**RECOGNITION ON A JOB WELL
DONE**

Officers Heriberto Barrios-Gomez, Matthew Schmidt, Louis Scarlata, and Kevin Puca- Alpha 2 Patrol (Commanded by Lt. Charles Stuart)

On February 10, patrol officers responded to the first block of north Arkansas Avenue in reference to occupants of a vehicle reporting another driver threatened to shoot them and a handgun was observed. Officer Barrios-Gomez confirmed the information with the occupants. The threats came after they refused to allow the man to merge while driving.

Officer Barrios-Gomez was able to review surveillance footage from a nearby convenience store and obtain the license plate of the suspect's vehicle. Officer Matthew Schmidt located the vehicle in the 3800 block of Atlantic Avenue. Officers Scarlata and Puca located the driver walking in the area. He was positively identified as the suspect and arrested. A loaded handgun was found in the vehicle and Suero was in possession of eight ecstasy pills.

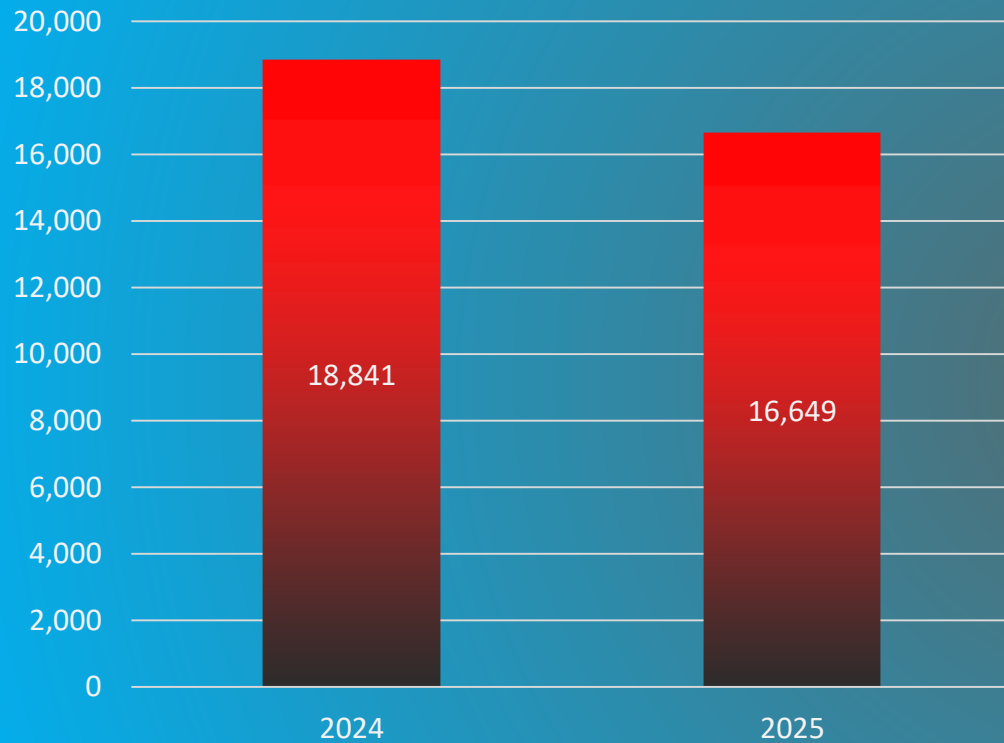
Acting on the information, the officers located the suspect at Sovereign and Arctic Avenues. He was placed in custody after being found in possession of a loaded handgun.

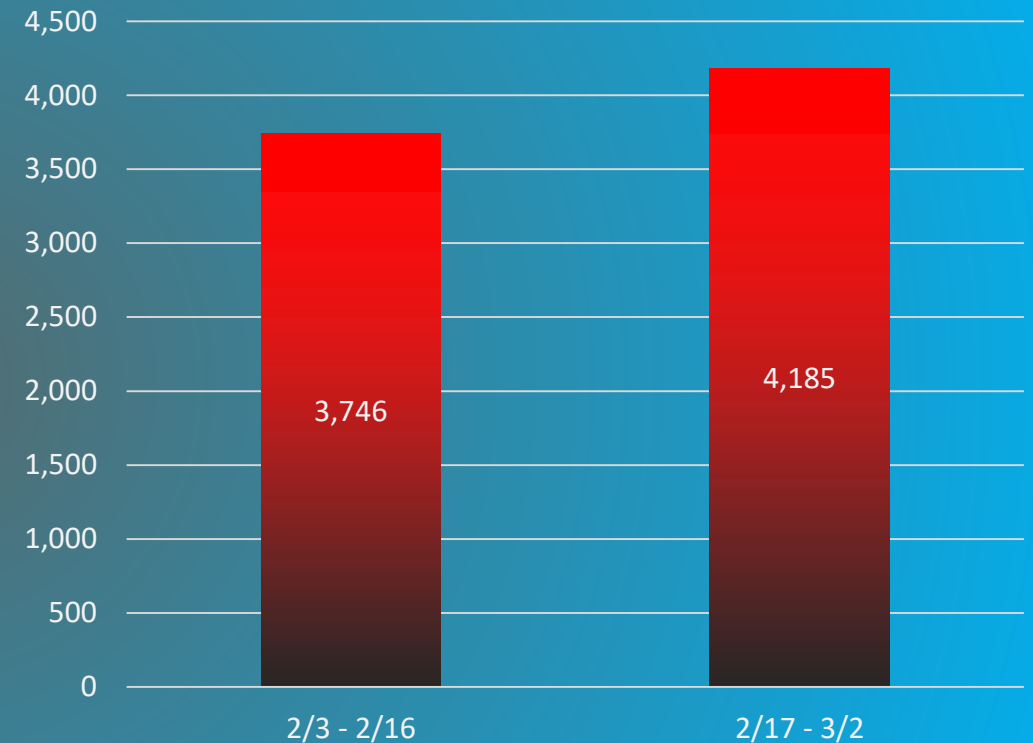
Calls for Service Overview

CFS (Year to Date Comparison)



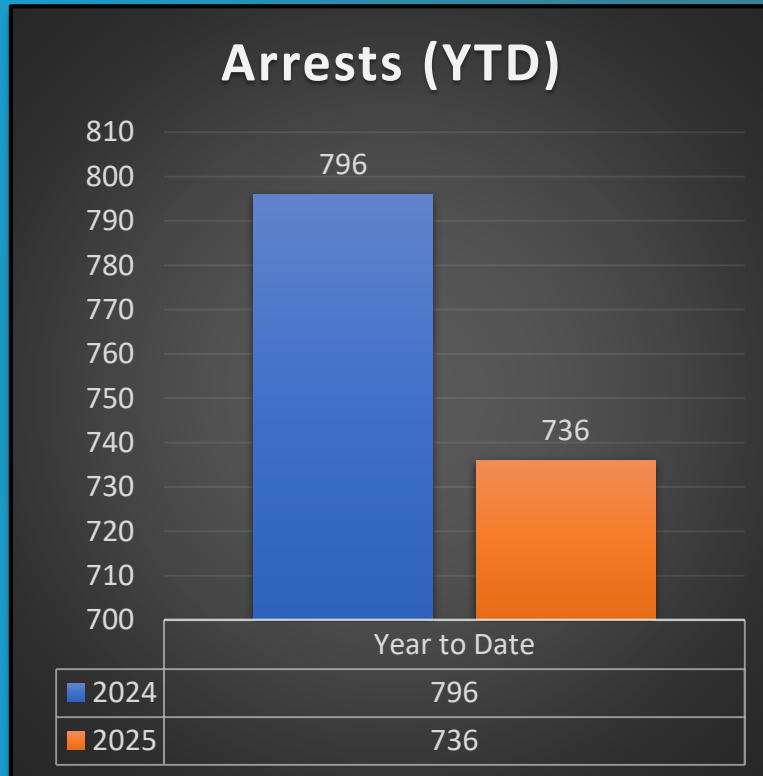
Calls for Service are down 11.6% in 2025 vs 2024 YTD

CFS (2 Week Comparison)

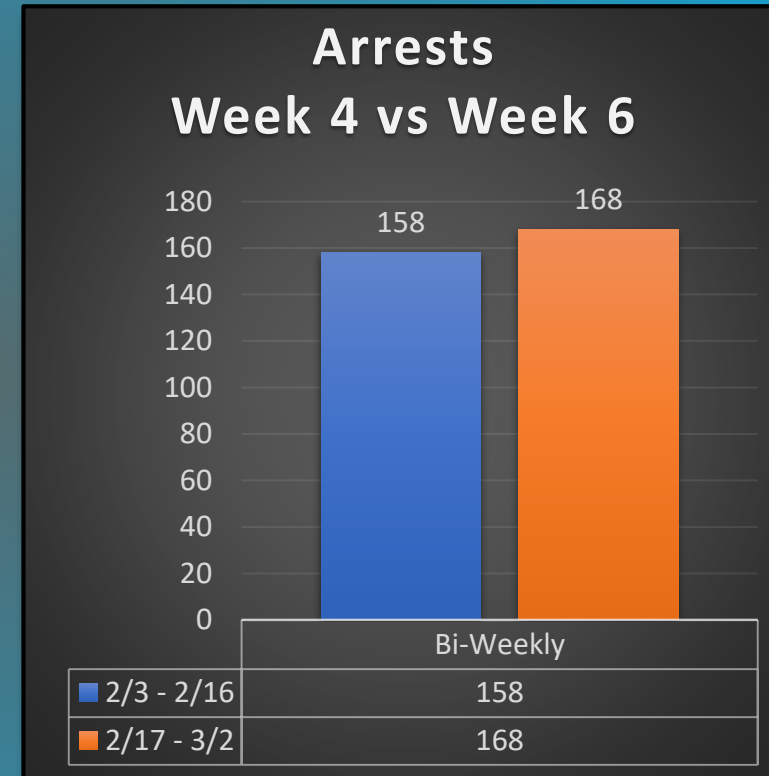


Calls for Service are up 11.8% from 2/3 - 2/16 vs 2/17 - 3/2

7.5% Decrease

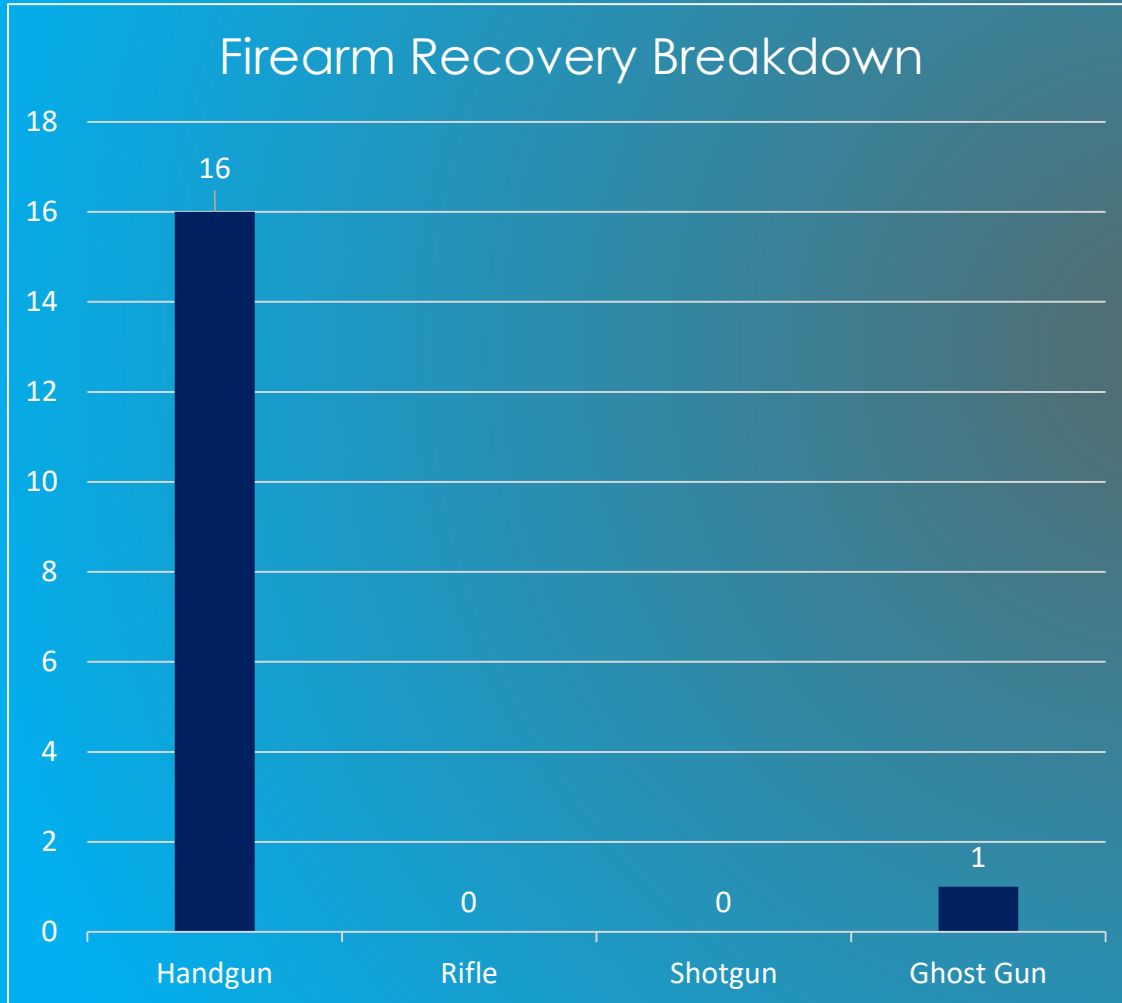

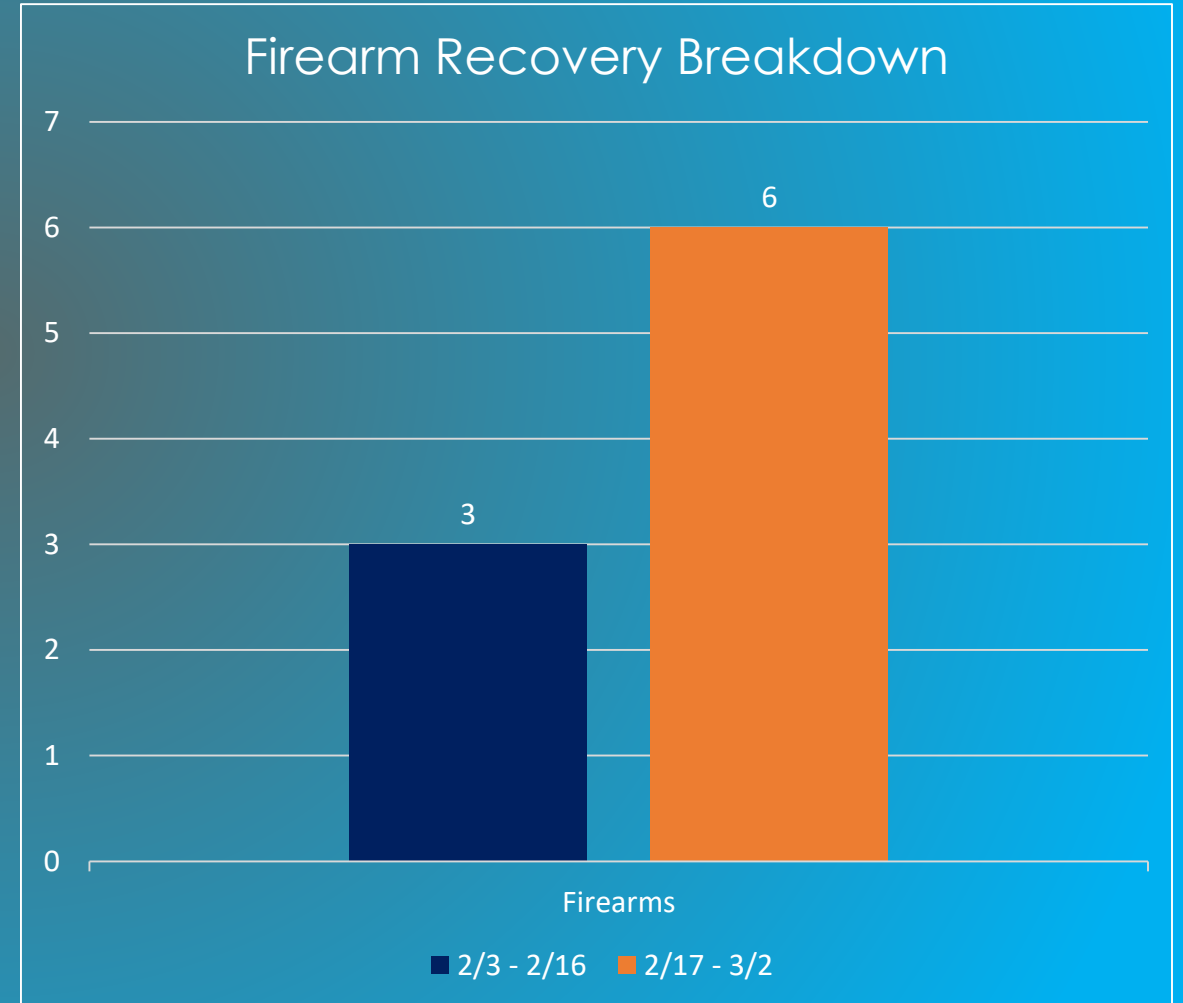
Firearms Recovery

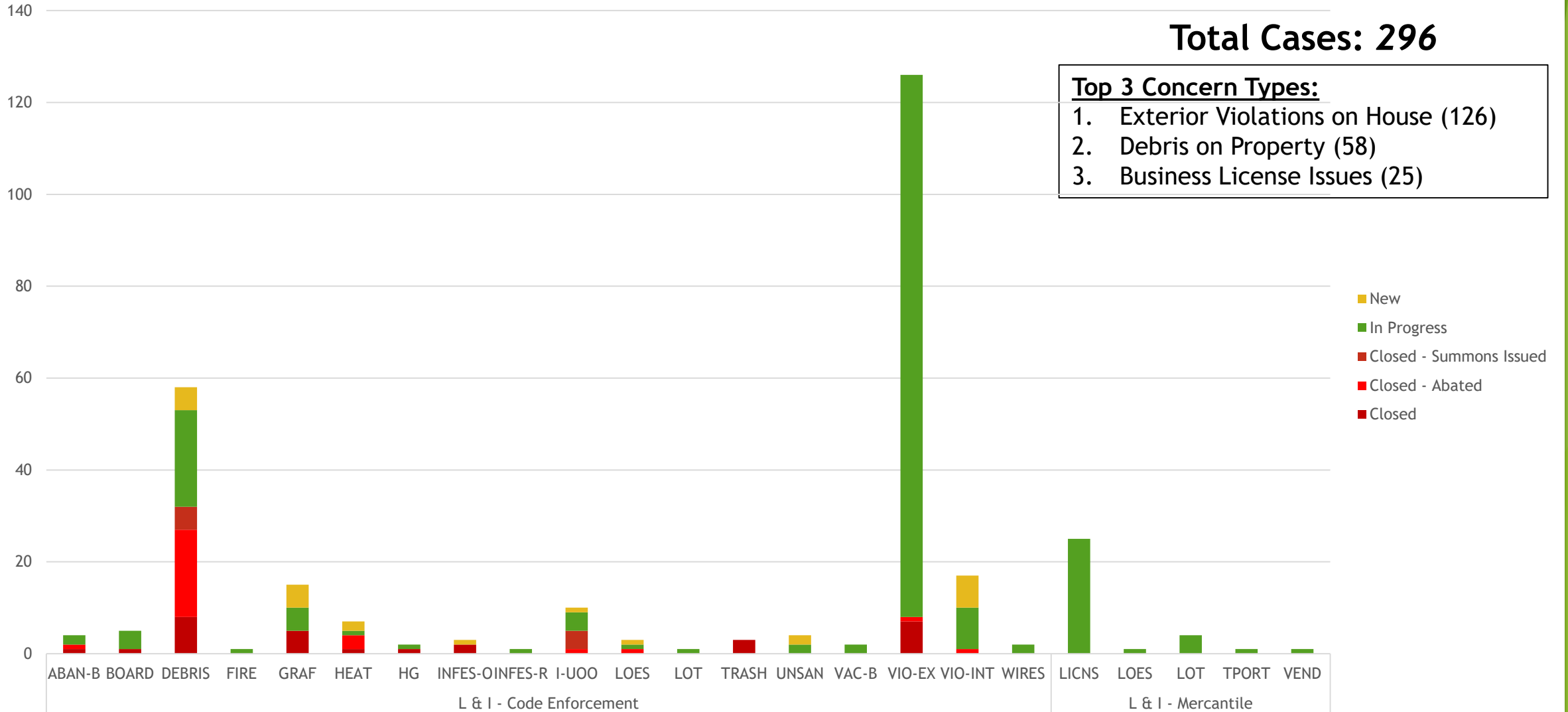

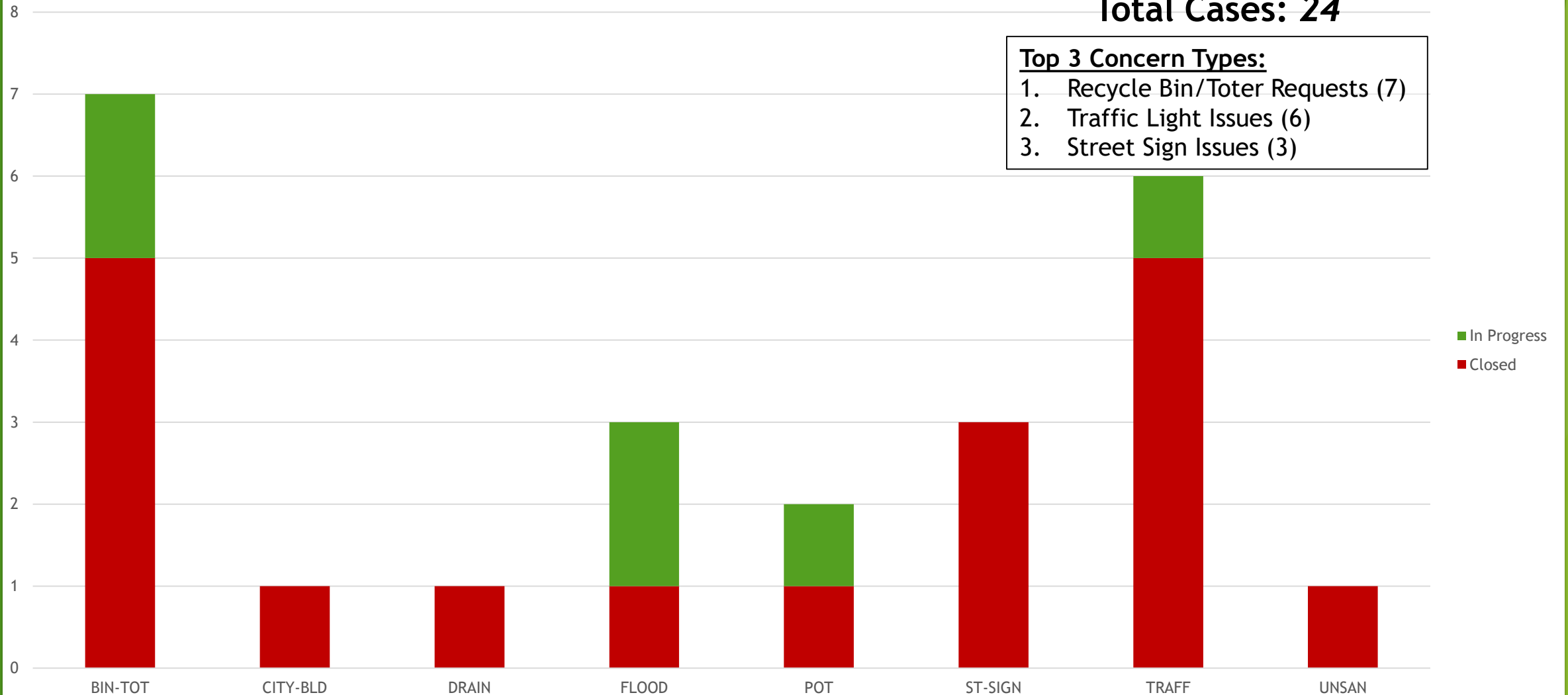
