Charlie 1 Platoon and Bravo 1 Platoon Officers – (Commanded by Lt. Howard Johnson and Lt. Jody Hersh)

On February 17, patrol officers responded to a residence in the 1100 block of Indiana Avenue for a report of a burglary in progress. Officers were advised that several individuals had entered the rear of the home. Arriving officers observed the lock on a rear door had been damaged and pry marks. The officers established a perimeter around the residence and attempted to place a telephone call to the owner. After unsuccessful attempts at reaching the owner, the officers directed the occupants of the residence to exit. Two men and a woman surrendered to the officers and were taken into custody. Officers located a hammer inside that was believed to be used to enter the door.

On February 20, patrol officers responded to a residence in the 300 block of north Connecticut Avenue for a report of man armed with a handgun. It was further reported that the suspect was going in and out of the residence and was extremely agitated as he was in possession of the gun.

Sergeant Mulhern arrived on scene and encountered the suspect. The suspect was initially detained as officers investigated the circumstances surrounding the allegations. They learned that while the suspect was in possession of the firearm, he pointed it at a woman who he also threatened with violence while in the presence of two children.

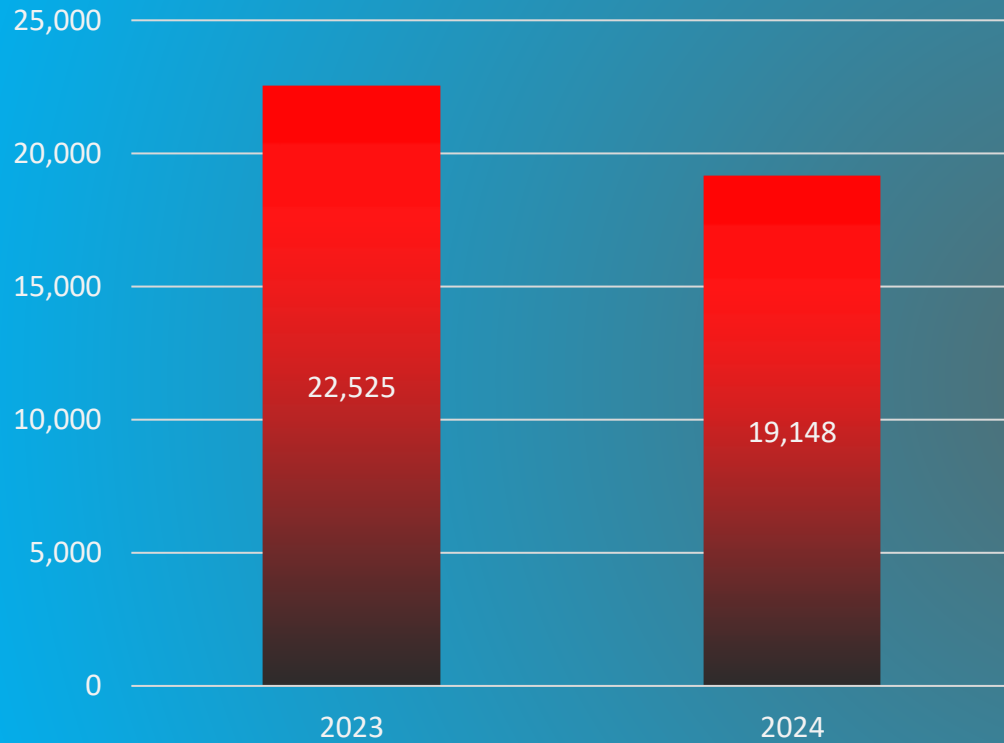
Officer Kelly located the handgun that was loaded with hollow-point ammunition in the kitchen leading to the arrest of the suspect.

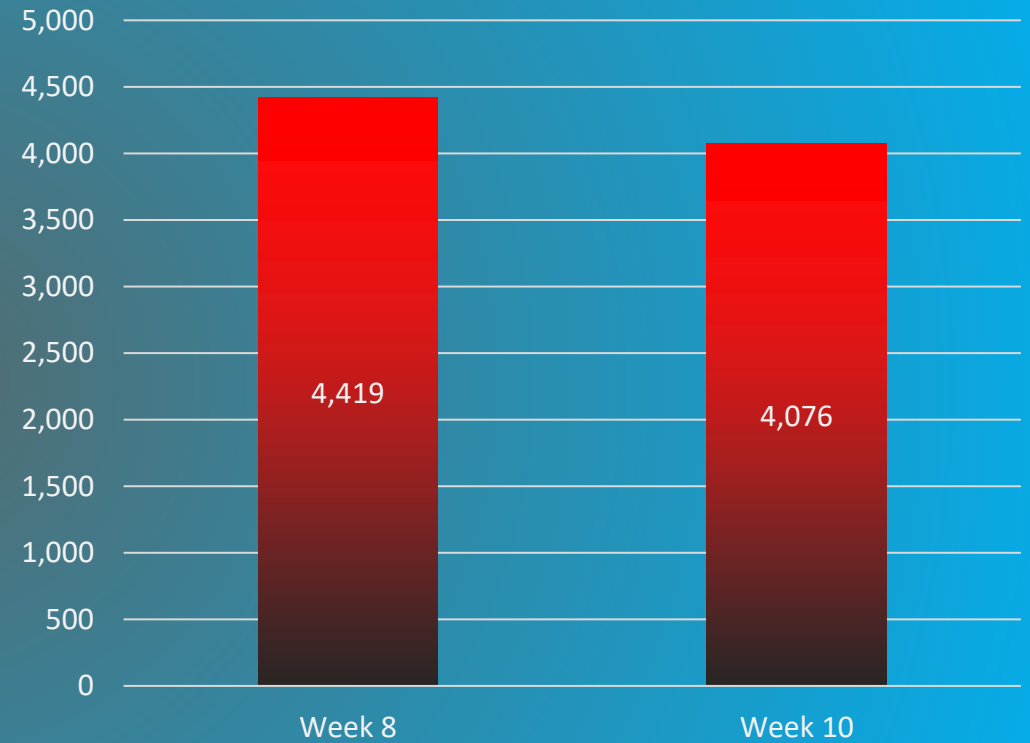
Calls for Service Overview

CFS (Year to Date Comparison)



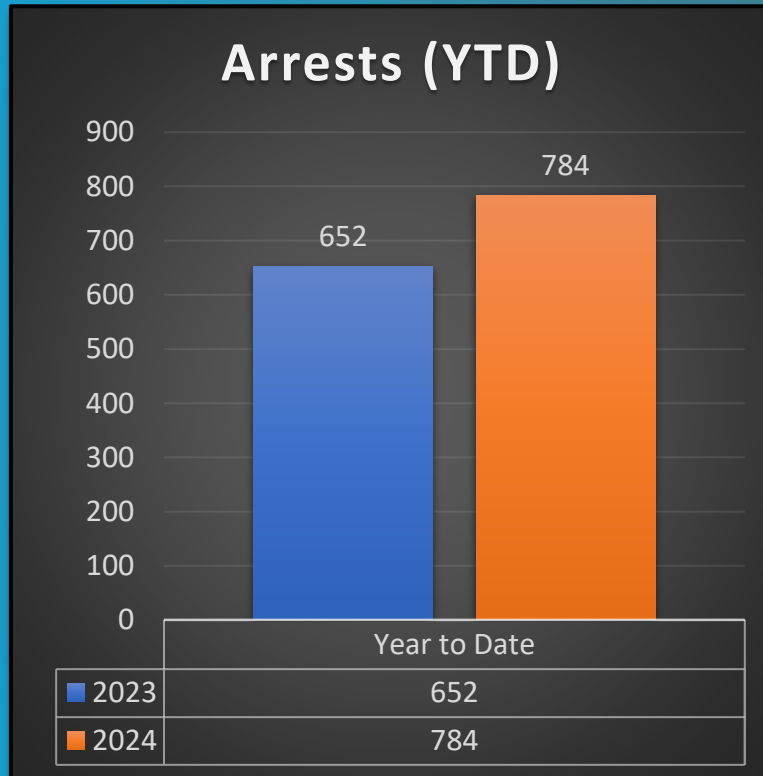
Calls for Service are down 15% in 2024 vs 2023 YTD.

CFS (2 Week Comparison)

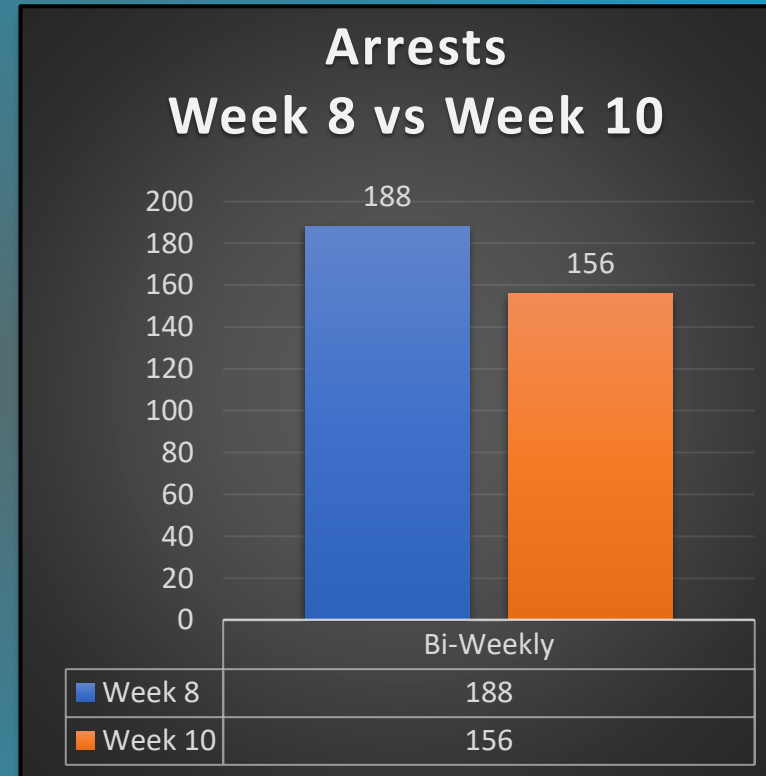


Calls for Service are down 7.8% from Week 10 vs Week 8

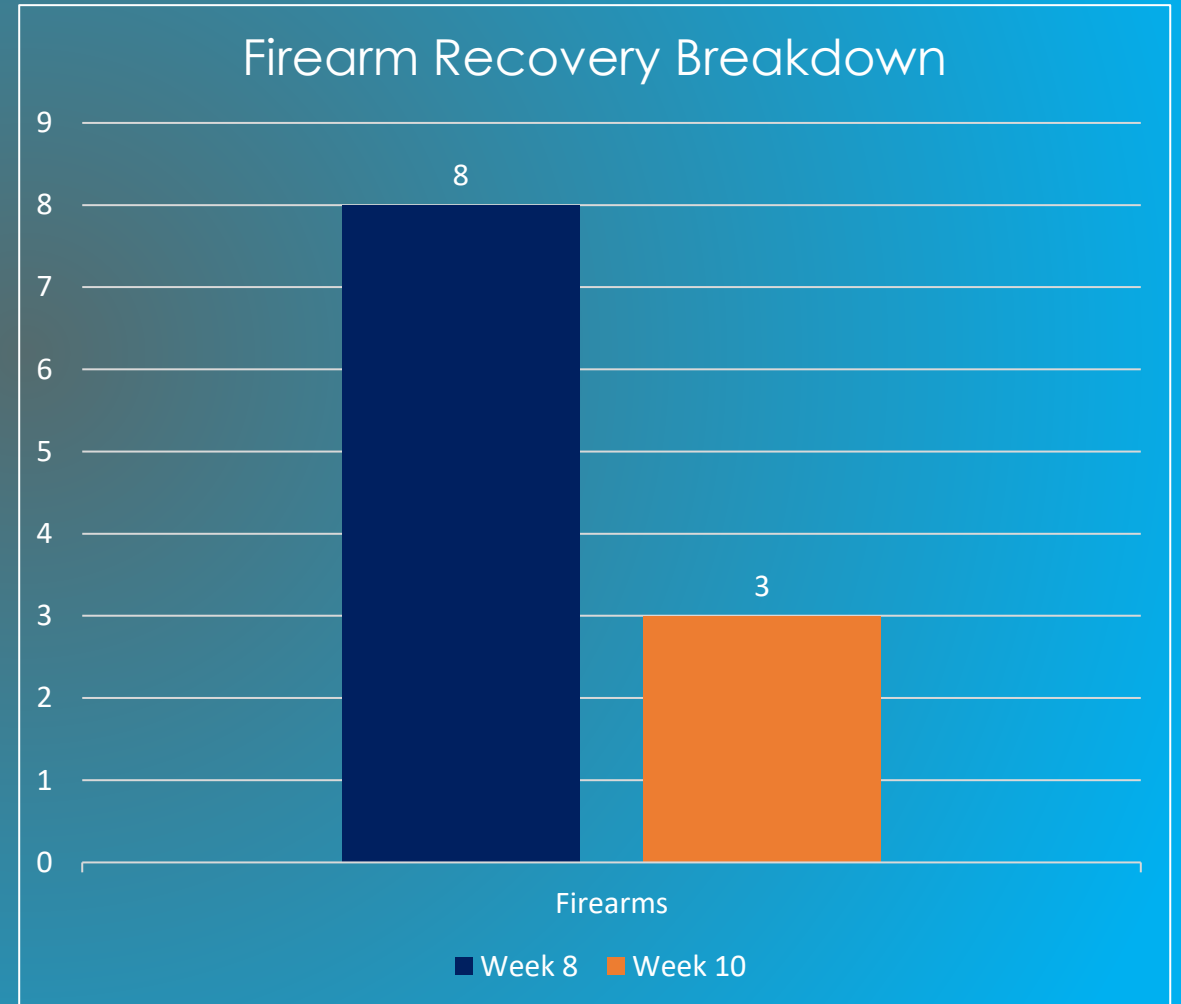
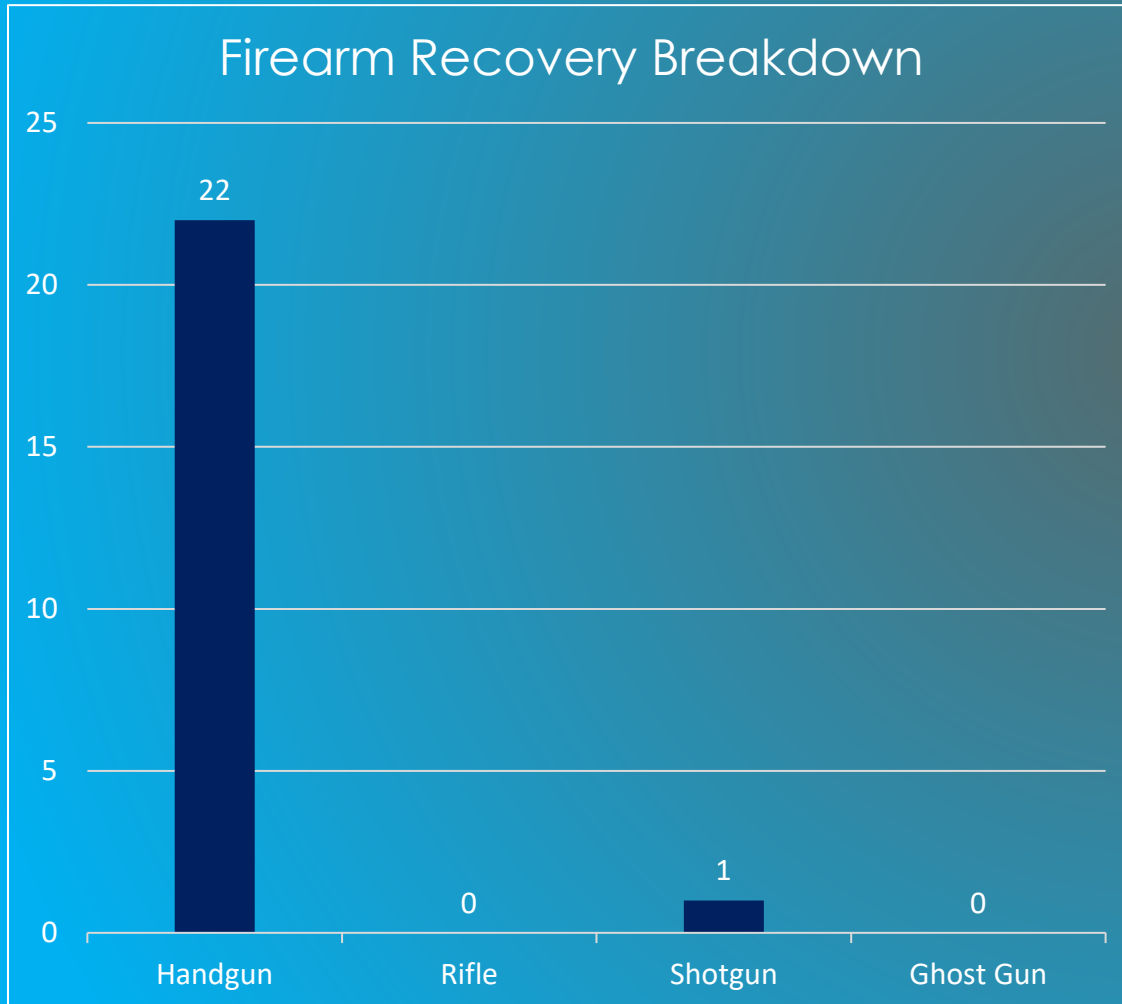

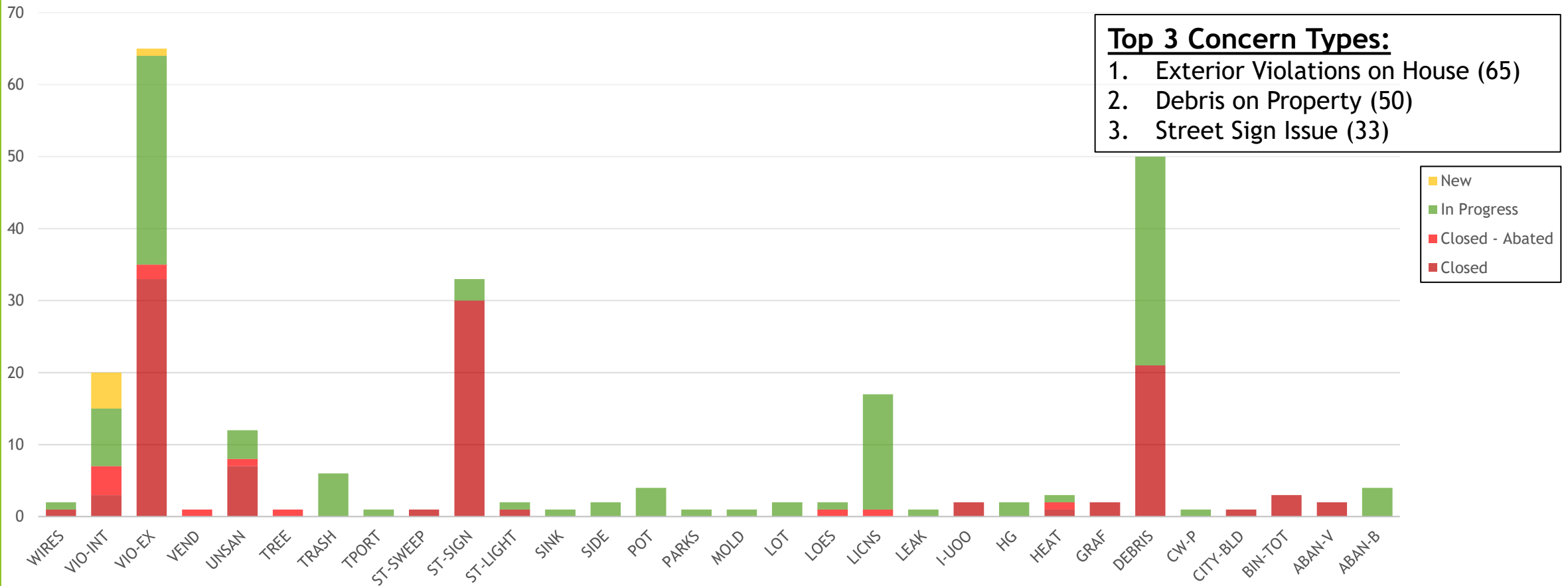
- 120 of those cases have been closed

Geographic Location



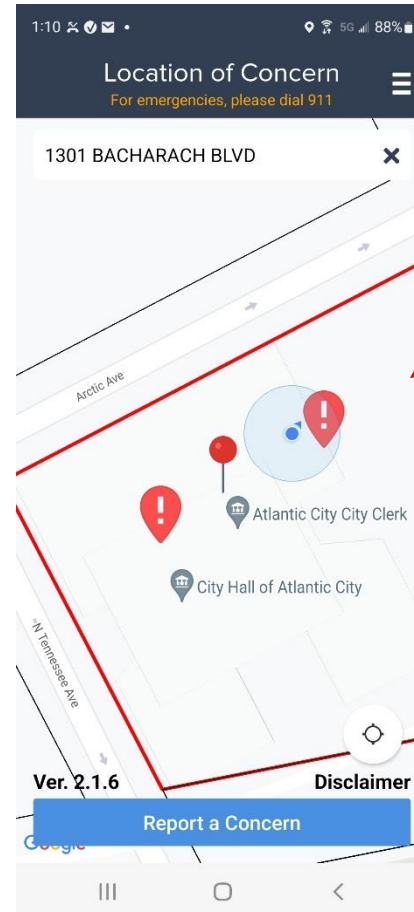
