

## **K9 Officer Adrian Nunez-Santos – Charlie 2 Platoon (Commanded by Lt. Omar Martin)**

On March 23, K9 Officer Nunez-Santos observed a vehicle illegally parked blocking the lane of traffic in the area of California and Fairmount Avenues. The driver opened his door for Officer Nunez-Santos who immediately observed drug paraphernalia on the floorboard. The driver was removed from the vehicle and arrested.

Two other occupants were also placed in custody. During a search of the vehicle, the officers located two loaded handguns, small amounts of heroin and methamphetamine, and drug paraphernalia. One occupant was also found to have an active warrant for his arrest.

Officer Nunez-Santos is to be recognized for a job well done!

## **Detective Troy Grams – Special Investigations Section (Commanded by Lt. Richard Andrews)**

On March 21, detectives of the Special Investigations Section concluded a one-month investigation into the distribution of illegal narcotics with a court authorized search warrant in the first block of south Kentucky Avenue.

The target of the investigation had an outstanding warrant for his arrest and was taken into custody as he left the apartment building. Once inside the residence, detectives located two additional occupants. During a search of the residence, detectives recovered a loaded handgun, 14 grams of cocaine, more than 15 grams of heroin, 29 individual bags of heroin more than \$1,400 in cash, and paraphernalia used in the packaging and distribution of narcotics.

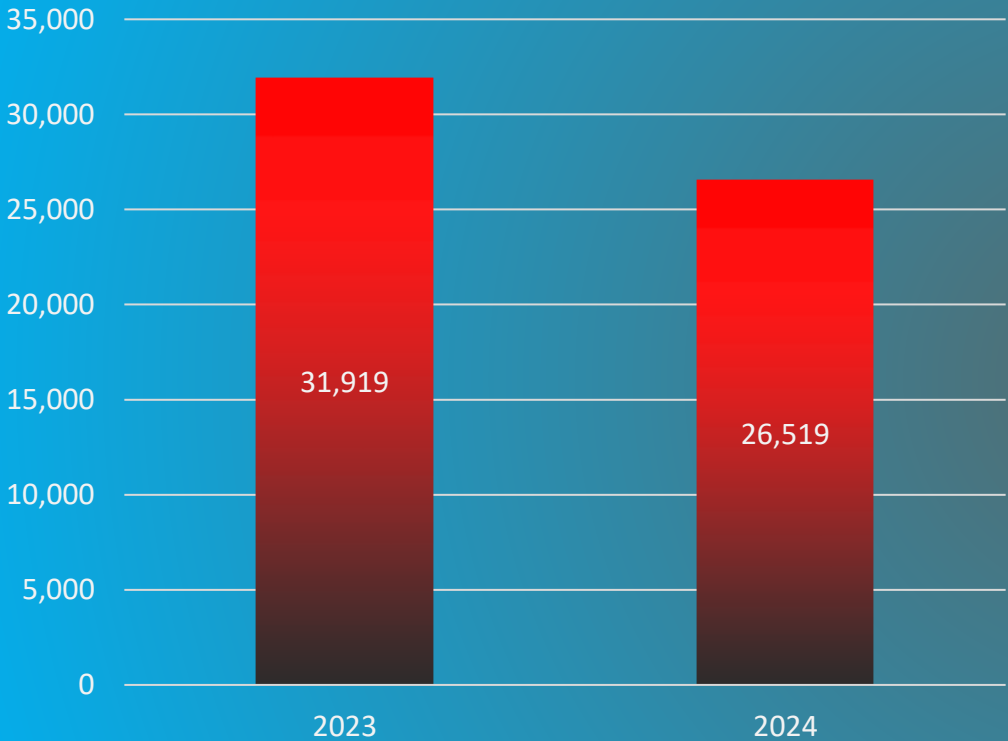

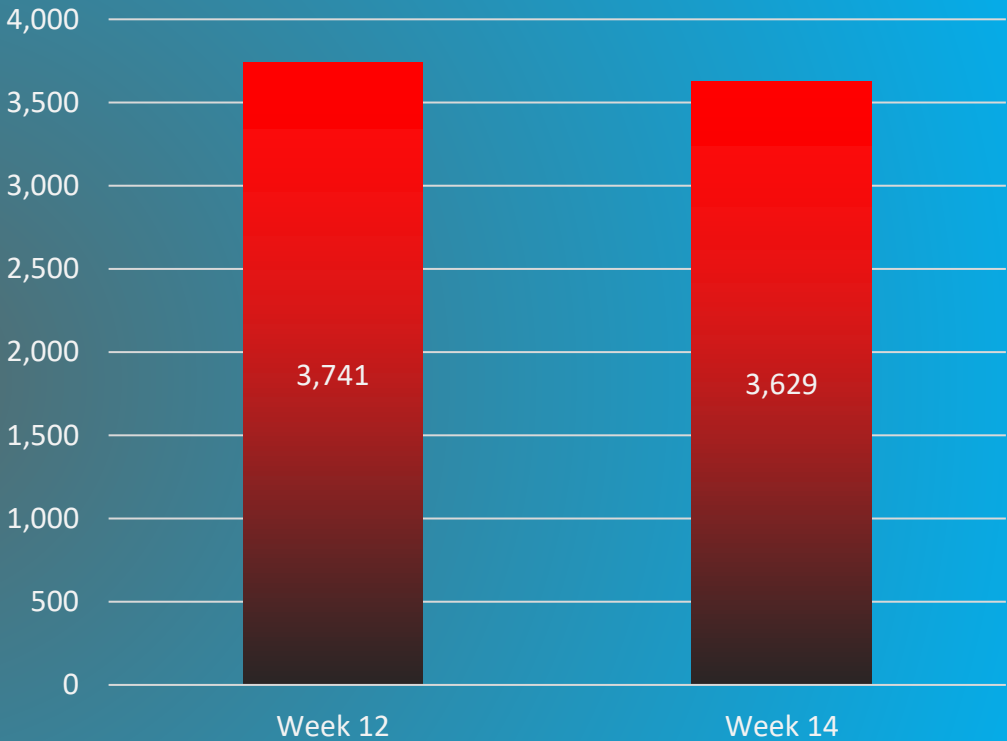
# Calls for Service Overview

CFS (Year to Date Comparison)



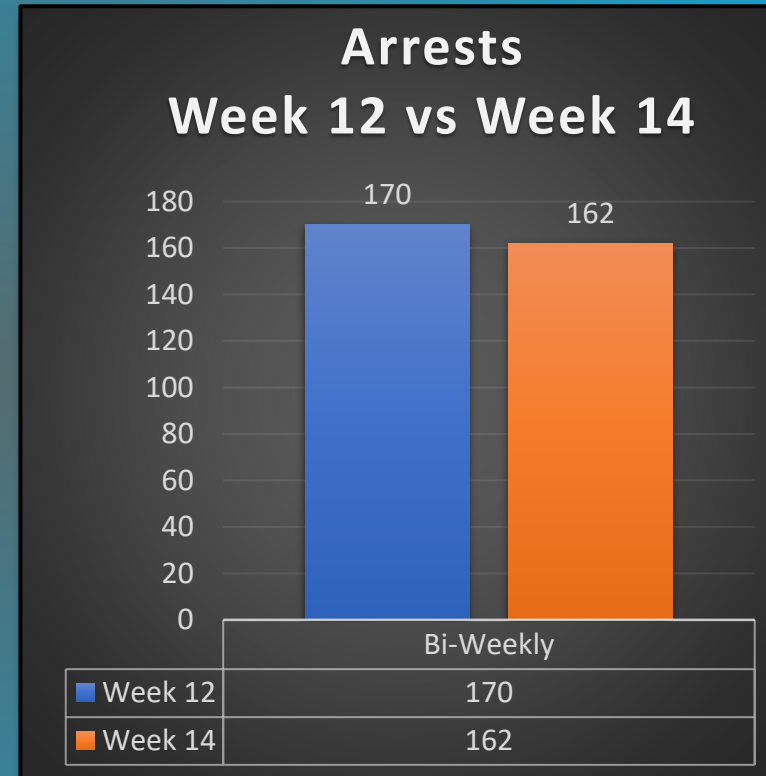
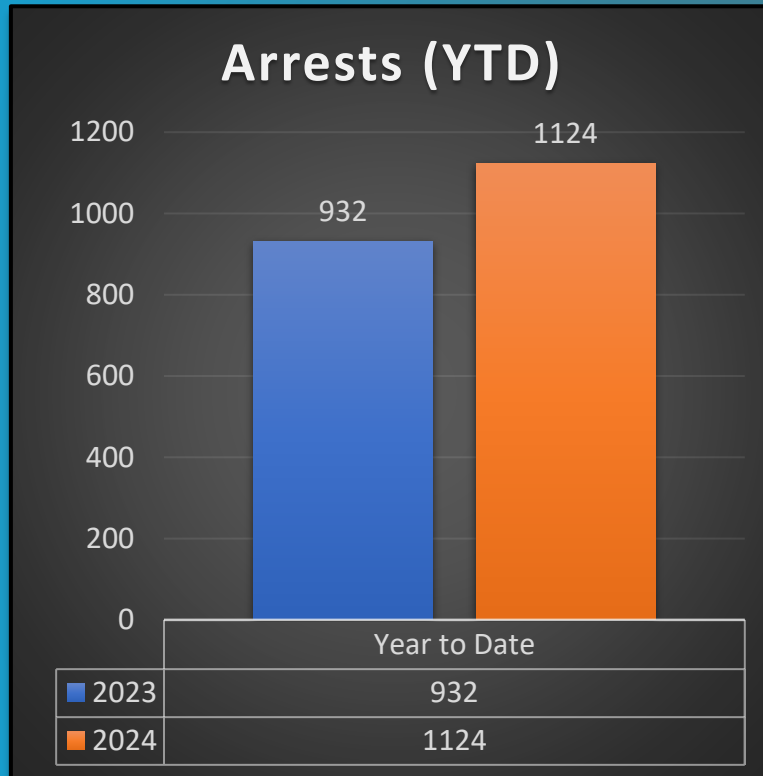
Calls for Service are down 16.9% in 2024 vs 2023 YTD.

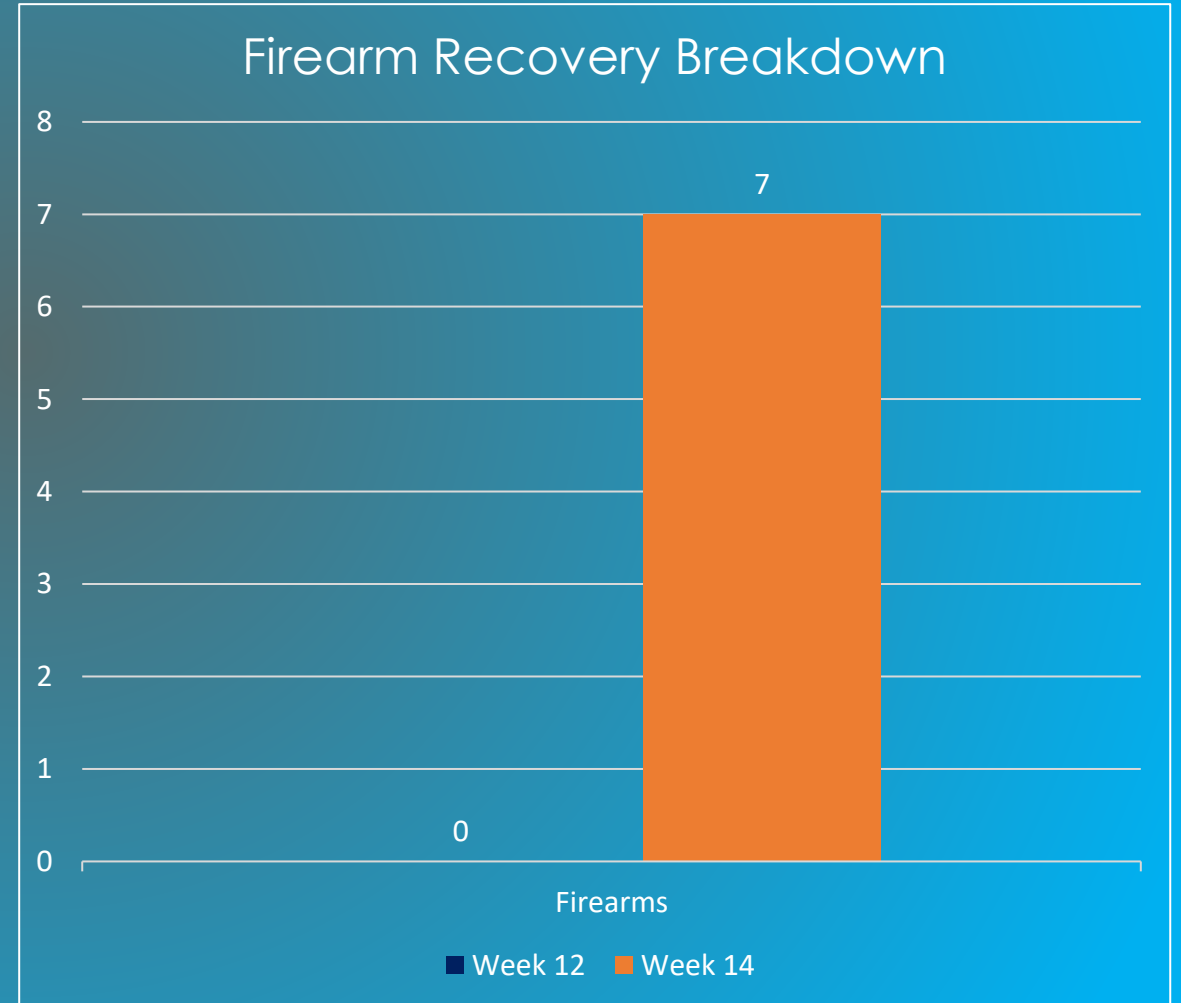

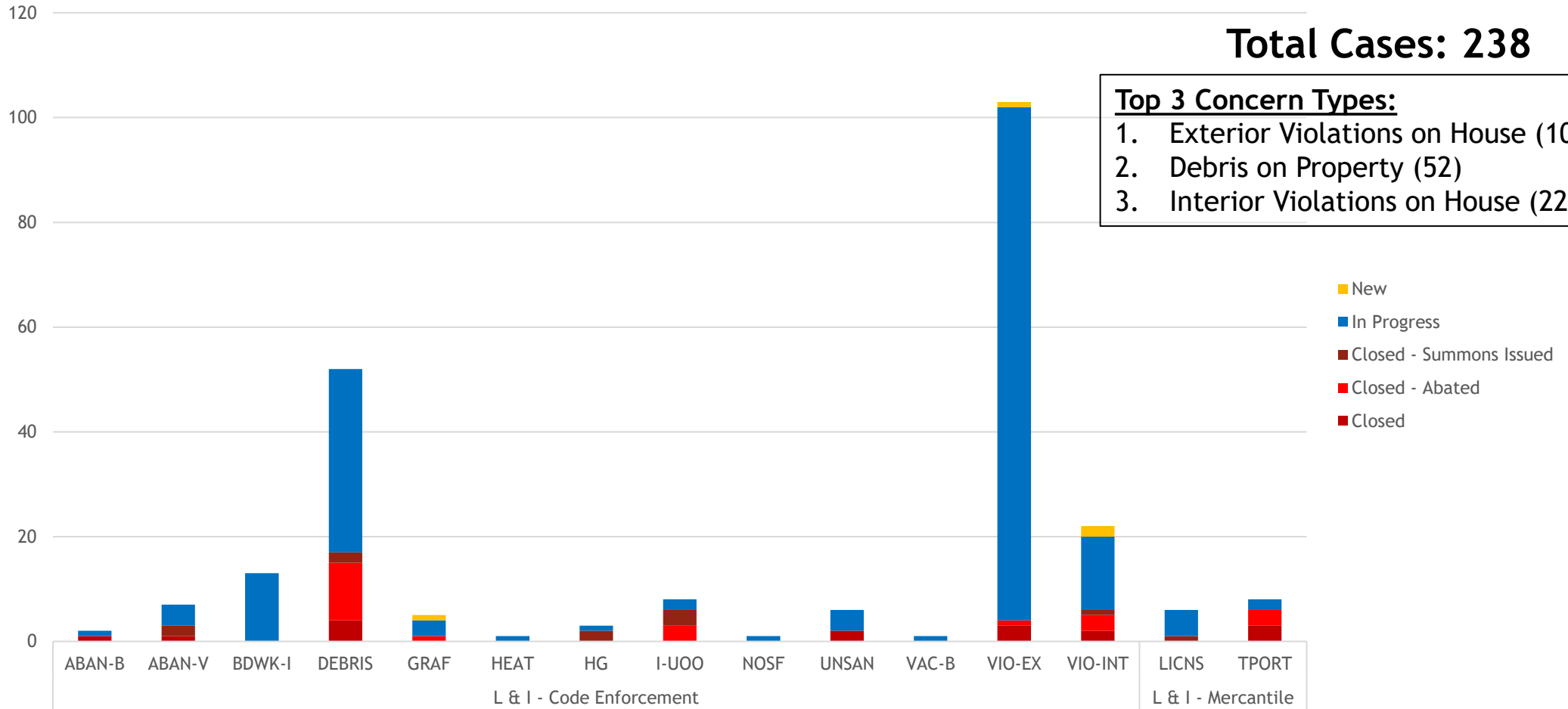

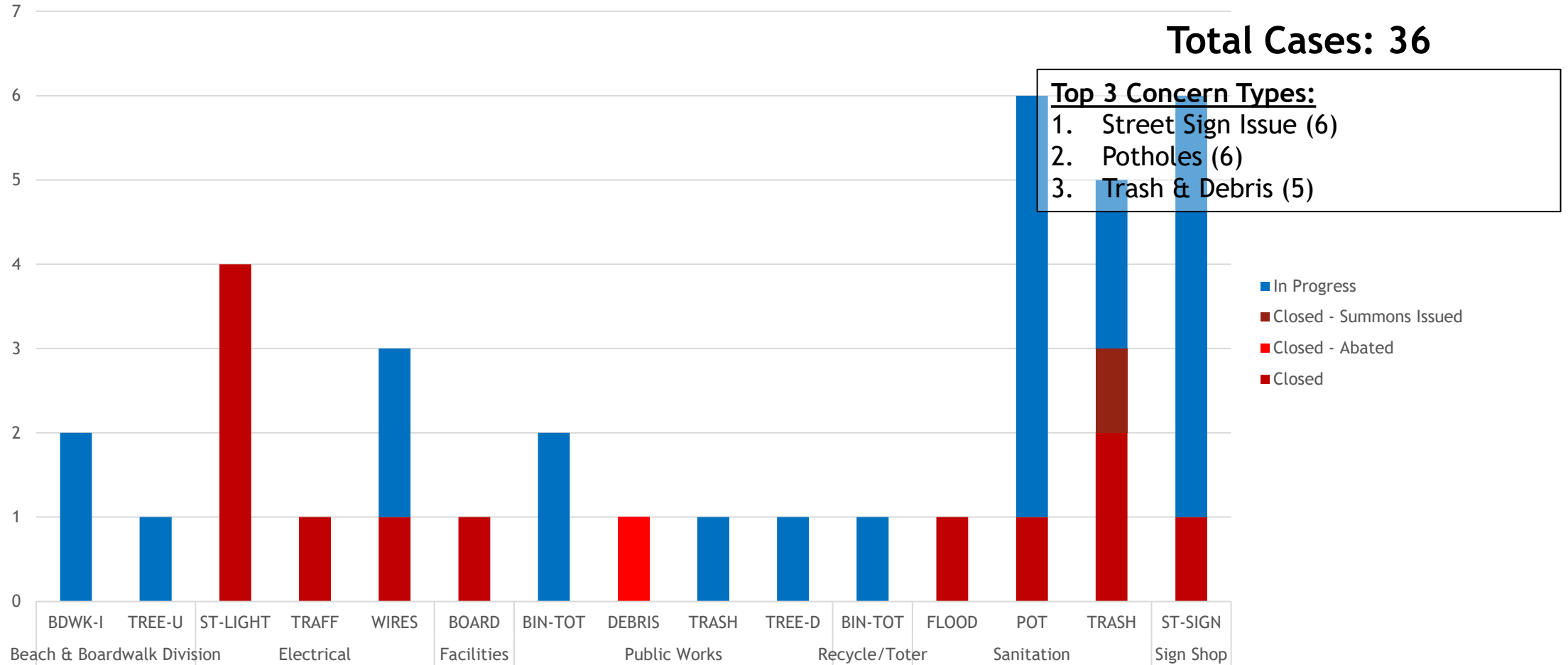
