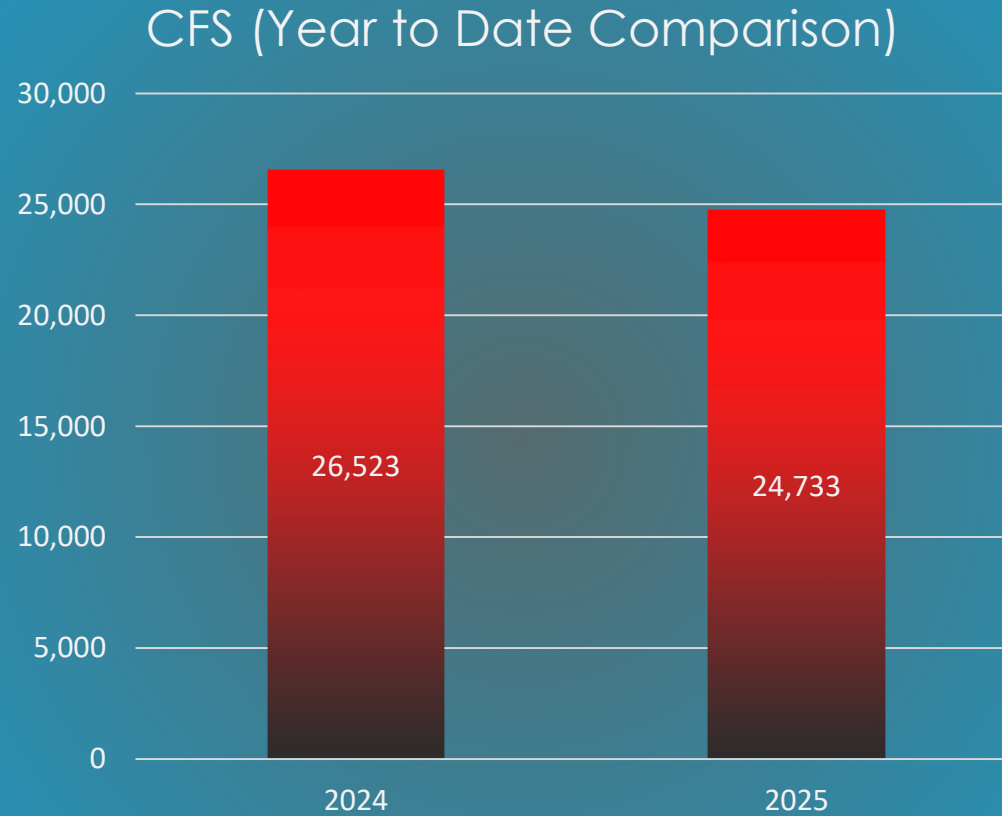

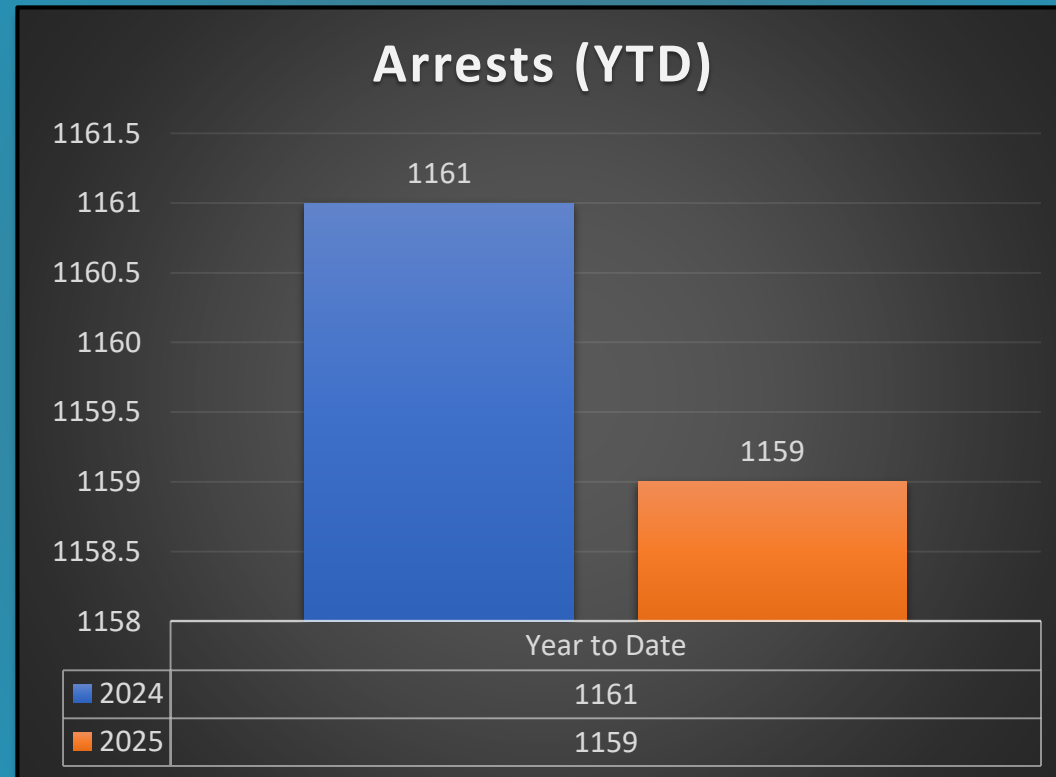

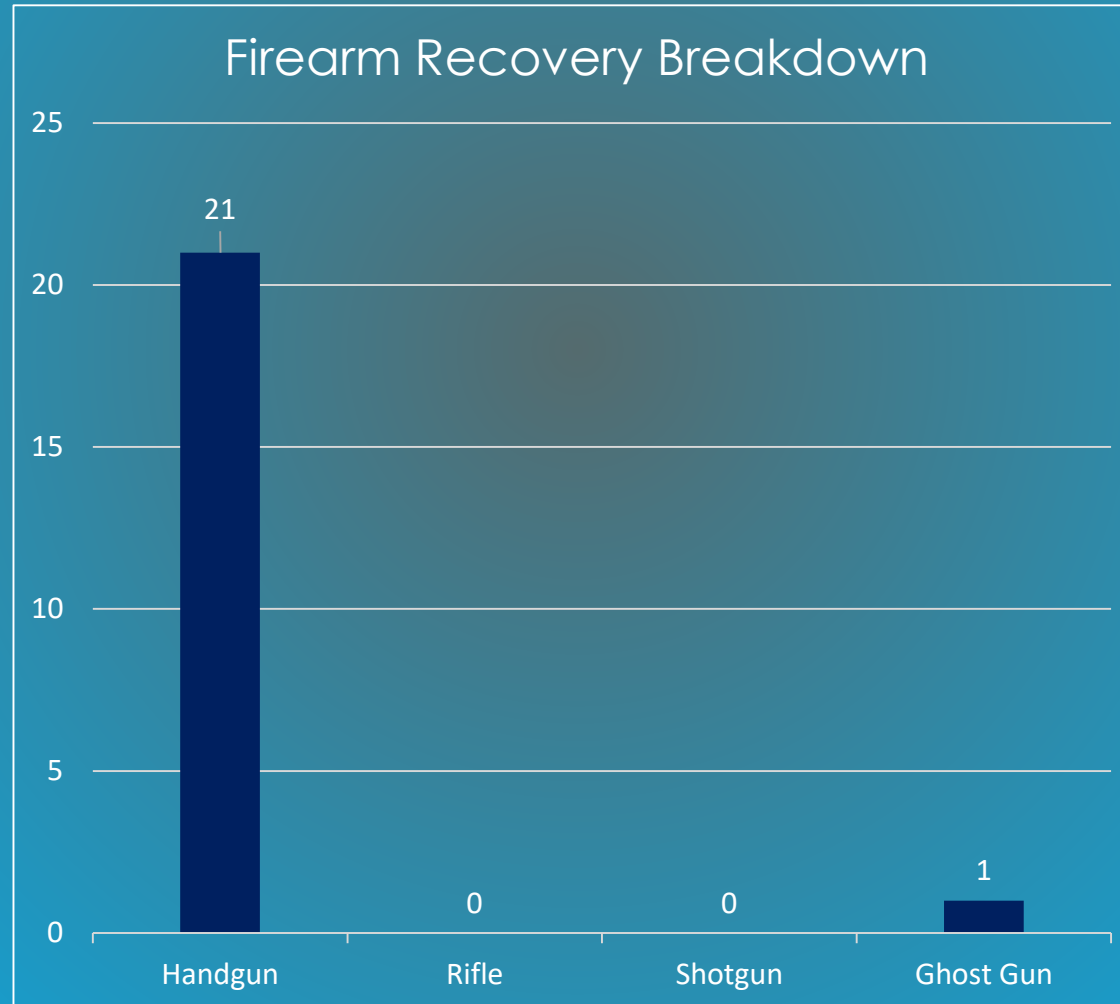
Arrests Overview



Firearms Recovery

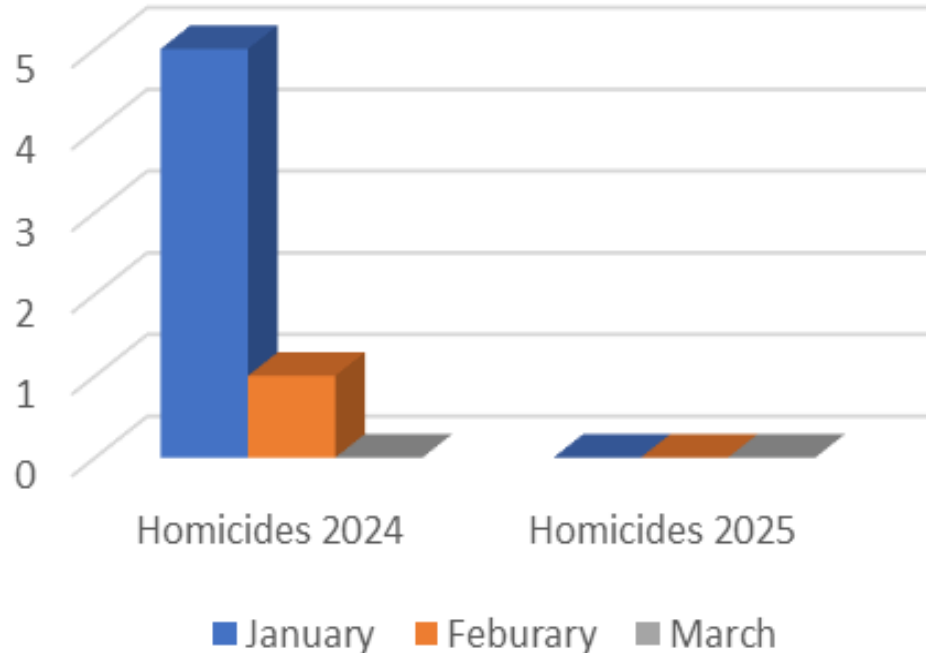

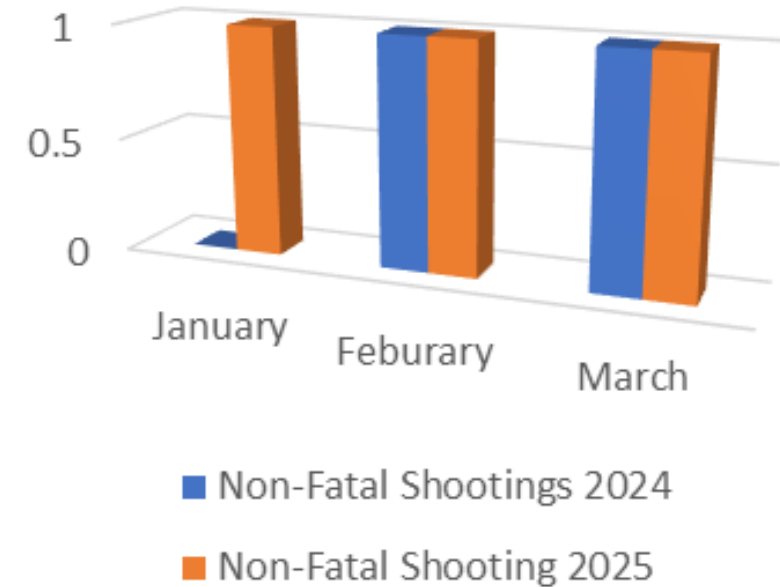


Homicides/Non-Fatal Shootings

In 2024, ACPD investigated eight total cases, whereas only three investigations have been reported so far in 2025—a 62.5% reduction. Notably, there have been no homicides in the first quarter of 2025, versus 6 in the first quarter of 2024. However, the department has investigated three non-fatal shooting incidents in 2025, compared to two in 2024.

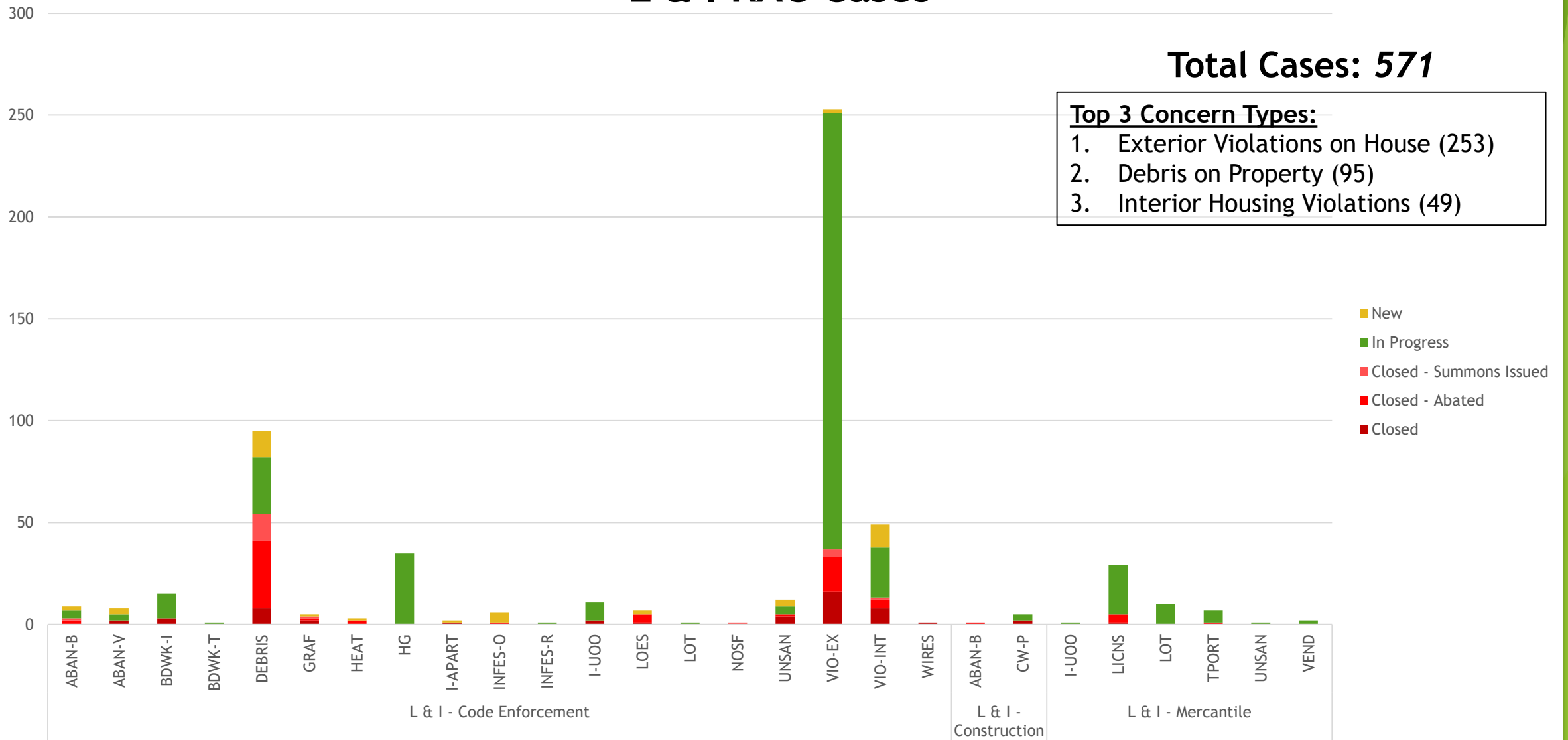

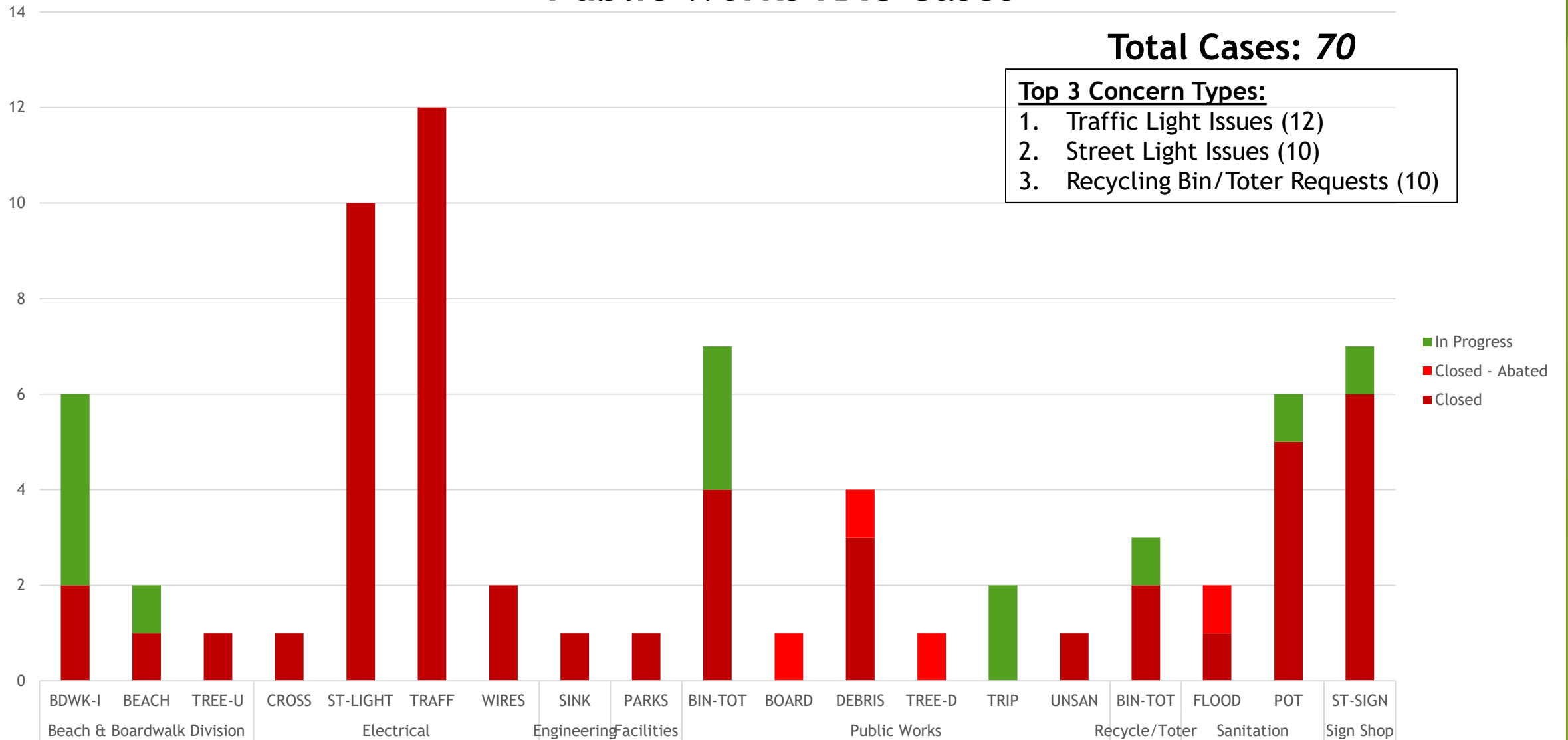
