**RECOGNITION ON A JOB WELL
DONE**

Surveillance Center Personnel and Officer Kevin McGloin- Charlie 2 Platoon (Commanded by Lt. Omar Martin)

On December 20, at 2:25 AM, Surveillance Center personnel alerted patrol officers to a burglary in progress at a restaurant in the 3000 block of the Boardwalk. A description of the suspect was provided to responding officers. Officer McGloin quickly arrived and observed the suspect walking away from the store. The suspect was stopped and found to be in possession of bolt cutters. He was placed in custody without incident. He was also found to have numerous active warrants for his arrest.

Officers Moustafa Maarouf and Ivaylo Penchev- Charlie 1 Platoon (Commanded by Lt. Howard Johnson)

On December 28, patrol officers responded to the 400 block of Indiana Avenue for a ShotSpotter alert detecting gunshots in the area. Officers arrived to locate evidence of gunfire. Through the initial investigation, officers were able to obtain descriptions of two men leaving the area in a vehicle.

Officers Maarouf and Penchev located the suspect vehicle and observed two men matching the description of the suspects standing outside. As the officers attempted to speak with the men, one man fled leading Officer Penchev on a foot pursuit. During the chase, the man discarded a handgun and was ultimately apprehended. Officer Maarouf detained the second man who was questioned and later released pending further investigation.

Officer Julian Monsalve- Bravo 1 Platoon (Commanded by Lt. Robert Macready)

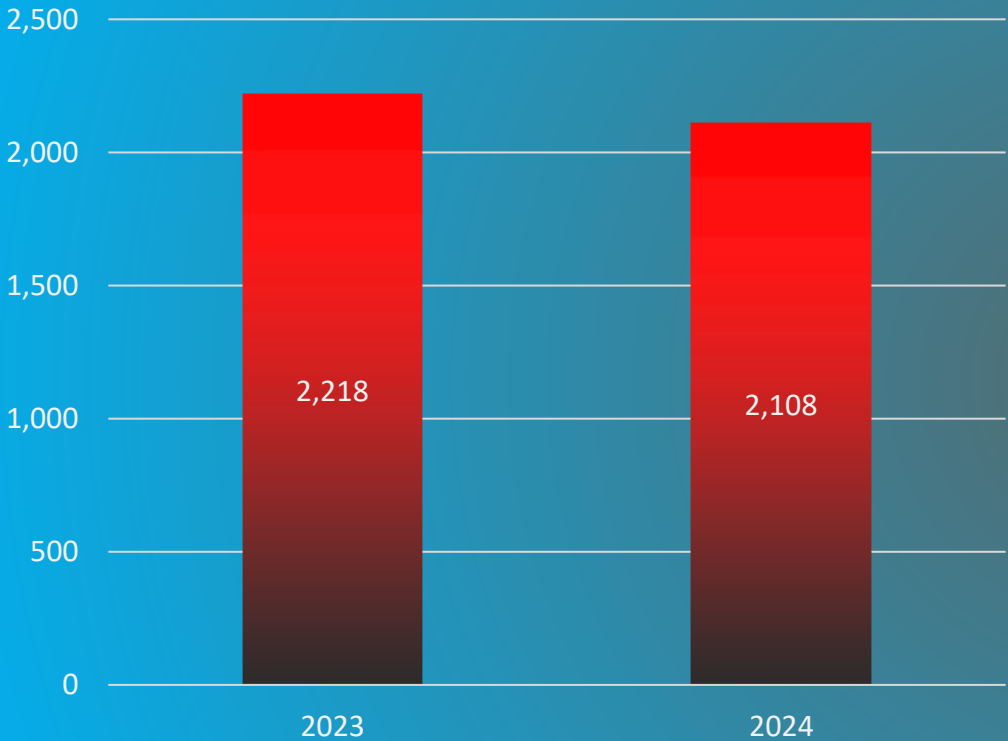
On January 4, Officer Monsalve observed a burglary suspect walking in the 1300 block of Atlantic Avenue. The man matched the description of suspect involved in a vehicle burglary the night before that occurred nearby. Officer Monsalve attempted to detain the suspect who ignored the officer's directions and continued to walk away before eventually running away. The suspect attempted to climb a chain-link fence to escape, but was unsuccessful and apprehended. As Officer Monsalve was attempting to take the suspect into custody, the suspect used his free hand to attempt to reach under his body towards his waistband area. After being secured in handcuffs and moved to a seated position, a loaded handgun was located under the suspect. The suspect was also charged in the vehicle burglary.

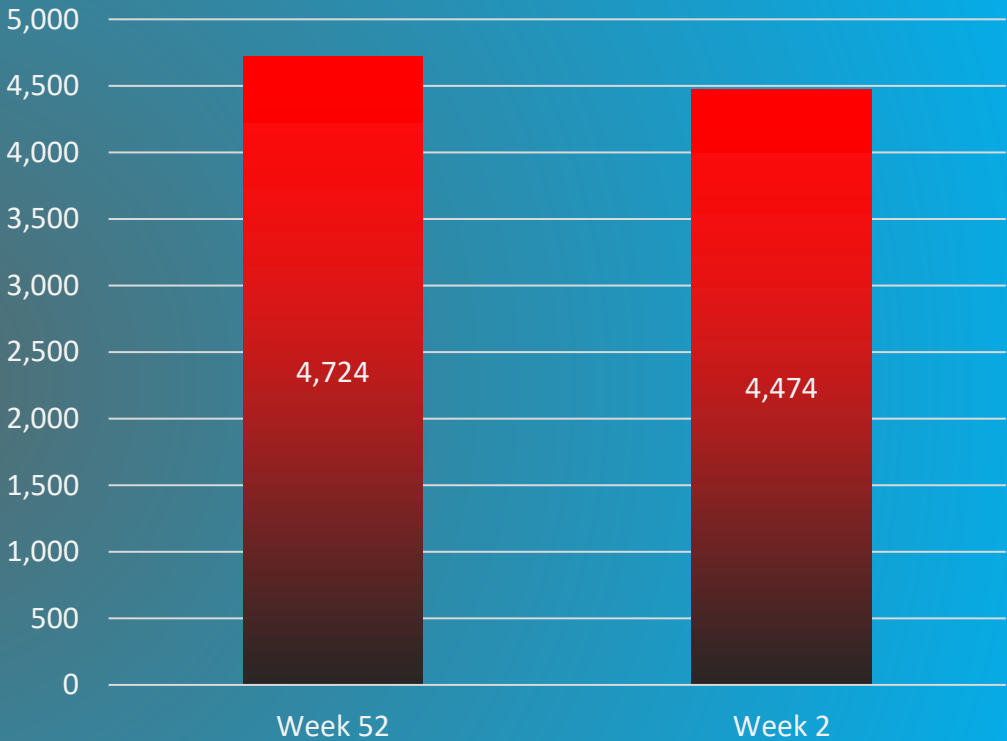
Calls for Service Overview

CFS (Year to Date Comparison)



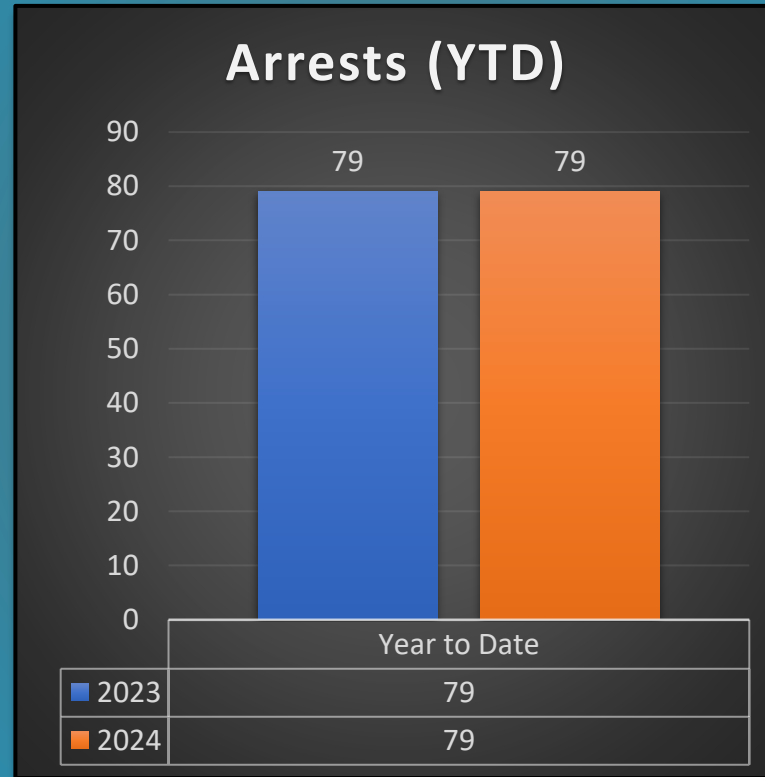
Calls for Service are down **5%** in 2024 vs 2023 YTD.

Arrests Overview

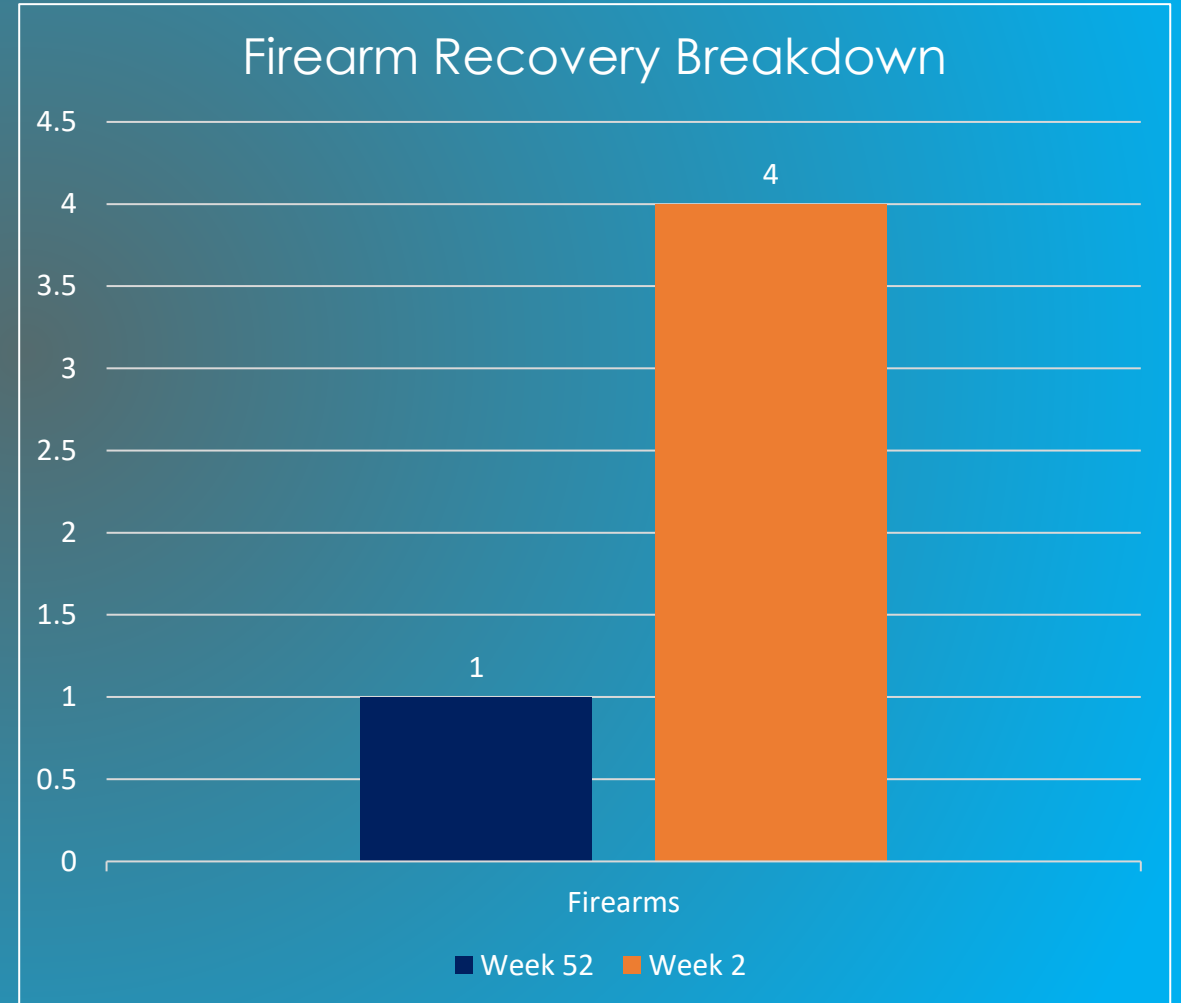
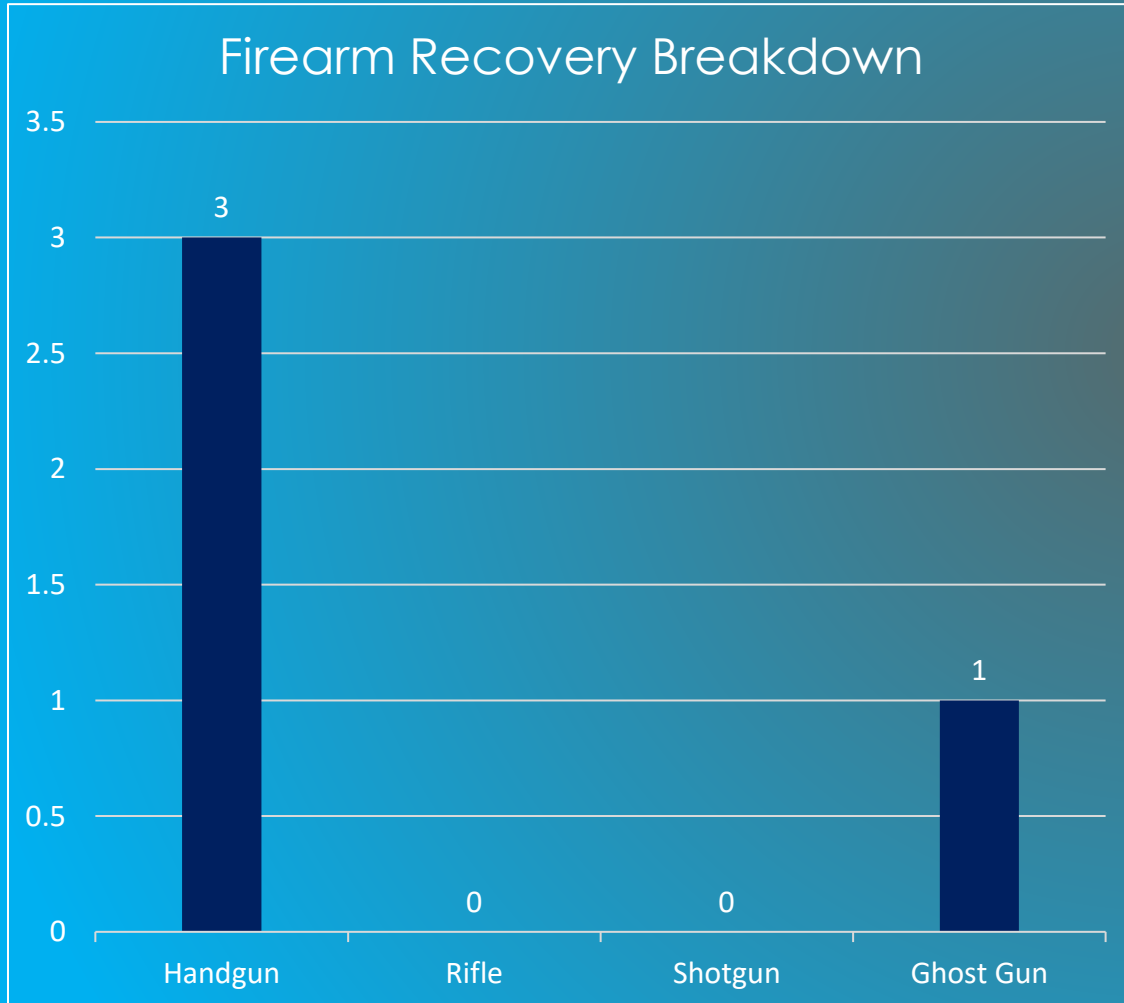

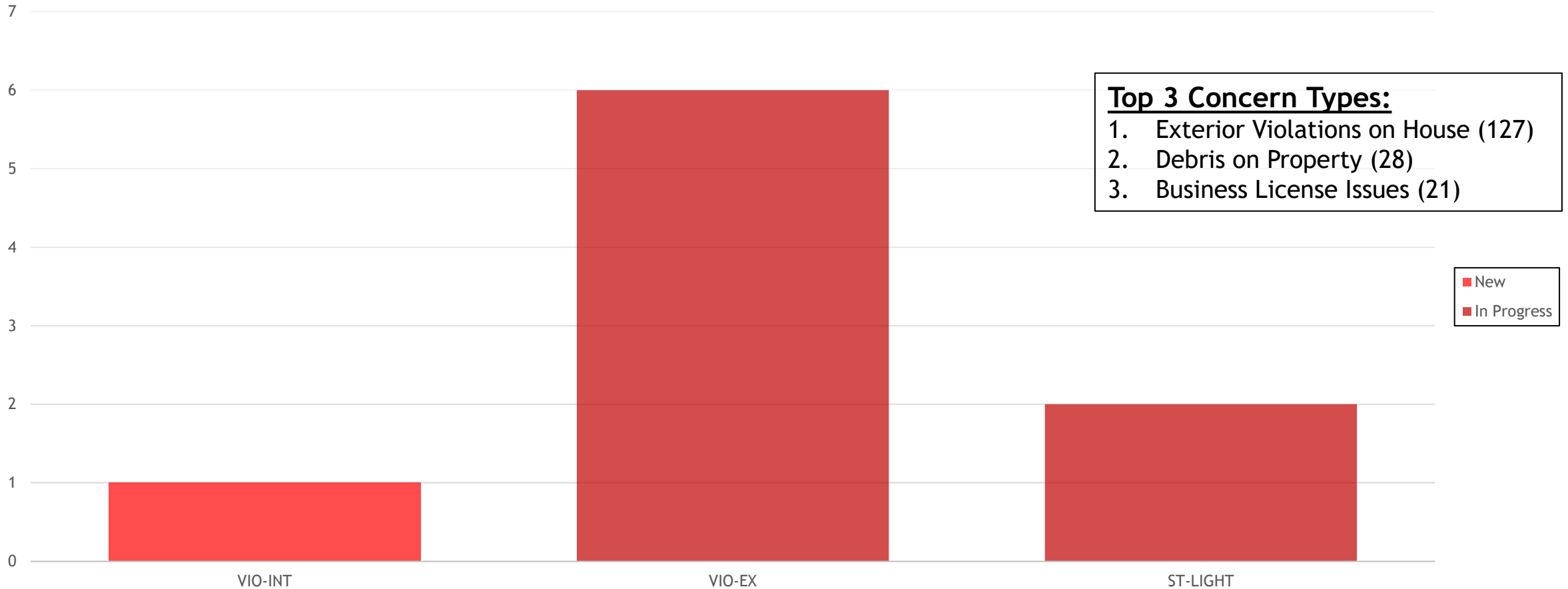
- 108 of those cases have been closed

Geographic Location



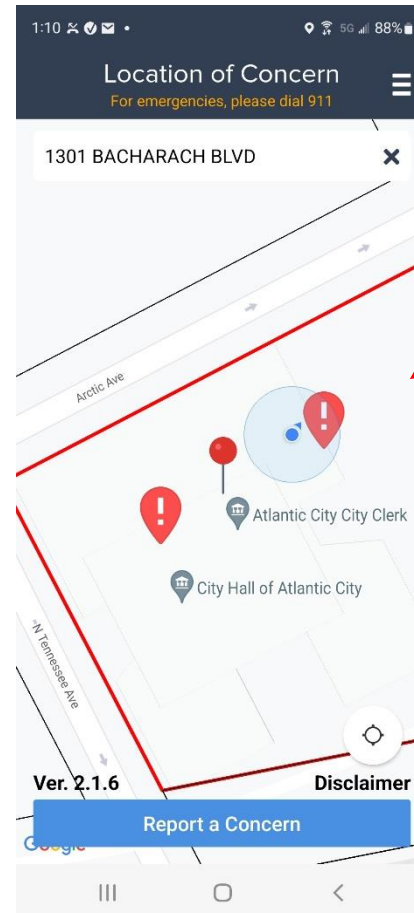
