# **Sergeant Jonathan Walsh and Officers Kyle Riordan, Kyle Bender, Aiden Richardson (Bravo 1 TDD & Patrol)**

On July 2, patrol officers responded to the area of Florida Avenue for a swimmer, 13, caught in a rip current being pulled away from the shoreline. Sergeant J. Walsh arrived and without hesitation recognized the urgency and quickly removed his police equipment and entered the ocean. He was assisted by Officers K. Riordan, K. Bender, and A. Richardson who also entered the ocean.

Sergeant Walsh swam to the juvenile and was able to secure him. He was closely followed by Officer Riordan who assisted in getting the juvenile back to shore where he was transported to the hospital.

All officers involved should be recognized for their rapid response in this event!

# Detective Moustafa Maarouf, Officers Julian Monsalve, Bayron Zelaya-Chavez & Ivaylo Penchev

On June 29, Detective Maarouf and Officer Monsalve were on assignment at El Charro Bar when they heard one shot fired north of their location. They were alerted to a male suspect with a gun driving on Turnpike Road. The officers approached the vehicle and ordered the suspect to stop, in which he refused to comply and drove towards police at a high rate of speed.

Two additional Officers, Penchev and Zelaya-Chavez, were in the area to assist with the situation in a marked patrol vehicle. The suspect continued traveling at a high rate of speed and crashed head on into the marked patrol vehicle, causing injuries to both officers. The suspect was then ordered out of the vehicle and taken into police custody. Officers Penchev and Zelaya-Chavez were treated on scene by EMS.

The contributions of all involved played a vital role in this incident and each person deserves recognition for their hard work!

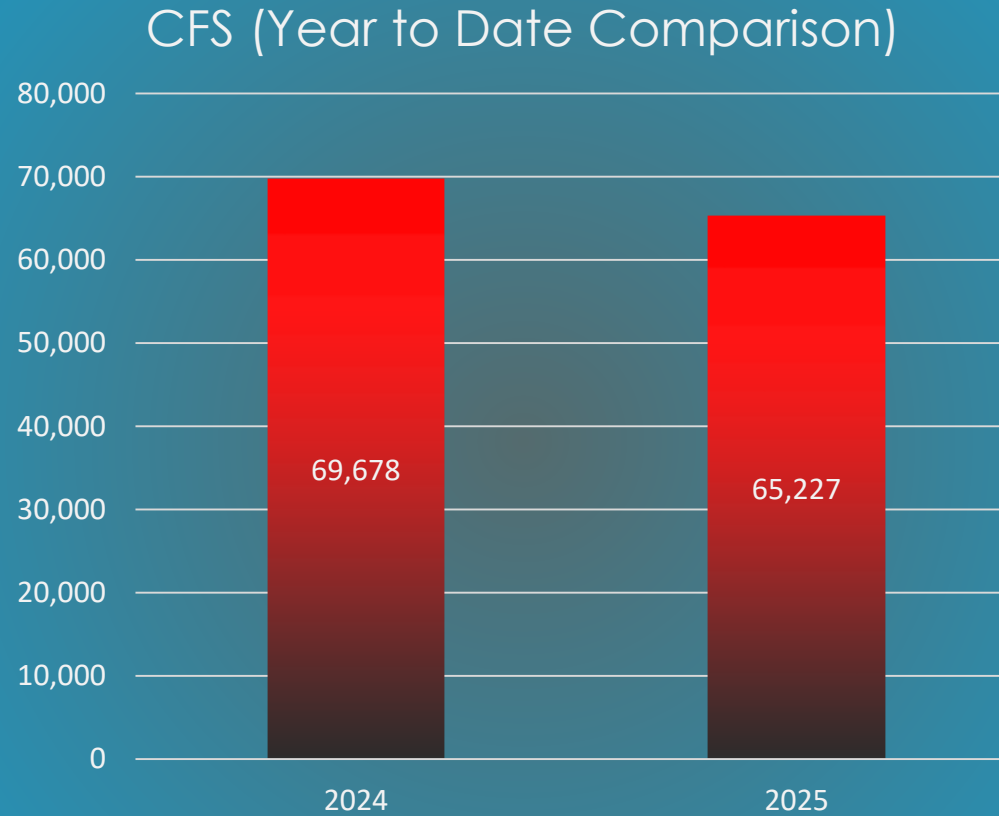

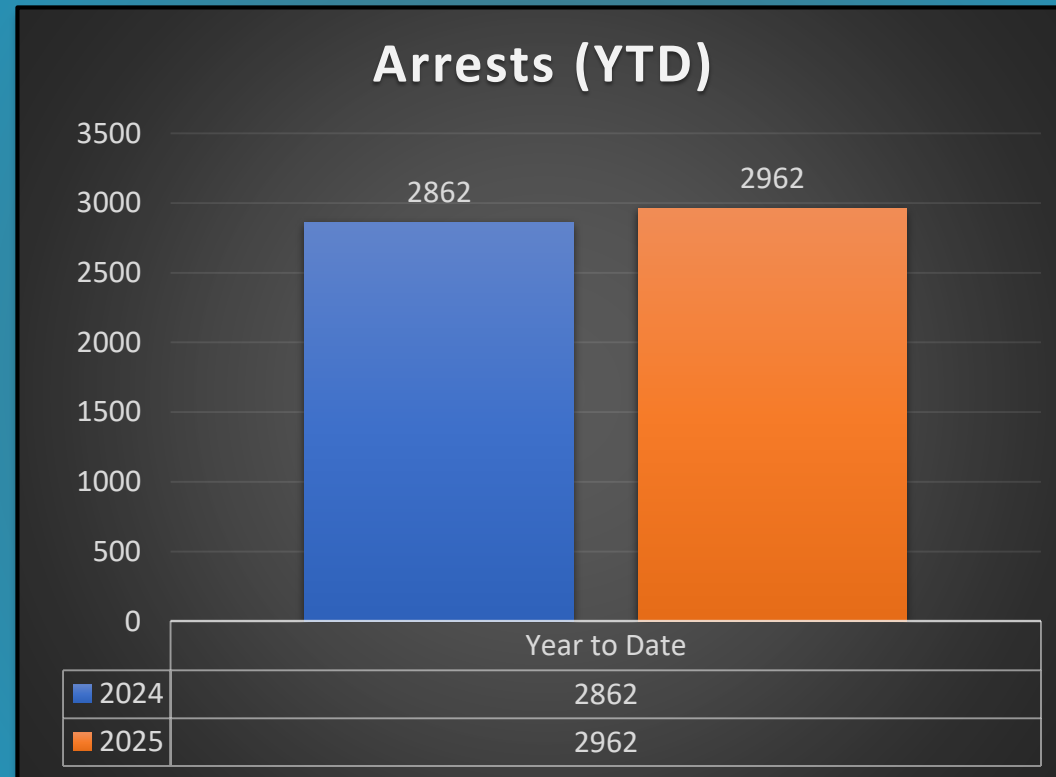
# Calls for Service Overview

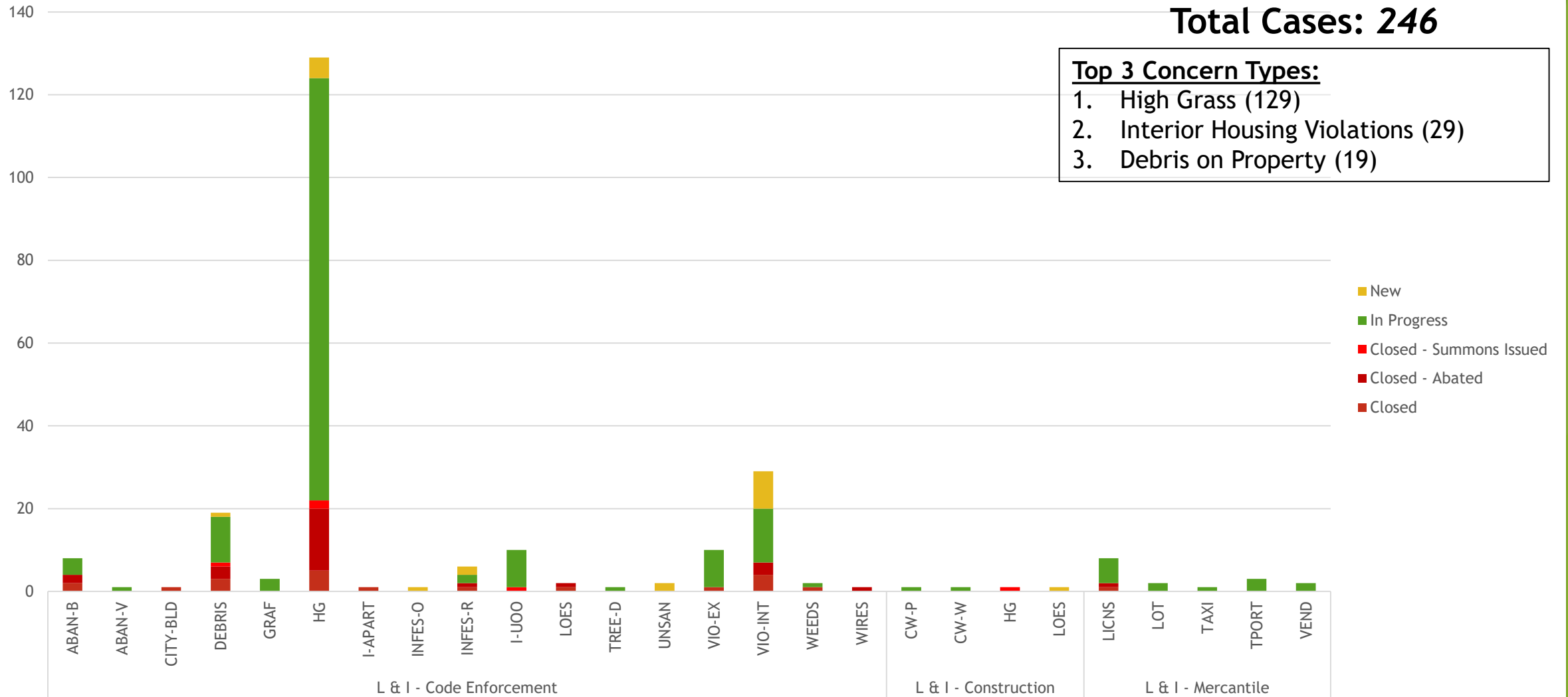

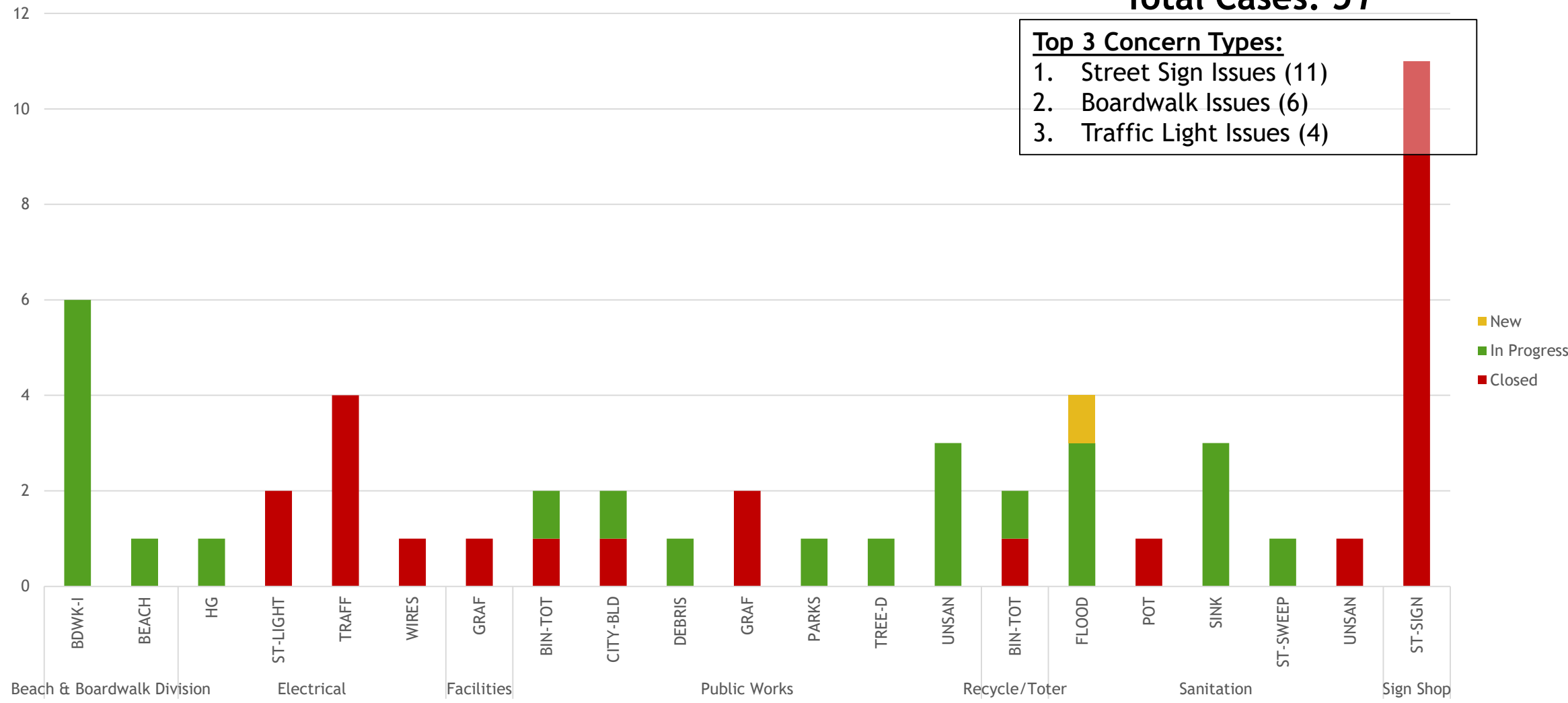

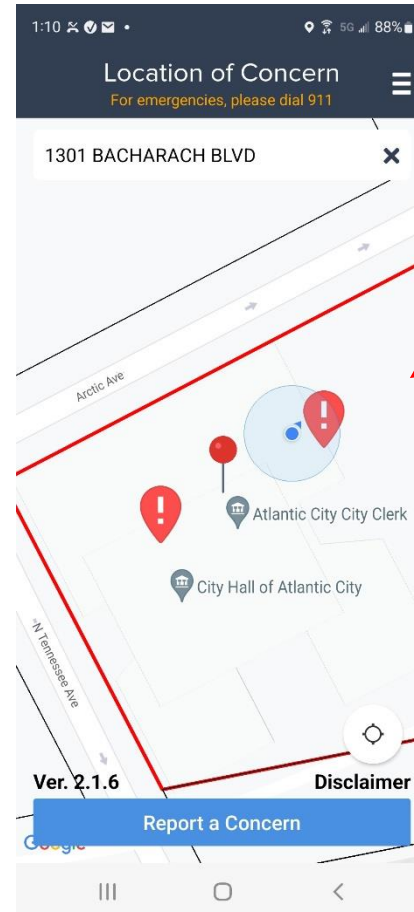

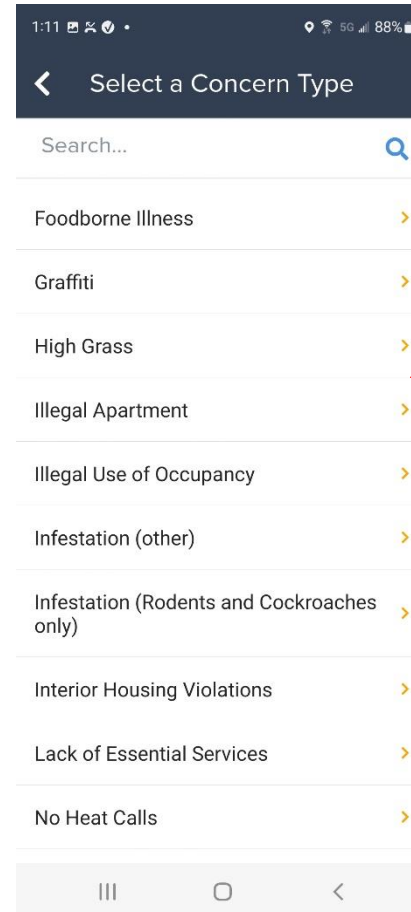

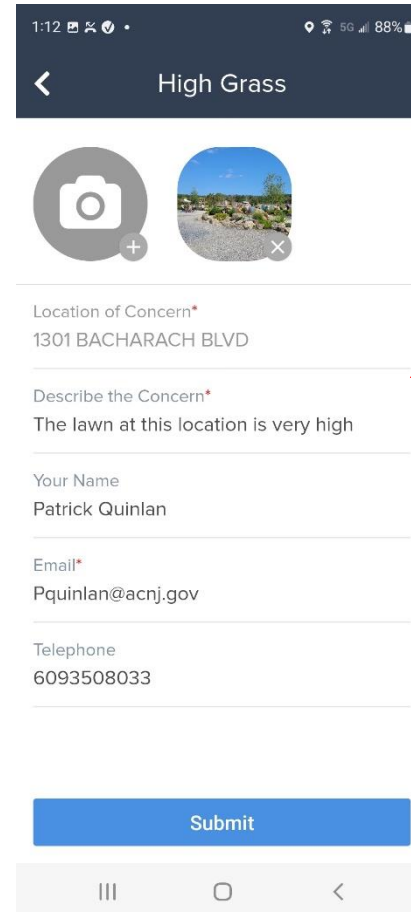
