RECOGNITION ON A JOB WELL DONE

Detective Eric Evans and the Special Investigations Section- (Commanded by Lt. Richard Andrews)

On September 1, detectives executed two residential search warrants following a two-month investigation into the possession and distribution of narcotics led by Detective Evans. The targets of the investigation were each arrested at their residence for active warrants. One warrant was executed in the 600 block of North Annapolis Avenue and the other in the 4200 block of West End Avenue.

During the searches, detective recovered the following items.

- One loaded handgun
- Additional ammunition
- 653 individual bags of heroin
- 46 grams of ecstasy
- 314 grams of cocaine
- 59 grams of marijuana
- 24 grams of methamphetamine
- \$2,751 in cash
- paraphernalia used in the distribution of narcotics

On September 10, patrol officers responded to the top floor of a parking structure in reference to a man who lying on the ledge of the top floor continually looking over. Surveillance Center personnel were able to locate the man on camera and provide the responding officers with real-time information.

Officers Petinga and Harned were first to arrive. The officers calmly attempted to engage the man in conversation as he knelt from the ledge. They continued to ask questions and got closer as the man still looked over the side of the garage and never turned around to them. Fearing the man would jump with their arrival, the officers quickly rushed the man and pulled him off the ledge to safety.

As the officers held onto the man and tried to assure that he would be okay, he attempted to break free from their grasp and go towards the ledge. The officers were forced to take him to the ground and place him in handcuffs to ensure his safety.

The man was transported to the AtlantiCare Regional Medical Center for evaluation.

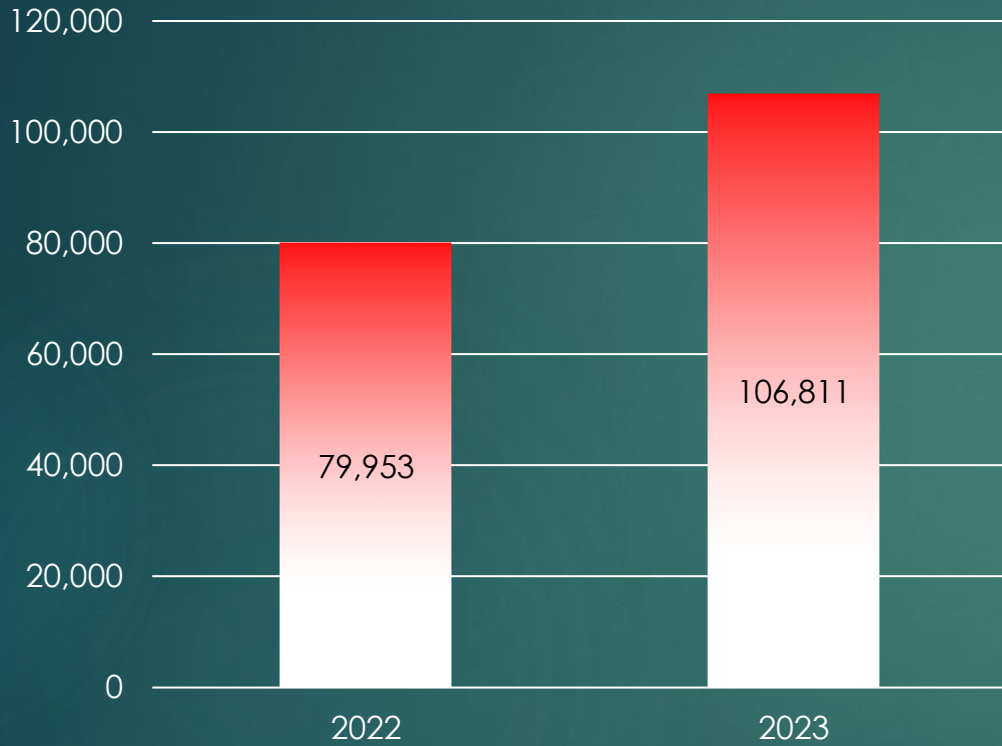
Officers Petinga and Harned were assisted by Officers Cruz, Drinks and Harold.

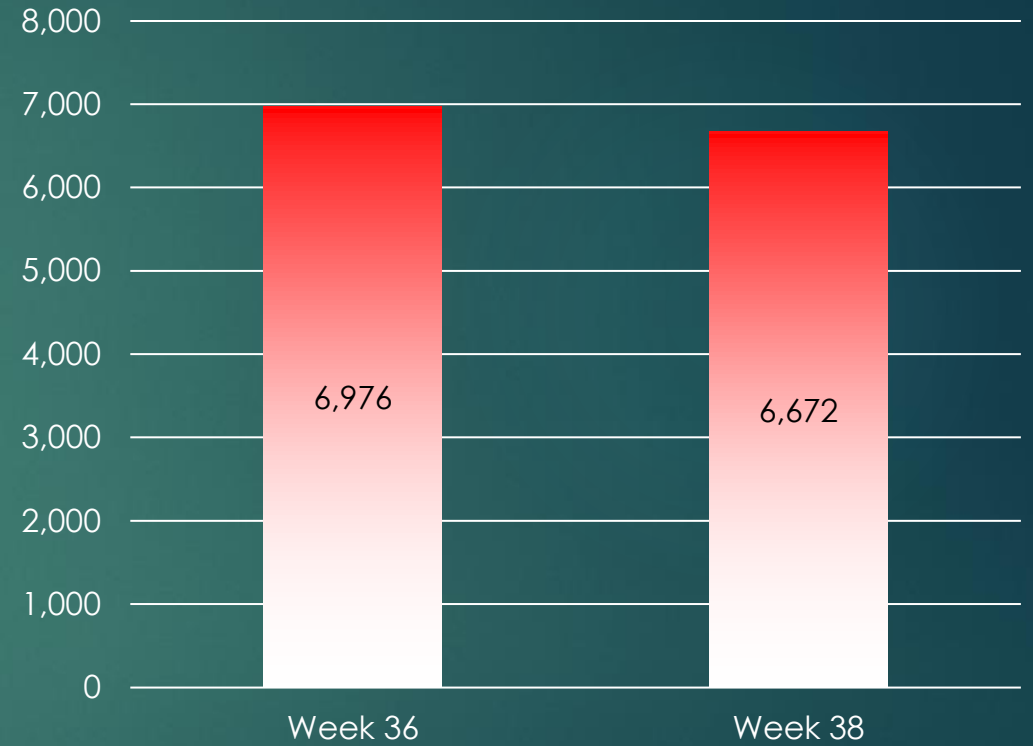
Calls for Service Overview

CFS (Year to Date Comparison)



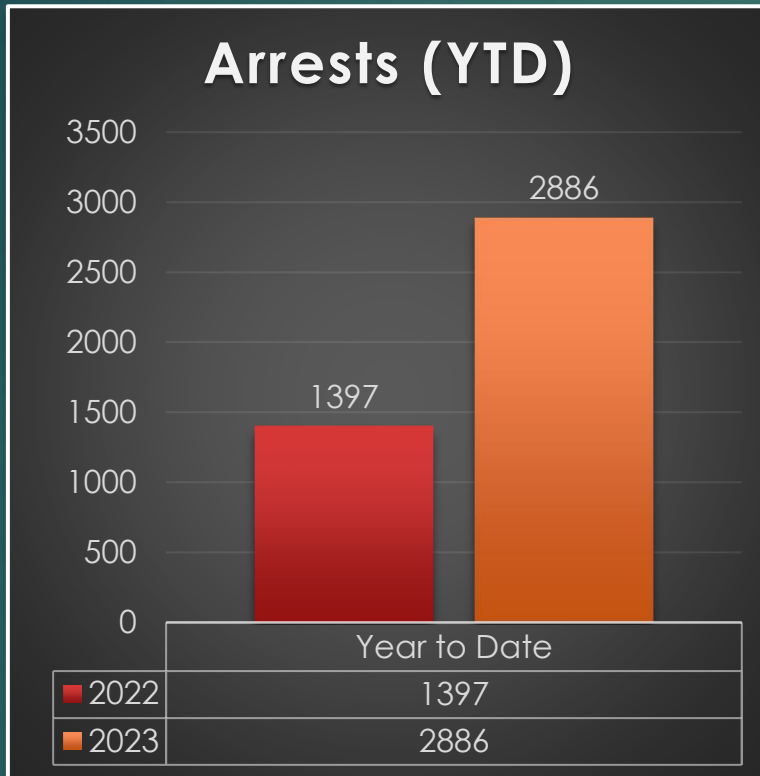
Calls for Service are up **34%** in 2023 vs 2022 YTD.


CFS (2 Week Comparison)

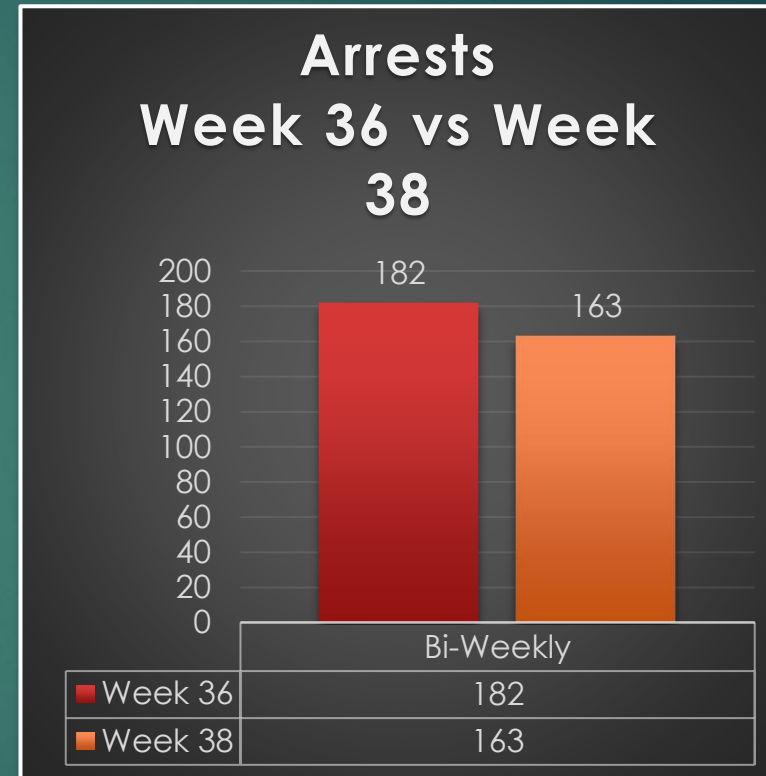



Calls for Service are down **4%** from Week 36 vs Week 38

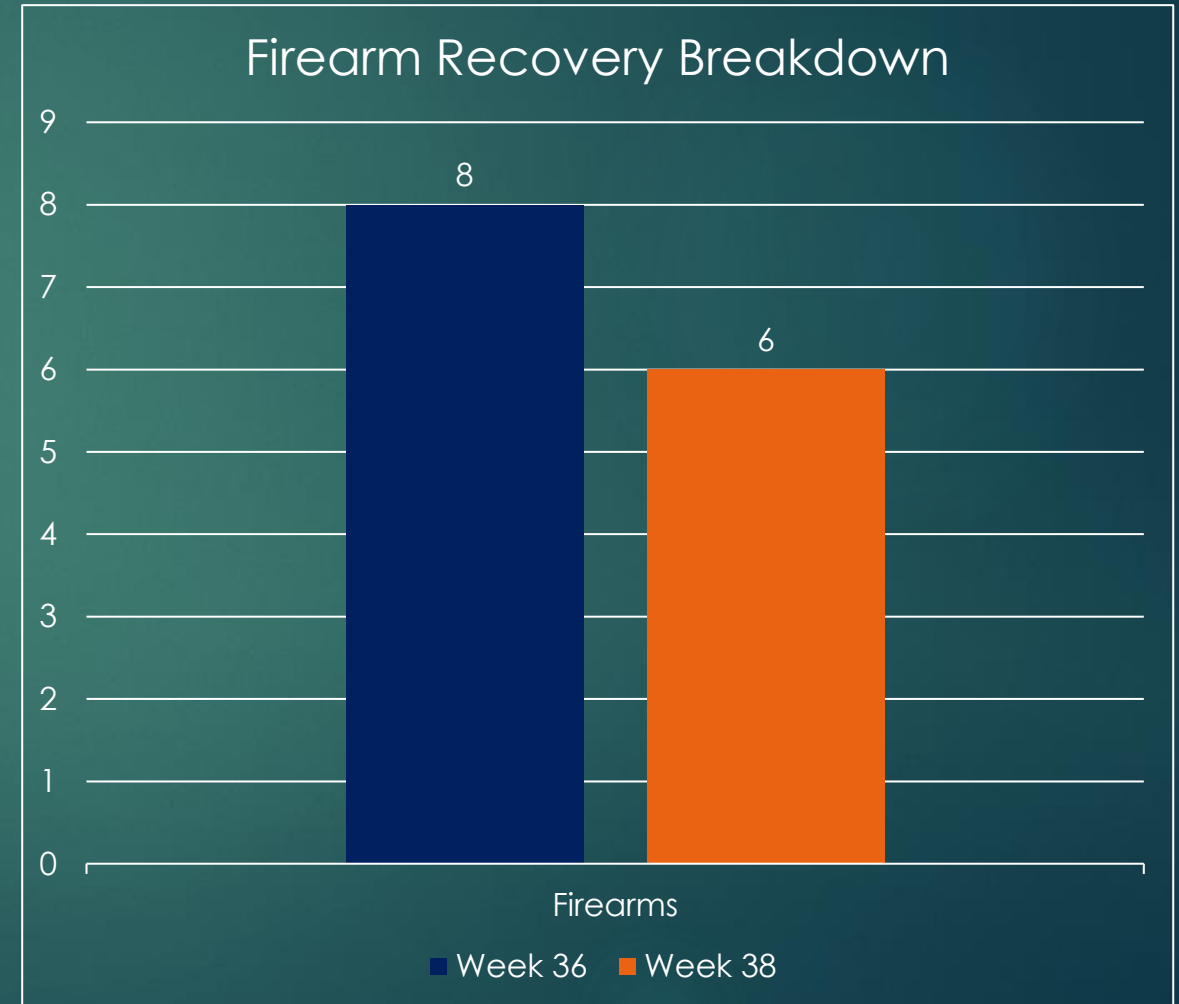

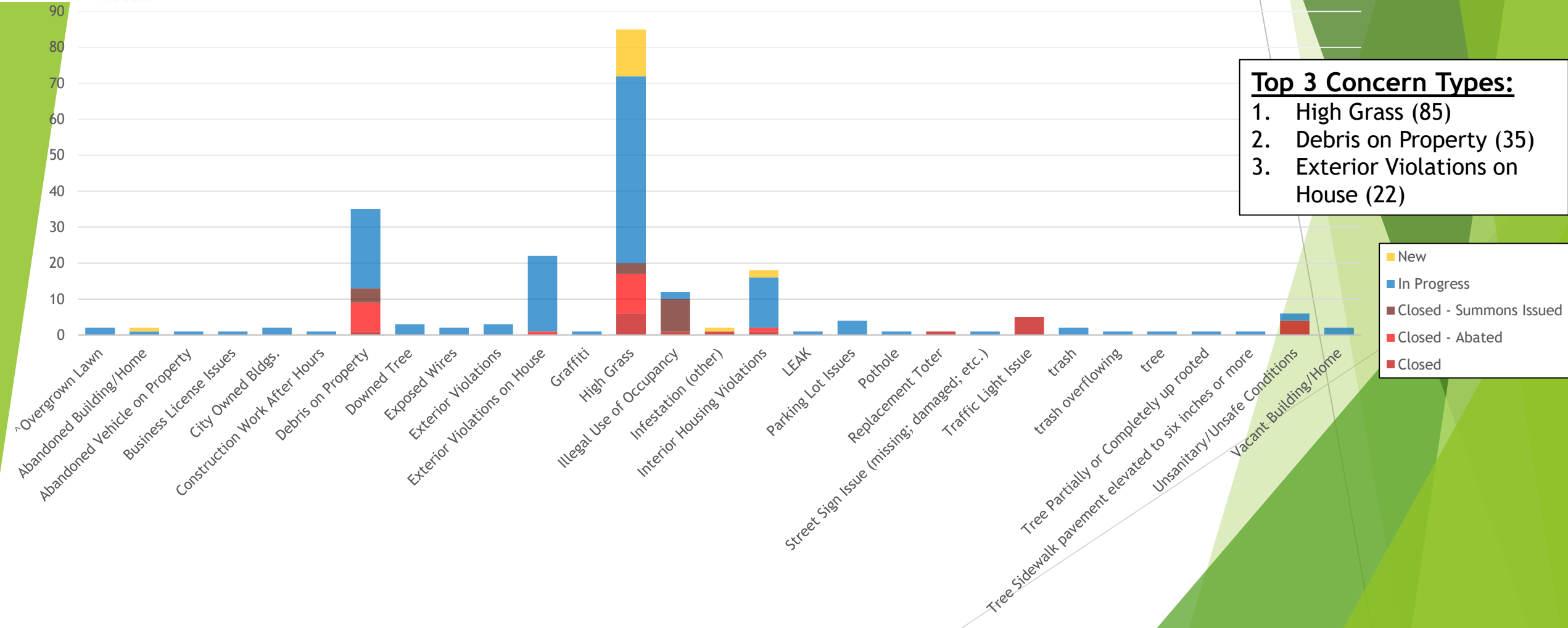
