## **Detectives of the Special Victims Unit (Supervised by Sgt. John Sharkey)**

On June 22, patrol officers responded to the area of Kingston and Sunset Avenues in reference to a 13-year-old female meeting up with a 21-year-old male. Officers located the pair and began to speak with them about their relationship. They learned that they had recently met on social media.

An investigation conducted by detectives of the Special Victims Unit revealed that the male was aware of the female's age and wanted to engage in a sexual relationship with her. He was ultimately placed in custody.

During the course of this investigation, detectives learned of another investigation where the male was suspected of inappropriately touching an 11-year-old female when he was 16-years-old in March 2019. While being interviewed, the male made incriminating statements leading to being criminally charged in that case as well.

# Officers Kenlyn Johnson and Bryan Victoria-Garcia, and Detective Christopher Dodson

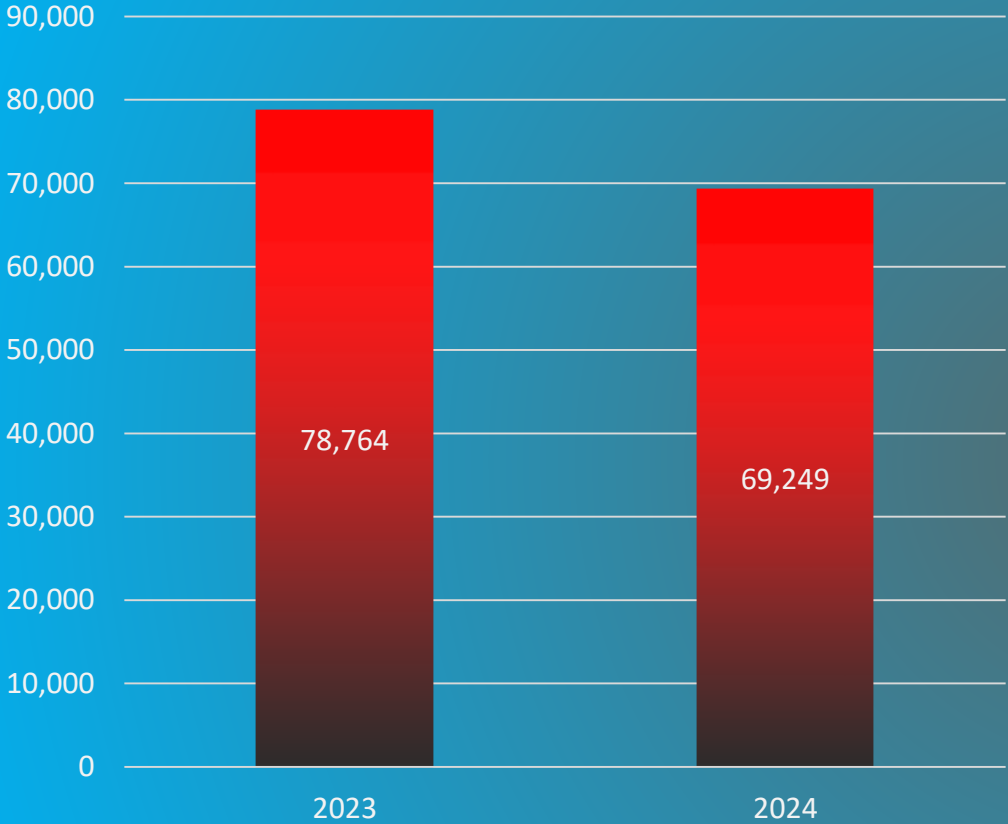
On July 4, Officer Johnson responded to the 700 block of Maryland Avenue in reference to a dispute involving the repossession of a vehicle. Officer Johnson spoke with a female who was the registered owner of the vehicle and the tow truck driver. The female was attempting to prevent her vehicle from being towed away.

While Officer Johnson was verifying information, the female entered her vehicle and sped onto the sidewalk striking a parked car. She pulled up to her children and ordered them in the vehicle. Officer Victoria-Garcia ordered the female to exit her vehicle. She refused and accelerated away with her children now in the car. While fleeing the scene, the female struck another vehicle occupied by a woman and her four children ranging in ages from one to 10. She fled the scene of that crash and was ultimately located by Detective Dodson where she was arrested without incident.

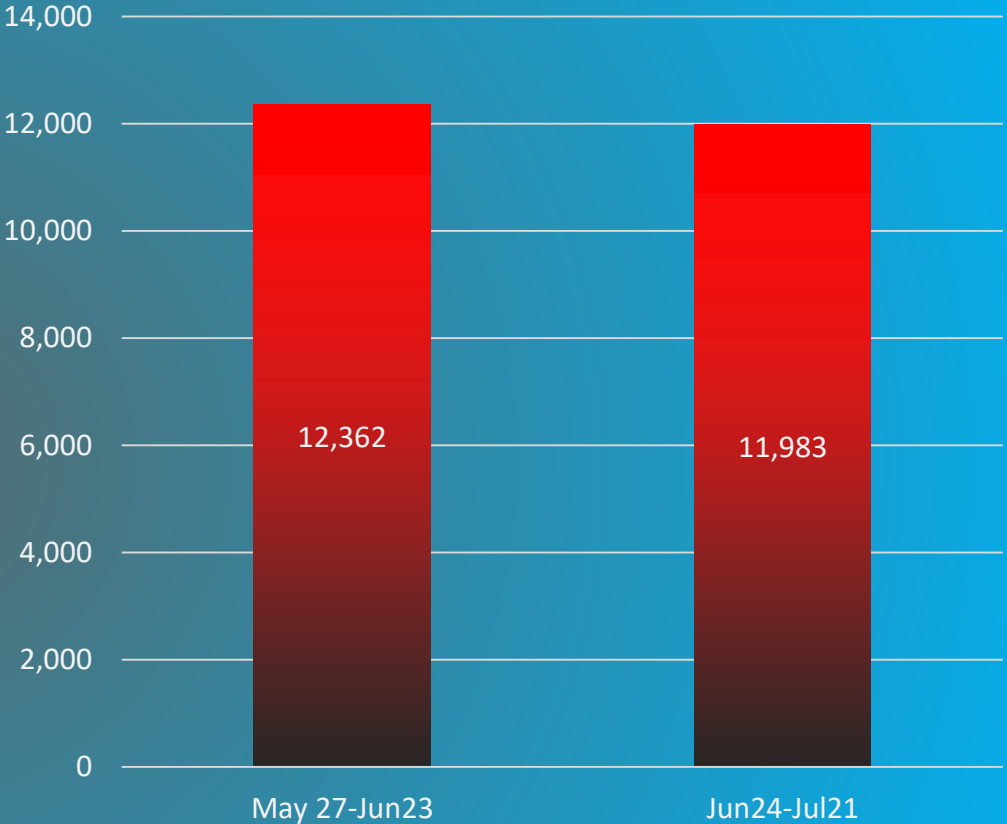

# Calls for Service Overview

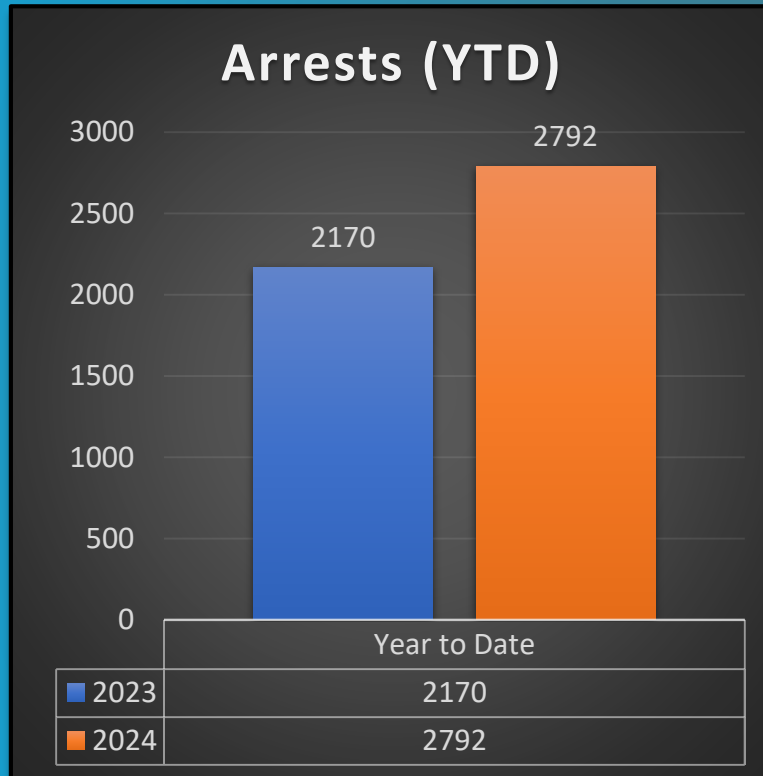


Calls for Service are down 12.1% in 2024 vs 2023 YTD.

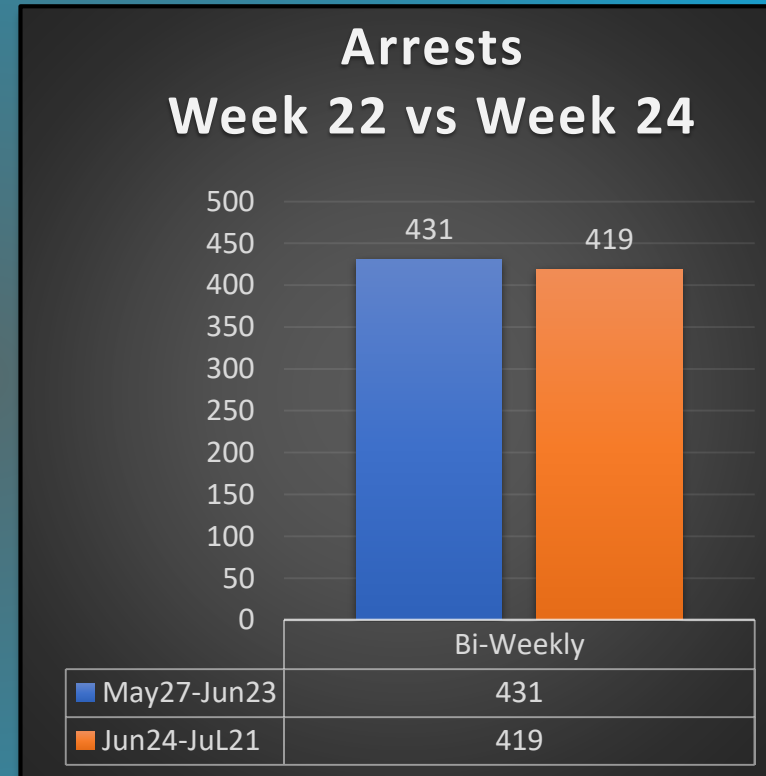


Calls for Service are down 3.1%

28.7% Increase

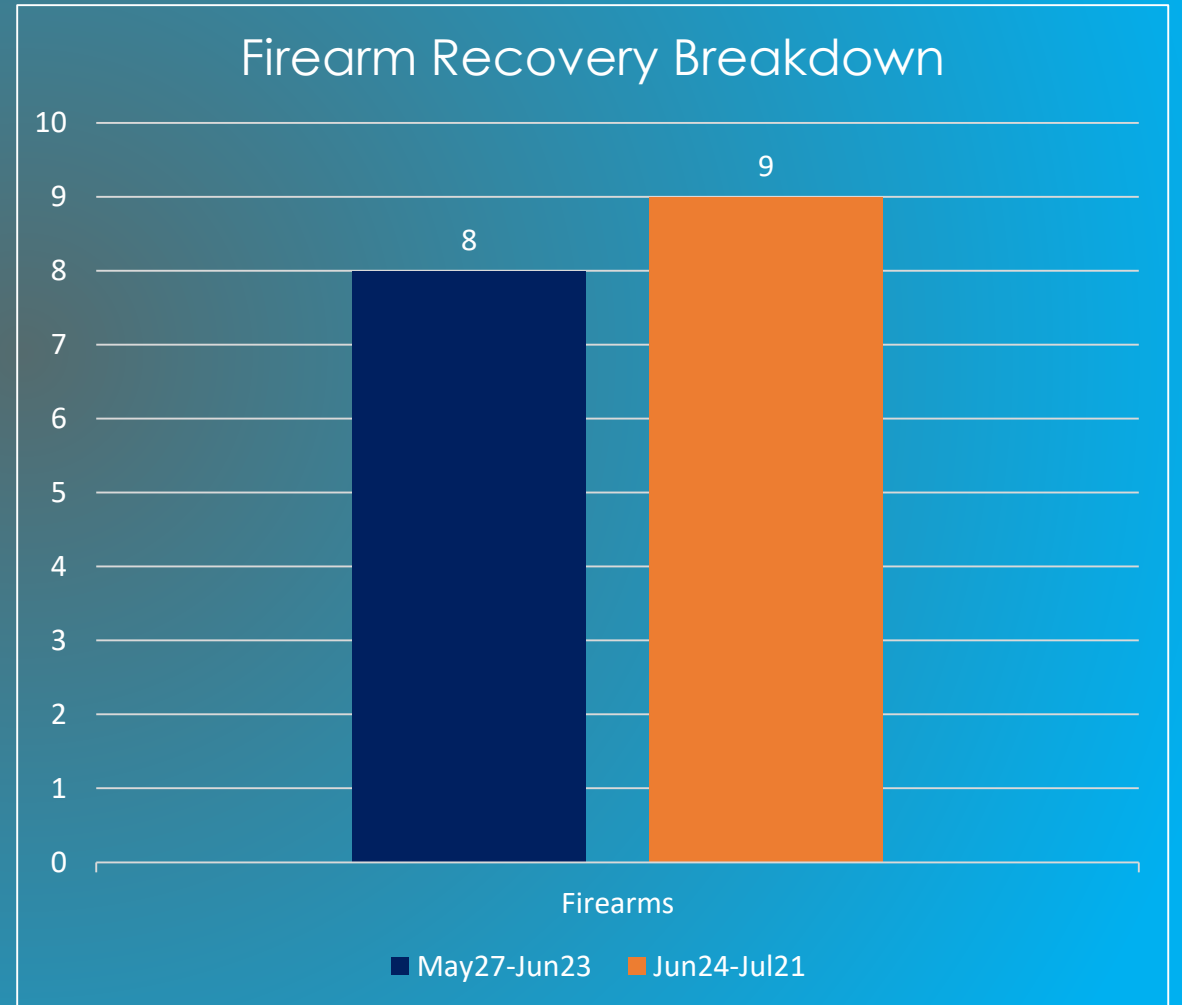
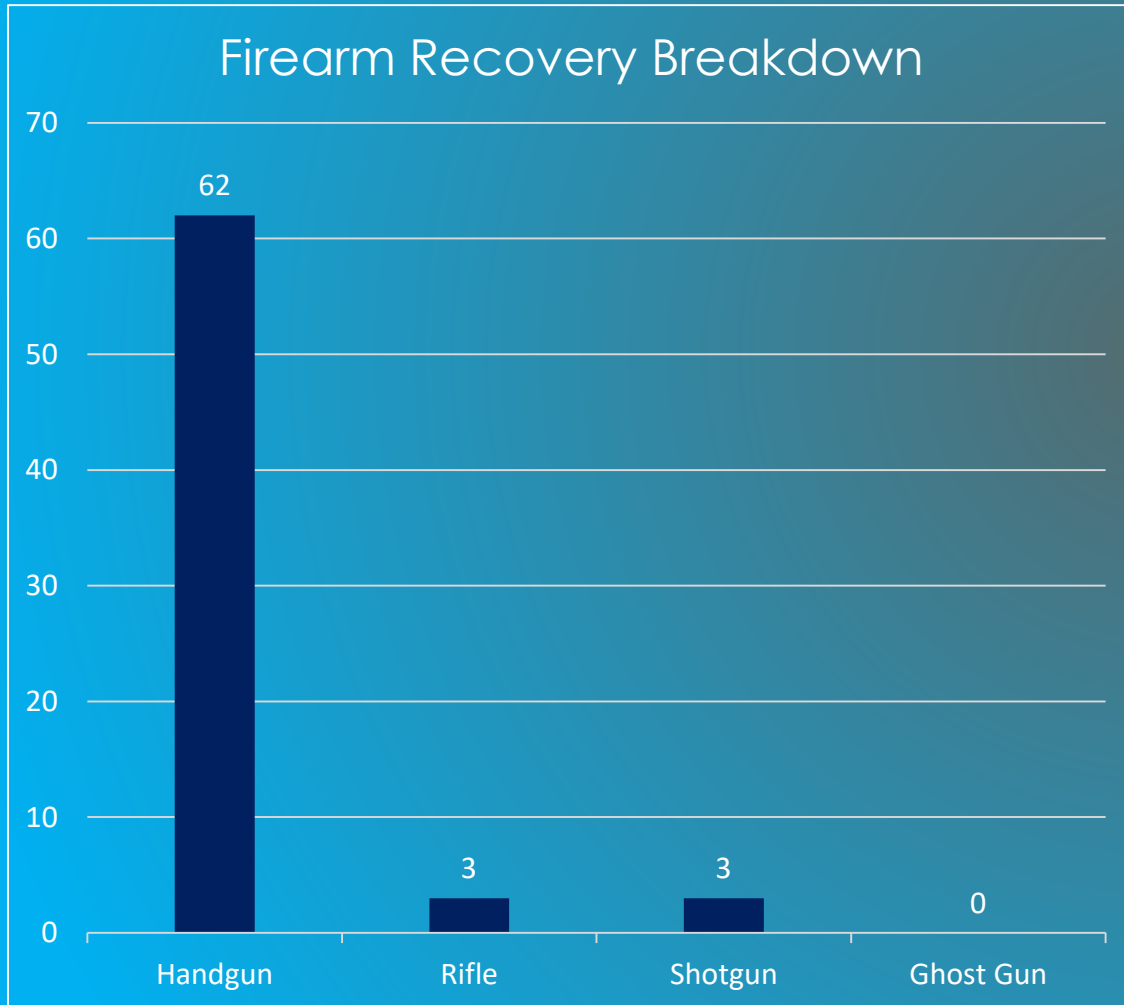

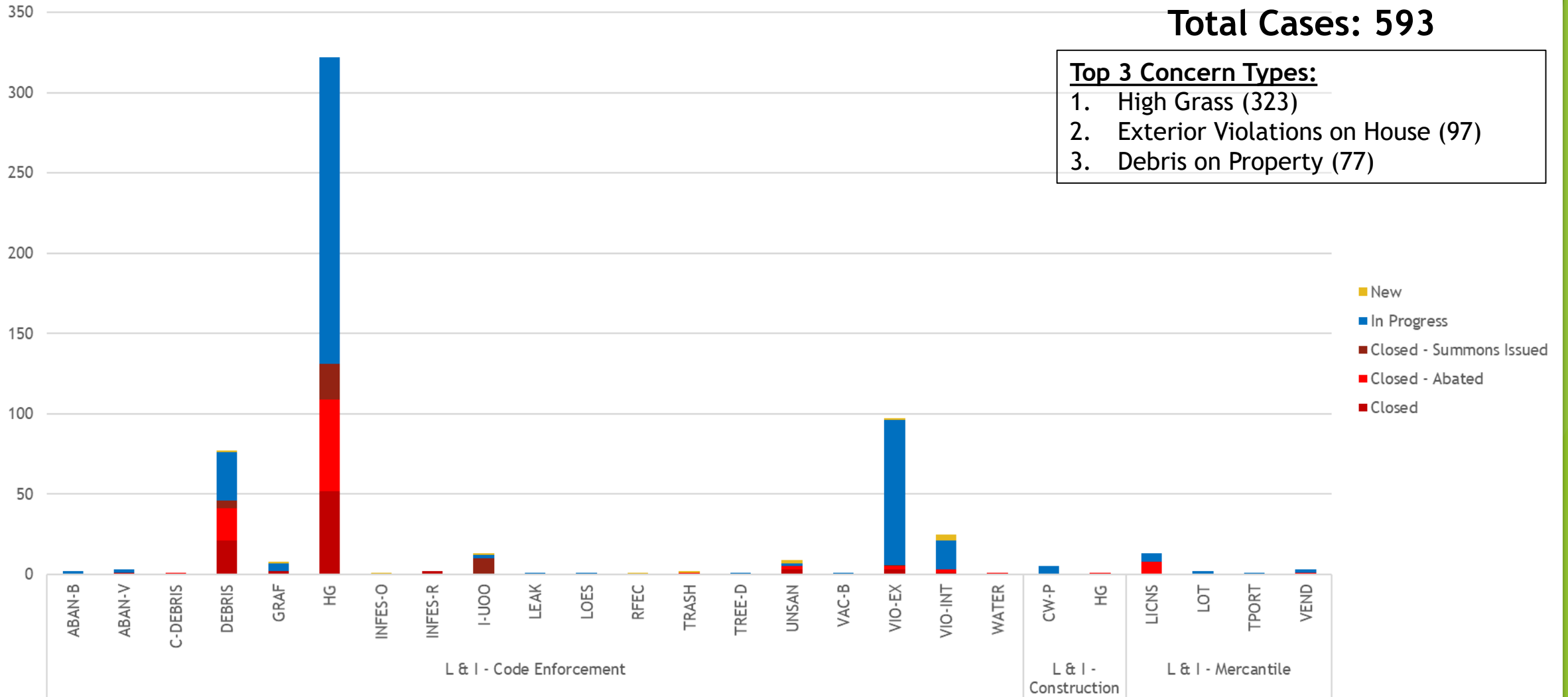

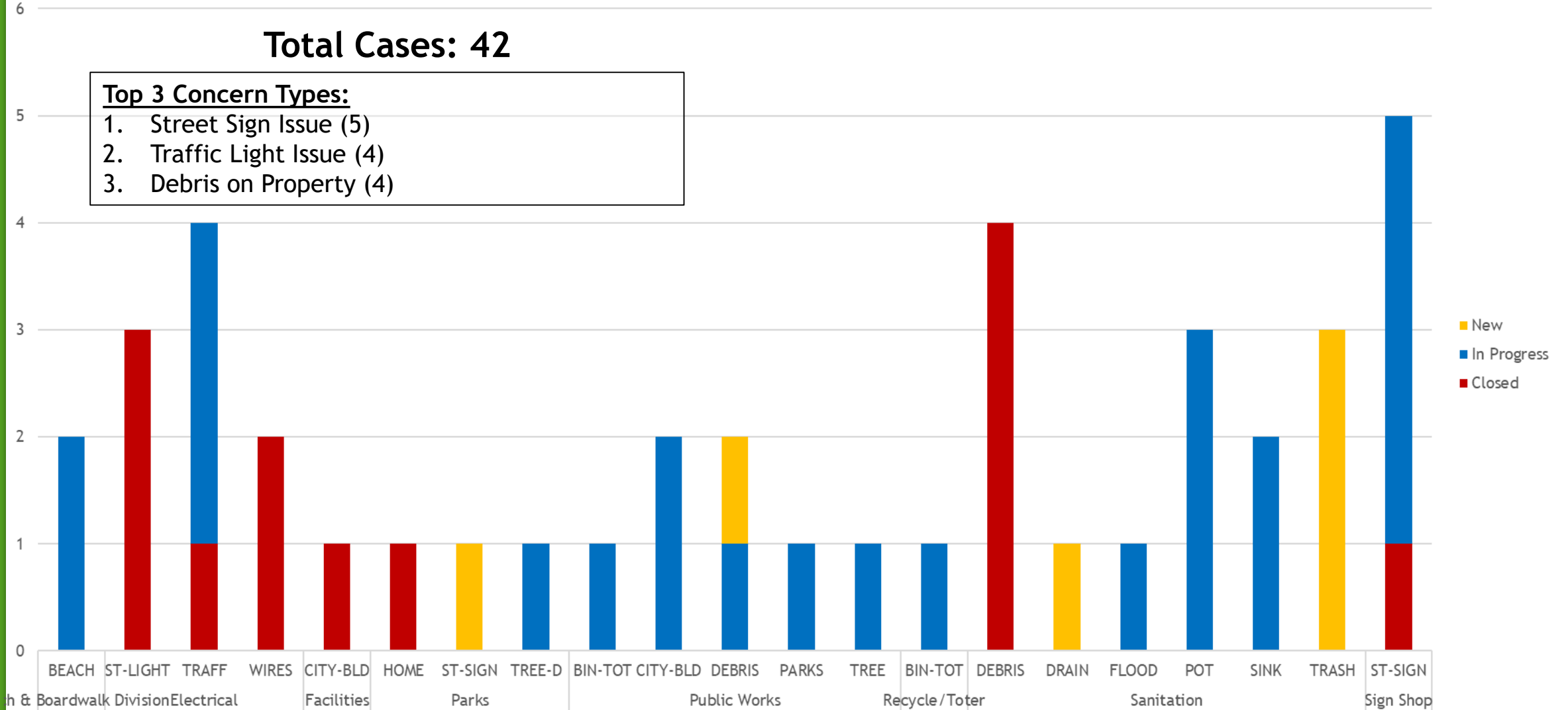

#### Geographic Location



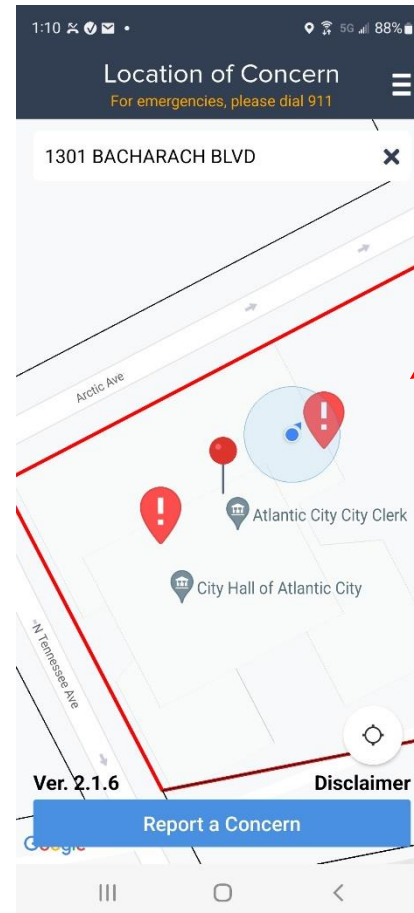
