**RECOGNITION ON A JOB WELL
DONE**

Officers Kevin McGloin, Martina Martin, Matthew Stollenwerk- Alpha 2 Patrol and Detective Juanita Harris- Criminal Investigations

On May 12, Officer McGloin responded to the 1500 block of Atlantic Avenue to take a report of a stolen vehicle and provided officers with a description of the vehicle.

Less than 90 minutes later, Officer Martin located the stolen vehicle and attempted to conduct a motor vehicle stop but the suspect fled. The suspect failed to stop at a red traffic signal and crashed into another vehicle. The suspect attempted to flee on foot, but was taken into custody by Officers Martin and Stollenwerk. The officers located a loaded handgun and knife in the vehicle.

While investigating this incident, patrol officers responded to the first block of south Kentucky Avenue for a man that was stabbed. It was clear that the victim's injuries were not sustained immediately before the officer's arrival and were sustained a period of time prior.

An investigation conducted by Detective Harris identified the vehicle theft suspect as being responsible for the stabbing.

Sergeants Christian Ivanov and Officer Andy Nunez-Santos- Charlie 1 Patrol and Sergeant Daniel Arra- Bravo 1 Patrol

On May 25, Officer Nunez-Santos was stopped by a woman who reported that a man approached her vehicle at Bellevue and Pacific Avenues and attempted to enter her vehicle while in possession of a handgun. At the time, the woman's child was also in the backseat of the car. The woman did not immediately call 911 and later located Officer Nunez-Santos.

Officer Nunez-Santos was able to obtain a description of the suspect which was provided to officers in the area. Sergeants Ivanov and Arra observed the suspect at Florida and Pacific Avenues. The suspect fled on foot from the sergeants who gave chase. The sergeants apprehended the suspect who continued to resist arrest. He was found in possession of a loaded handgun.

Atlantic City PD, EHT PD, Galloway PD, and Pleasantville PD

On May 25, patrol officers responded to a report of a juvenile shot in the 100 block of north Rhode Island Avenue. Arriving officers located an 11-year-old boy suffering from a gunshot wound. The officers rendered aid until the boy was transported to the AtlantiCare Regional Medical Center, City Division, with non-life-threatening injuries.

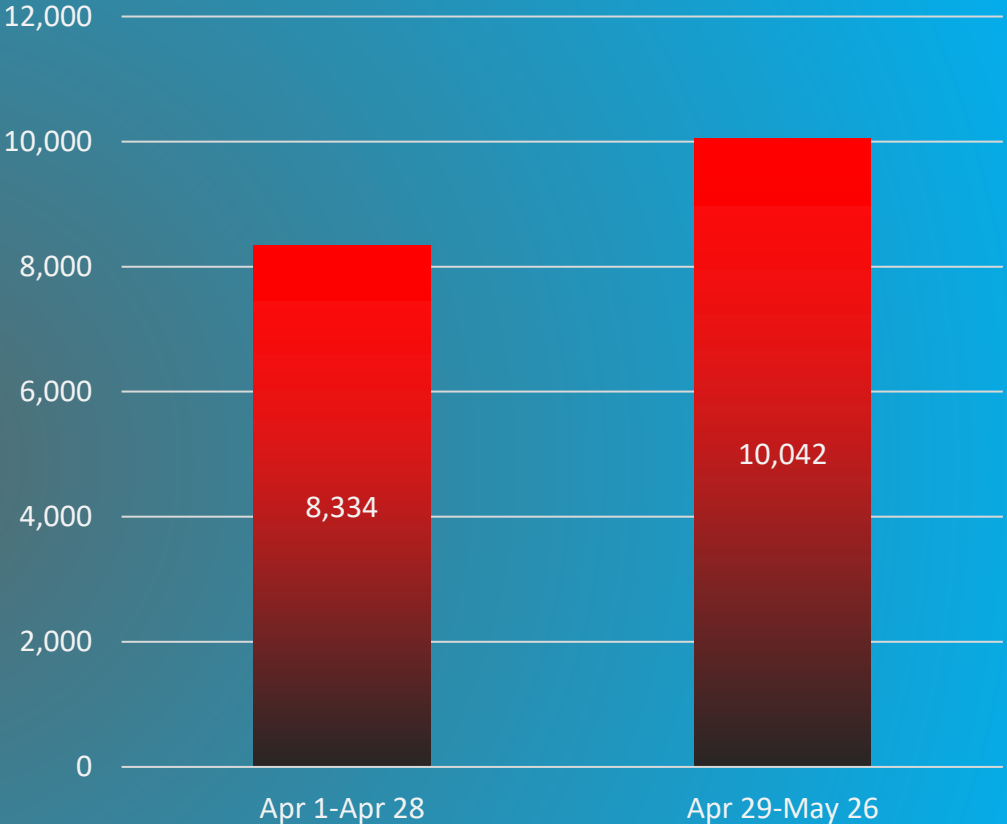
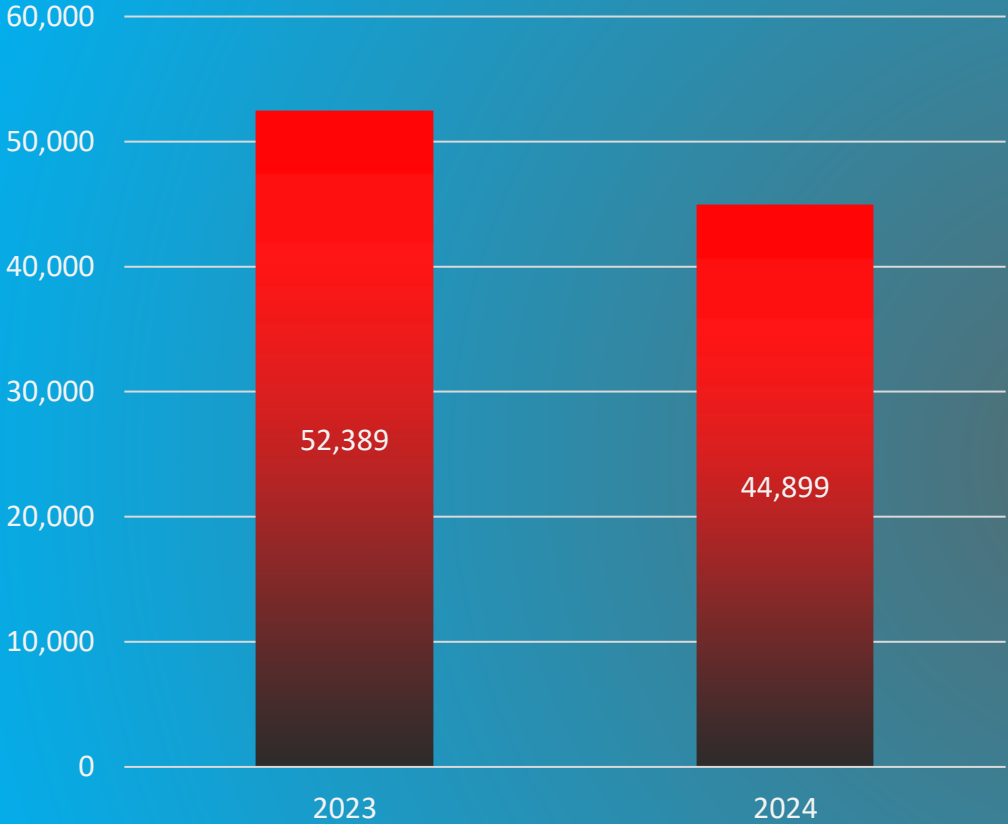
An investigation by patrol officers and later detectives of the Violent Crimes Unit identified two female suspects. The women arrived on the street with a hammer and a handgun to encounter a group that they had a prior altercation with. They began to smash out a vehicle's window then began to shoot at the group. One of the fired projectiles entered a residence and struck the victim while he was lying on the floor.

On the morning of May 26, detectives charged the two women for their role in the shooting. Egg Harbor Township police located one suspect while Pleasantville police located the other. Both women were turned over to the ACPD.

Calls for Service Overview

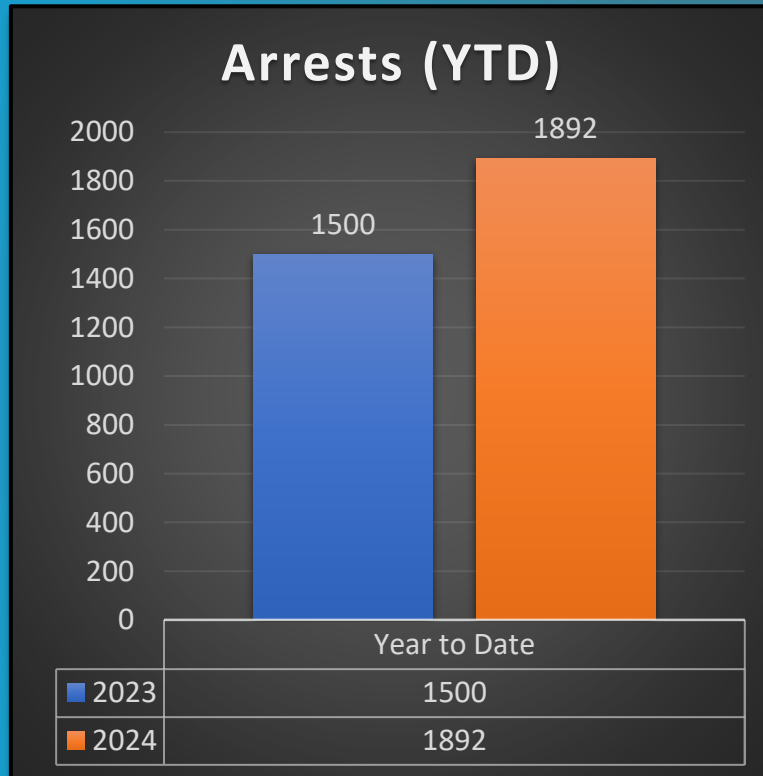


Calls for Service are down 14.2% in 2024 vs 2023 YTD.

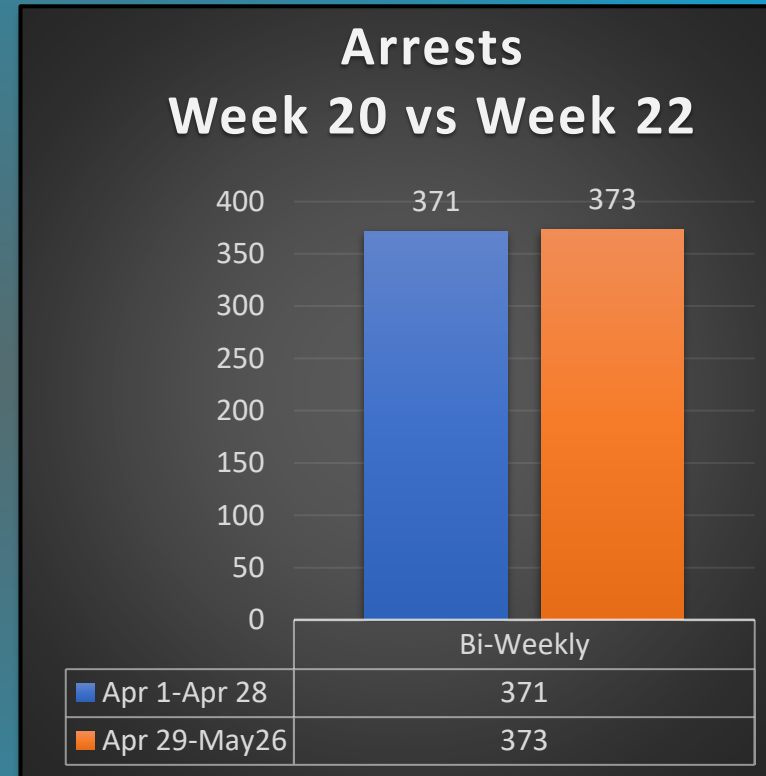


Calls for Service are up 20.15%

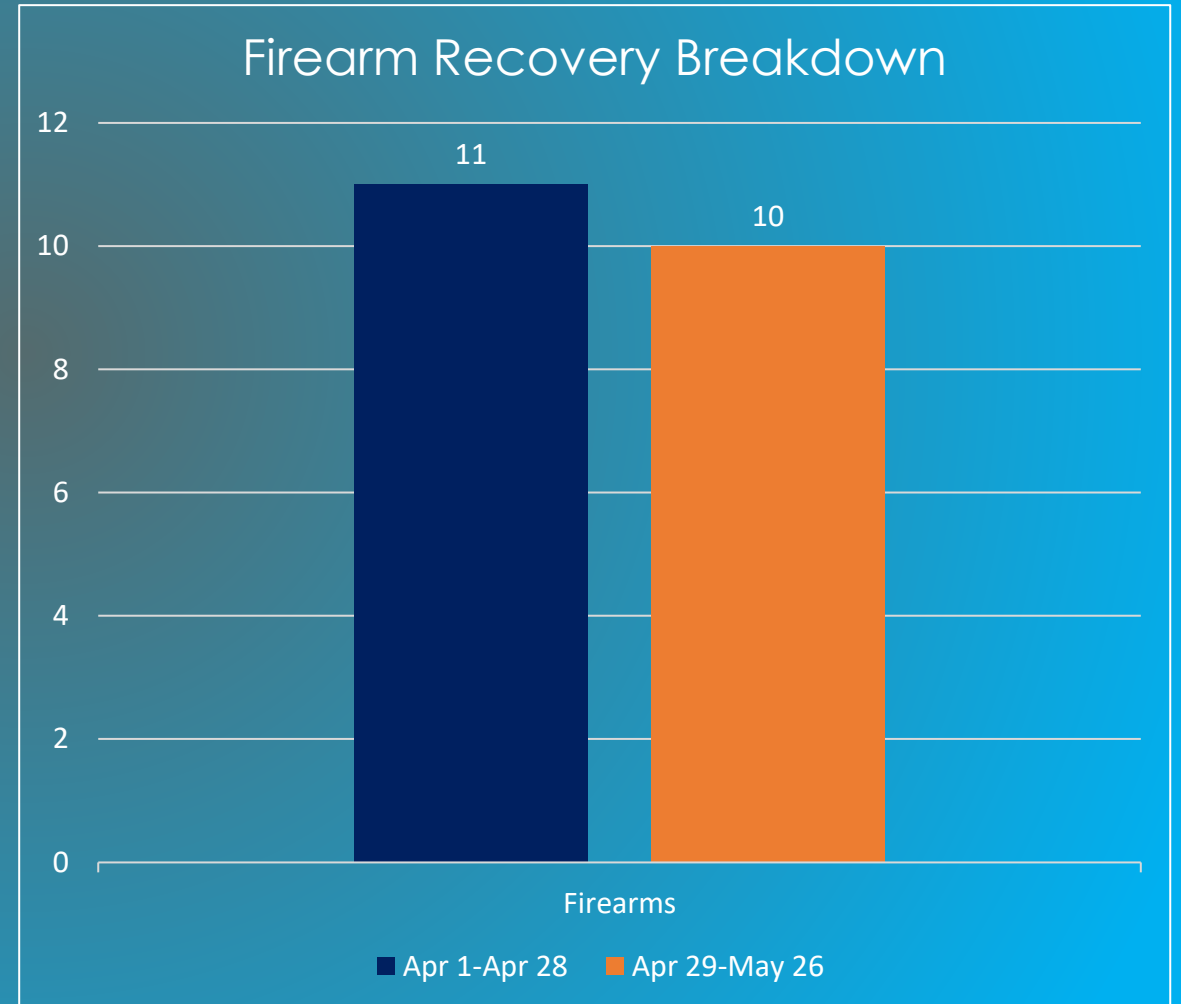

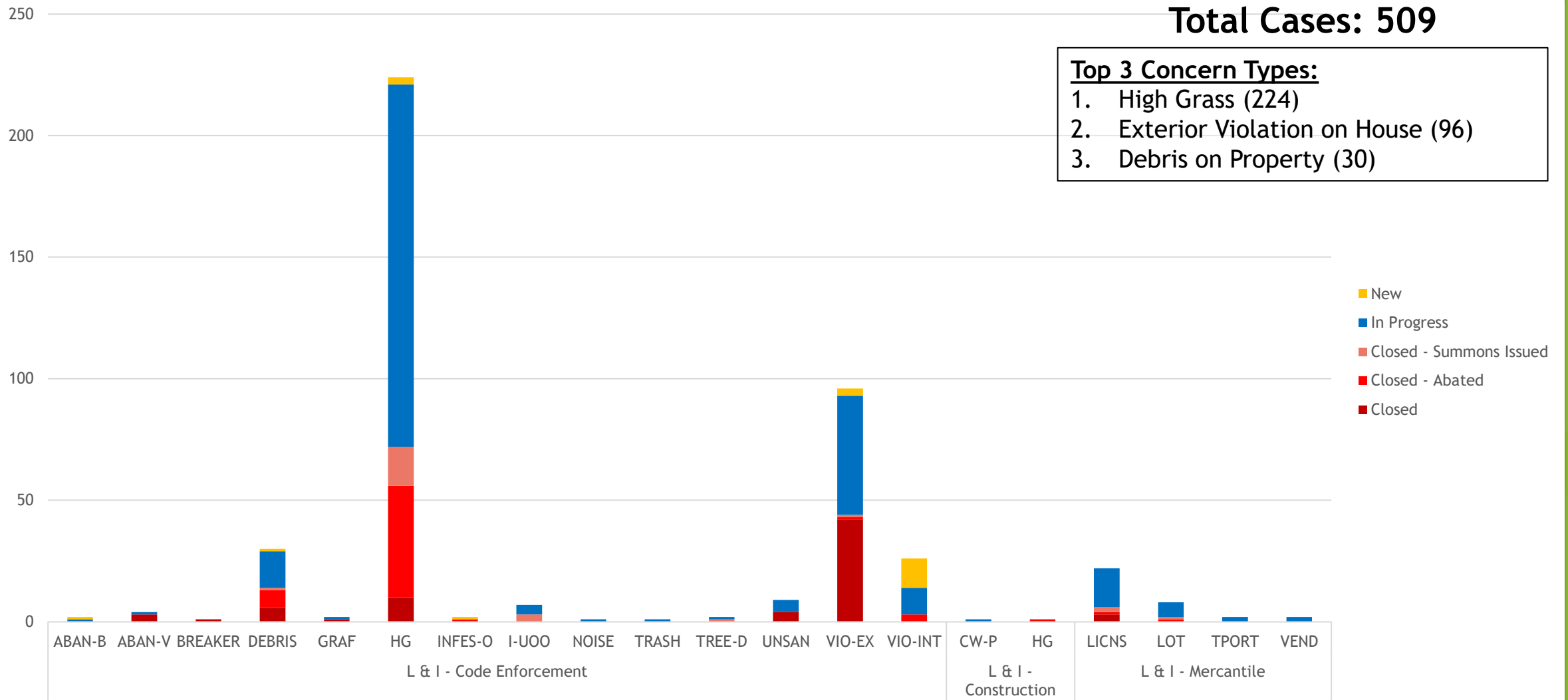
