- It has not been legally occupied for a period of six (6) months.
- The property is in need rehabilitation.
- The property is currently unfit for human habitation.
- The condition and vacancy materially increases the risk of fire to the property and adjacent properties.
- The dilapidated appearance materially affects the (economic) welfare of the residents of the area in close proximity to the property.
- The updated Abandoned Property list will be presented to City Council for adoption at the October 23rd monthly meeting. Approximately 80 properties will be included of which 35 are commercial properties

## **Officers Shalon Blake and Jovahn Perez- Bravo 1 Patrol (Commanded by Lt. Jody Hersh)**

On September 19, an alert was received for a vehicle entering Atlantic City. The alert was for a male who operated the vehicle and had numerous active warrants for his arrest. The suspect triggered other automated license plate readers as he drove down Atlantic Avenue. Officers Shalon and Jovahn located the vehicle at Vermont and Atlantic Avenues. The suspect attempted to provide false information to the officers, but he was arrested.

A continuing investigation by Officer Blake led to a court authorized search warrant of the suspect's vehicle. During a search, a loaded handgun was recovered. A woman with the suspect during his arrest was found to have provided officers with false information. The female suspect's identity has now been confirmed and she is charged with various crimes, has numerous active warrants for her arrest, and is currently wanted.

All are to be recognized for a job well done!

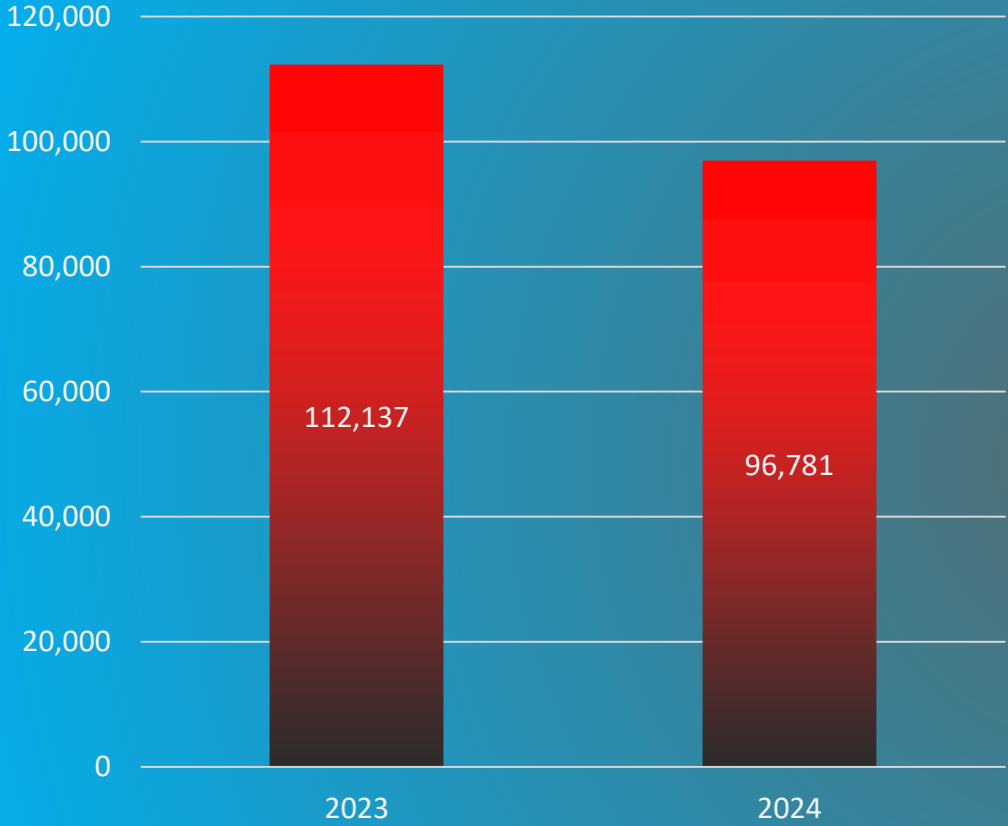
## **Officers Zayon Pitts- Alpha 2 Platoon (Commanded by Lt. Will Santiago)**

On September 22, patrol officers responded to Route 30 and Grammercy Avenue for a report of a motor vehicle crash. Officer Pitts arrived to learn that two occupants in one of the vehicles had fled the scene on foot. Officer Pitts located the passenger several blocks from the crash scene. 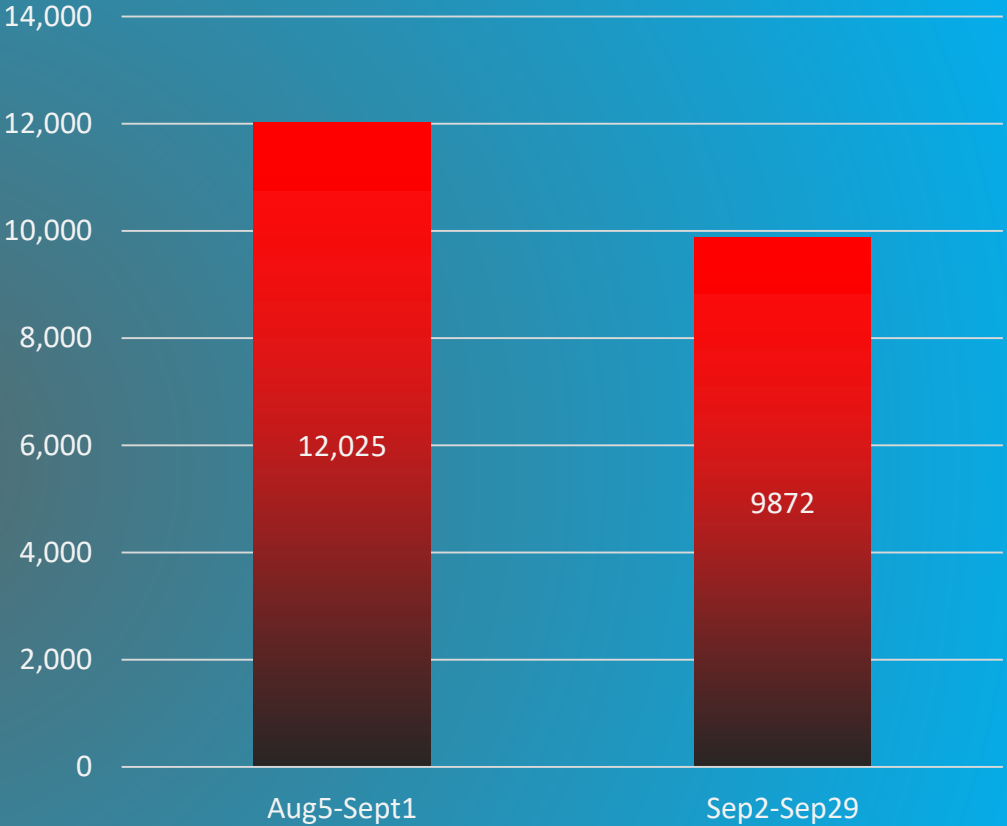

# Calls for Service Overview

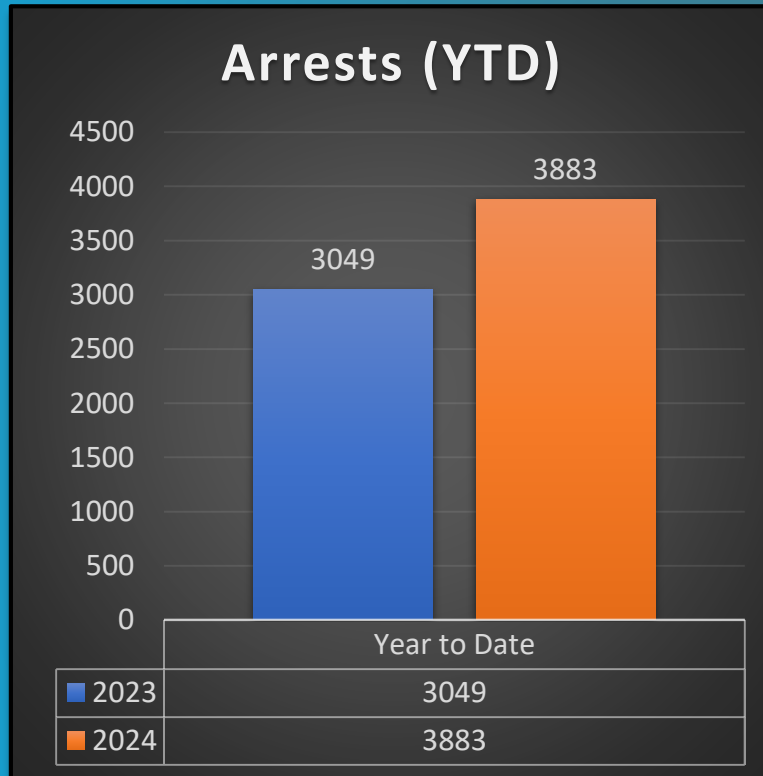


Calls for Service are down 13.7% in 2024 vs 2023 YTD.

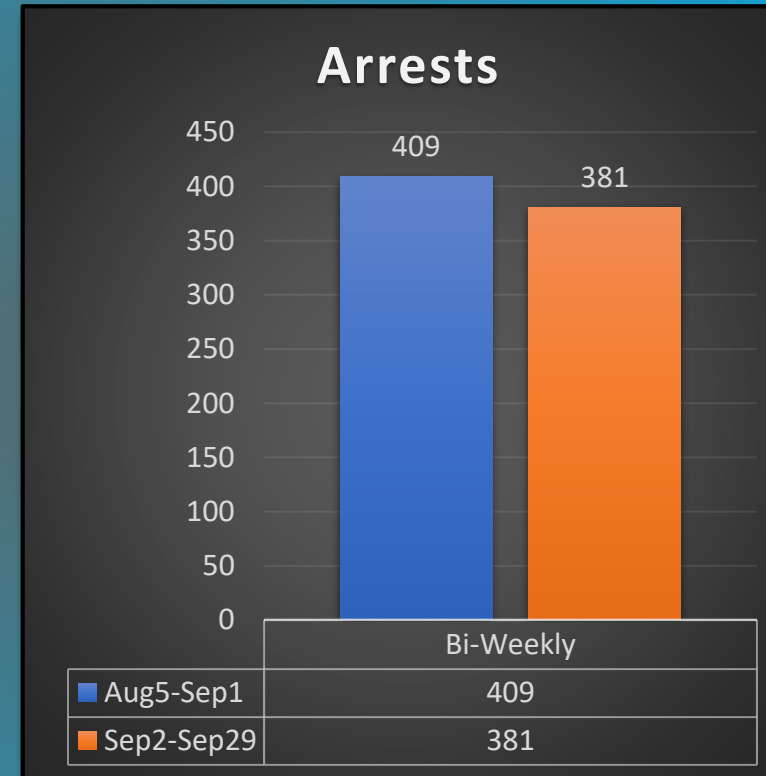

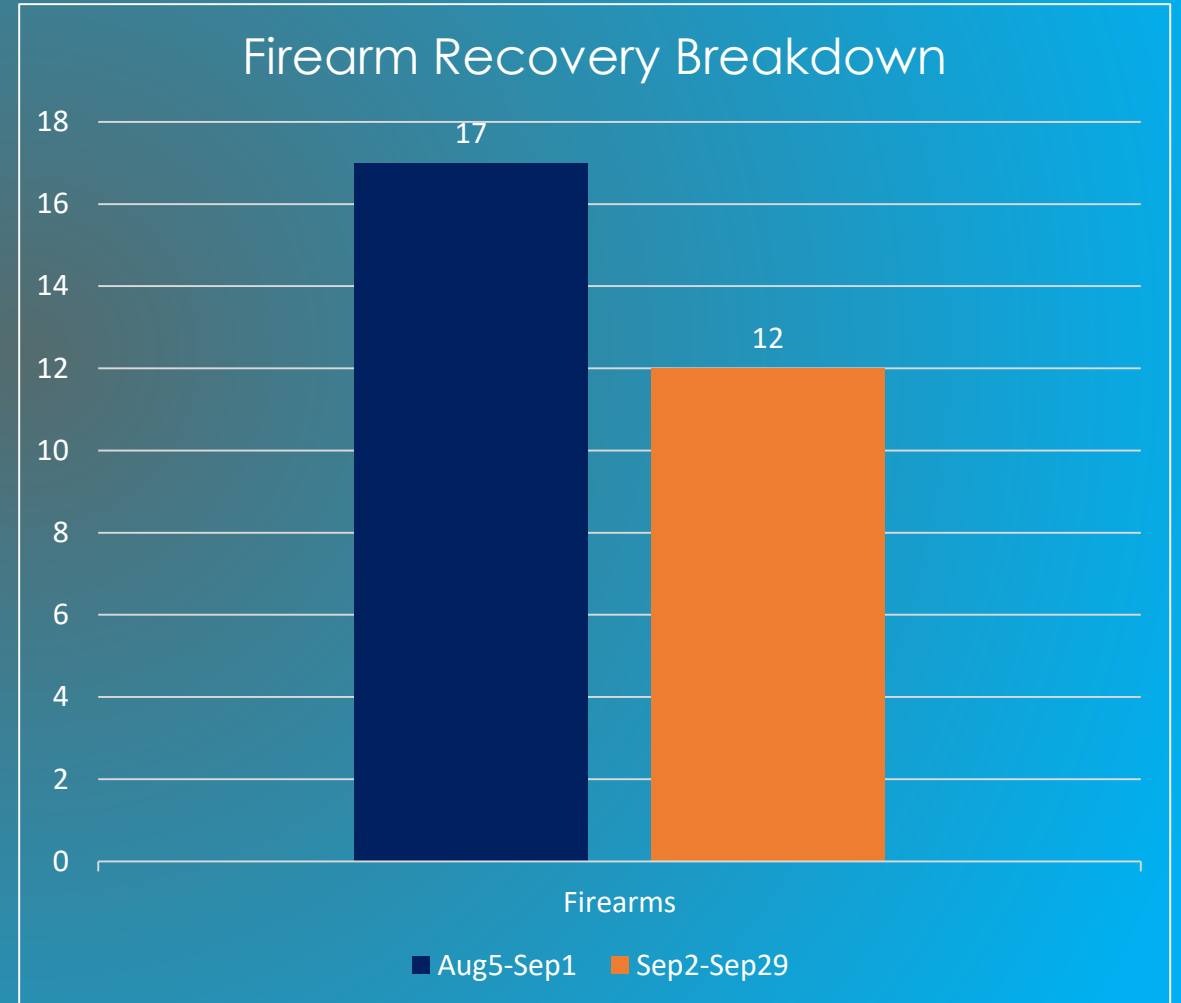

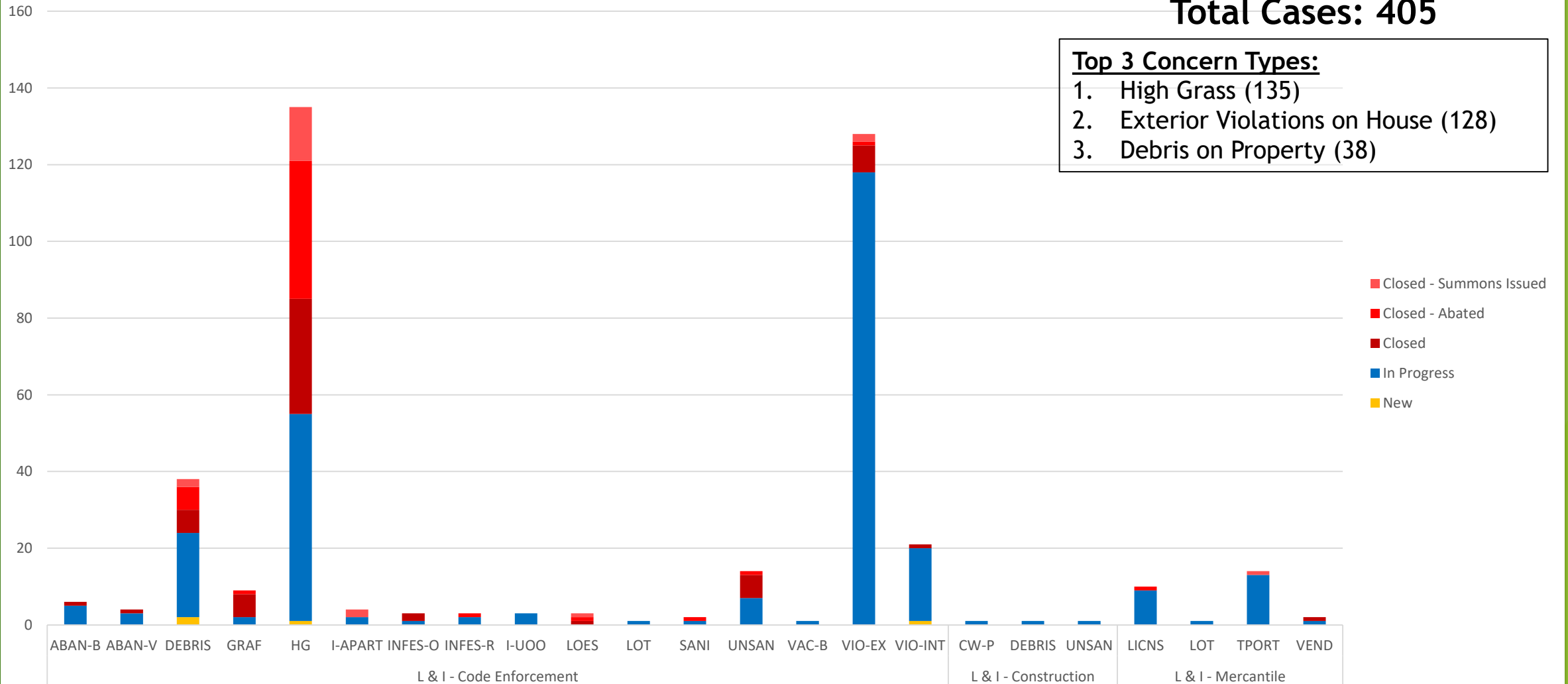
