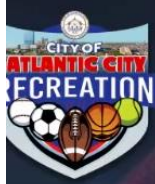

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Q:

Concern: Vehicle issue on 1900 Block of Emerson Ave

A:

ACPD: The Traffic Unit supervisor along with Code Enforcement responded to the block together. At the time they were there, two vehicles were legally parked and registered appropriately. Code Enforcement took additional action.



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Q:

Concern: Homeless issue at South Bellevue Ave

A:

Health & Human Services: We visited the site a few times and noticed that there weren't any homeless individuals there at the time. There has been a larger police presence in the area which has assisted in cleaning up the area. We will continue to monitor the area.



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Q:

Concern: Regarding AirBnBs and other Short-Term Rentals

A:

Licensing & Inspections: The Code Enforcement staff is very aggressive in monitoring illegal STR's. Through the 24/7 Hotline from Granicus- Host Compliance if a complaint is received the Code staff can verify and determine if the property is a licensed STR. Also, by completing period inspections and property checks Code staff can locate illegal STR's. 153 summons have been issued this year to unlicensed/ illegal rental properties. The fines for noncompliance and operating illegally range from \$1,000 for the first violation to \$2,000 for each addition summons.



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Q:

Concern: Update on Connecticut Ave project

A:

Planning: The City met on-site with several departments to assess and confirm the challenges to access by emergency vehicles to the development. A solution was offered to create several paved 'cuts' along the landscaped berm. Specifications for the recommendation will be drafted for review and implementation.

RECOGNITION ON A JOB WELL DONE

Surveillance Center personnel, Officers Courtney Campbell, Christopher Campbell, Troy Grams, Scott Sendrick and Maria Borsani- Alpha 1 Platoon (Commanded by Lt. Frank Timek)

On October 7, patrol officers responded to Kentucky and Pacific Avenues in reference to a man that was stabbed multiple times. Arriving officers located the victim, 30, suffering from serious injuries and bleeding profusely from an arm wound. Officers Grams, Courtney Campbell, and Christopher Campbell immediately rendered aid including the applying of a tourniquet. The victim was transported to the AtlantiCare Regional Medical Center, City Division, with serious but non-fatal injuries.

Surveillance Center personnel were able to locate and track two suspects who fled onto the Boardwalk but not before throwing the knife used in the attack on the roof of a nearby building. Officers Sendrick and Borsani located the suspects arrested them without incident.

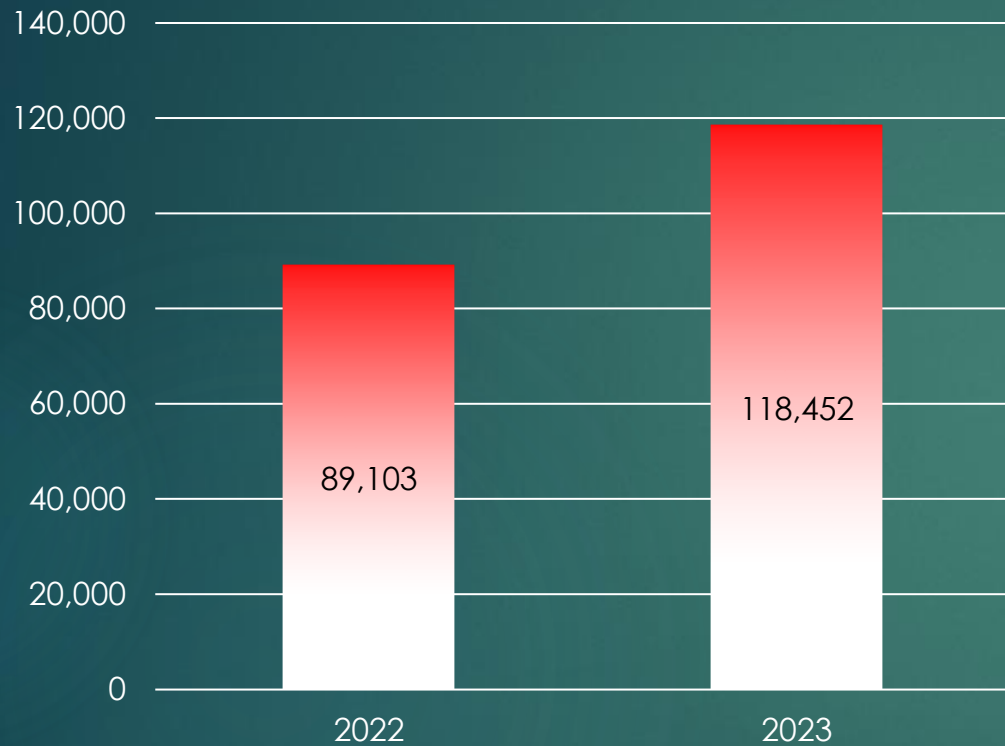
Officer learned that during the assault, the suspects stole numerous personal belongings from the victim and also had active warrants for their arrest.

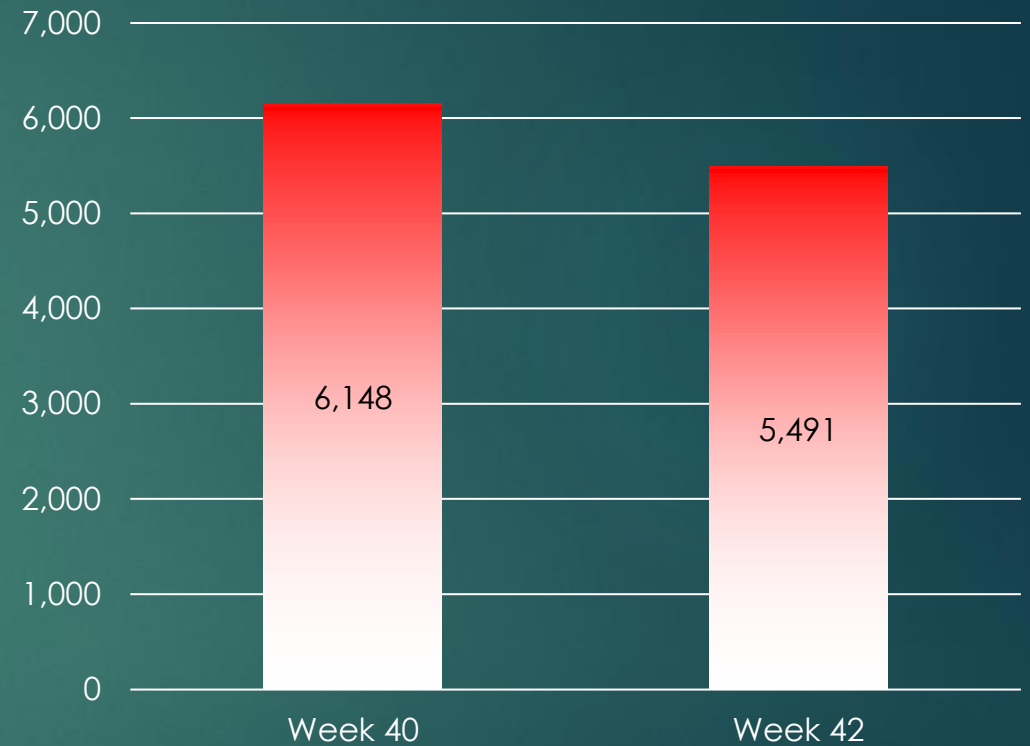
Calls for Service Overview

CFS (Year to Date Comparison)



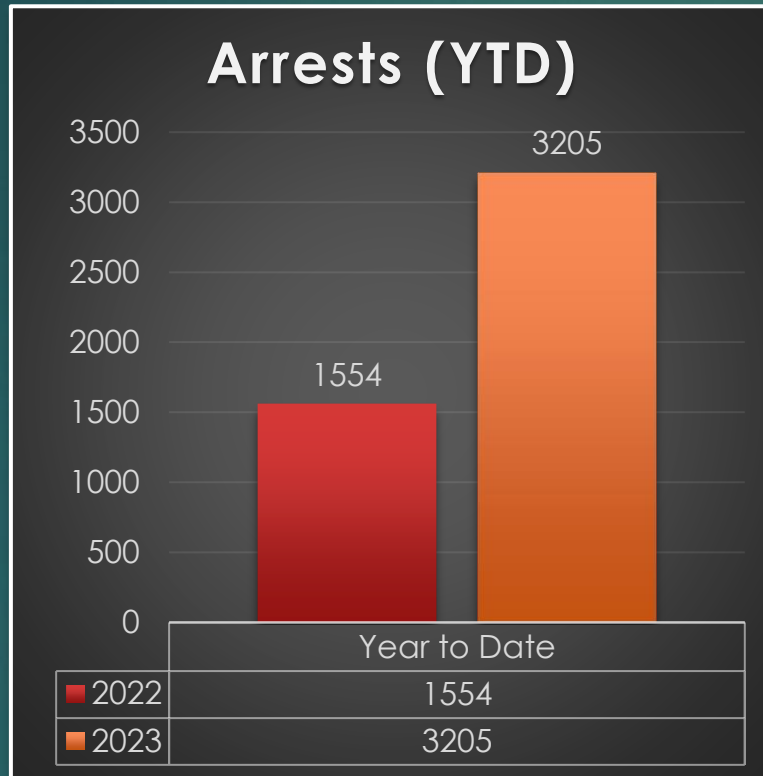
Calls for Service are up **33%** in 2023 vs 2022 YTD.


CFS (2 Week Comparison)

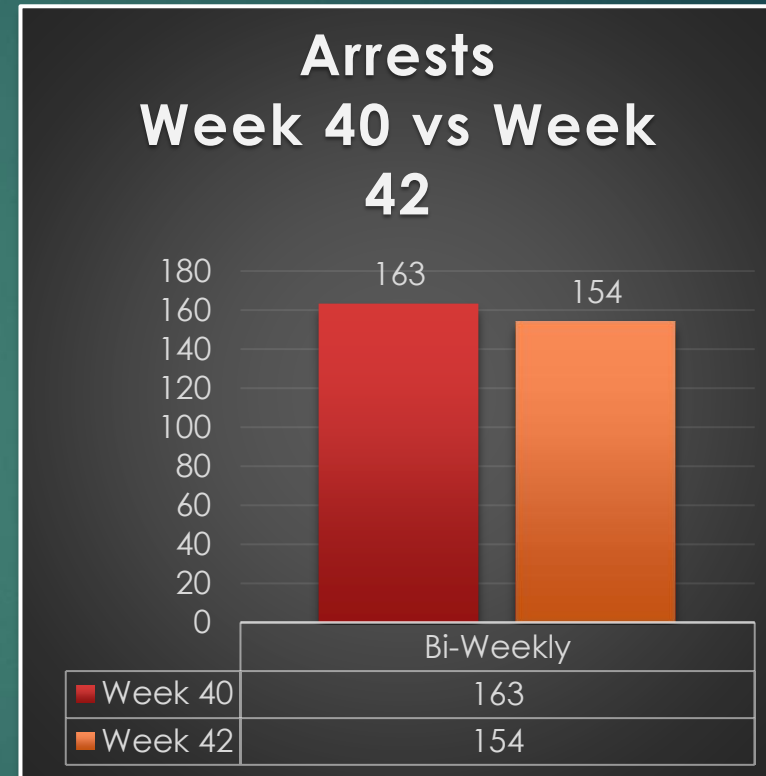


Calls for Service are down **11%** from Week 40 vs Week 42

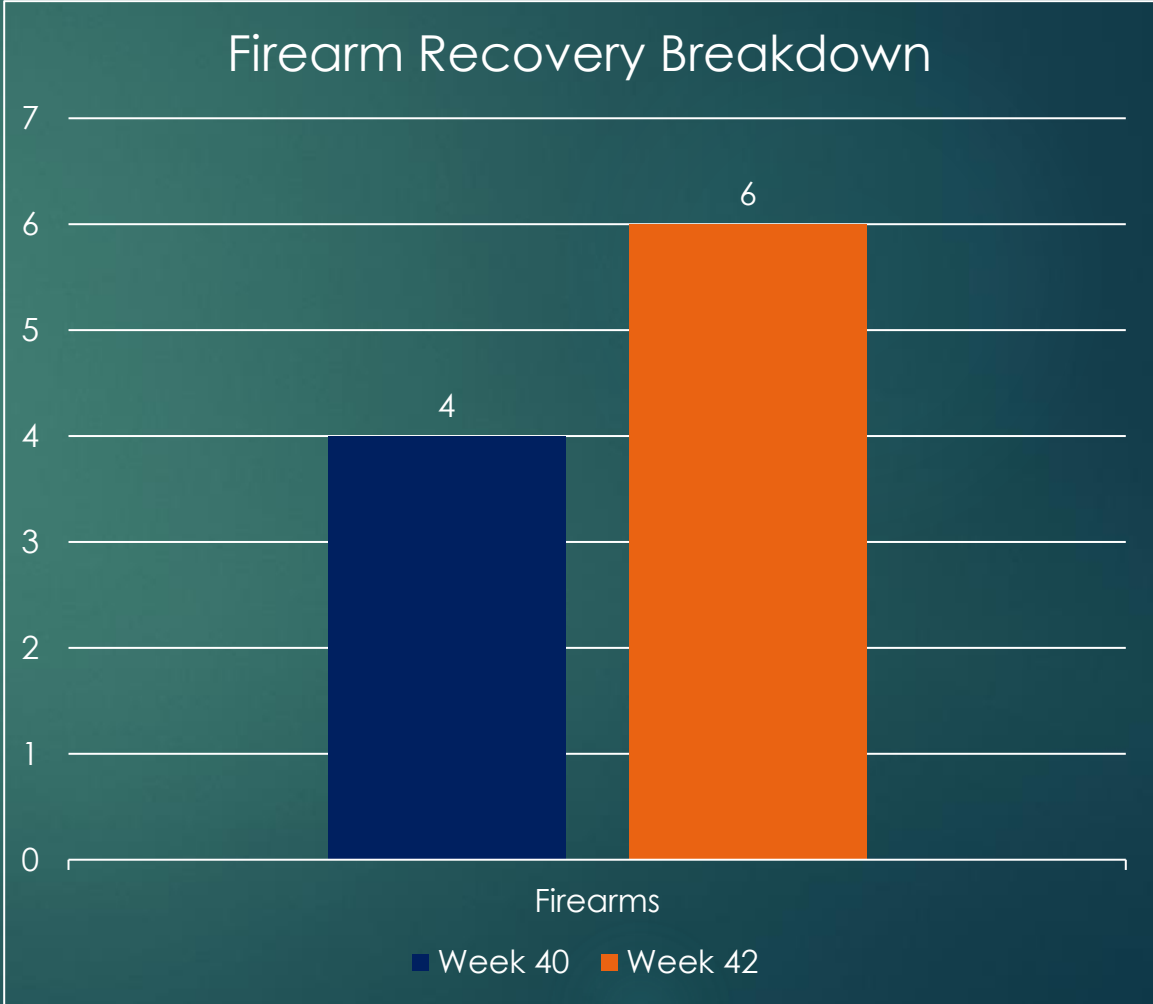
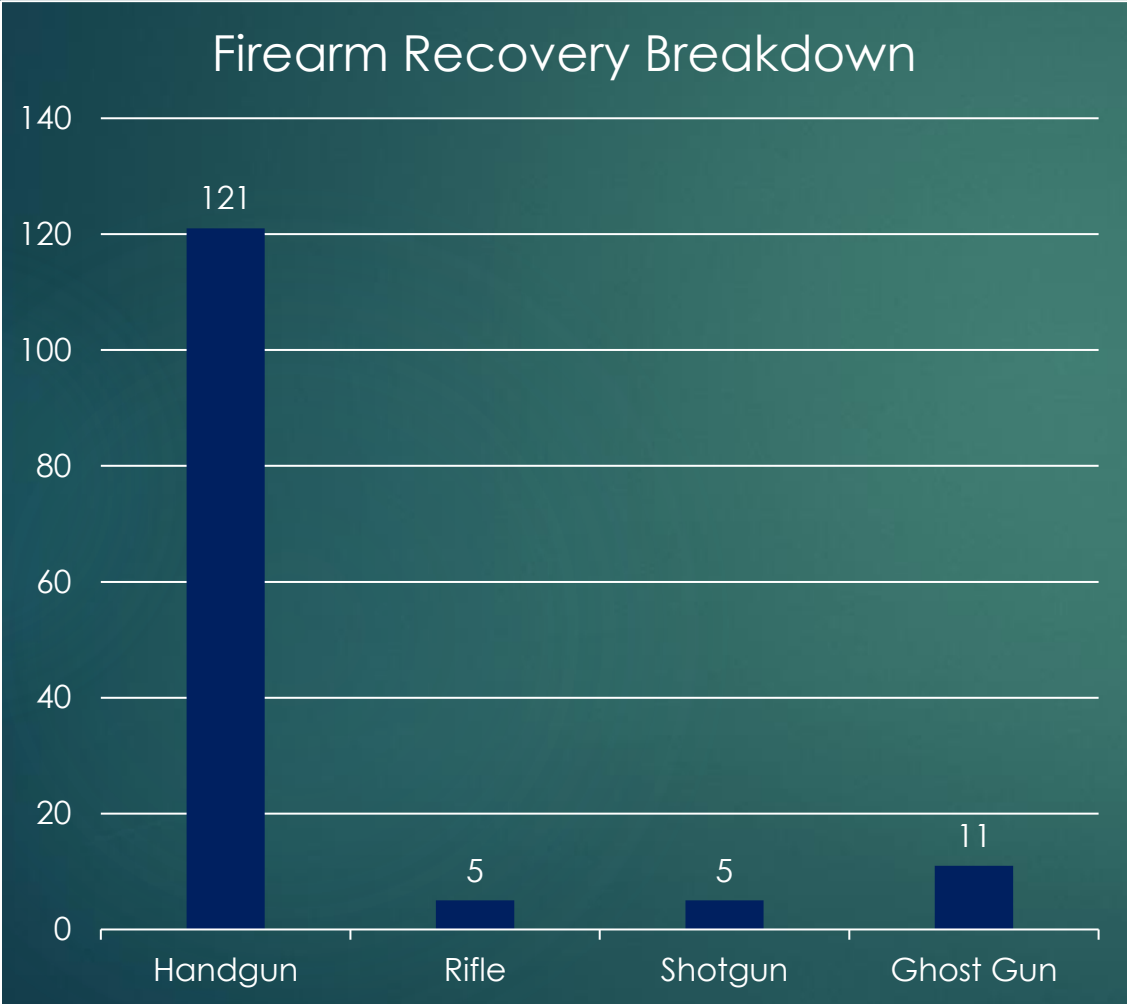

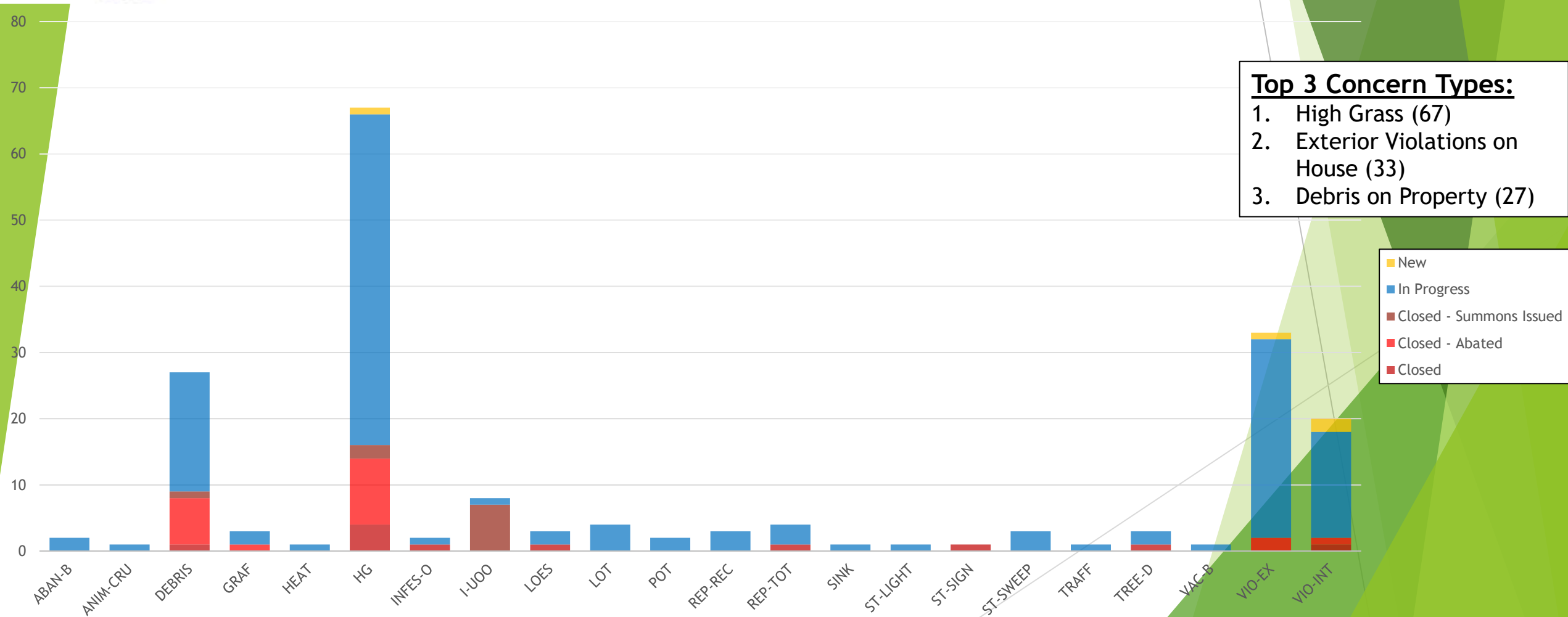
- **42** of those cases have been closed
