**RECOGNITION ON A JOB WELL
DONE**

Detective Zayon Pitts (CIS) and Detective Aaron Jones (VCU)

On April 29, 2025, Detective Jones, assisted by members of the United States Marshals Service NY/NJ Regional Fugitive Task Force- Atlantic City Division, located a robbery suspect on Weymouth Avenue in Ventnor City, NJ. The suspect was taken into custody without incident.

The suspect was wanted following investigations by Detective Pitts into two armed robberies that occurred at a liquor store in the 3300 block of Atlantic Avenue on April 4th and 26th.

Following the suspect's arrest, detectives executed a court authorized search warrant at a residence on Weymouth Avenue. During the search, detectives recovered the handgun that was believed to be used during the incidents.

Alpha 2- Patrol and TDD, CIS, Communications, All

On May 5, 2025, detectives were alerted that a vehicle stolen following a homicide in Philadelphia, PA had passed by several automated license plate readers in Atlantic City. The description of the vehicle was broadcast to officers and within five minutes, Officers Jesse Oliver-Logan, Will Herrerias, and Jose Ruiz located the unoccupied vehicle.

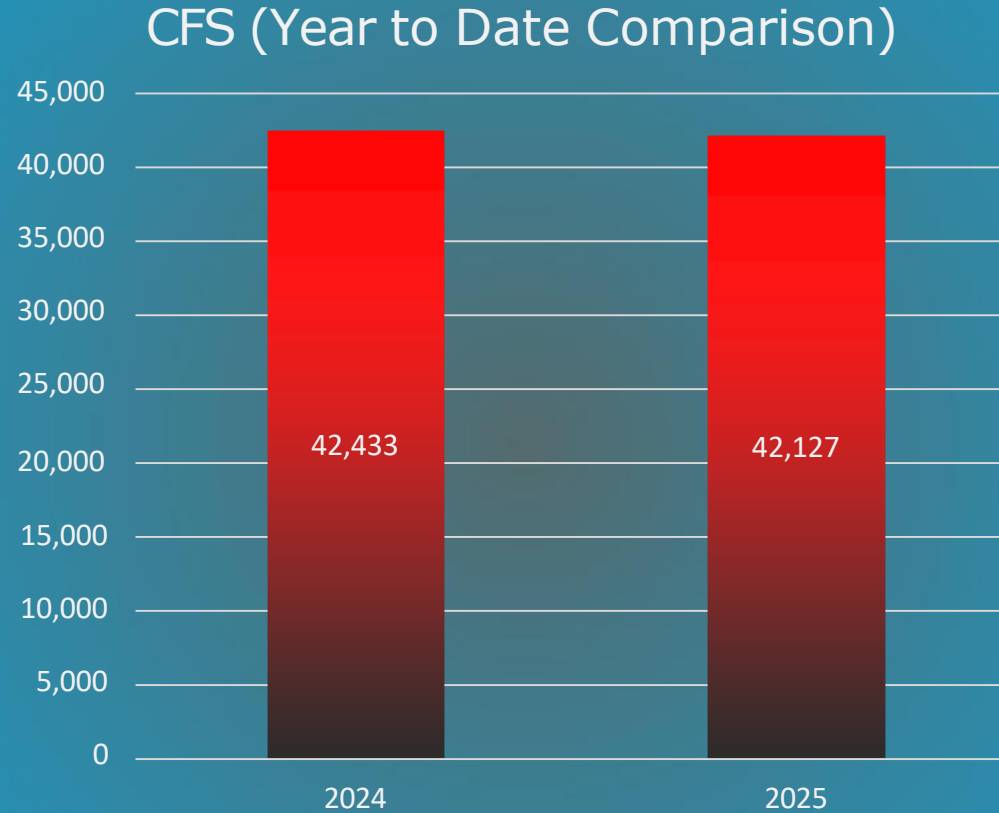
As the officers began to investigate, additional information was received that the homicide suspect was on the Boardwalk. Multiple officers flooded the area in search of the suspect. They were aided by the security staff from nearby casinos who assisted in reviewing surveillance from inside and outside their properties.

During the search, Officers Saroar Hossain and Juan Garcia located the suspect in the 1300 block of the Boardwalk and took him into custody without incident. He was found in possession of a loaded handgun. He was later charged with homicide and other related offenses in Philadelphia.

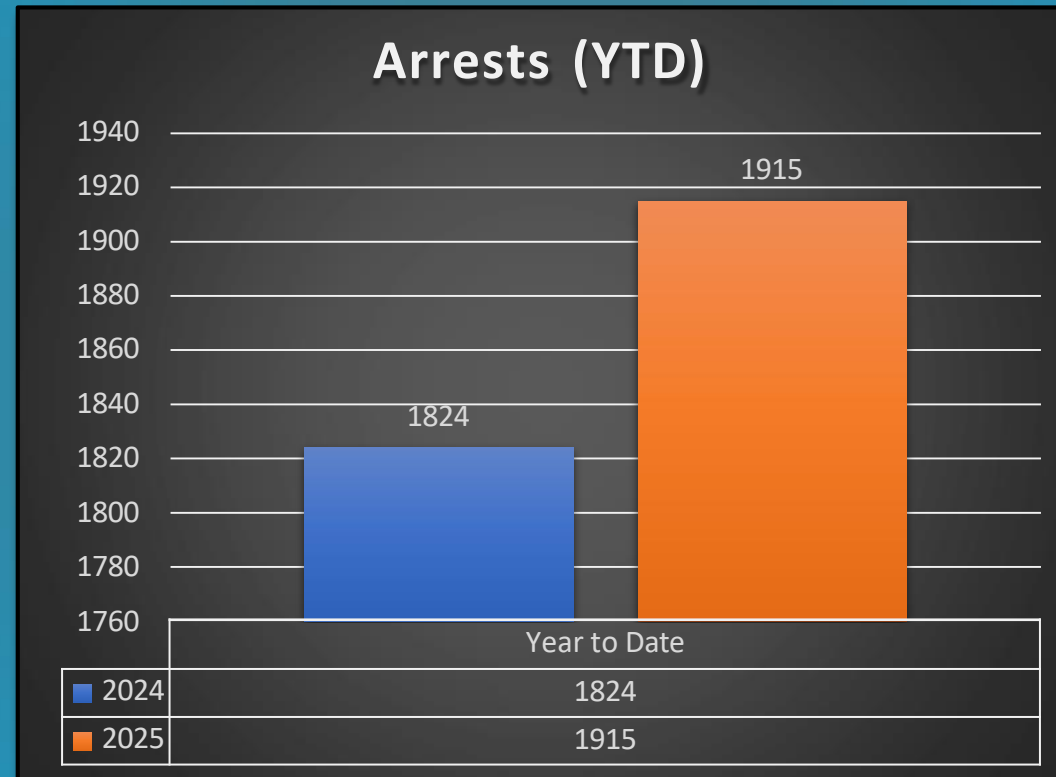
Calls for Service Overview

Projects

- The Citywide Surveillance Camera Project, which is about two-thirds complete, is expected to further enhance crime investigations, motor vehicle crash analysis, and officer safety by providing real-time data to officers responding to calls for service.
- Automated License Plate Readers are still being added and have become a great addition to the technology that is being used to assist in locating and arresting wanted individuals and aid in crime investigations.
- The Casino Reinvestment Development Authority (CRDA) has approved a \$3 million grant to fund additional patrols in the Tourism District. Starting April 1, 2025, and running through March 31, 2026, this funding will allow increases to police presence along the Boardwalk, Pacific Avenue, and Atlantic Avenue.
- Five new utility terrain vehicles (UTVs) were deployed, enabling officers to better navigate the beach and Boardwalk areas.

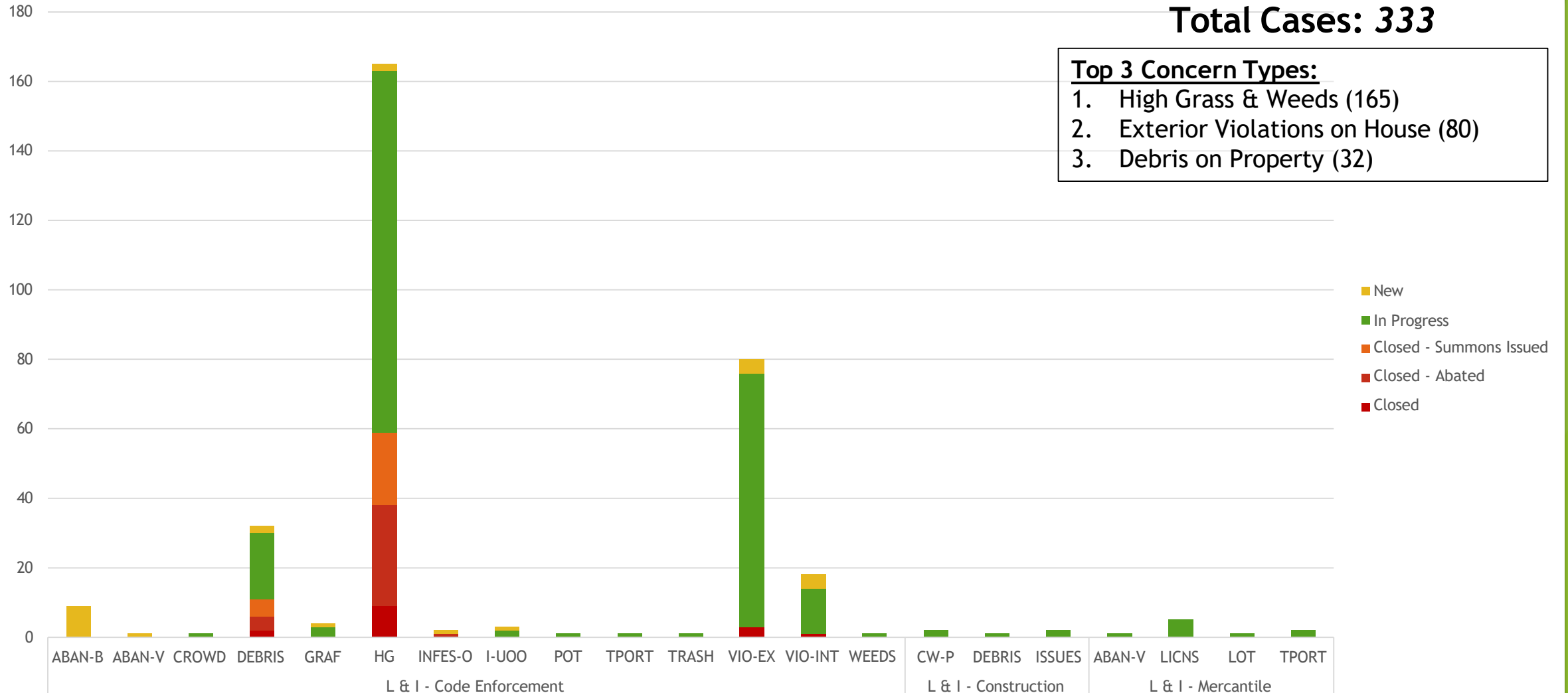

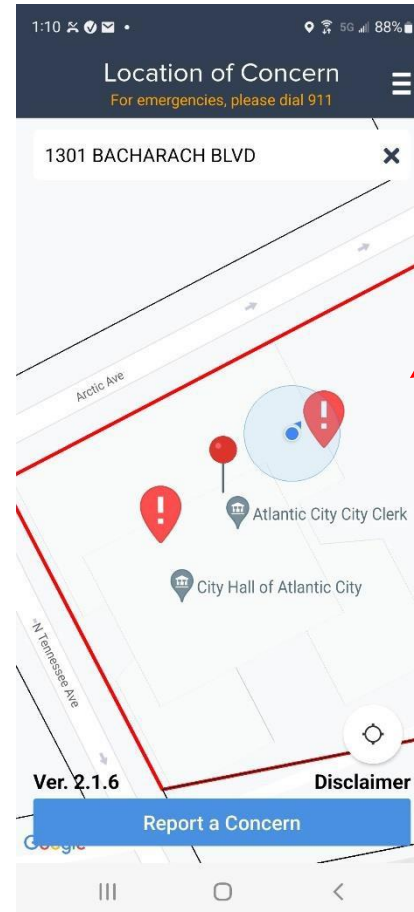

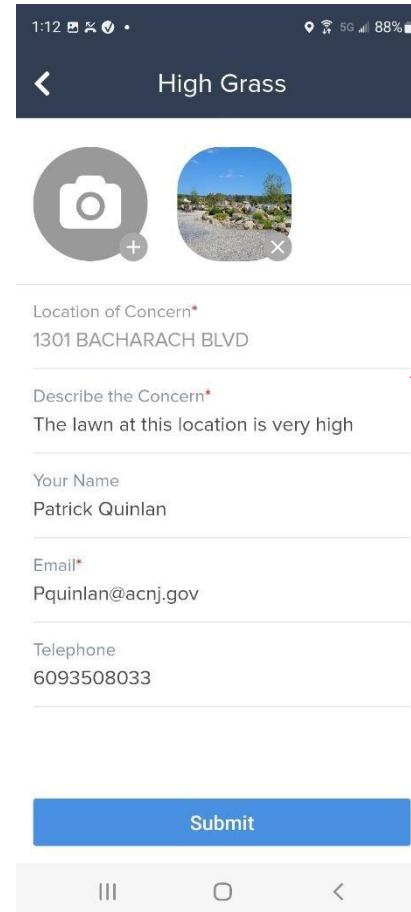
