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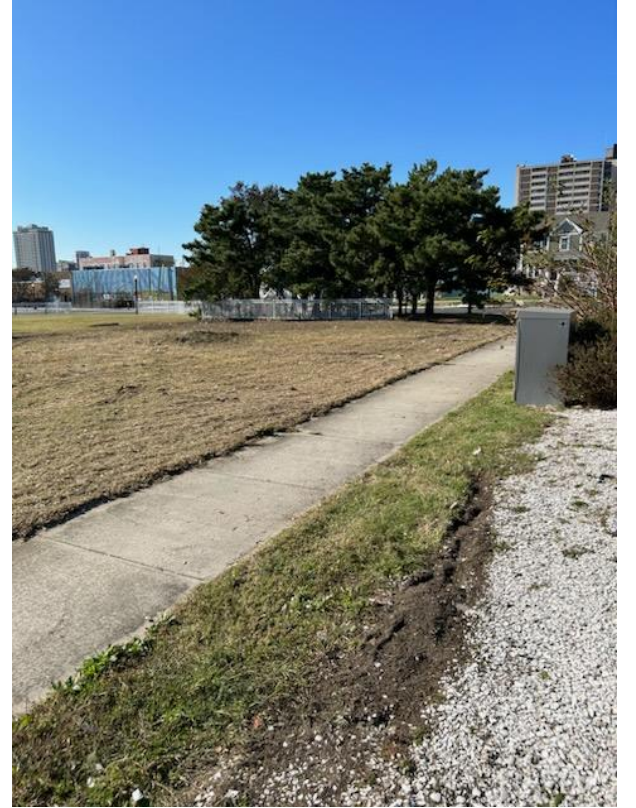

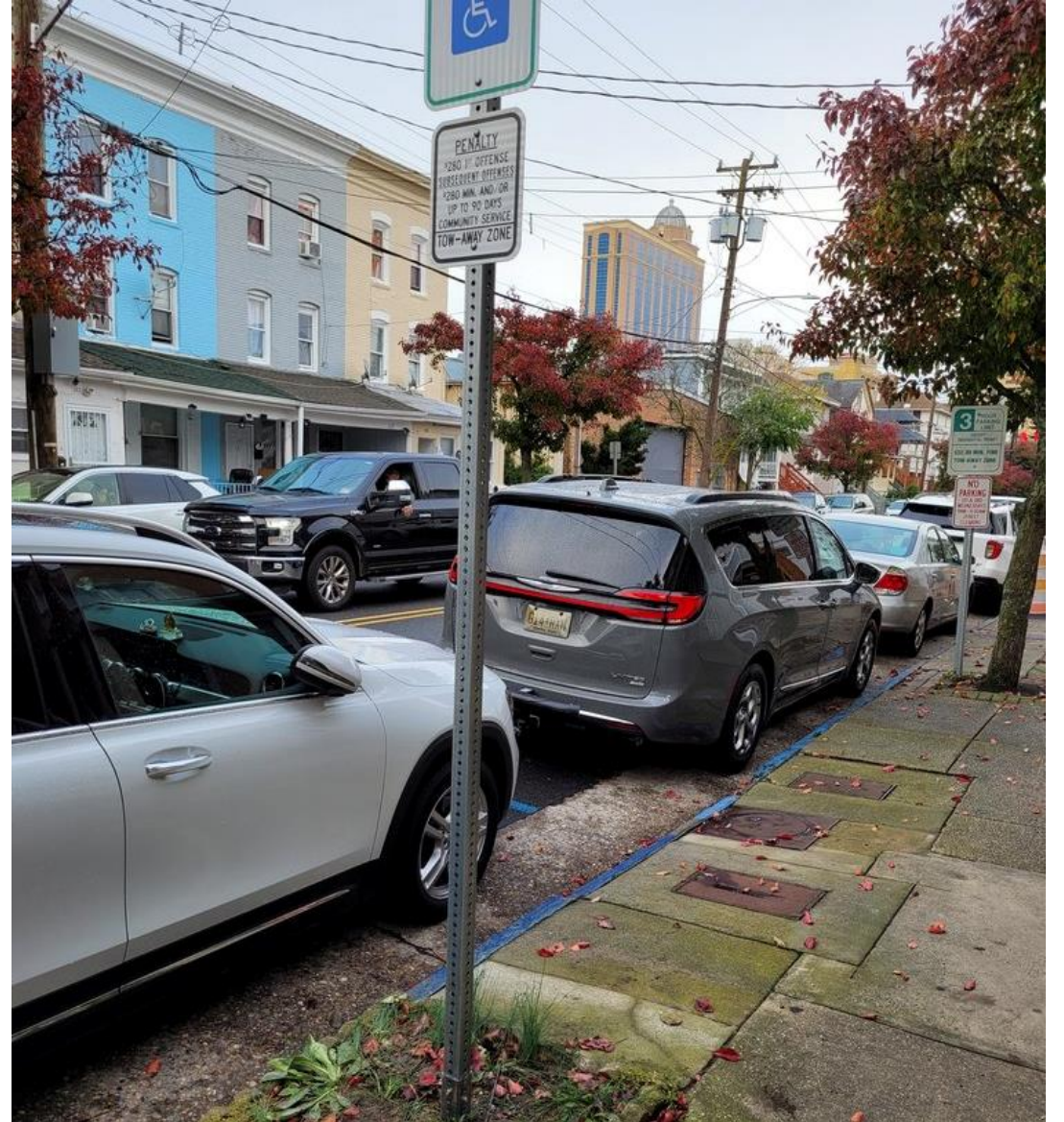

Over the last two weeks, SIS detectives have led four separate investigations resulting in the arrest of seven individuals. During these investigations, the following has been recovered.

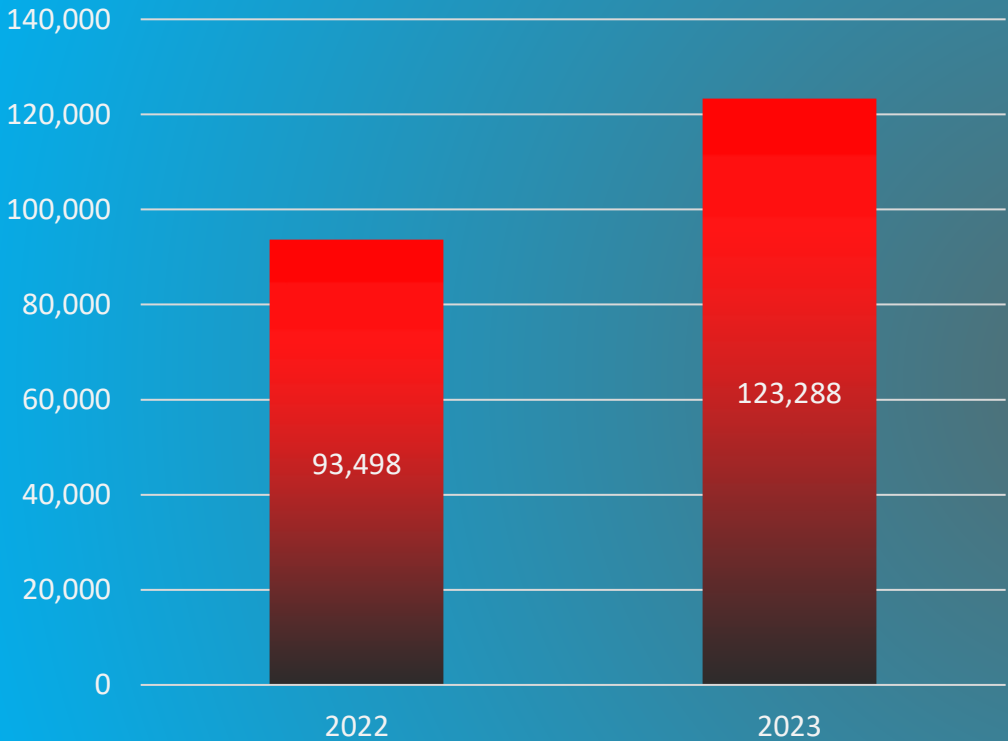
- 9 handguns

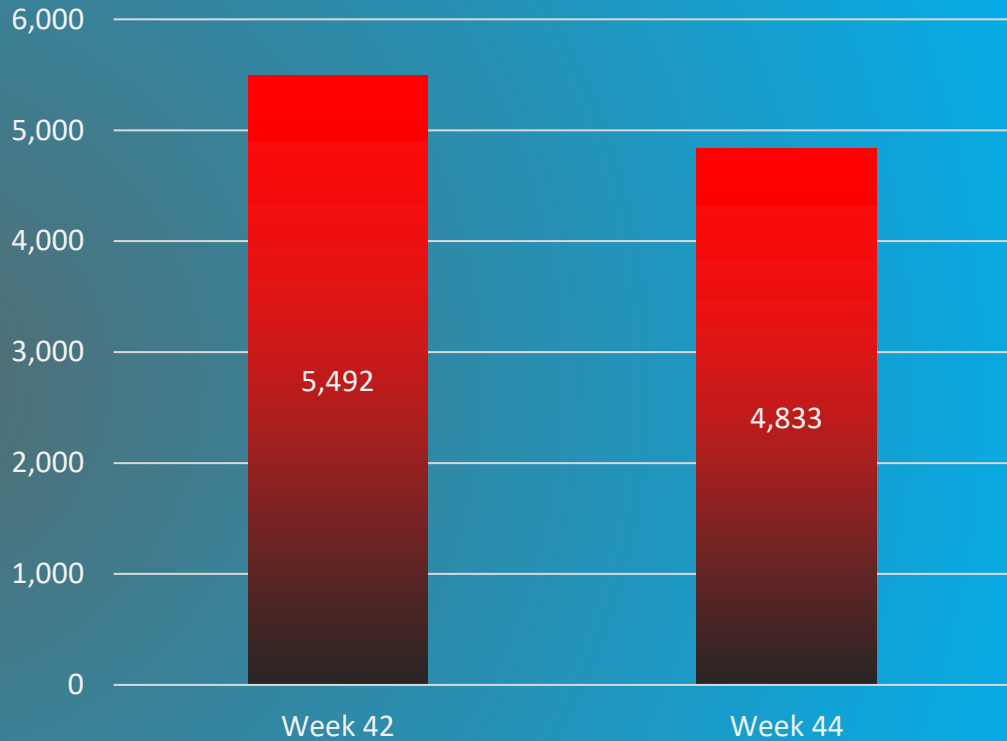
Calls for Service Overview

CFS (Year to Date Comparison)



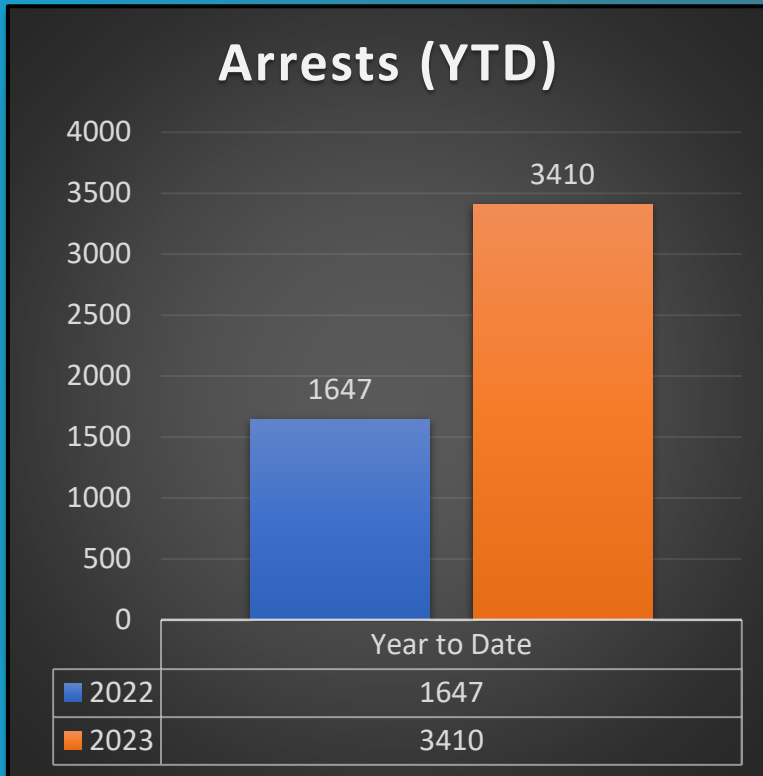
Calls for Service are up **32%** in 2023 vs 2022 YTD.

CFS (2 Week Comparison)

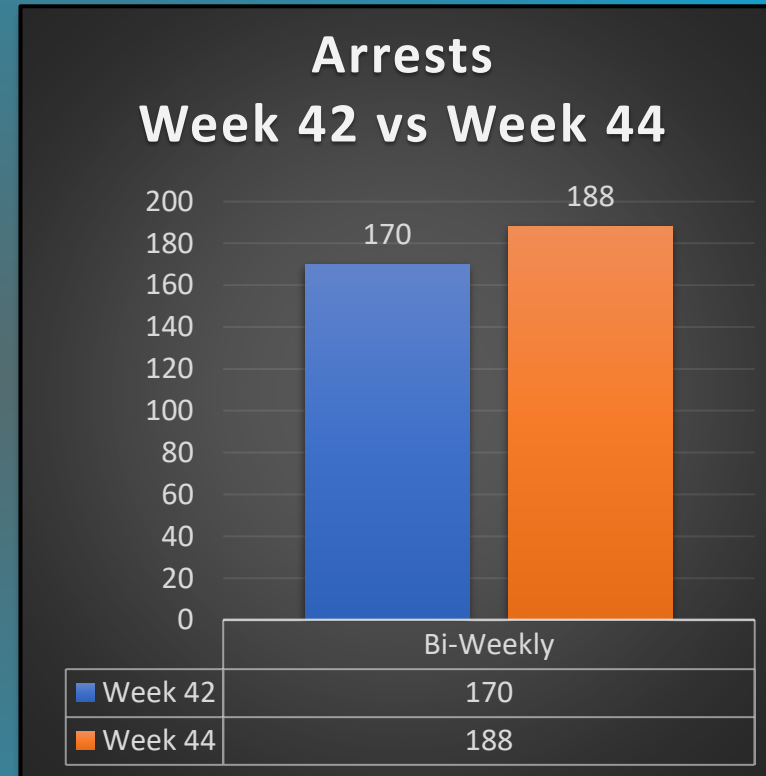

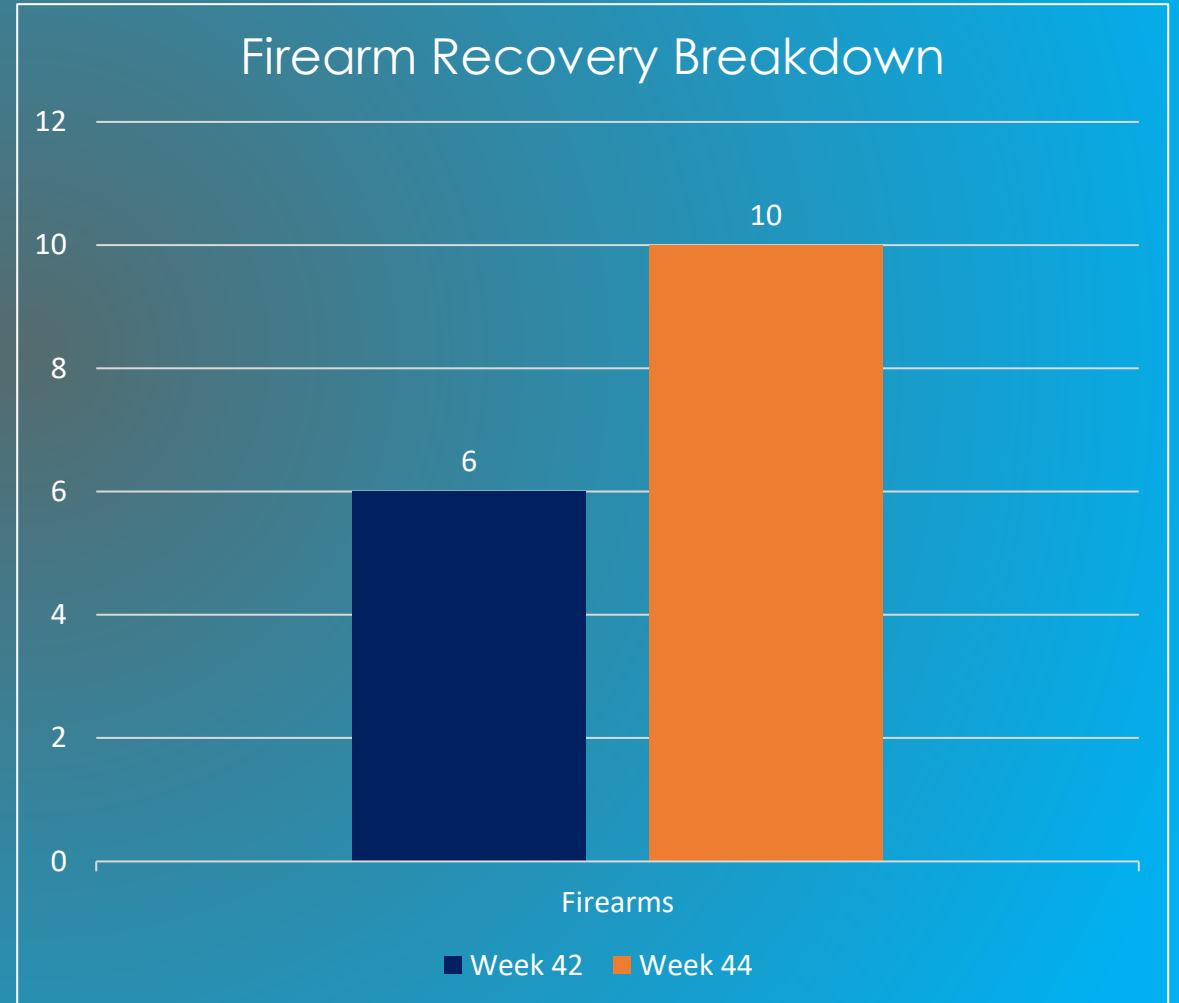
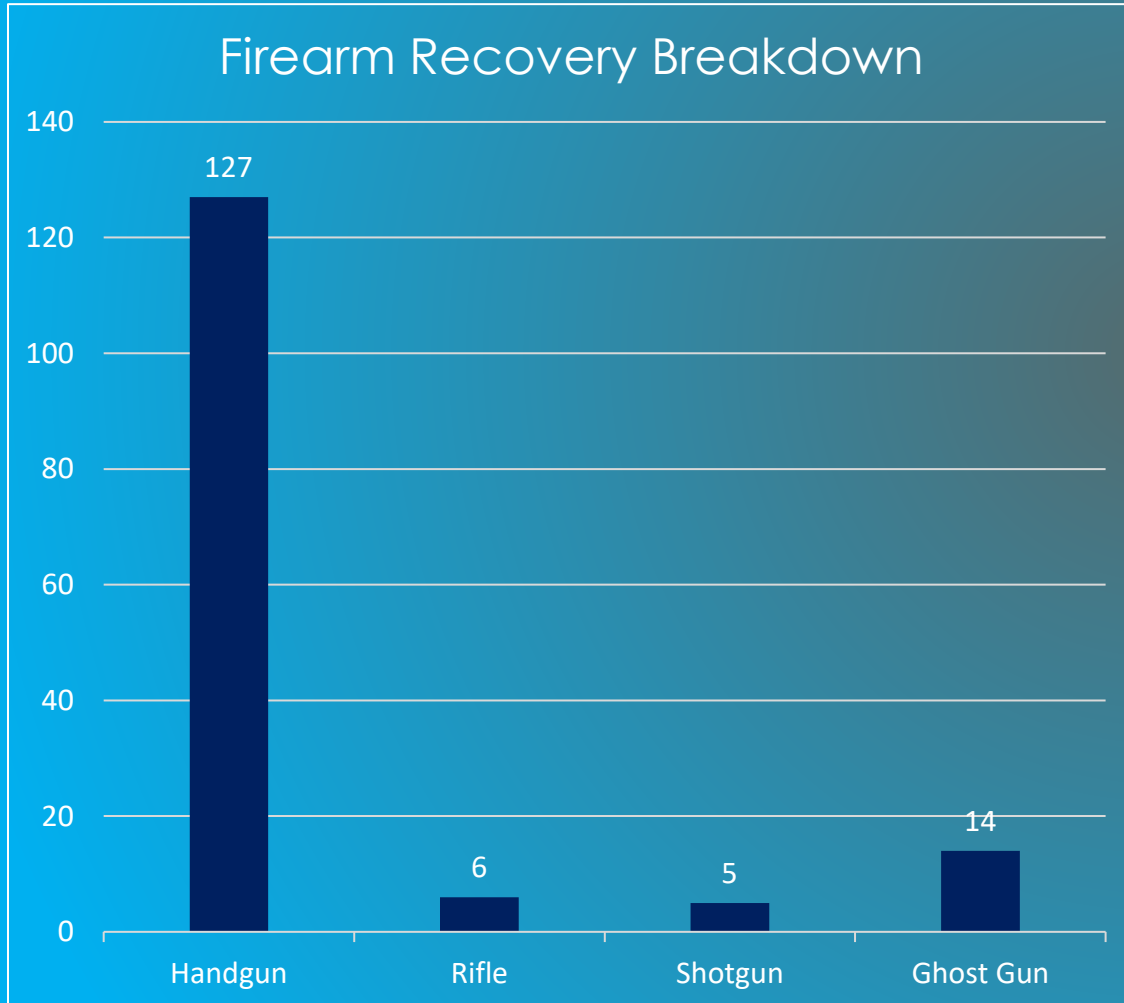

212 total Report-A-Concern cases were received

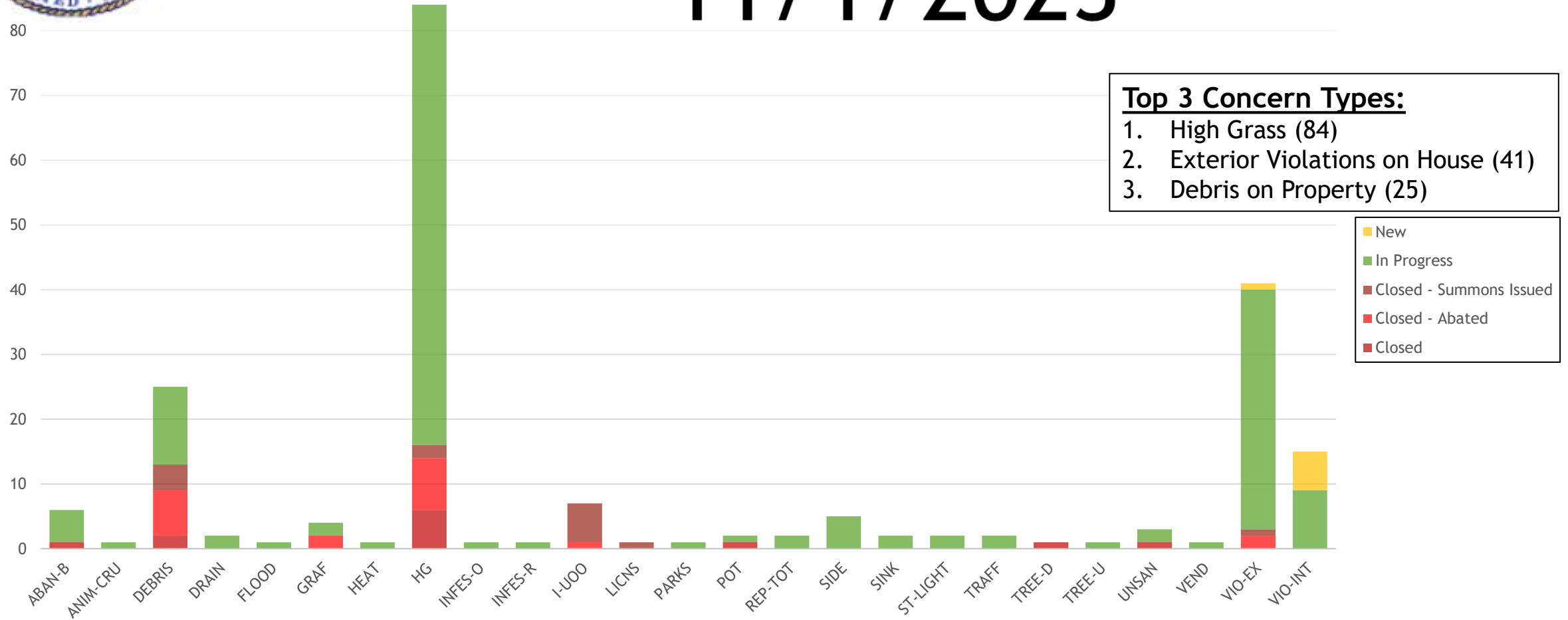
- 46 of those cases have been closed
