**RECOGNITION ON A JOB WELL  
DONE**

**Officer Matthew Schmidt- Alpha 2 Patrol (Commanded by Lt. Will Santiago)  
Officers Michael Regalbuto and Alex Torres- Charlie 1 Patrol (Commanded  
by Lt. Howard Johnson)**

On July 15, Officer Schmidt, the department's Humane Law Enforcement Officer, initiated an investigation into an allegation that a man had abandoned a canine at the Humane Society of Atlantic County during evening hours when staff was not available.

During Officer Schmidt's investigation, he determined that the suspect arrived at the Humane Society, lifted his canine over his head and dropped the canine into the Humane Society's yard causing the canine to land on its side. The canine was also missing patches of fur.

Officer Schmidt also determined that the suspect was involved in a similar incident in April where he left three canines at the Humane Society in a similar fashion. The suspect was criminally charged for his actions.

On August 10, Officers Regalbuto and Torres arrested the suspect during a motor vehicle stop in the 1100 block of Baltic Avenue

## **Officers Irwin Sanchez, Josue Rodriguez, Dylan Imbrenda, and Melvin Murray III- Bravo 2 Patrol (Commanded by Lt. William Tracy**

On August 13, patrol officers responded to the 1500 block of Atlantic Avenue for a report of a man that was stabbed. Officers arrived to learn that the victim and suspect had left the area. Officers Sanchez and Rodriguez located the victim, 27, of Bridgeton, NJ, in the 1700 block of Atlantic Avenue. The victim was suffering from stab wounds and bleeding heavily. The officers transported the victim to the AtlantiCare Regional Medical Center, City Division, for treatment of non-life-threatening injuries.

A description of the suspect was obtained and broadcasted to officers. Shortly after, Officers Imbrenda and Murray III located the suspect walking in the area of the Arctic Avenue. The suspect was positively identified and arrested. He was found in possession of a folding knife and had blood on his clothing. Officers learned that the victim and the suspect were involved in a physical altercation before the stabbing occurred.

## **Bravo 1 Platoon (Commanded by Lt. Jody Hersh)**

On August 9, patrol officers responded to the Tropicana Atlantic City in reference to a robbery. The victim was approached by five males one of which was in possession of a large knife that was held to the victim's back as they demanded his belongings. The victim was assaulted and had his property stolen. The suspects then fled from the building.

Tropicana security officers were able to obtain video surveillance of the suspects. Members of the police department's Surveillance Center were then able to locate surveillance coverage of the suspect's fleeing. Photographs of the suspects were provided to officers in the area. Officers William Harned and Julian Monsalve observed three males on the first block of south Texas Avenue. All three males ran from the officers, but were ultimately apprehended.

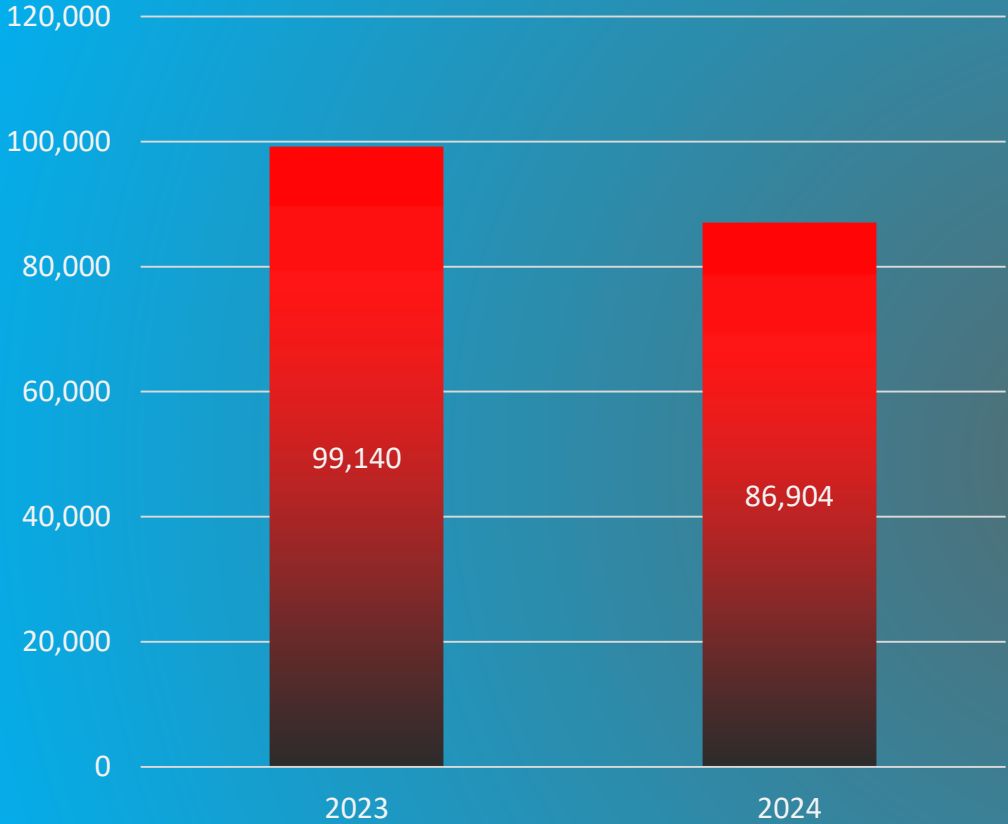
Officers Harned and Monsalve along with Officer Adrianna Petinga arrested a fourth suspect in the 2600 block of Atlantic Avenue.

Officers Christopher Campbell and Juan Perez-Delacruz located the fifth suspect in the 2600 block of Arctic Avenue. The suspect fled before being taken into custody. He was arrested after a short foot pursuit. While fleeing, the suspect dropped a bag that contained a large knife similar to the one used in the robbery. Items belonging to the victim were also recovered.

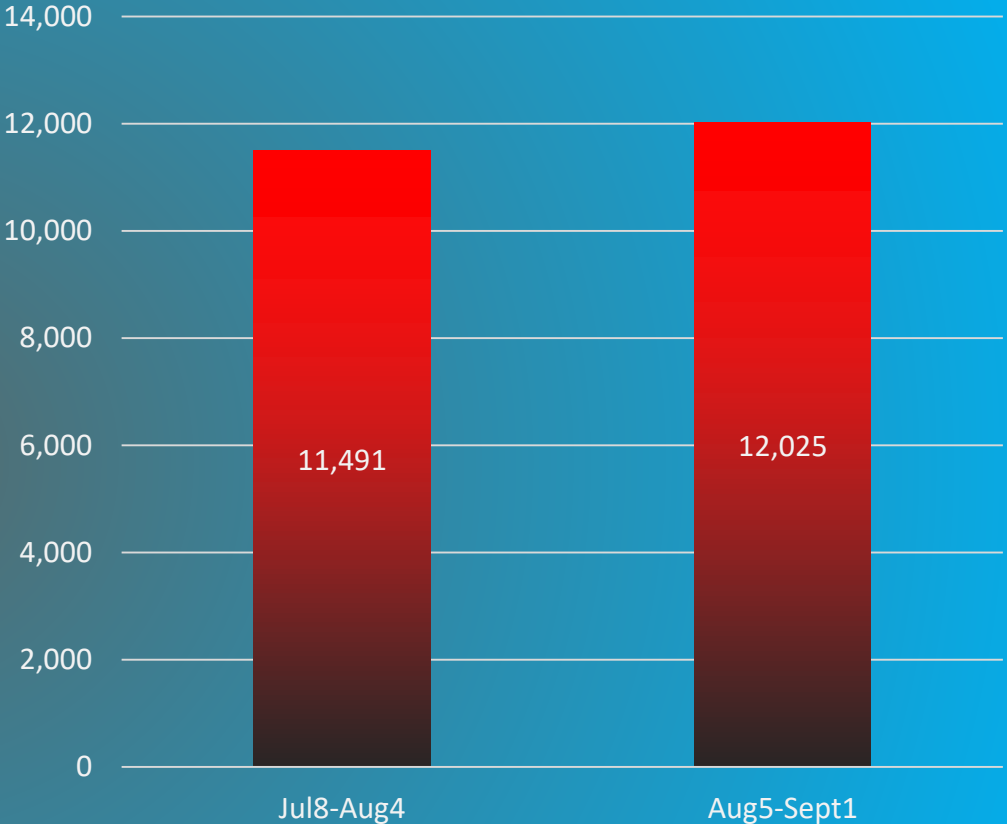

# Calls for Service Overview

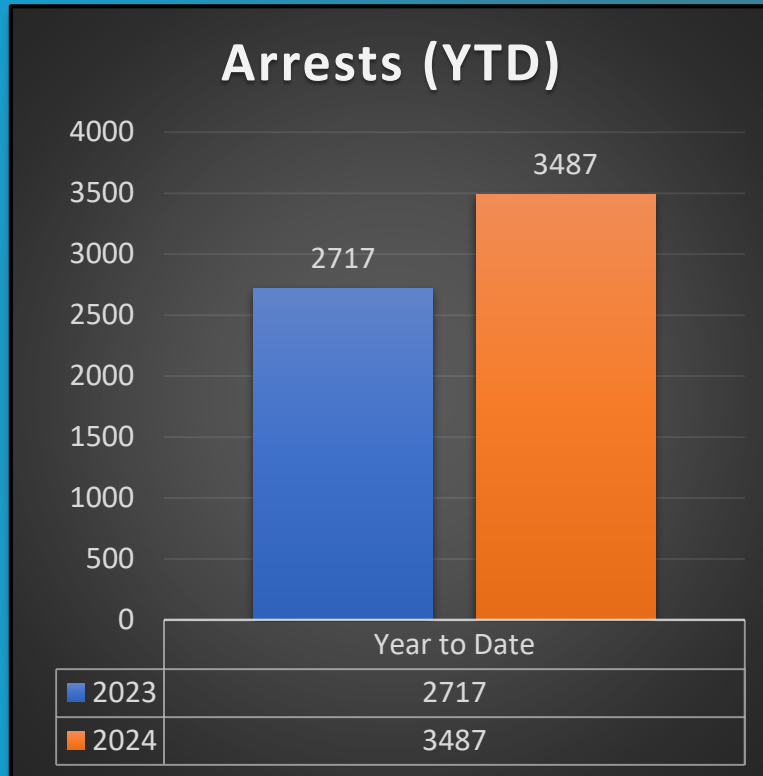


Calls for Service are down 12.3% in 2024 vs 2023 YTD.

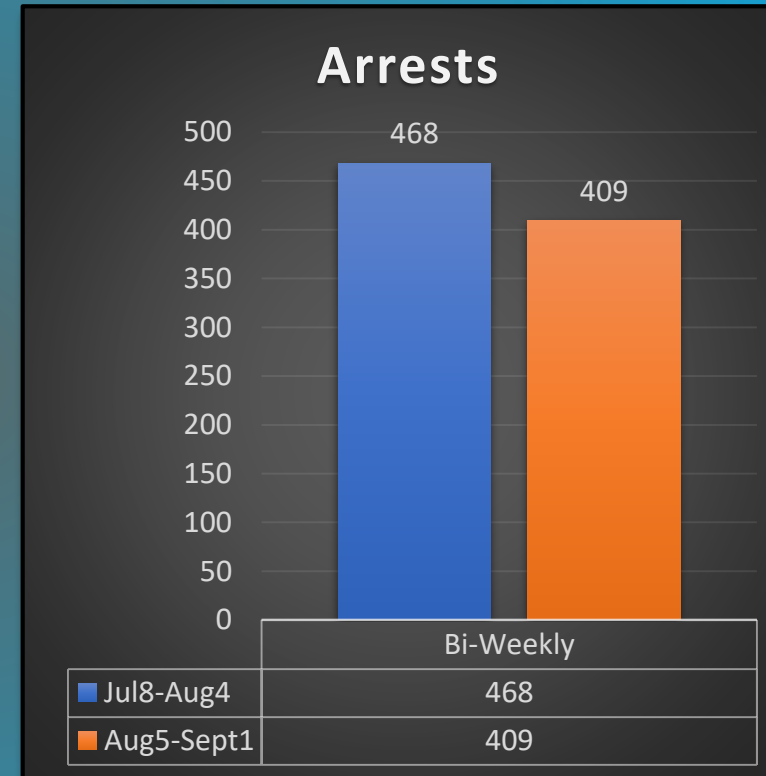


Calls for Service are up 4.6%

28.3% Increase

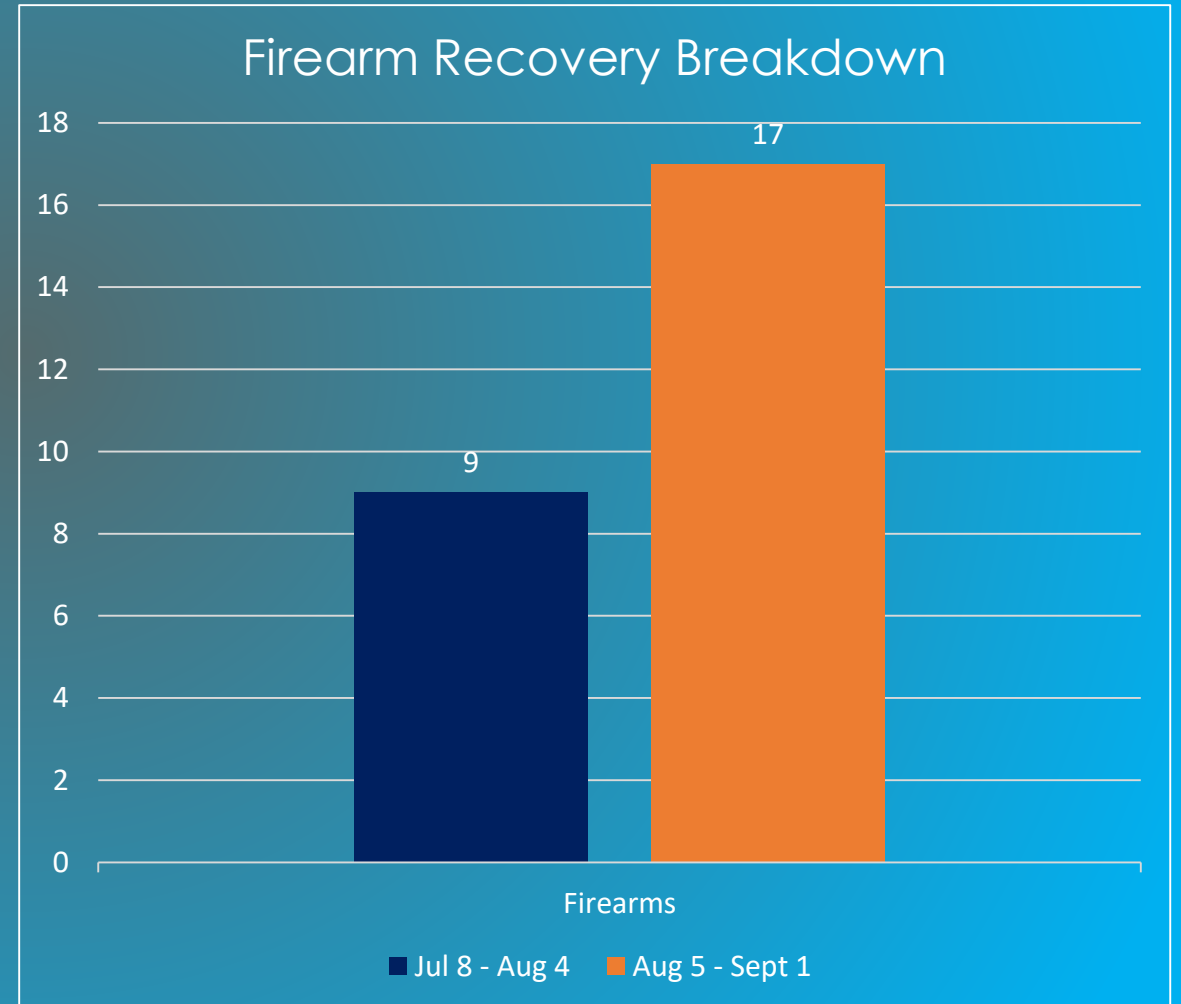
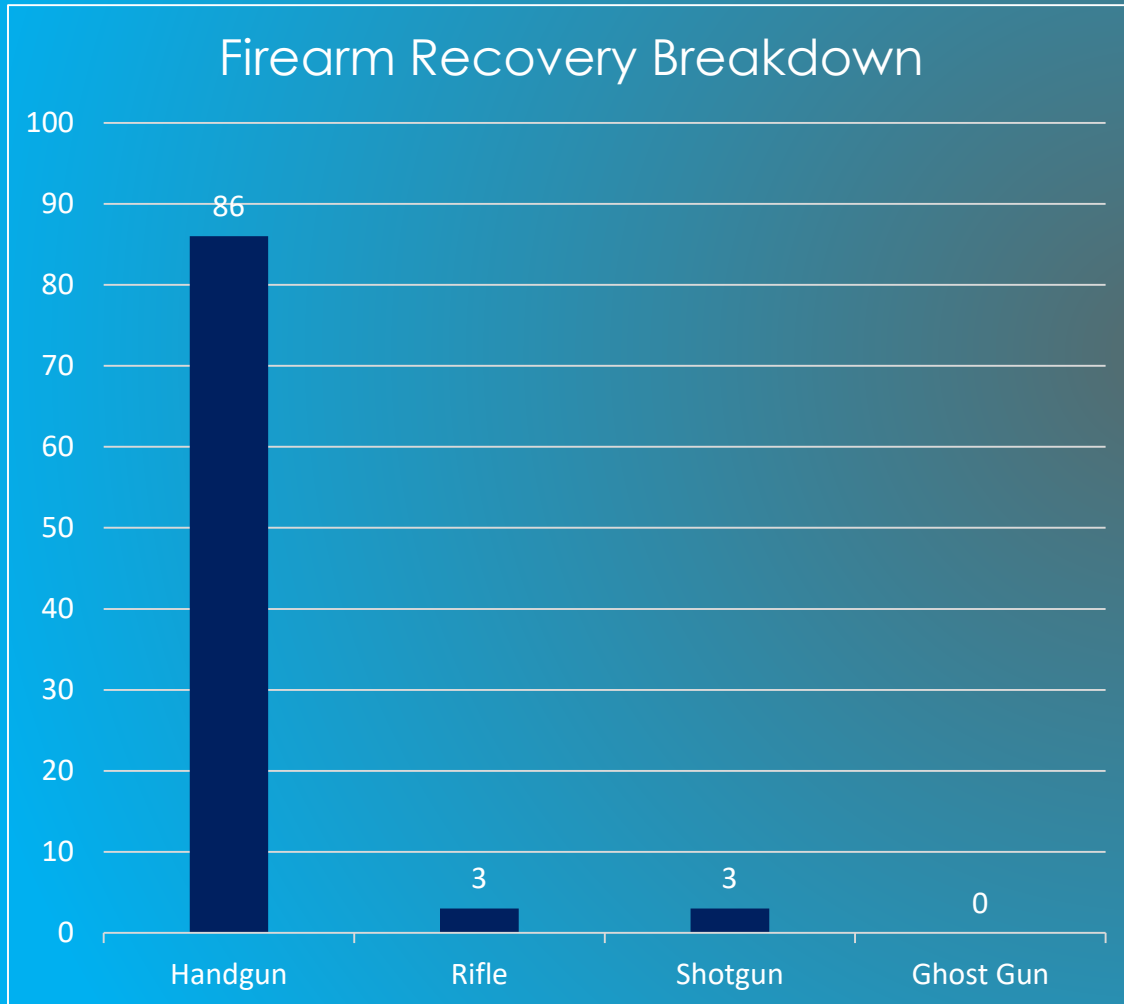

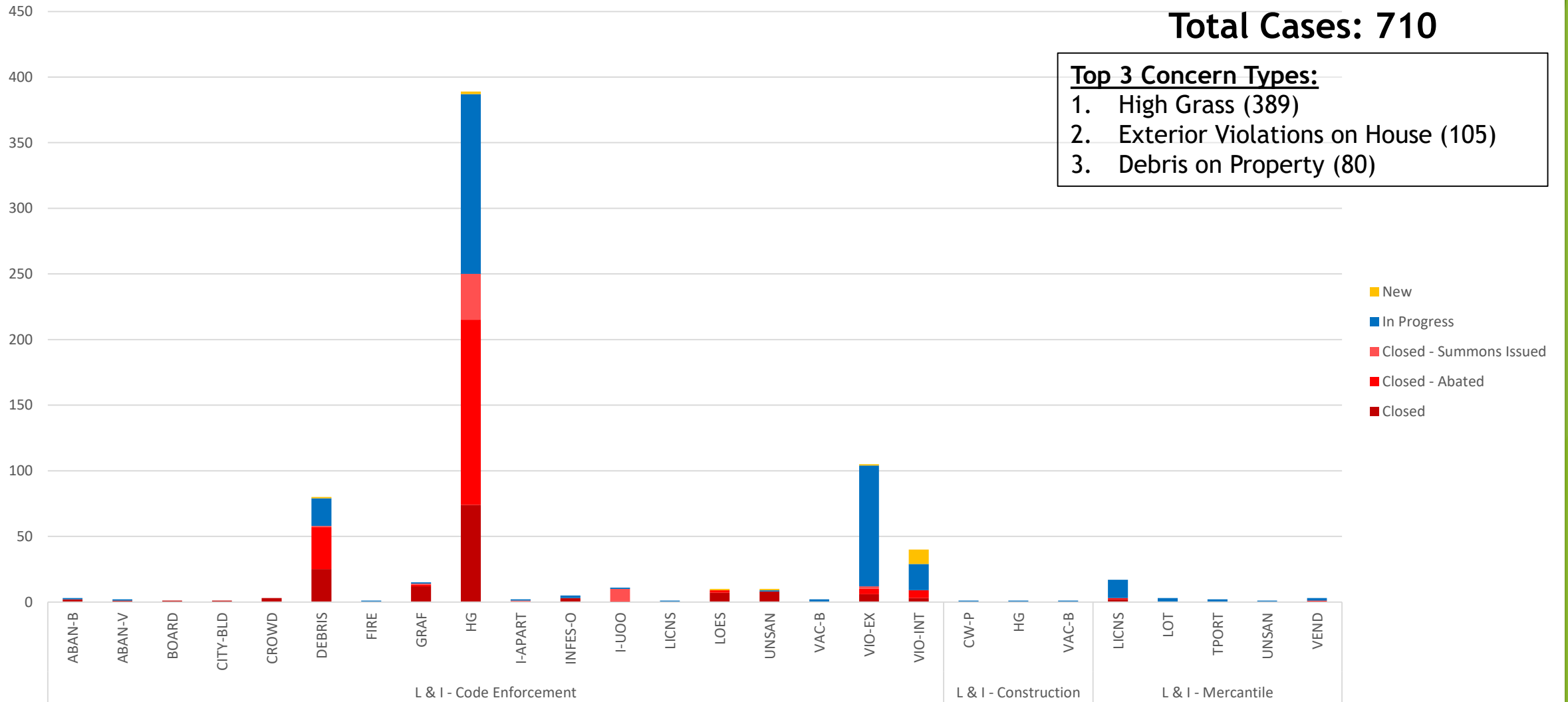

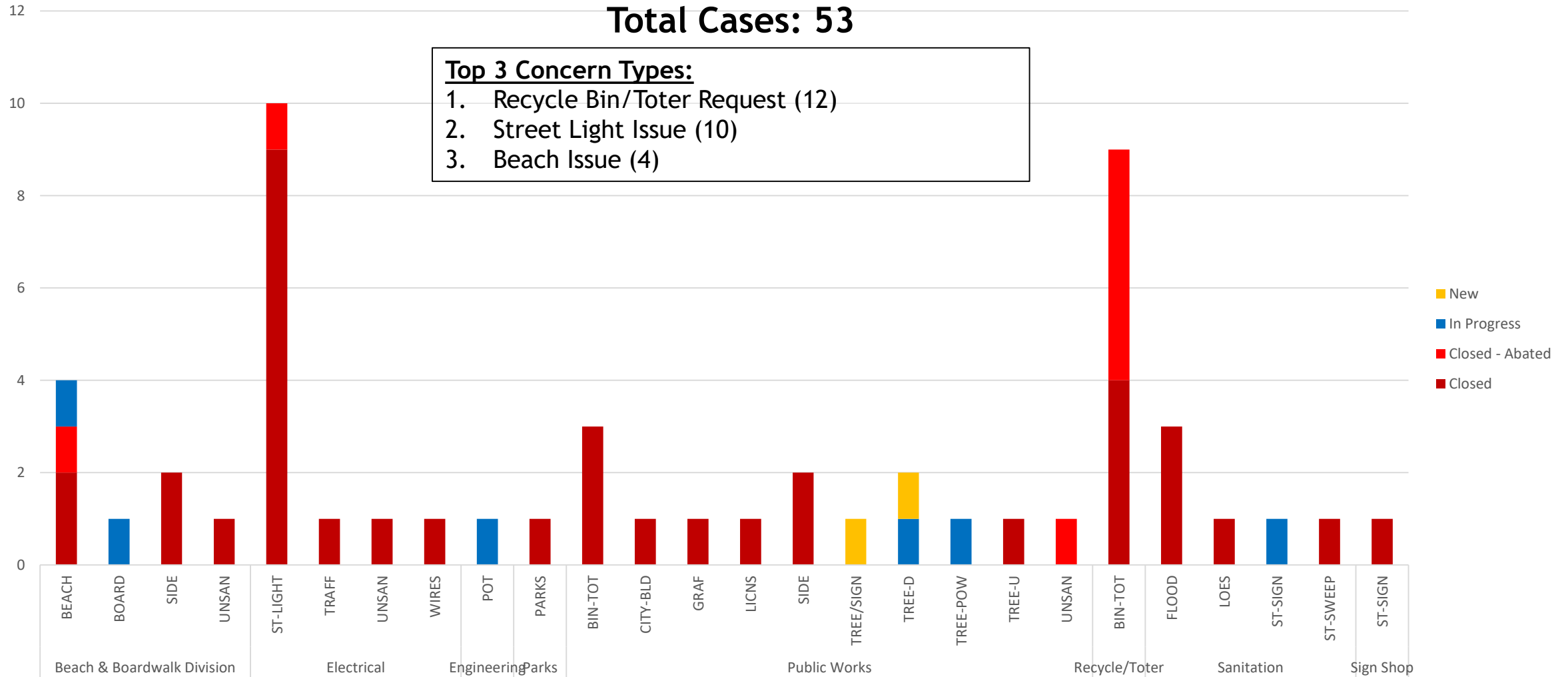

#### Geographic Location



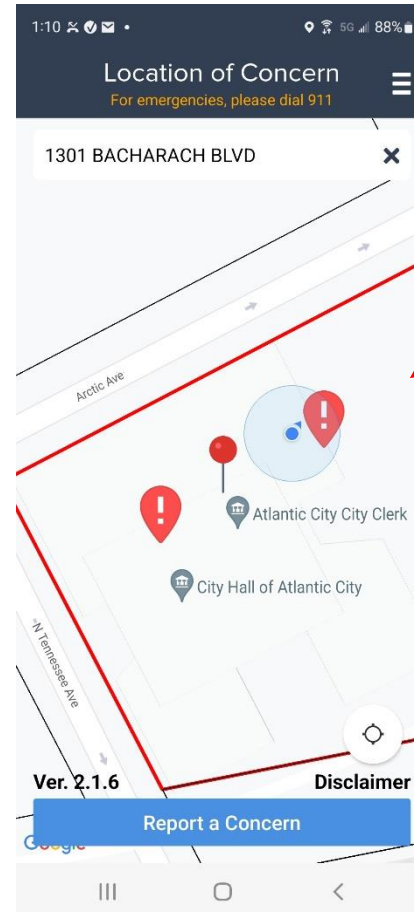



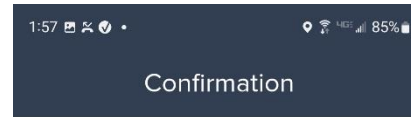
