**RECOGNITION ON A JOB WELL
DONE**

Officers James Eckert, Rashawn Cochran, and La'Tray Butcher- Alpha 2 Platoon (Commanded by Lt. Donnell Holland)

On December 4, Officer Butcher responded to a residence in the 1200 block of Indiana Avenue for a report of a woman stealing packages off a porch. Officer Butcher observed surveillance video that showed a woman drive her vehicle up towards the residence and steal the packages. A flyer was disseminated to the police department of the suspect and her vehicle.

On December 5, Officer Eckert and Cochran observed the suspect and conducted a motor vehicle stop. The driver matched the suspect's description and had warrants for her arrest. The officers also observed opened packages in the rear seat that were identical to the items stolen off the porch.

Officers Christopher Campbell, Bayron Zelaya-Chavez, Wahab Malik, and Criminal Investigation Section detectives

On December, patrol officers responded to the first block of south Iowa Avenue in reference to a man that was stabbed. Officer Campbell arrived to locate the victim suffering from a stab wound to his leg. A resident of the building was attempting to render aid to the victim. Officer Campbell immediately took over medical aid by applying a tourniquet to the victim's leg. The victim was later transported to the medical center to be treated for non-life-threatening injuries.

While on scene, Officer Campbell spoke with the resident who stated that he witnessed the victim being robbed. An investigation by officers, and later detectives of the Criminal Investigations Section, determined that Hall had stabbed the victim after the two became involved in a dispute. Hall was located inside an apartment and taken into custody.

Officers Albert Herbert and Howard Mason and Ventnor City Detective Kevin Brady

Officer Herbert arrested a man following an investigation into graffiti being spray painted and marked on numerous locations in Atlantic City and Ventnor City. Officer Herbert was aided in the investigation by Officer Mason and Detective Brady.

During the month of August, both police departments were alerted to numerous locations that were vandalized including completed art projects in the Lower Chelsea neighborhood of Atlantic City, electrical boxes, and businesses. The officers began a cooperative investigation that led to the arrest.

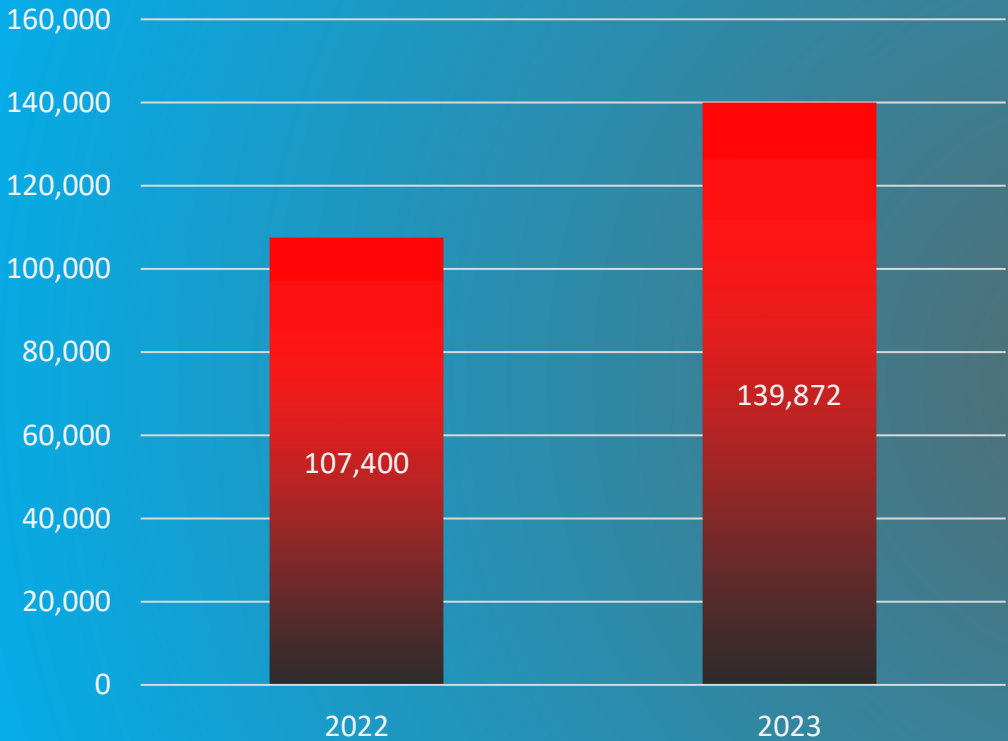
During a search of the suspect's residence, officers located evidence that was used including a sketchbook with artwork, 73 spray paint cans, 30 paint markers, approximately 75 spray nozzles, and 150 Sharpie markers.

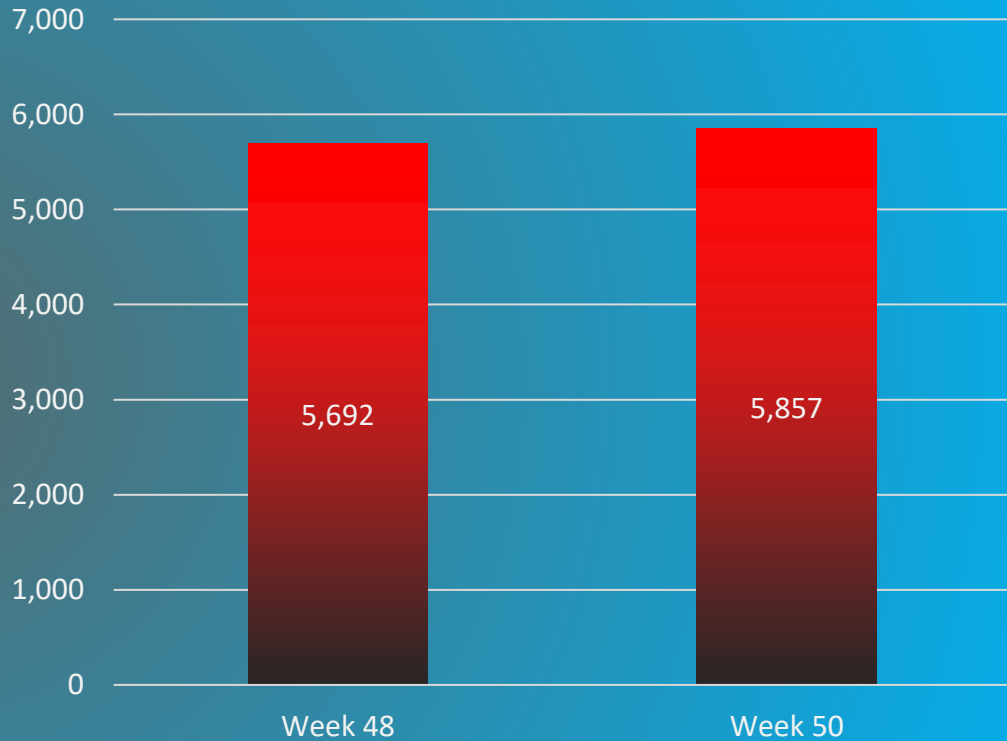
Calls for Service Overview

CFS (Year to Date Comparison)



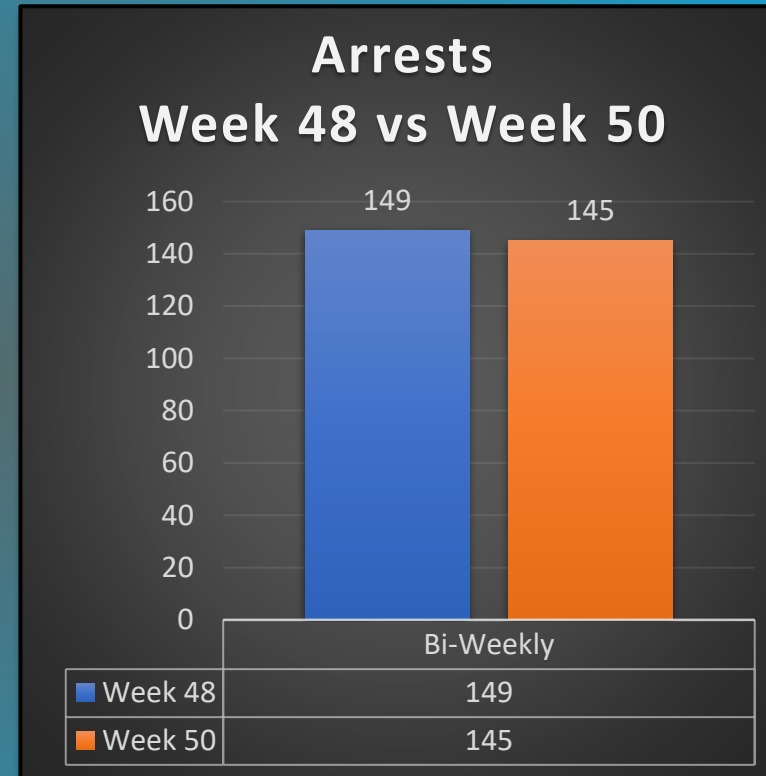
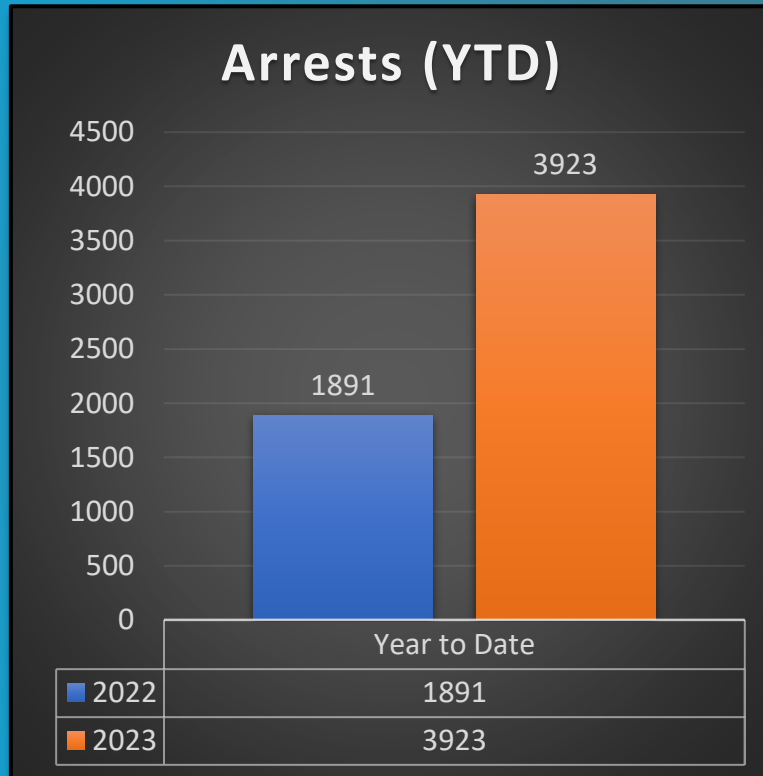
Calls for Service are up **30%** in 2023 vs 2022 YTD.

Arrests Overview



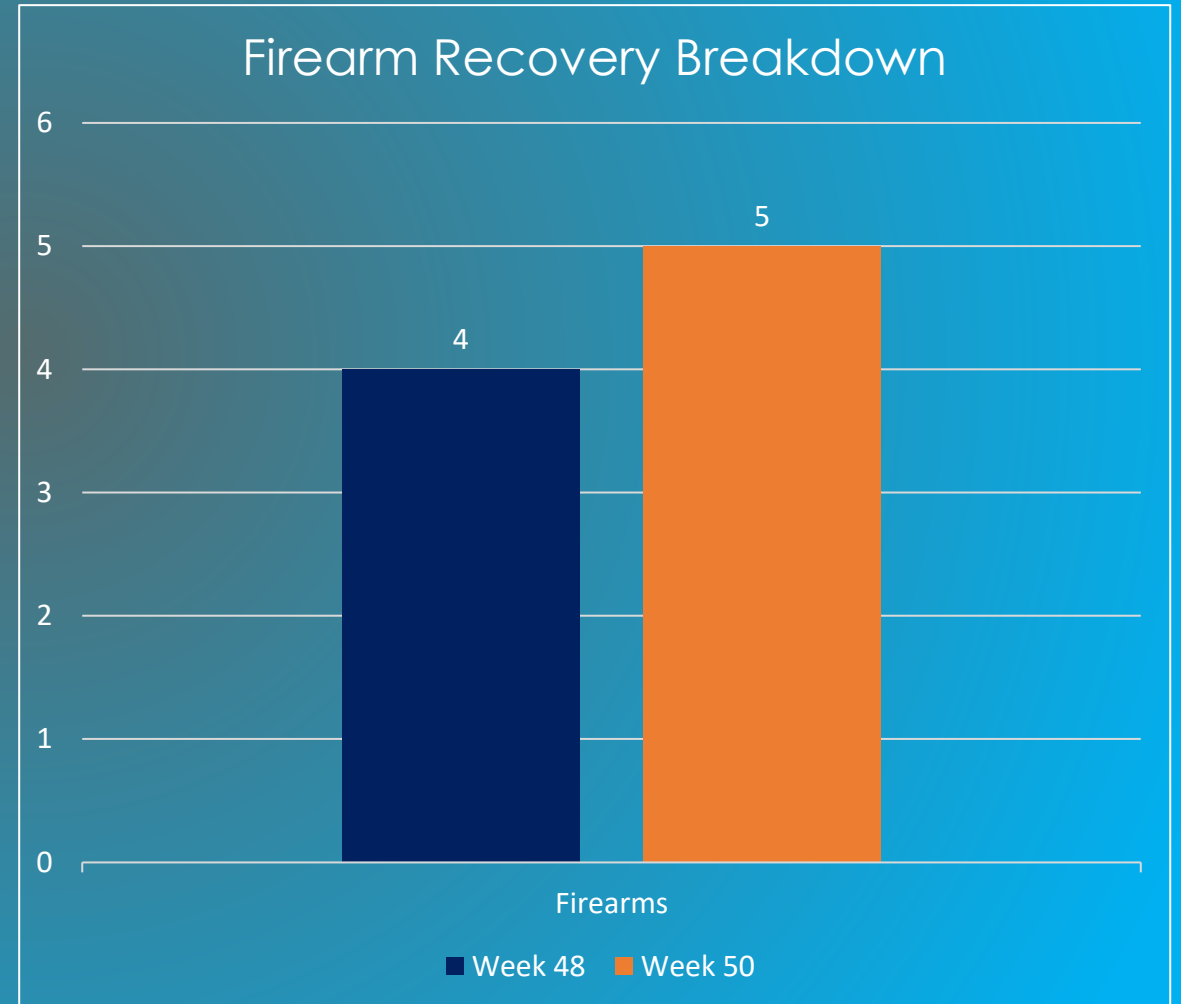
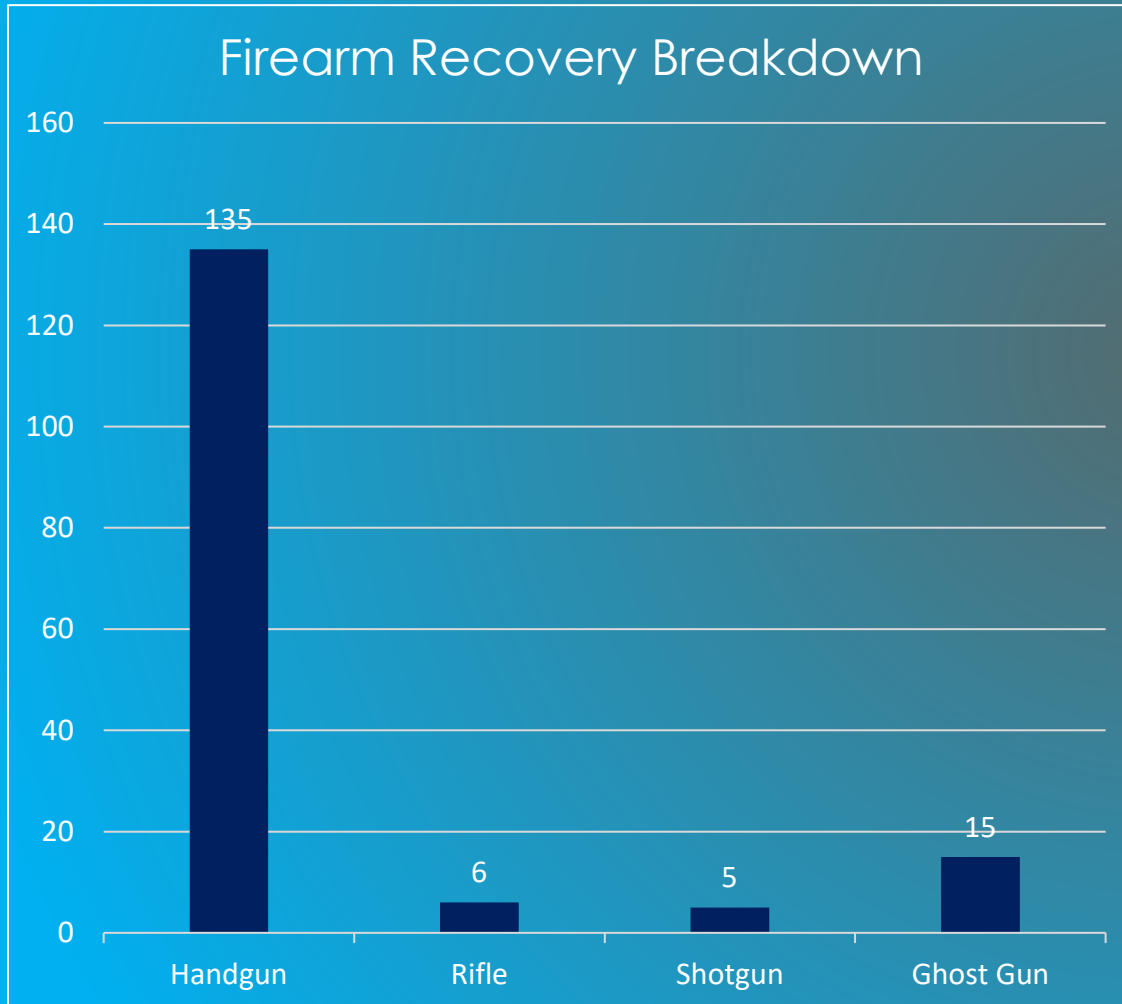

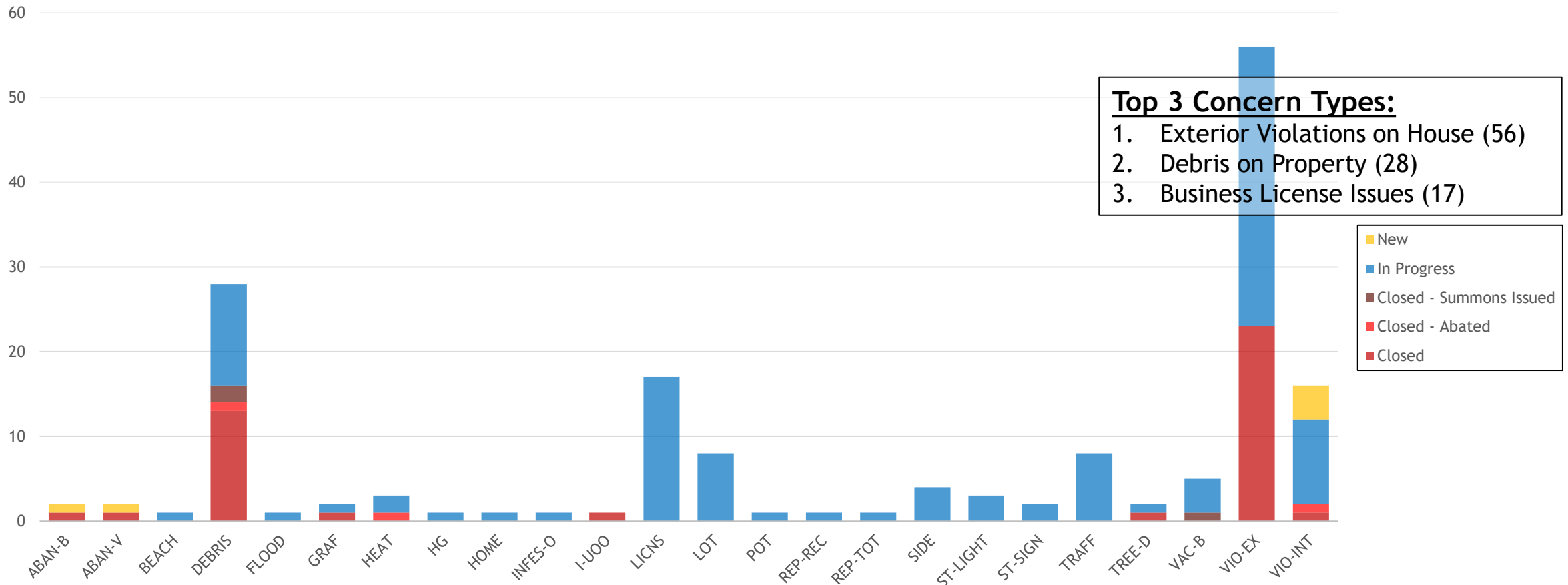


