## **Officers Anthony Nastasi and Nicholas Cardani- Neighborhood Coordination Unit Bravo 1 (Commanded by Lt. Jody Hersh)**

On April 12, Officers Nastasi and Cardani observed a wanted man in the 1500 block of Atlantic Avenue. A warrant had been issued for his arrest after he was identified as the suspect in a robbery.

During the robbery incident, the suspect assaulted a female acquaintance by striking her with a handgun and kicking her multiple times while she was on the ground. He demanded money and threatened the victim's life before fleeing with a cell phone.

During the man's arrest, he was found in possession of a loaded handgun and 15 bags of heroin. Johnson was also found to be a fugitive with a wanted warrant from York, PA.

## **Detective Lisa Kaplin-Caldwell- Criminal Investigations Section and Officers Adrianna Petinga and William Harned**

On April 24, patrol officers responded to the Showboat located in the 800 block of the Boardwalk for a report of man stabbed. Officer Petinga located a victim suffering from a stab wound that was bleeding heavily. She applied a tourniquet and rendered immediate aid before the victim was transported to the Medical Center

An investigation revealed that the victim became involved in an altercation with numerous suspects who assaulted him by punching, kicking, and stabbing. Several hours after the incident, Officer Harned arrested one of the involved suspects.

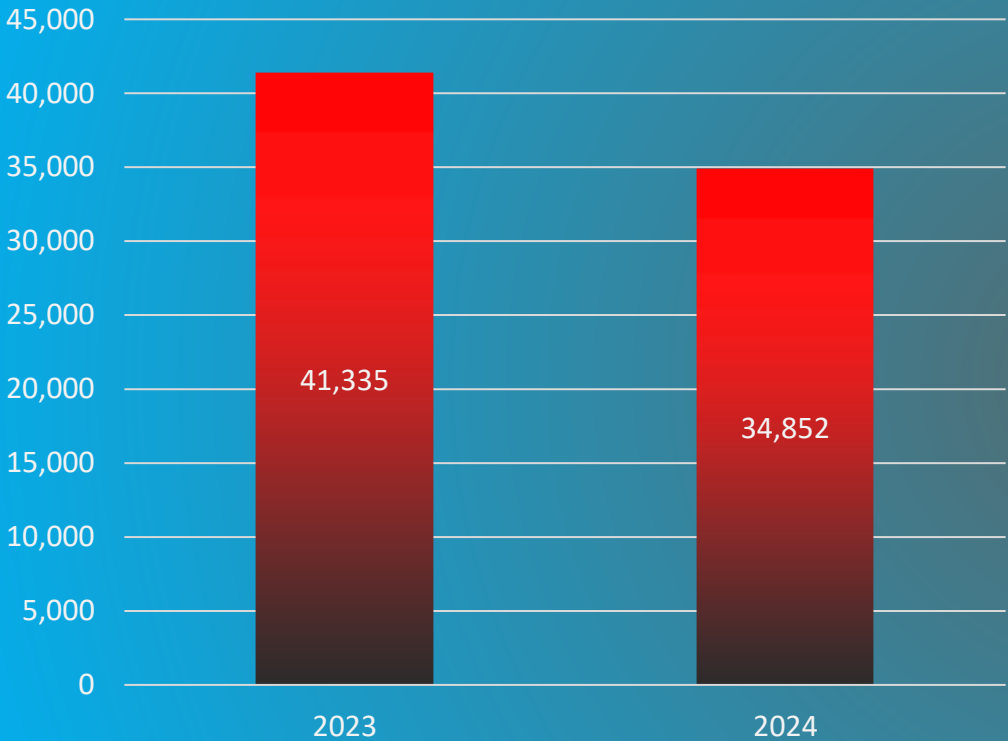
On April 25, a continuing investigation by Detective Kaplin-Caldwell led to the identity of the stabbing suspect. The suspect was also found to have an active arrest warrant issued by Camden County, NJ. Later in the evening, Showboat security personnel alerted the police department that the suspect, and a second man who was involved in the assault, had entered their property. As Officers Harned and Julian Monsalve were responding, they were provided with updated information that the suspects had left. The officers located the suspects at Delaware and Atlantic Avenues who were taken into custody without incident.

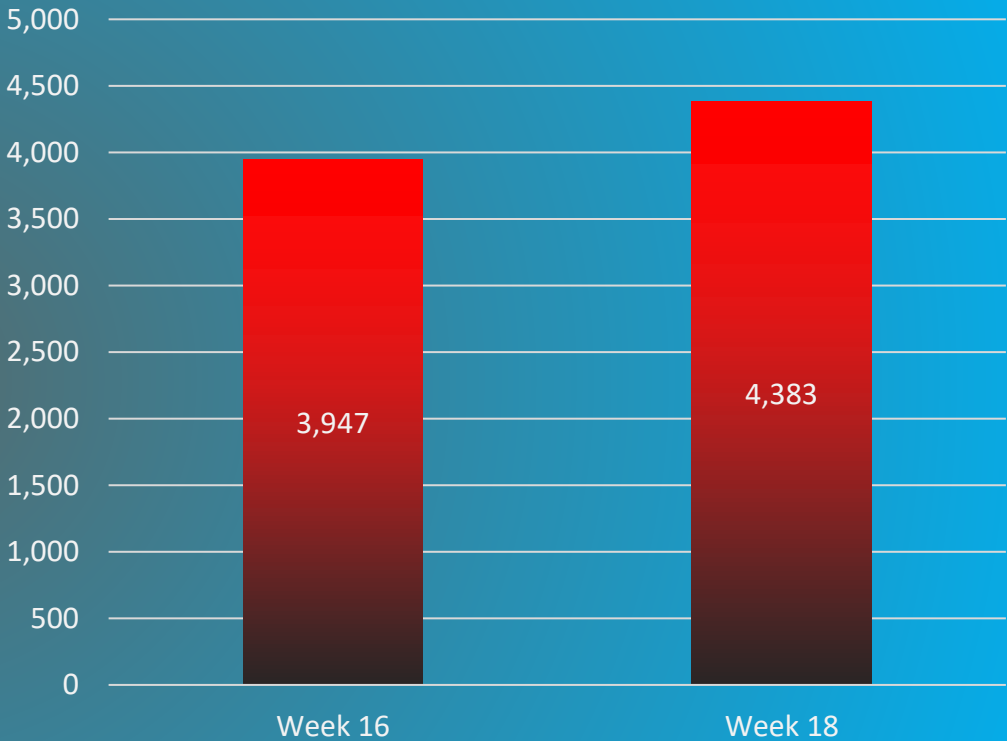
# Calls for Service Overview

CFS (Year to Date Comparison)



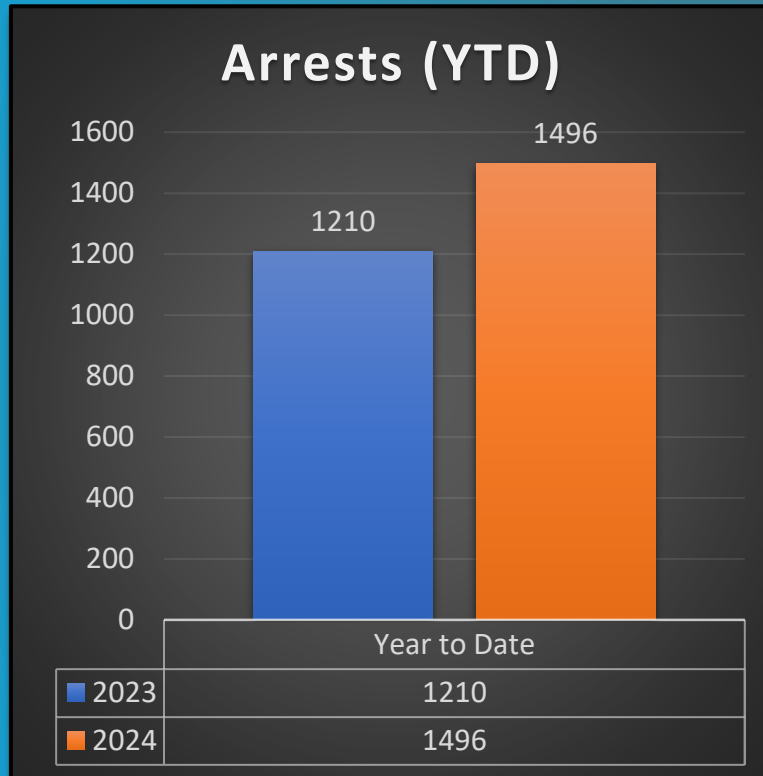
Calls for Service are down 15.7% in 2024 vs 2023 YTD.

CFS (2 Week Comparison)

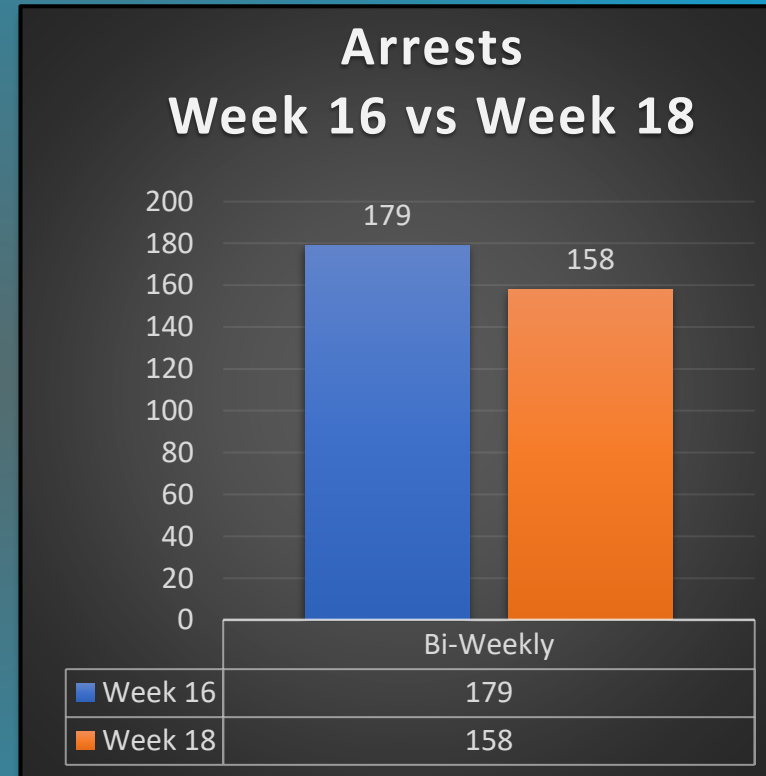

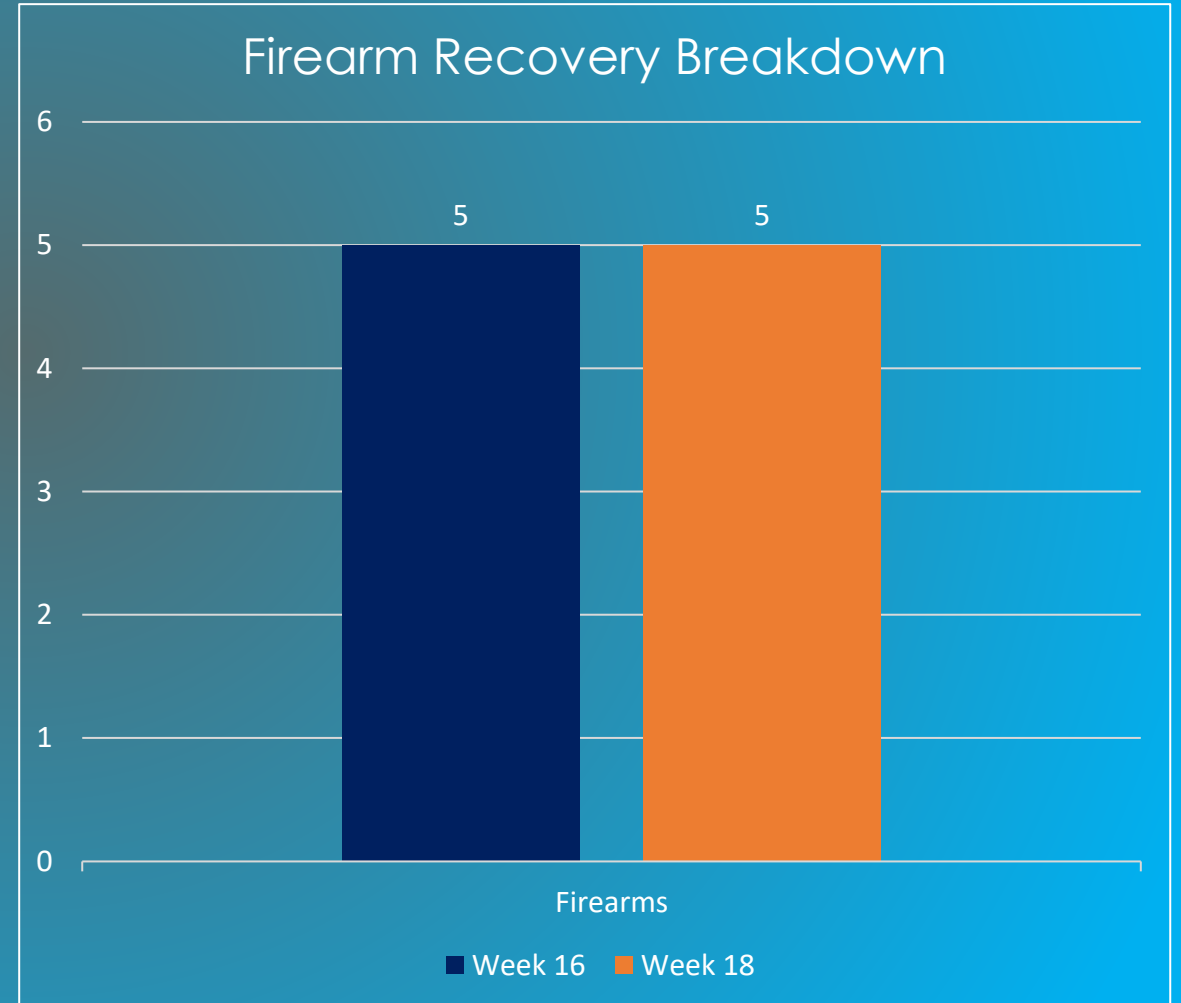

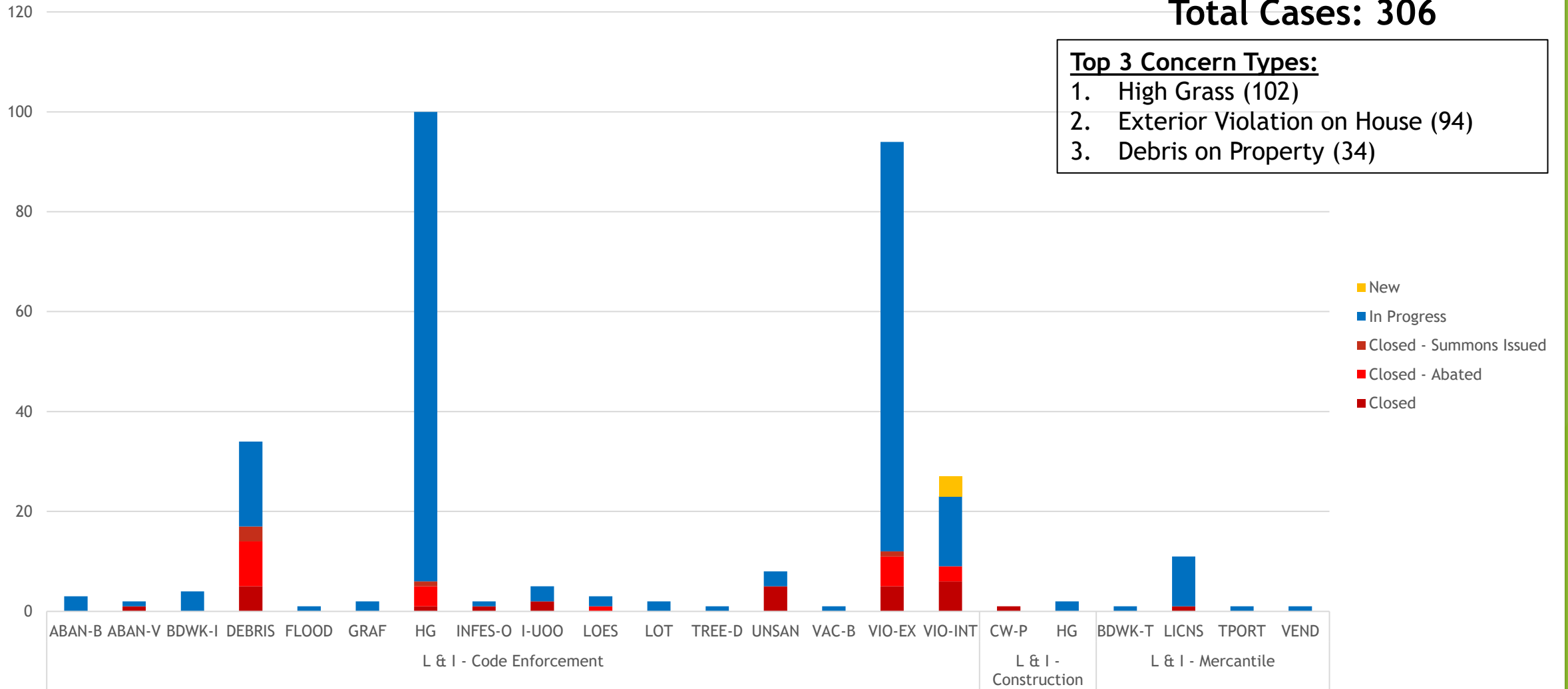

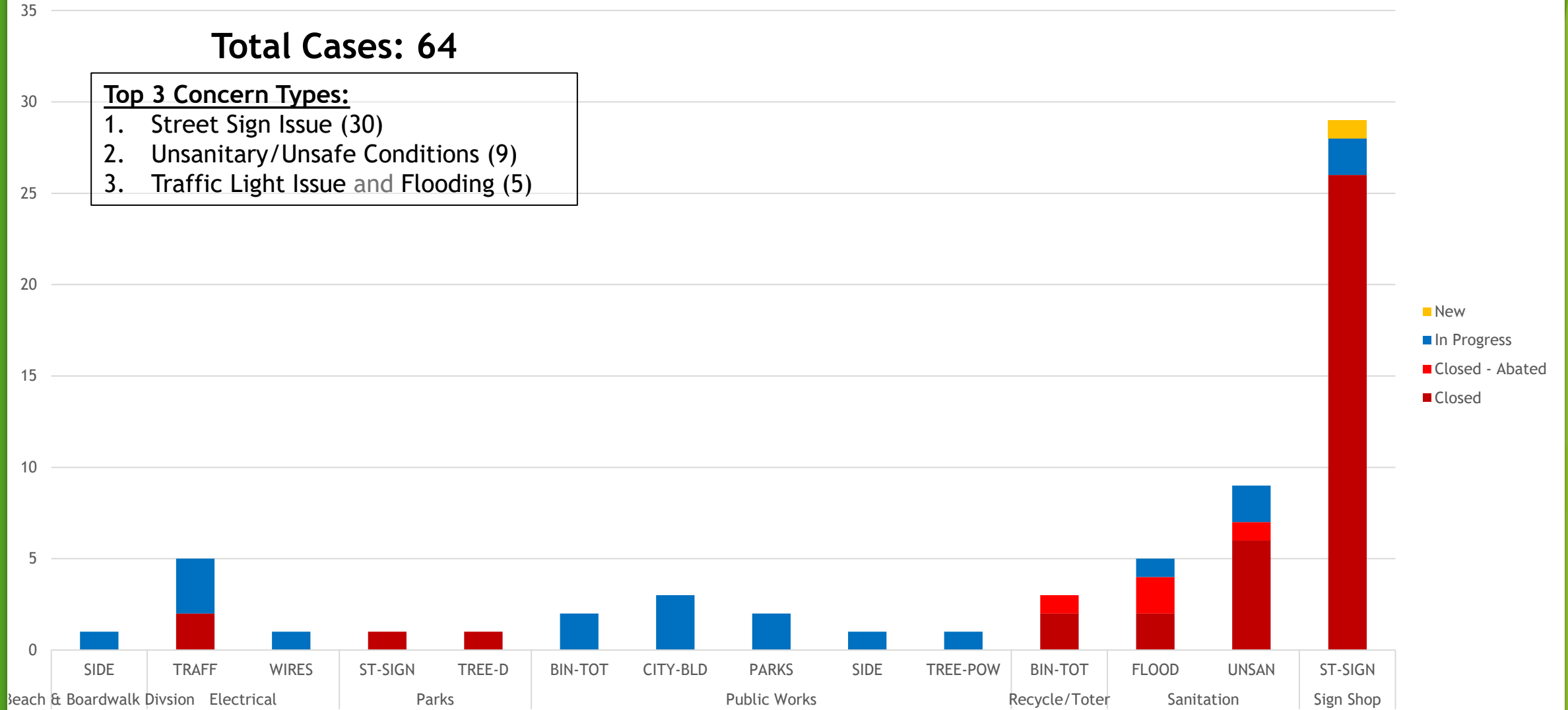
