

RECOGNITION ON A JOB WELL DONE

Detective Ermino Marsini- (Commanded by Lt. Richard Andrews)

On September 27, detectives of the Special Investigations Section in conjunction with the Federal Bureau of Investigation's Safe Streets Task Force executed a court authorized residential search warrant in the 900 block of Lexington Avenue. The search warrant was the culmination of a three-month investigation into the possession and distribution of narcotics by Detective Marsini.

Detectives arrested the target of the investigation after he left his residence for an outstanding warrant. During a search of the residence, detectives recovered the following items;

- One loaded handgun
- Nearly one kilogram, or more than two pounds, of cocaine
- More than 1.5 pounds of methamphetamine
- Approximately 770 individual bags of heroin
- Almost one pound of Marijuana
- 56 Oxycodone prescription pills
- 21 bottles of Promethazine
- Over \$5,500 in cash

Officers Bao Pham, Brandon Jackson, and Kyle Riordan- **Tourism** District Unit (Commanded by Lt. Jody Hersh)

On September 15, Officers Pham, Jackson, and Riordan were on foot patrol when they were stopped by the Ocean Casino Resort security team that a woman had entered a cab in the valet area and was in possession of a handgun. An attentive security officer observed the woman display the handgun at the entrance to the property before exiting and getting in the cab.

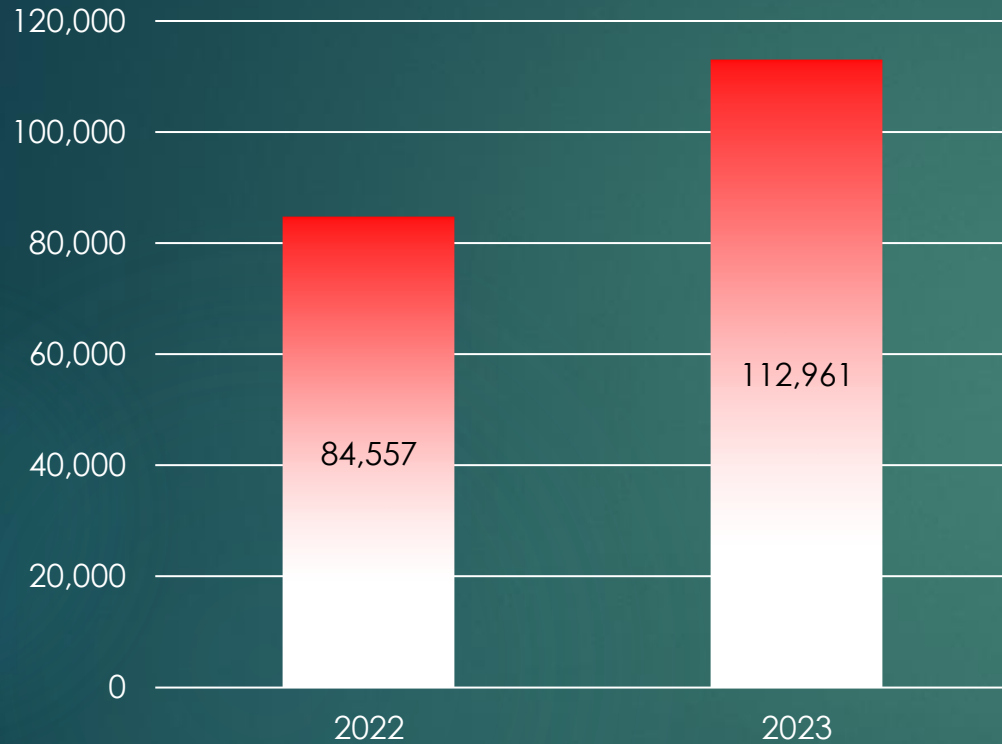
The officers were able to stop the cab and detain the woman. After speaking with her, the officers located a loaded handgun, 830 individual bags of heroin, and additional ammunition in the rear of the cab. The items were recovered and the woman arrested.

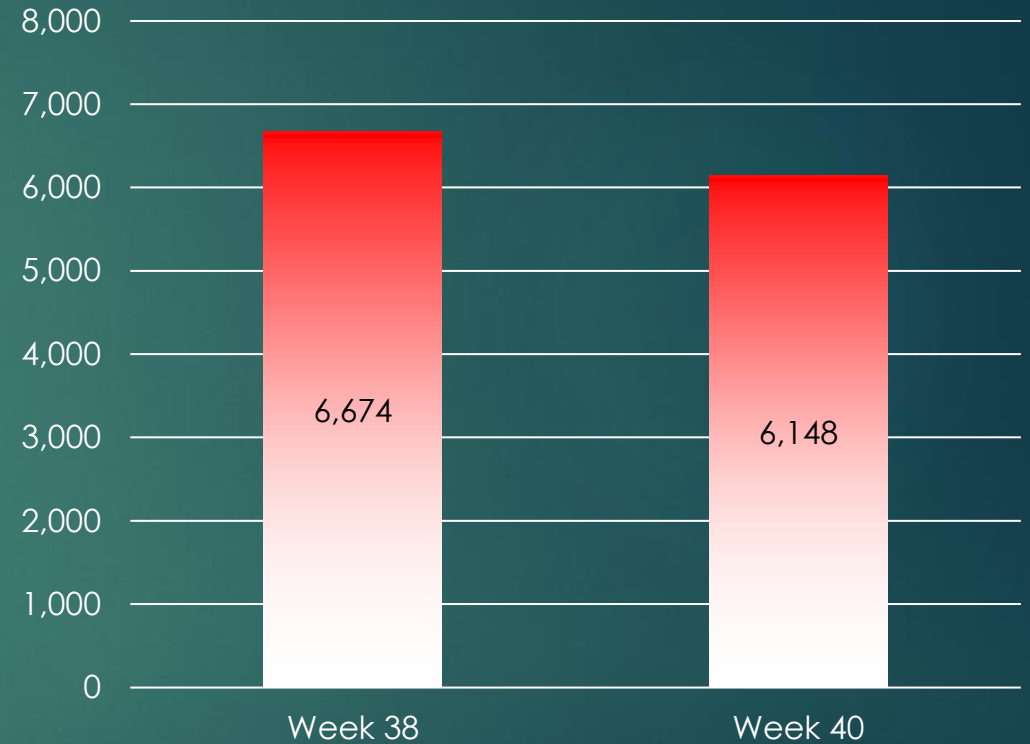
Calls for Service Overview

CFS (Year to Date Comparison)



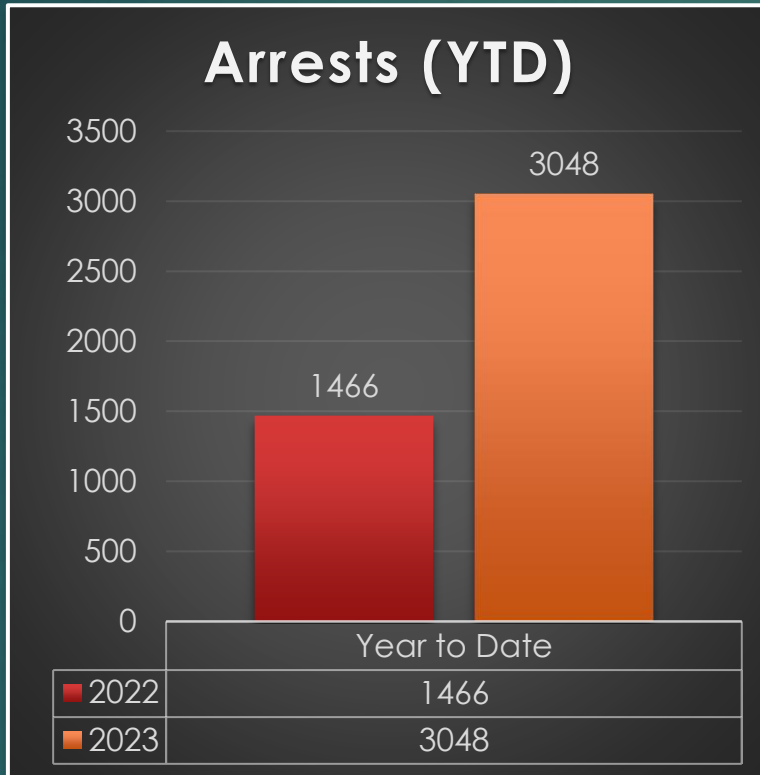
Calls for Service are up **34%** in 2023 vs 2022 YTD.


CFS (2 Week Comparison)

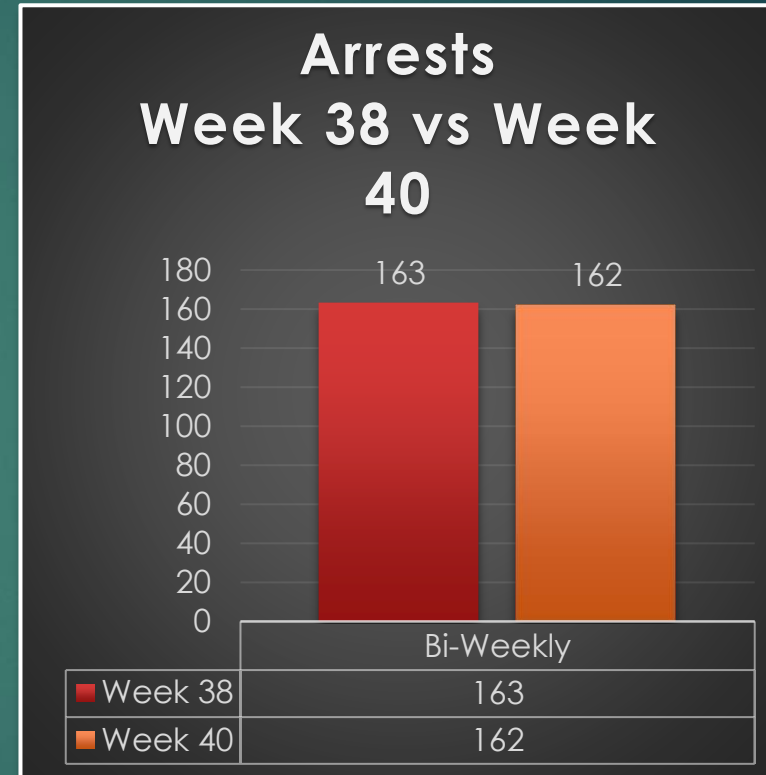


Calls for Service are down **8%** from Week 38 vs Week 40

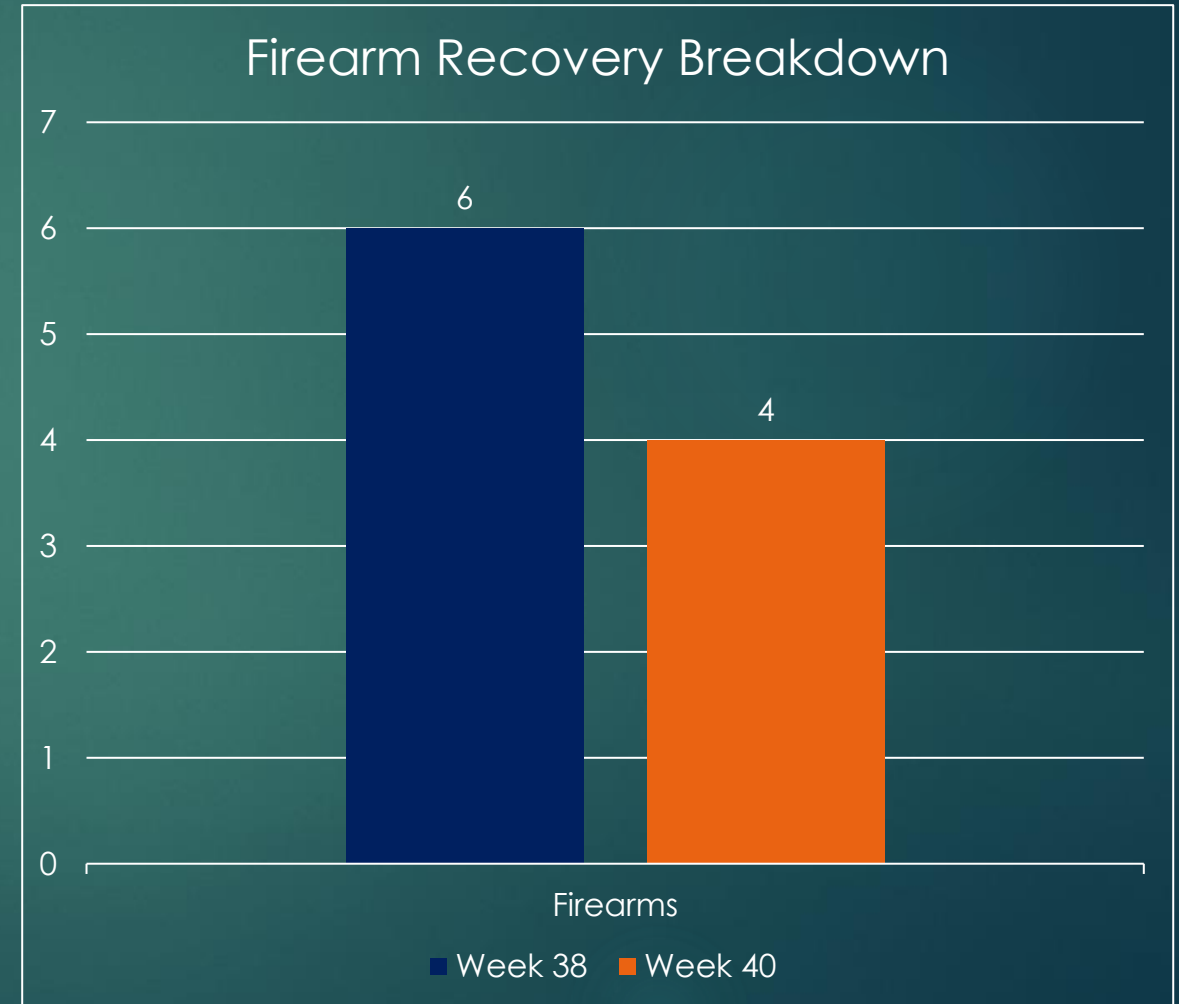

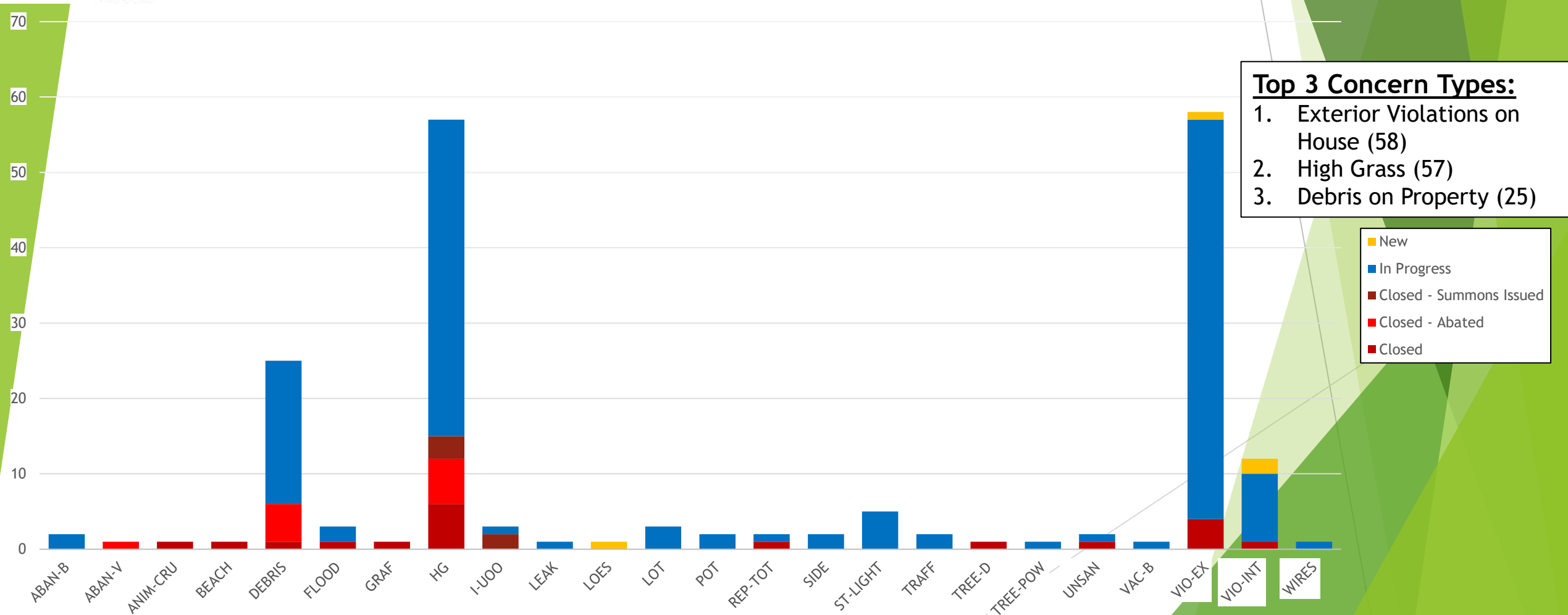
