**RECOGNITION ON A JOB WELL
DONE**

Officers Danish Mohammad and Ridge Gradel- Bravo 2 Platoon (Commanded by Lt. Frank Timek)

On November 8, Officers Mohammad and Gradel were patrolling the first block of south Florida Avenue when they observed the a man weighing a small object on a scale. This act is consistent with the distribution of narcotics. The officers approached the suspect and saw that cocaine was on the scale. He also had a single bag of heroin in his hand. The suspect was taken into custody without incident. He was found in possession of a loaded handgun and additional drugs.

A continuing investigation led the officers to the suspect's residence in the beach block of St. James Place where officers recovered more narcotics. In total, officers recovered 41 grams of cocaine, 18 grams of heroin, and 27 grams of methamphetamine. All are to be recognized for a job well done!

Officers Matthew Crosby, Gissell Garcia, Jesse Oliver-Logan, and K9 Gee- Bravo 1 Platoon (Commanded by Lt. Robert Macready)

On November 18, Officer Crosby conducted a motor vehicle stop in the 200 block of north South Carolina Avenue. Officer Garcia and K9 Officer Oliver-Logan, and his K9 partner, Gee, who is trained in narcotic detection, assisted.

During the stop, K9 Gee indicted to presence of narcotics in the vehicle. The driver and passenger, were arrested. Both men were found in possession of narcotics. The driver was found in possession of 200 individual bags of heroin while the passenger had 50 individual bags of heroin, 9 grams of cocaine, and more than \$1,100 in cash.

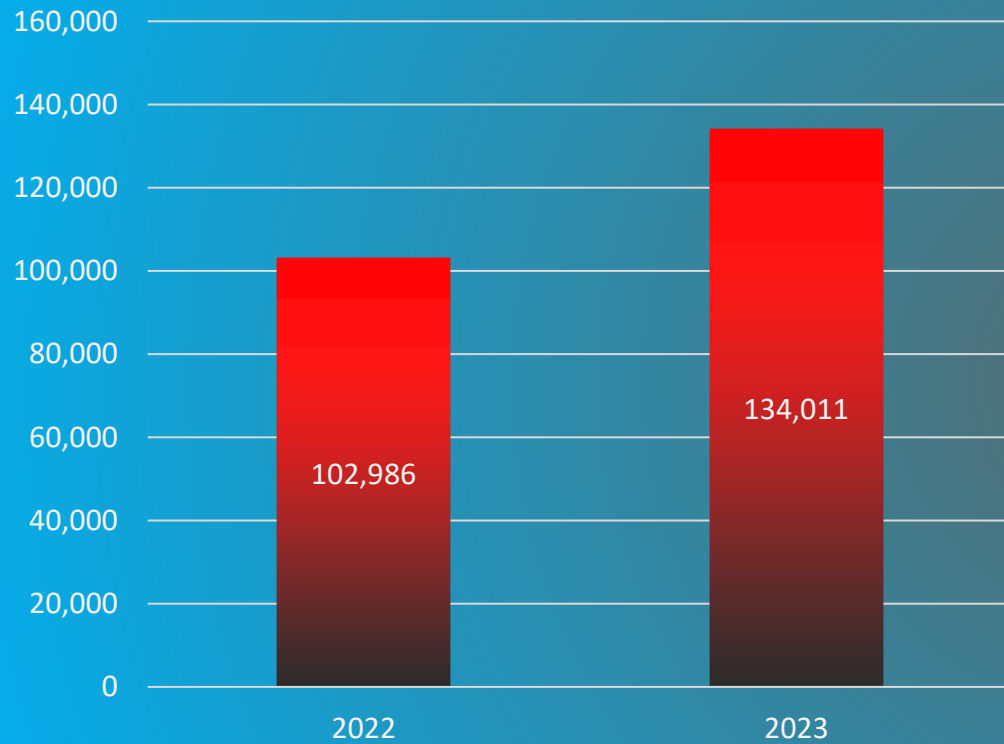
A continuing investigation led the officers to a residence in the 1300 block of Caspian Avenue. With assistance from K9 Gee, the officers recovered 1,175 individual bags of heroin.

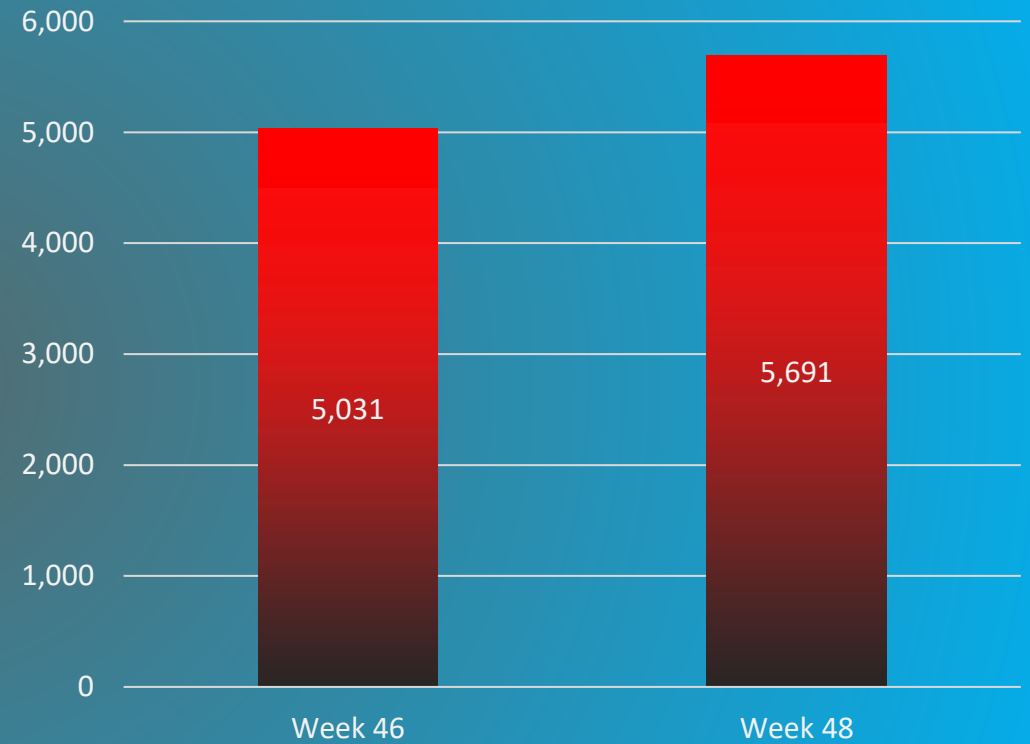
Calls for Service Overview

CFS (Year to Date Comparison)



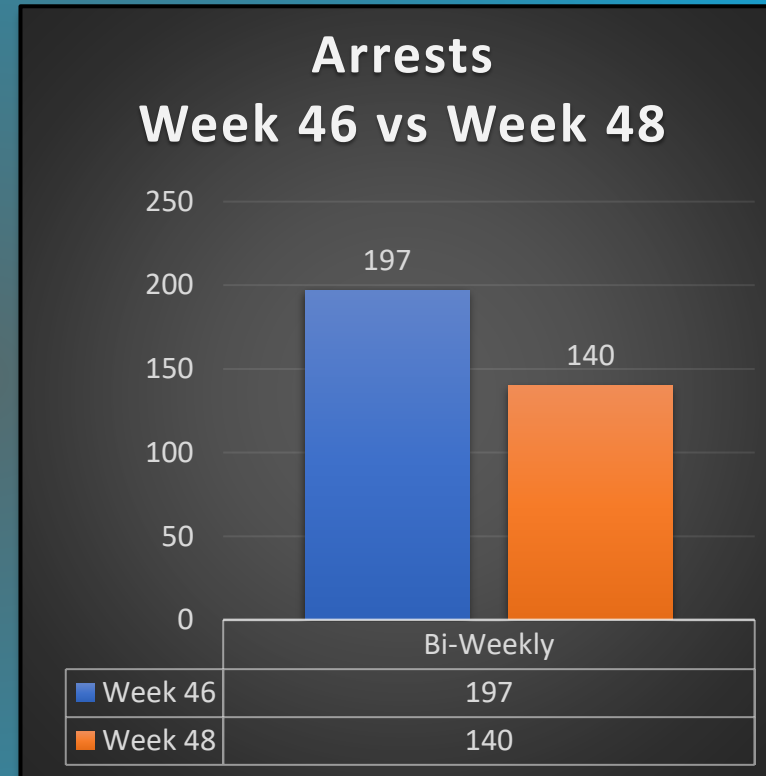
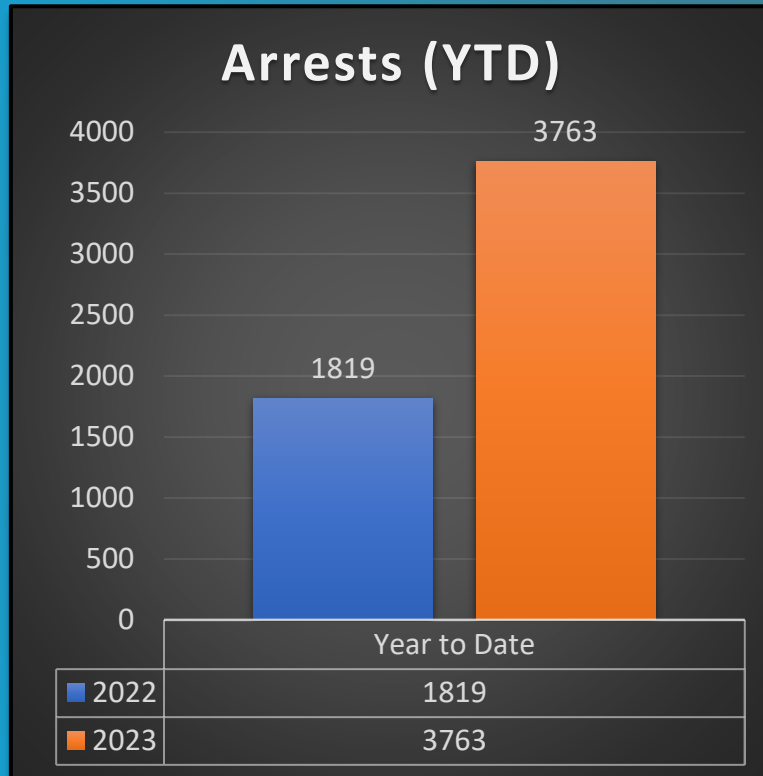
Calls for Service are up **30%** in 2023 vs 2022 YTD.

Arrests Overview



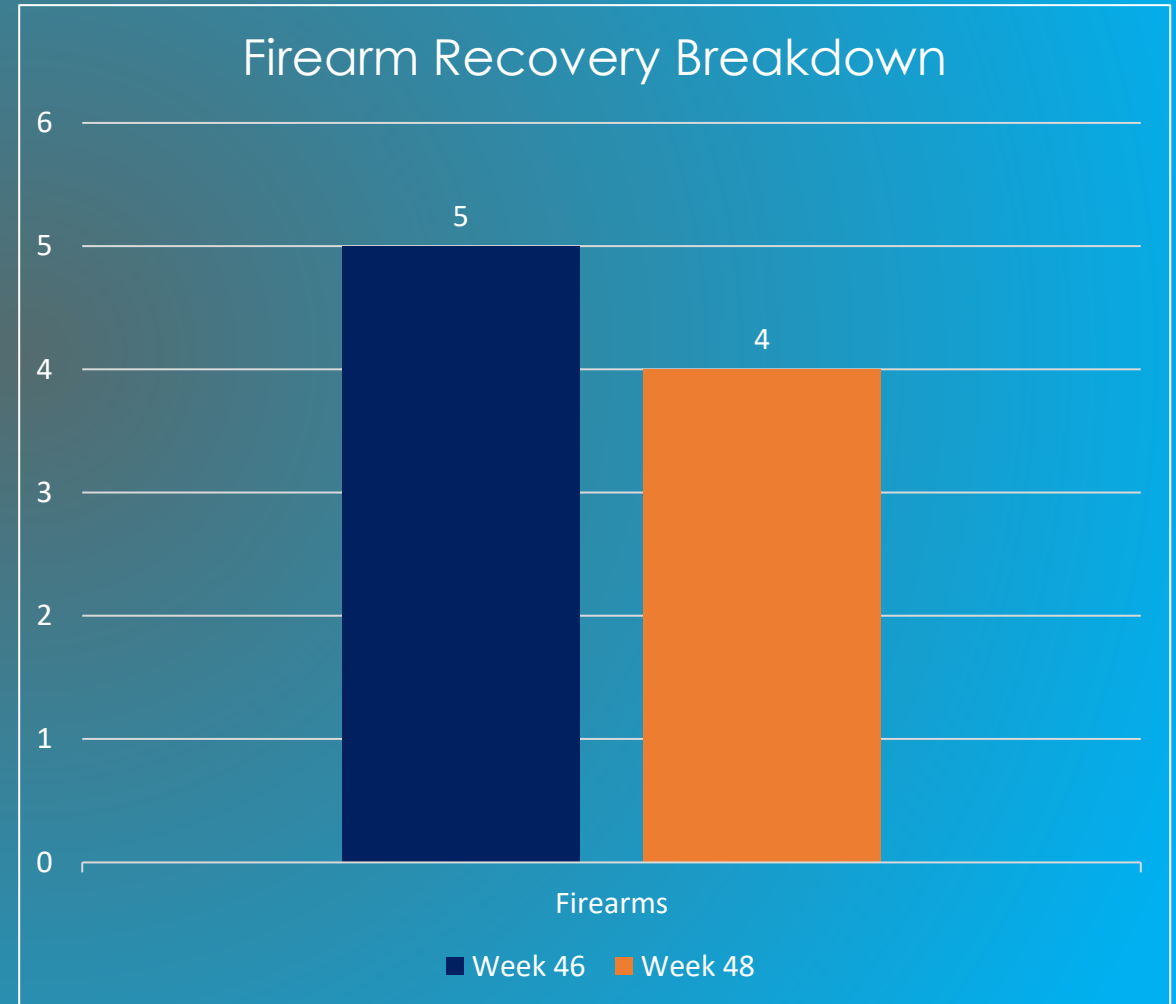
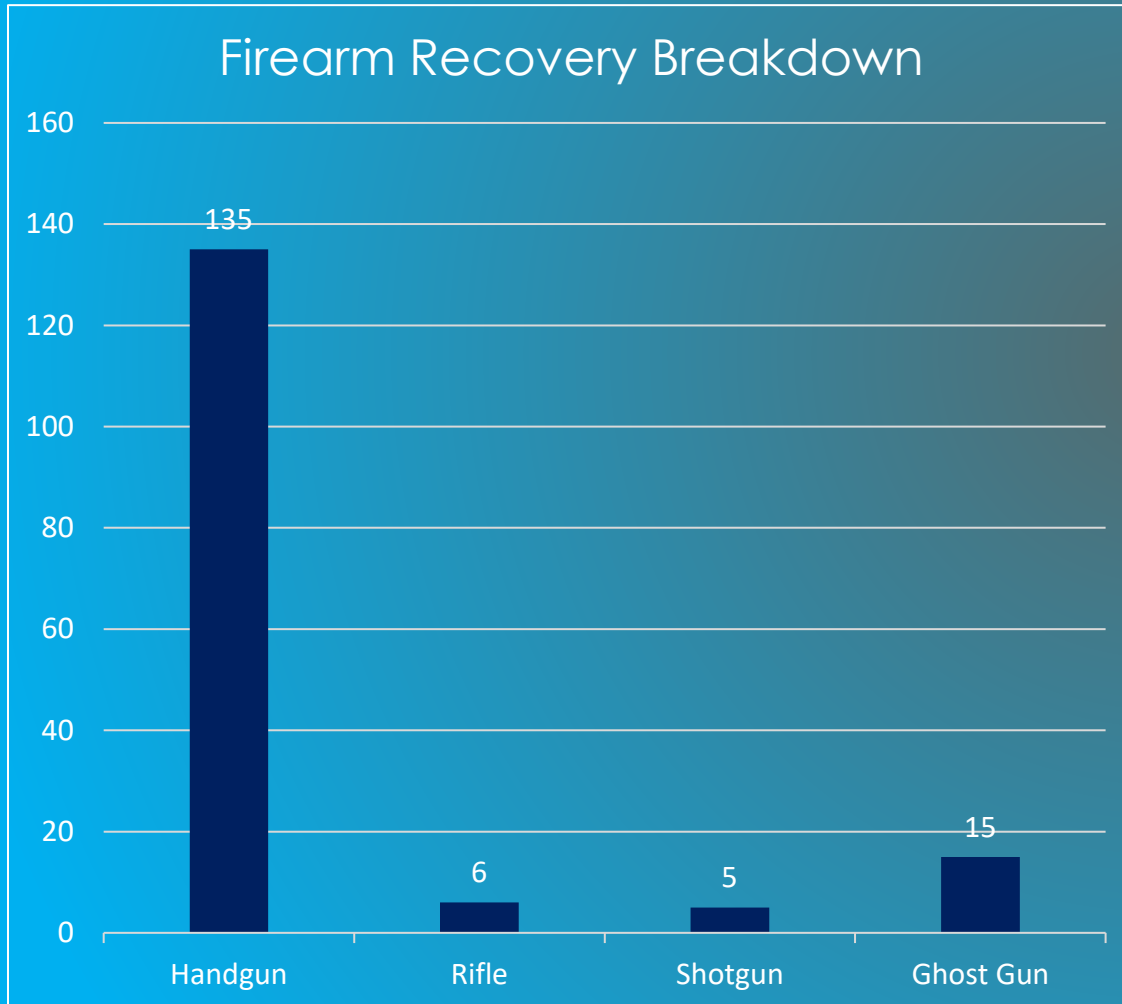

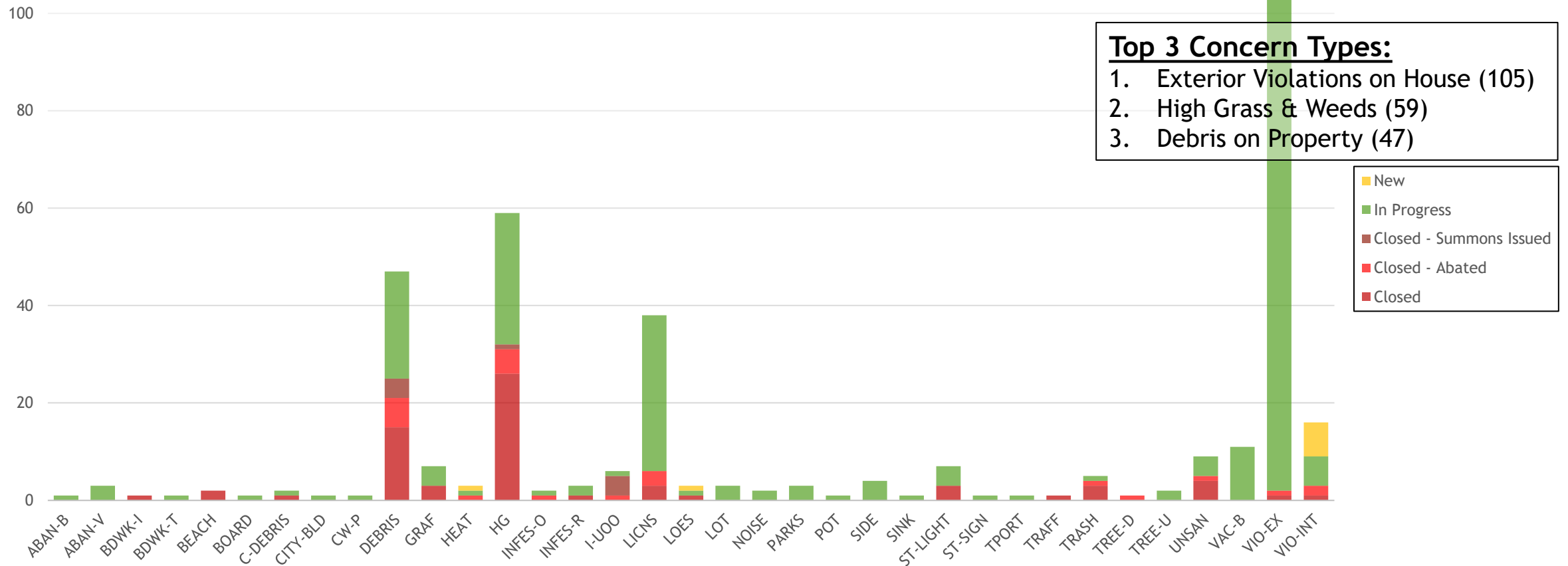
- **99** of those cases have been closed
