**RECOGNITION ON A JOB
WELL DONE**

On August 6, patrol officers responded to the 1400 block of the Boardwalk for a report of a man stabbed. Officers arrived to find the victim suffering from a stab wound. The man was transported to the AtlantiCare Regional Medical Center, City Division, with serious but non-life-threatening injuries.

Surveillance Center personnel were able to locate the incident and provide a description of the suspect to responding officers. Shortly after, Officer Revolus located the suspect at North Carolina and Pacific Avenues and taken into custody without incident. The suspect was charged with attempted murder.

Alpha Platoon Squad 2 (Commanded by Lt. Jody Hersh) and the Emergency Response Team (Commanded by Captain Edward Leon and Alexis Zeilinger)

On August 8, patrol officers responded to the Metropolitan Plaza Apartments in reference to a man experiencing a mental health episode and becoming aggressive. The caller was a mental health screener with AtlantiCare who had an involuntary commitment order for the man. Officers located the man in his apartment and began to engage him in conversation after he refused to open the door. Officers summoned members of the department's Crisis Negotiation Team in an effort to further engage the man. The SWAT team also responded after the man began to barricade the door.

While speaking with negotiators, the man threatened multiple times to assault the police officers on scene and light them on fire. This prompted a response from the Atlantic City Fire Department.

After almost four hours of negotiations, the SWAT team made entry into the apartment and the man was detained. He was transported to the AtlantiCare Regional Medical Center, City Division, for evaluation pertaining to his commitment order.

Residents in surrounding apartments were safely removed from the area. There were no injuries during this incident.

On August 15, Officer Kelly conducted a motor vehicle stop in the first block of south Ohio Avenue. While speaking to the driver and waiting for him to provide needed documents, Officer Kelly observed an open backpack with a handgun inside. The driver and his passenger were arrested with assistance from responding officers.

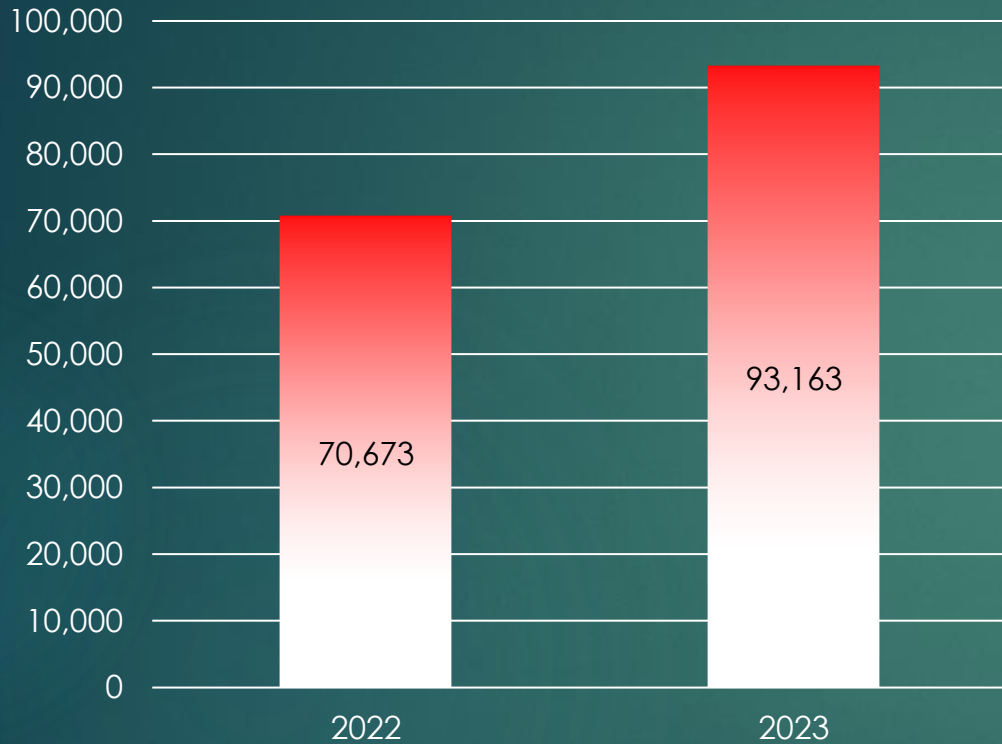
Officer Kelly recovered the backpack that contained the handgun and additionally found marijuana, and paraphernalia used in the distribution of narcotics. The passenger was found in possession of a handgun during a search following his arrest. Both men were also found to have outstanding warrants for their arrest.

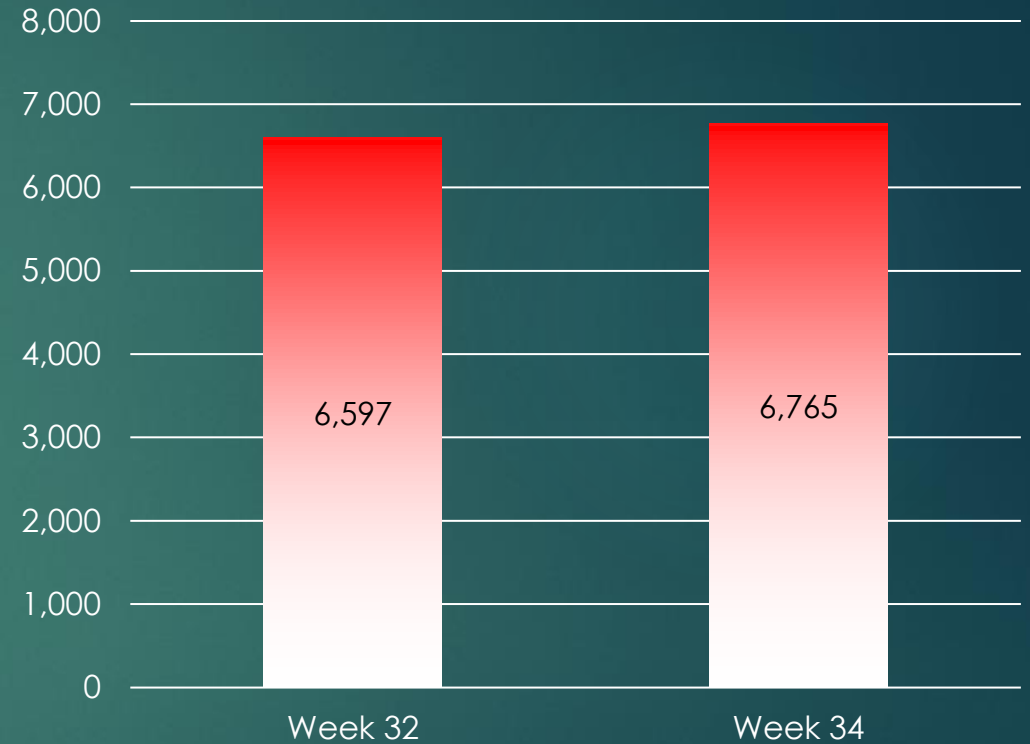
Calls for Service Overview

CFS (Year to Date Comparison)



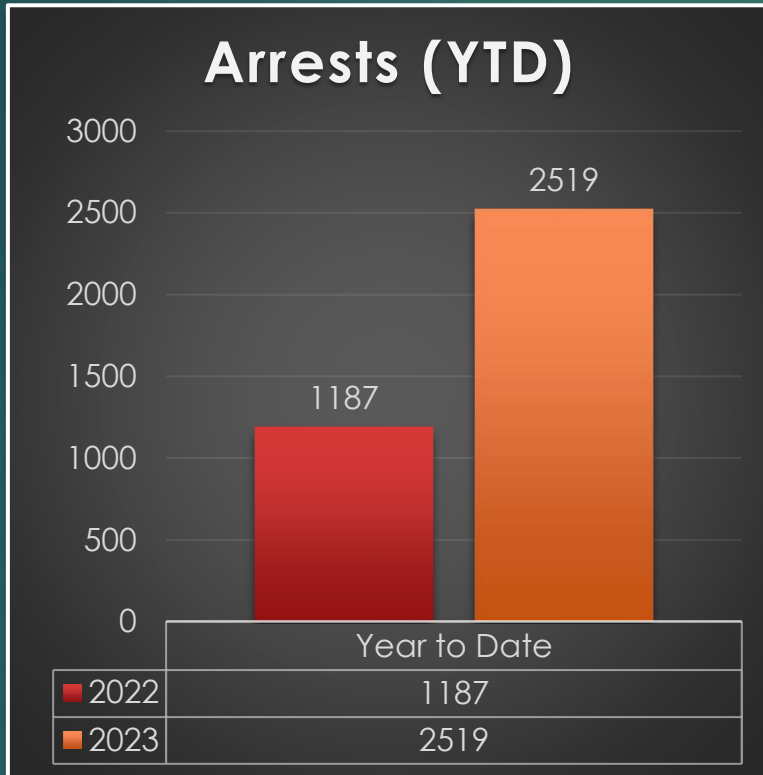
Calls for Service are up **32%** in 2023 vs 2022 YTD.


CFS (2 Week Comparison)

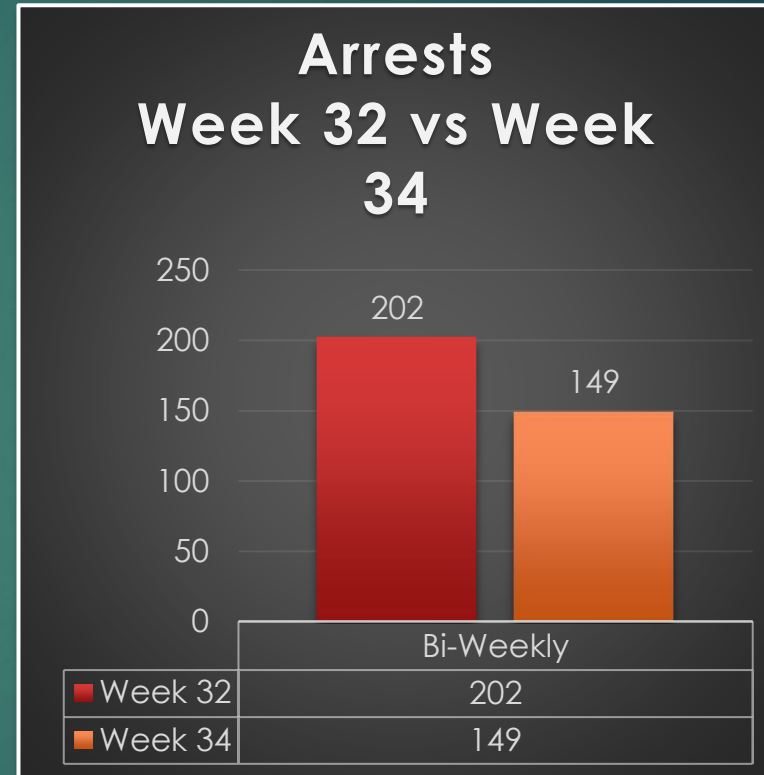

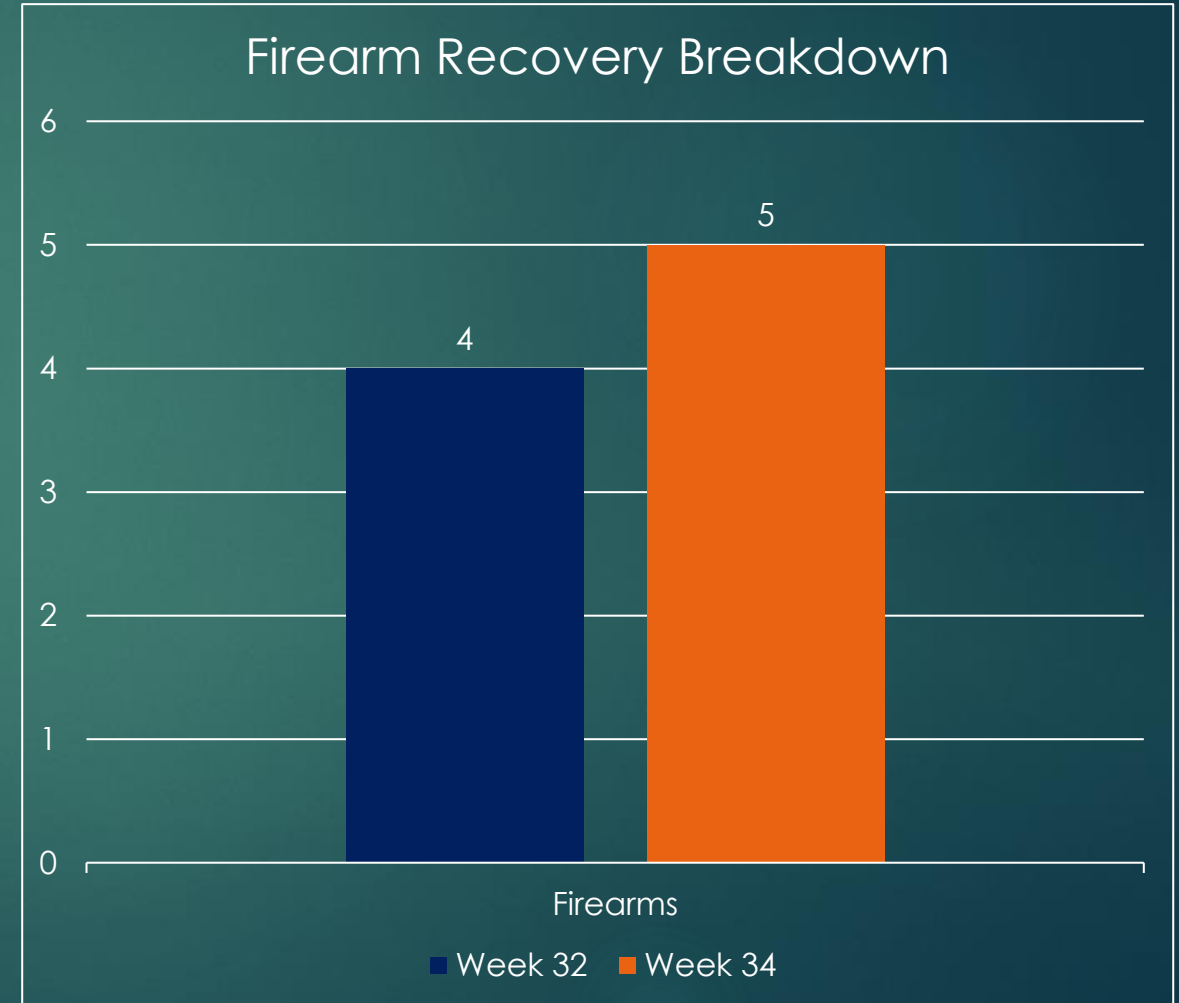

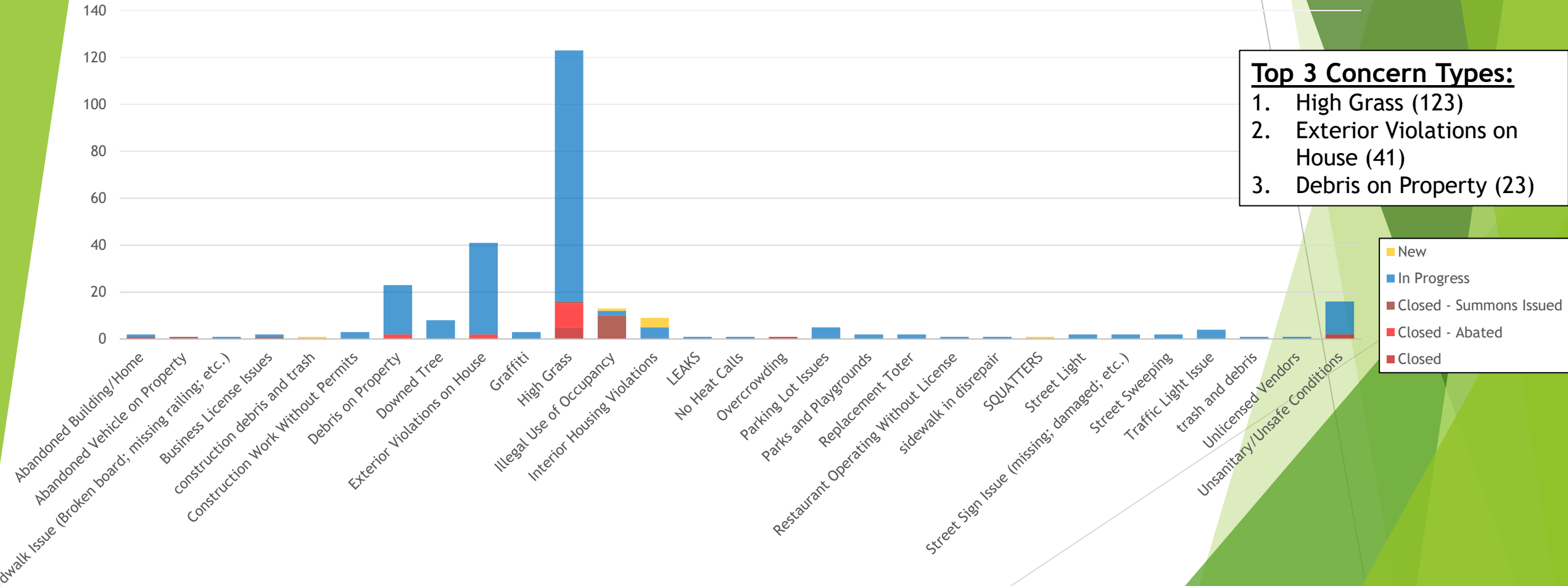

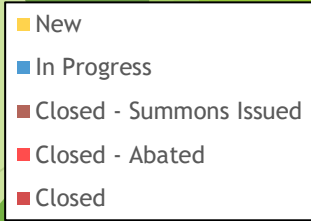
