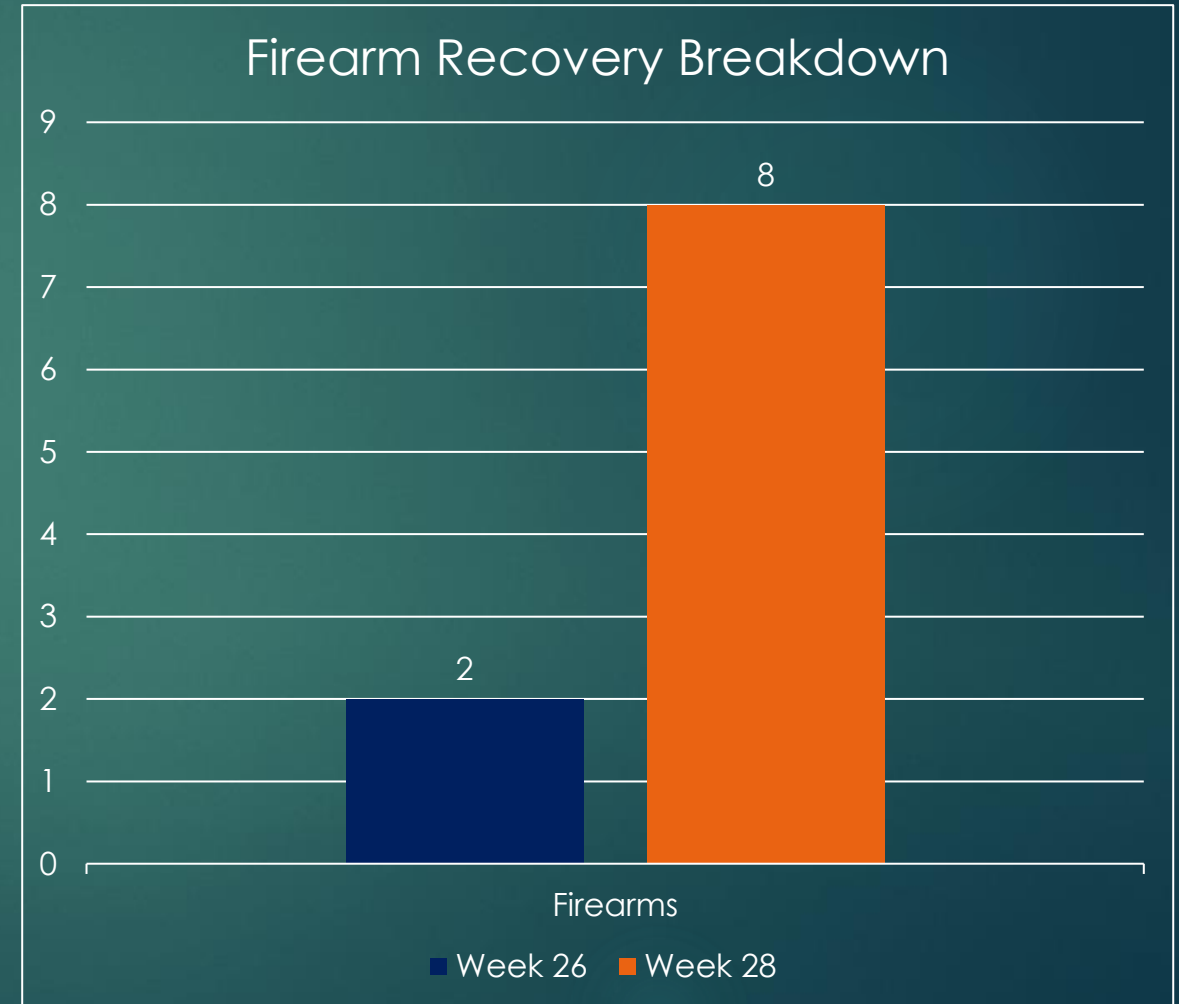
