**RECOGNITION ON A JOB WELL
DONE**

Officer Riley Flynn- Charlie 1 Patrol (Commanded by Lt. Howard Johnson

On May 26 at 12:58 AM, Officer Flynn was patrolling in the 800 block of north Maryland Avenue when he observed a commotion outside of a residence. Upon investigating further, he noticed smoke coming from a residence, and a person hanging out of a second-floor window. Officer Flynn quickly learned that there was a fire. He kicked in the front door and made entry into the smoke-filled residence. He made his way to the second floor where he contacted the 17-year-old female that was at the window and led her outside to safety. Officer Flynn re-entered the residence to help locate the family's pets including three dogs and one cat. He safely rescued the cats and dogs from the residence.

Sergeant Daniel Arra, Officers William Harned and Adrianna Petinga- Bravo 1 Patrol (Commanded by Lt. Jody Hersh)

On June 5 at 8:20 PM, patrol officers responded to the 400 block of north Delaware Avenue in reference to a large group outside in a fight. The group was a mix of adults and juveniles and mostly female. As officers attempted to intervene in the fight and make necessary arrests, they were assaulted as others interfered in these arrests. At the conclusion of the incident, three females were arrested.

An investigation by members of the patrol division and Criminal Investigations Section identified five females who were involved in the assault of police officers and the interference with the arrests. The five females were criminally charged and all arrested at various locations and times throughout the week.

On June 16, patrol officers responded to Chelsea Avenue and the Boardwalk for a report of a male shot. Officers arrived to find a juvenile male, 16, suffering from a gunshot wound. The juvenile was transported to the AtlantiCare Regional Medical Center, City Division, with a non-life-threatening injury.

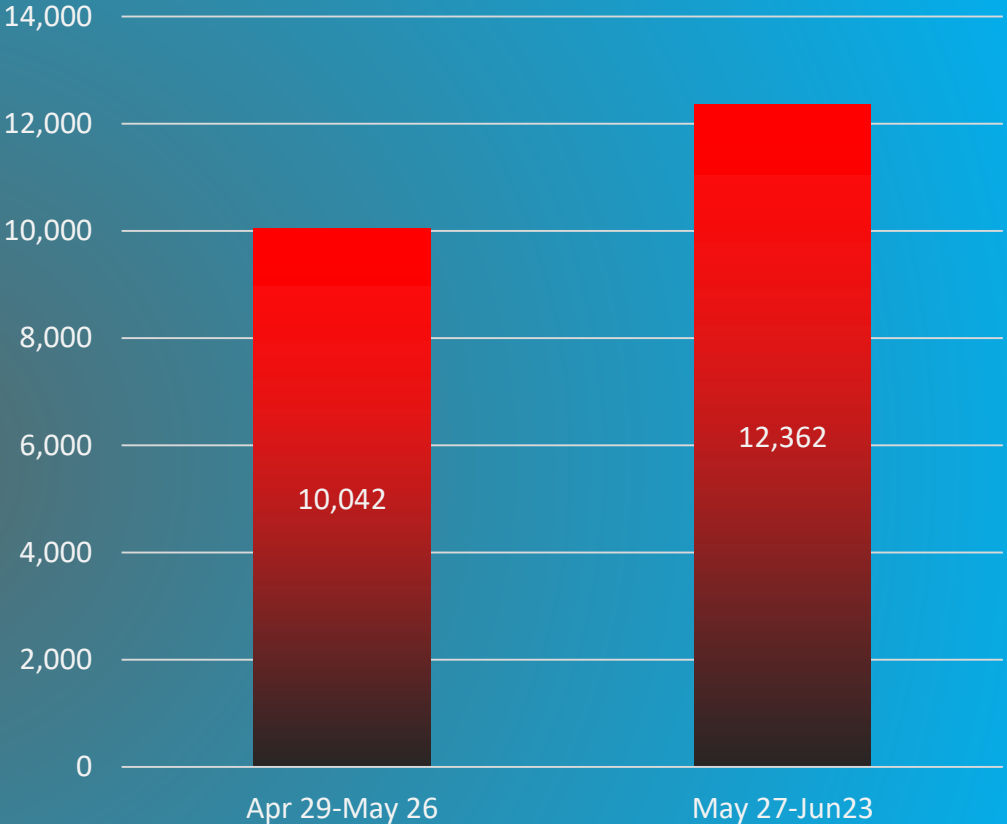
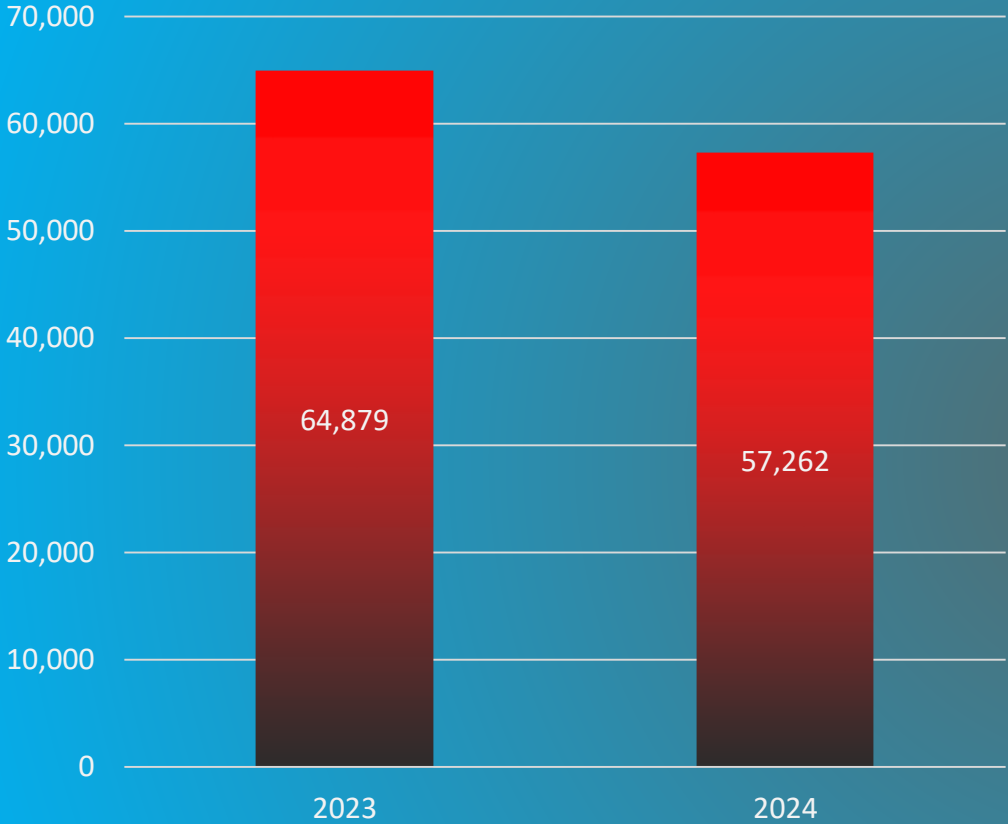
Detectives of the Violent Crimes Unit conducted an investigation that included interviewing witnesses and viewing footage from several surveillance cameras. During the course of the investigation, the juvenile and his Mother were interviewed a second time by detectives. The detectives learned that their initial interview was completely false. The juvenile shot himself while inside of a stall in a public restroom on the Boardwalk. The juvenile illegally brought a firearm on a trip to Atlantic City from Philadelphia.

On June 18, the juvenile pled guilty to the charges in Juvenile Court and was sentenced.

Calls for Service Overview

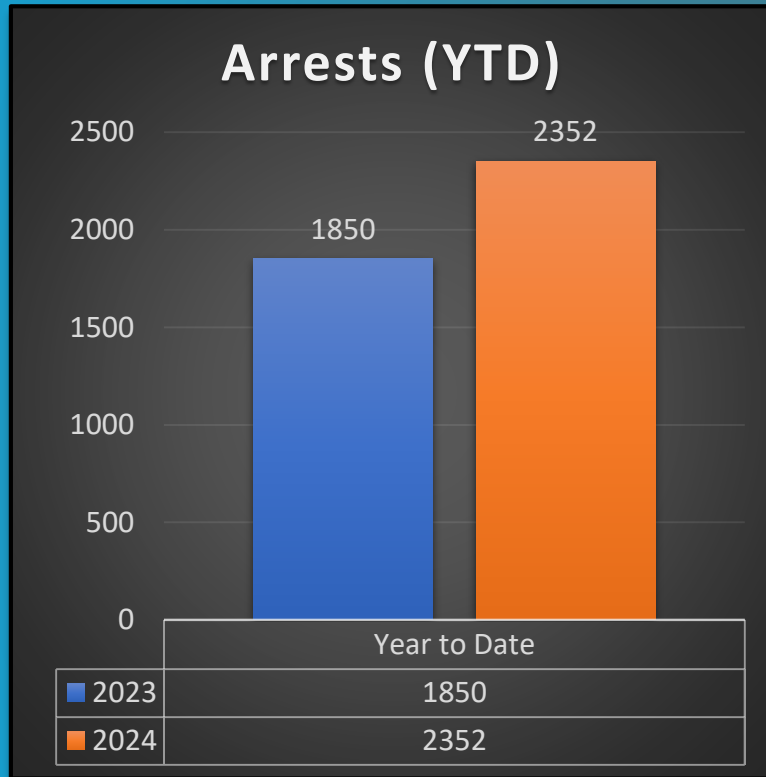


Calls for Service are down 11.8% in 2024 vs 2023 YTD.

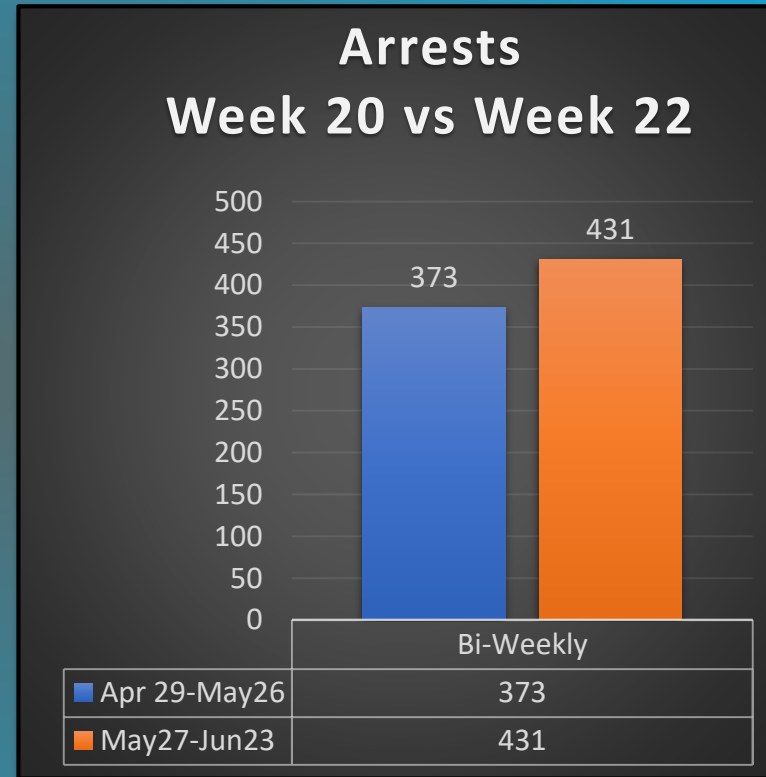


Calls for Service are up 23%

26.1% Increase

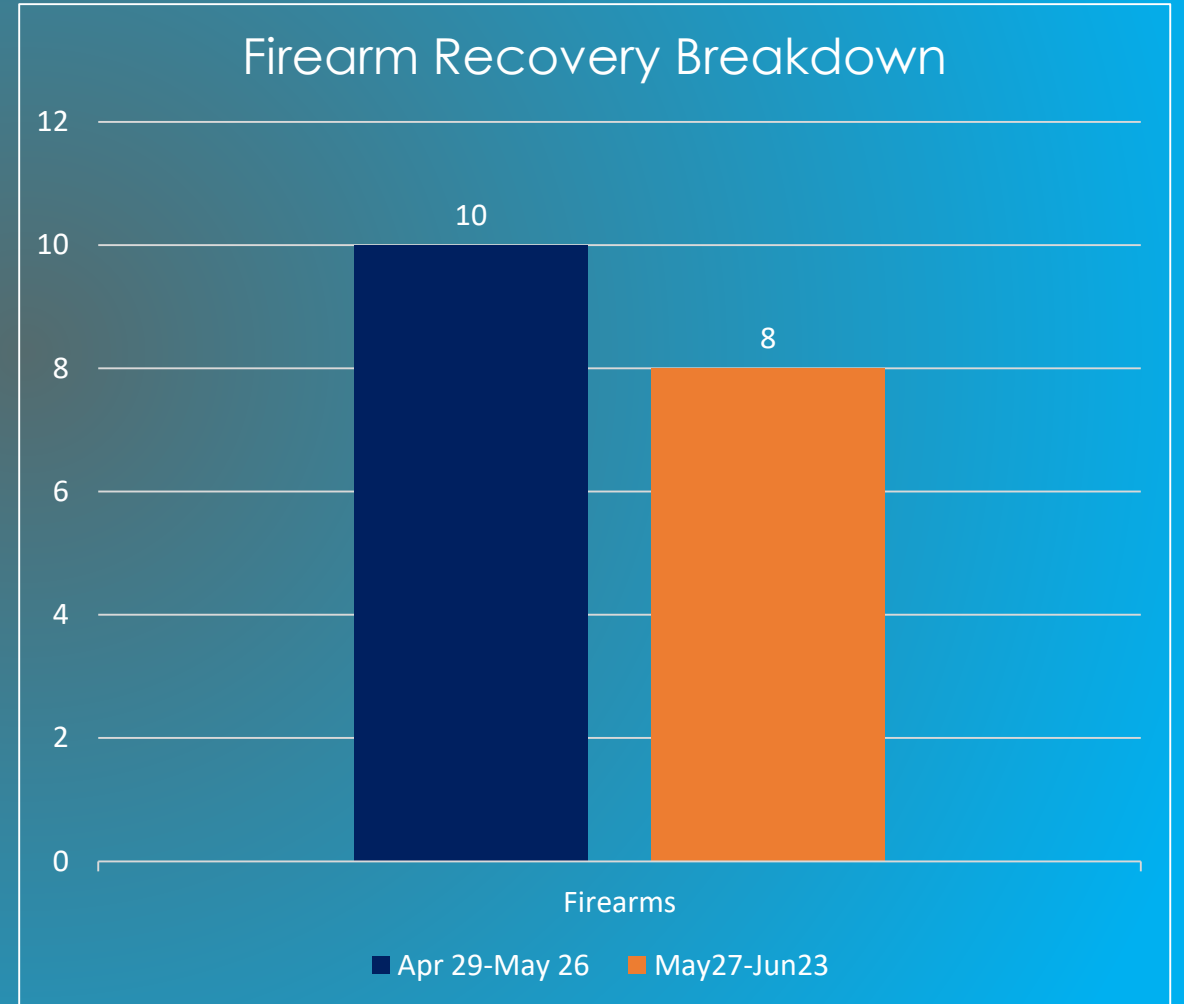
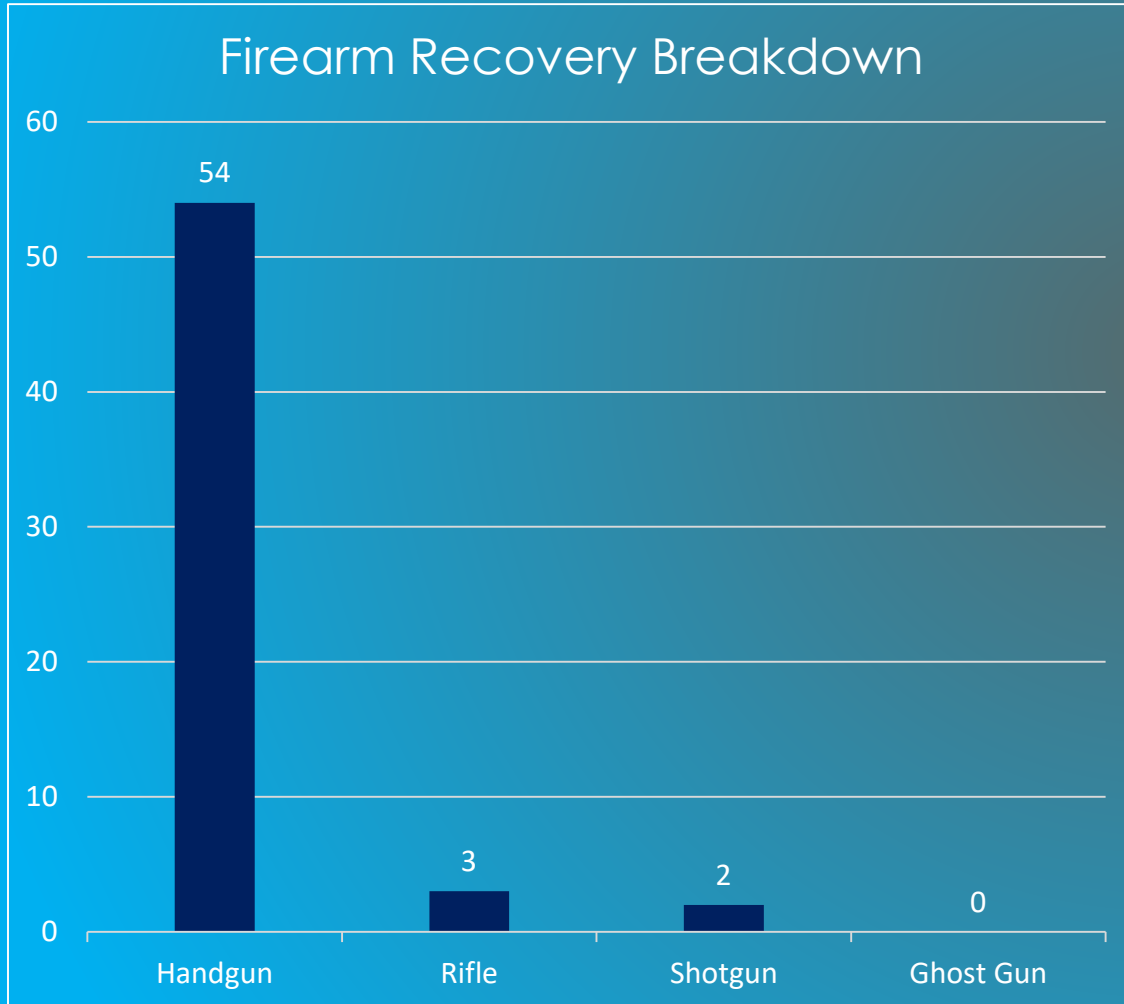

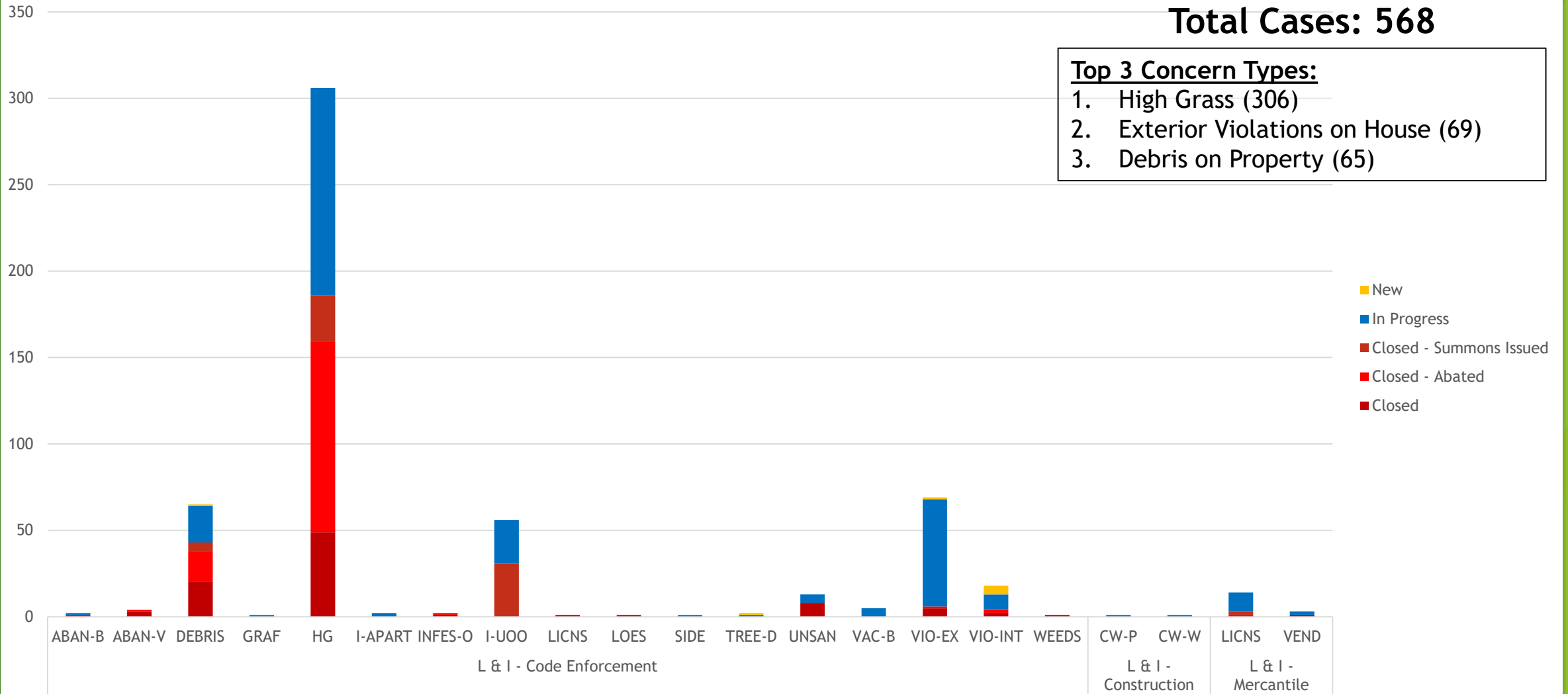

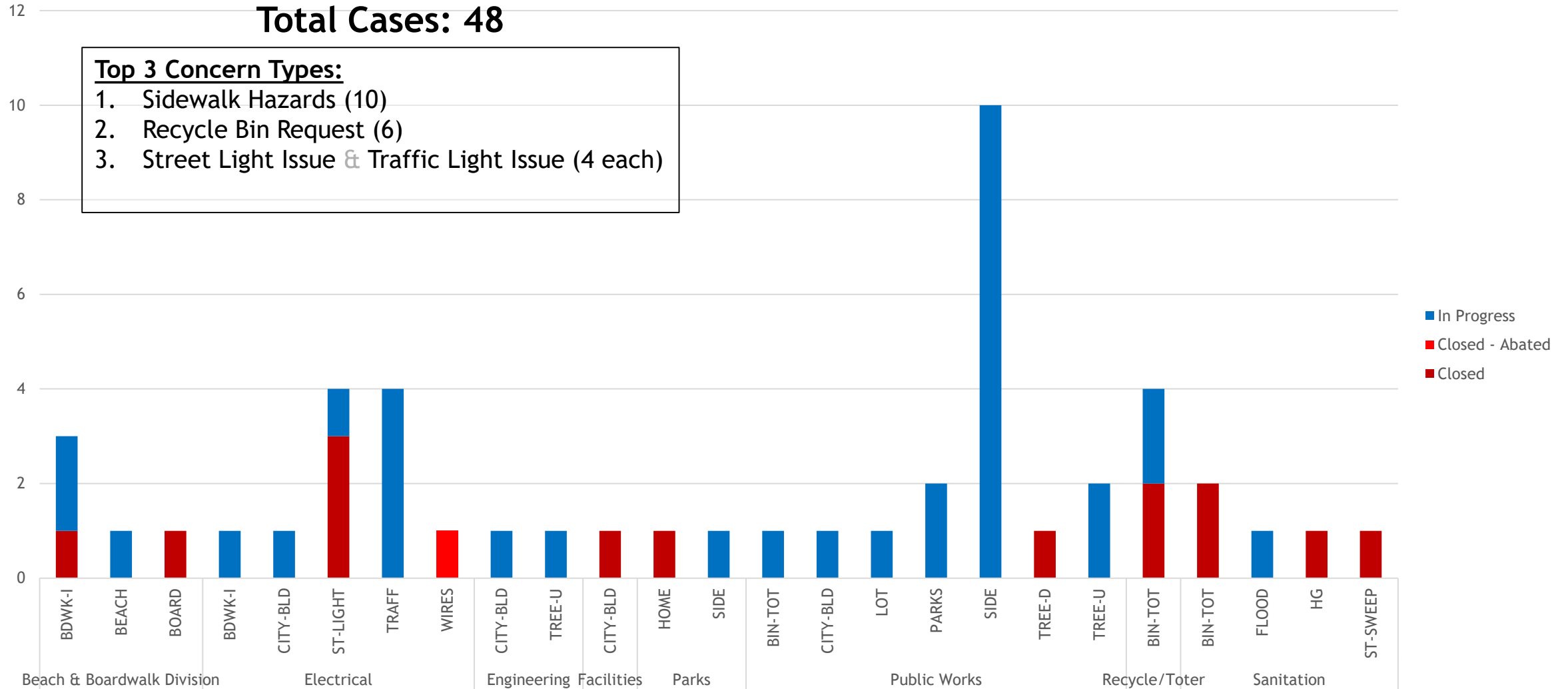
