On January 18, patrol officers responded to the 700 block of Drexel Avenue for a report of a man in possession of handgun who was openly displaying it. As officers arrived into the area, updated location information was provided. Officer Flynn located and attempted to speak with two males who fled. One male initially tripped and was detained. This male was a juvenile and released into the custody of his mother.

He was quickly apprehended. The suspect was found in possession of a handgun that had been reported stolen and had several active warrants for his arrest.

Platoon (Commanded by Lt. Henry White III)**

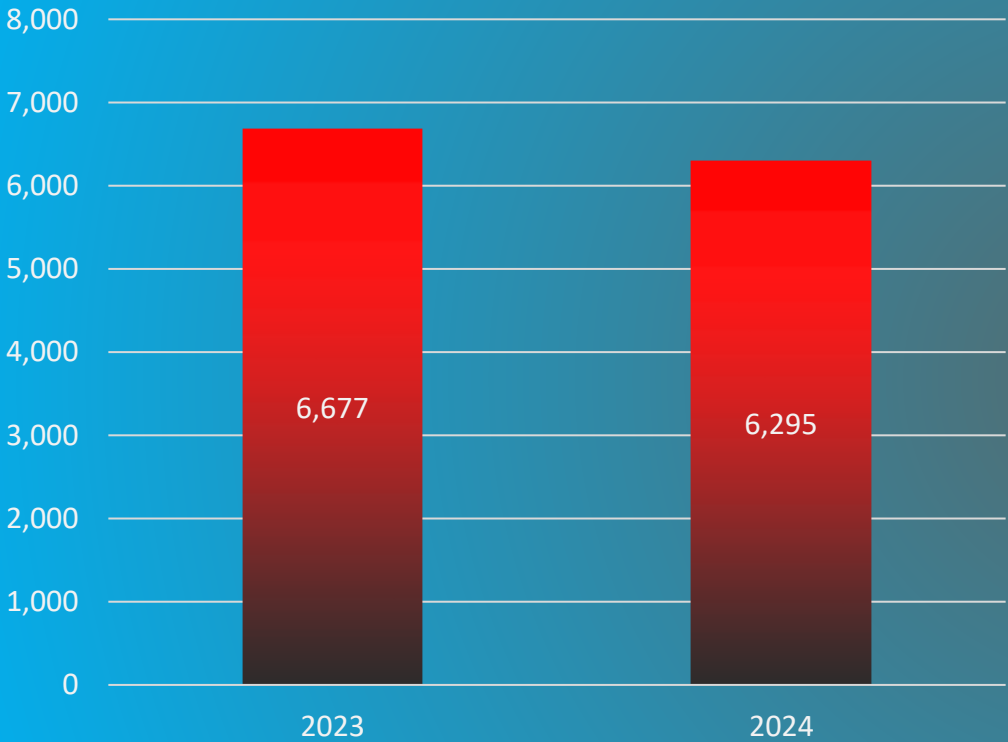

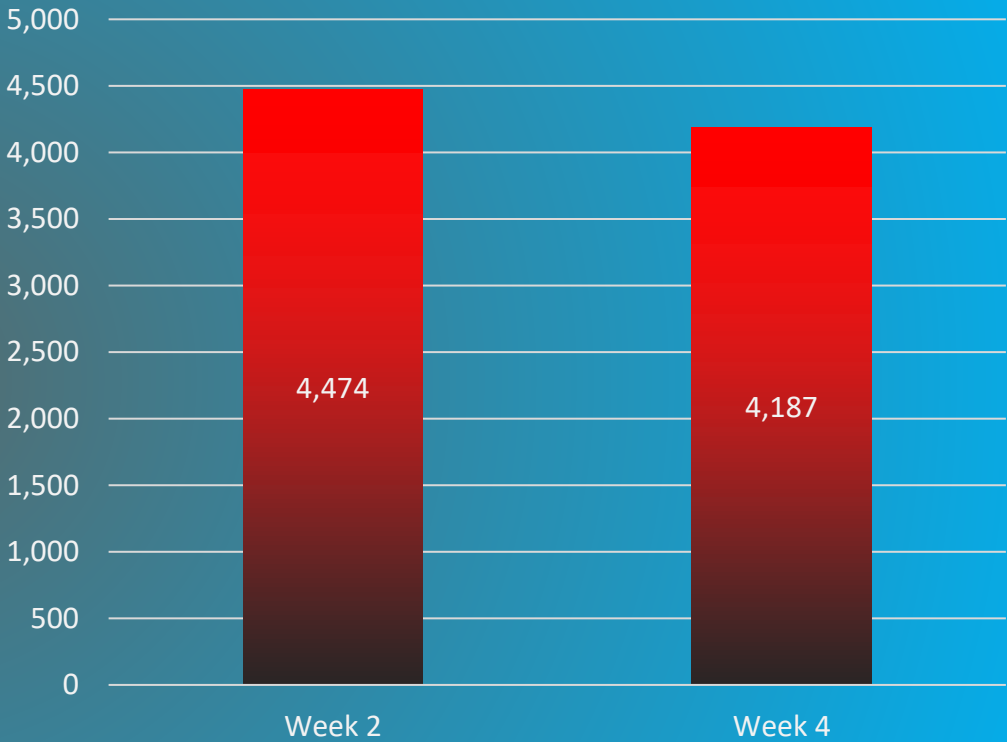
Calls for Service Overview

CFS (Year to Date Comparison)



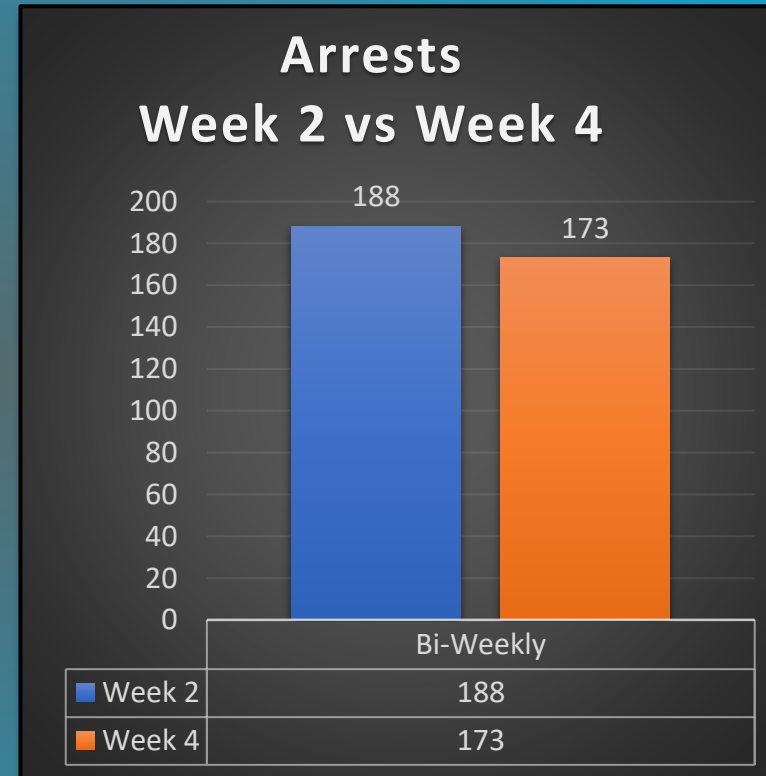
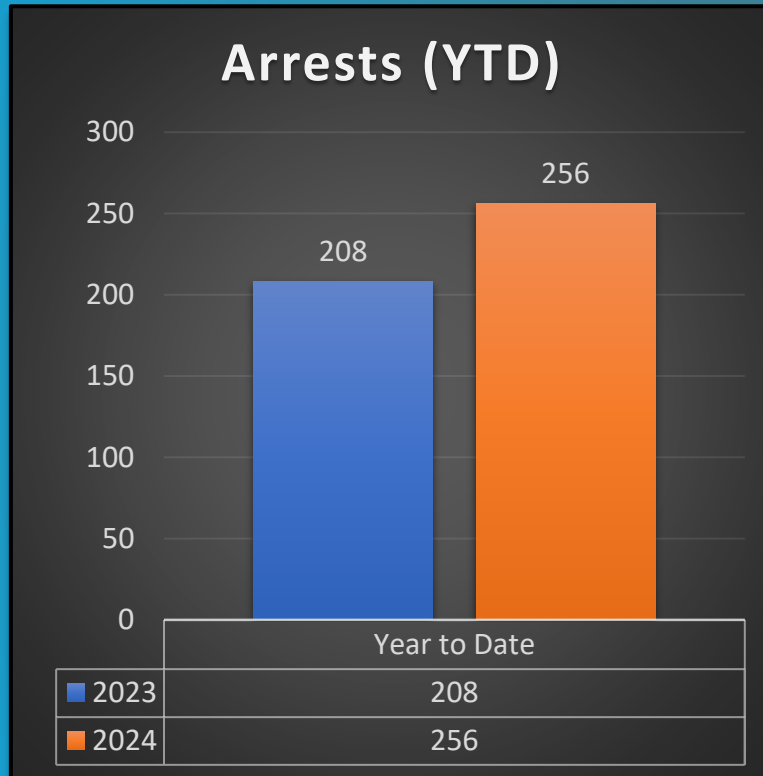
Calls for Service are down **6%** in 2024 vs 2023 YTD.

Arrests Overview



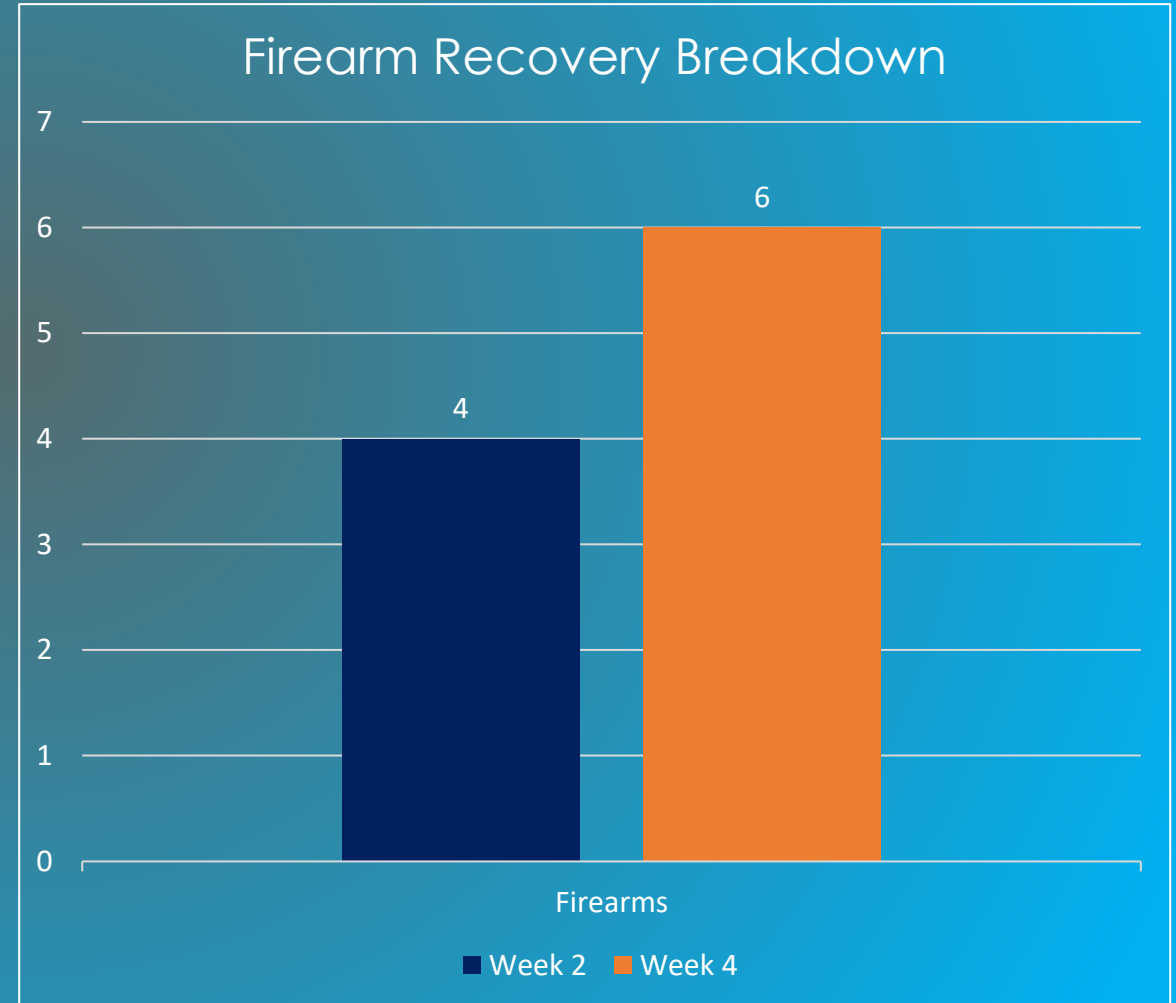
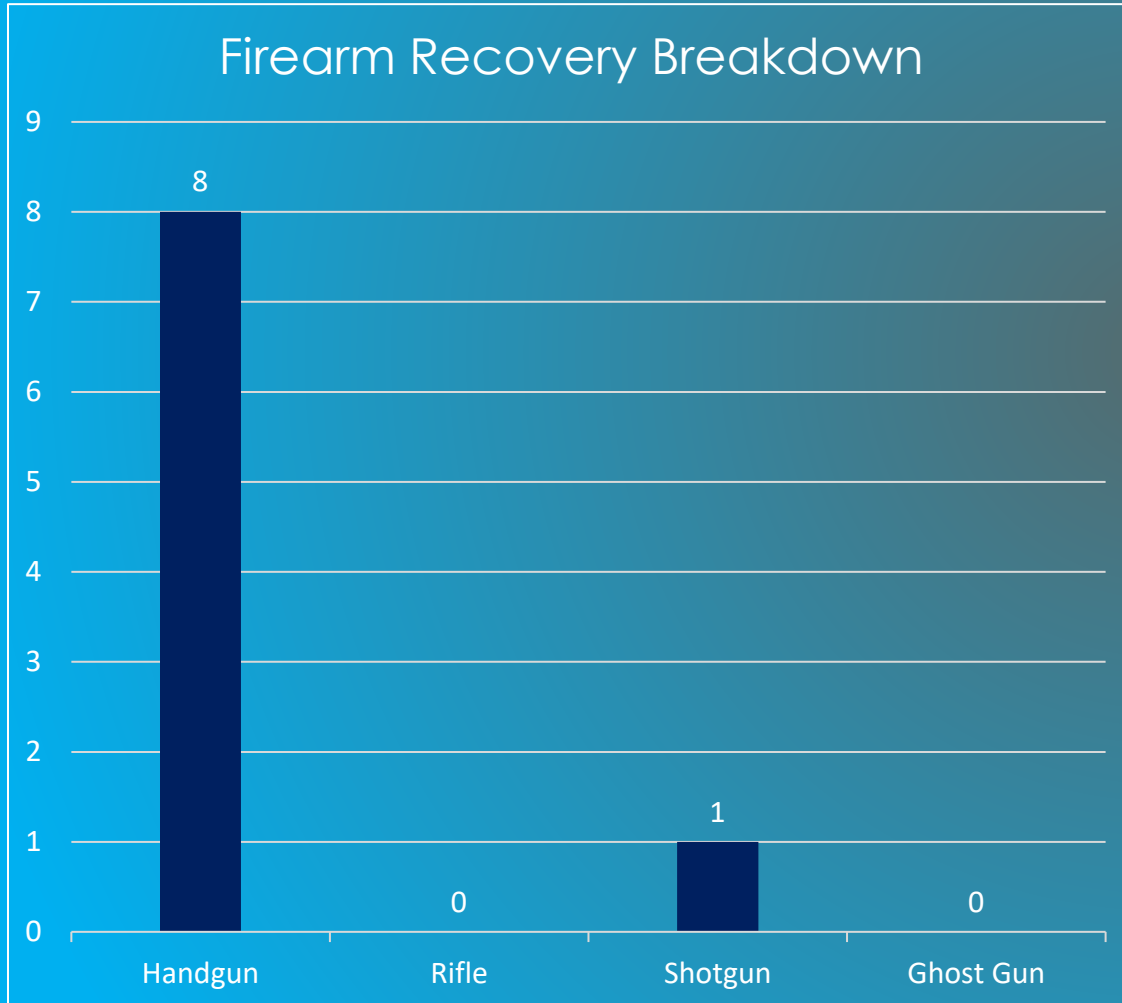

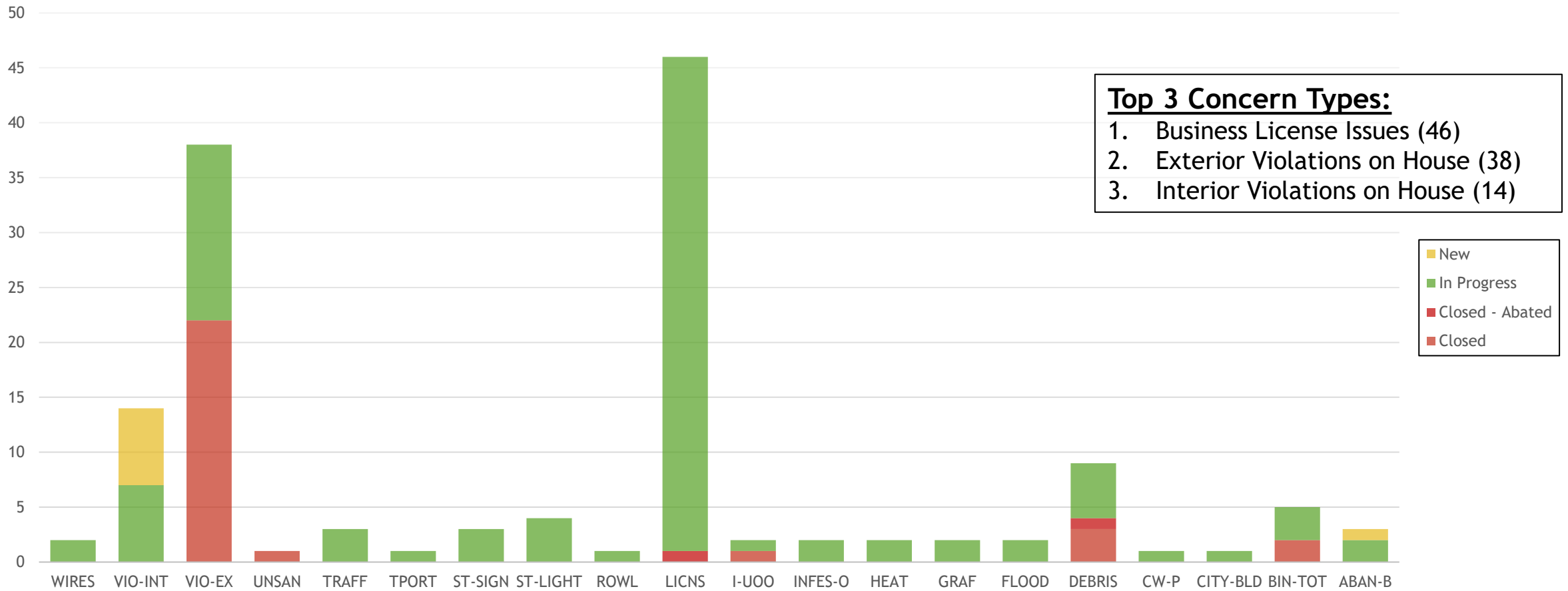
- 31 of those cases have been closed
