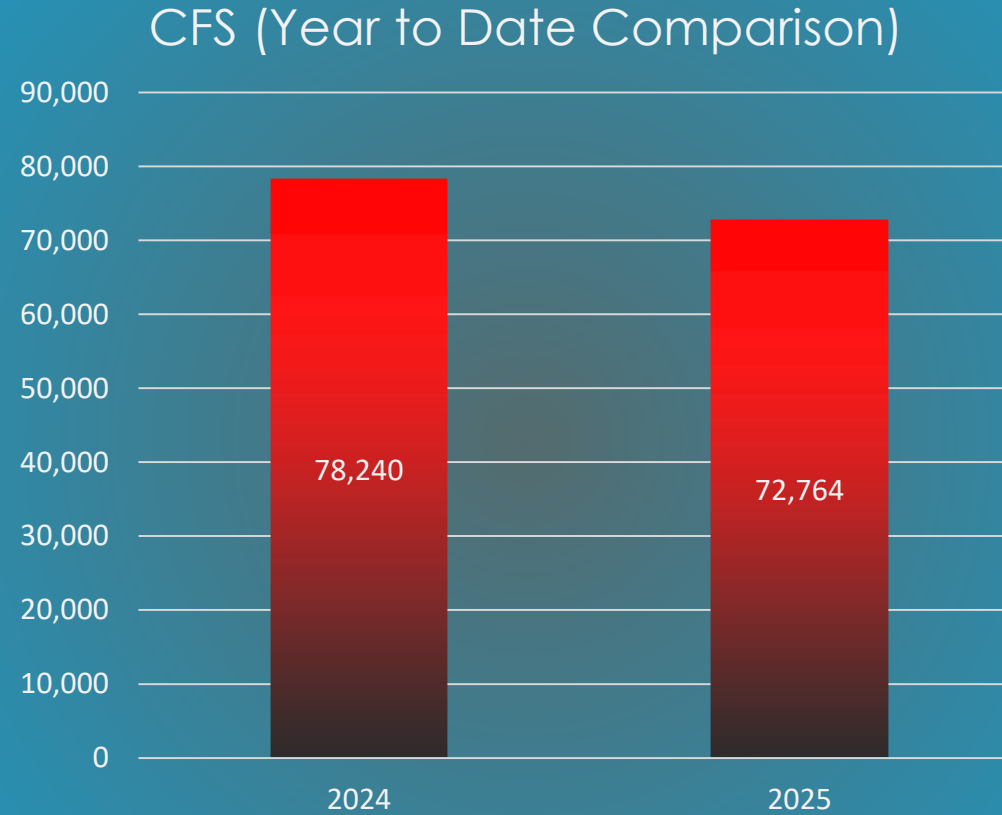
On July 29, 2025 a three-month collaborative effort between law enforcement agencies led to the simultaneous execution of three court authorized search warrants in Atlantic City, Pleasantville, and Mays Landing. The warrants targeted 3 suspects who were ultimately arrested. The three searches resulted in recovery of 7,605 individual bags of heroin, 902 fentanyl pills, more than five ounces of methamphetamine, three grams of cocaine, 123 suboxone films, a loaded handgun, and paraphernalia used in the distribution of narcotics.

The investigation was led by ACPD Detective Christopher Dodson with assistance from members of the DEA Liberty Mid-Atlantic High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area, New Jersey State Police, Atlantic County Prosecutor's Office, and Atlantic City Police Department's Special Investigations Section. The search warrants were executed by members of the Atlantic City Police Department's SWAT team and the Atlantic County SWAT Team.

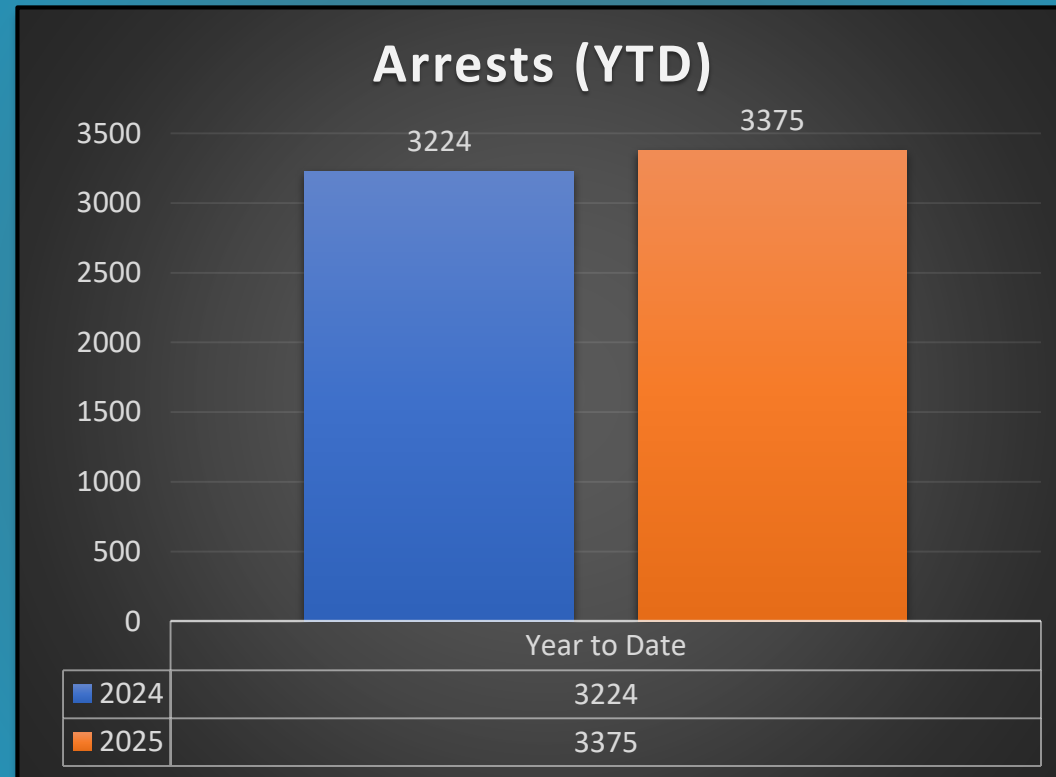
Calls for Service Overview

- **96.7%** of cases were responded to within 24 hours

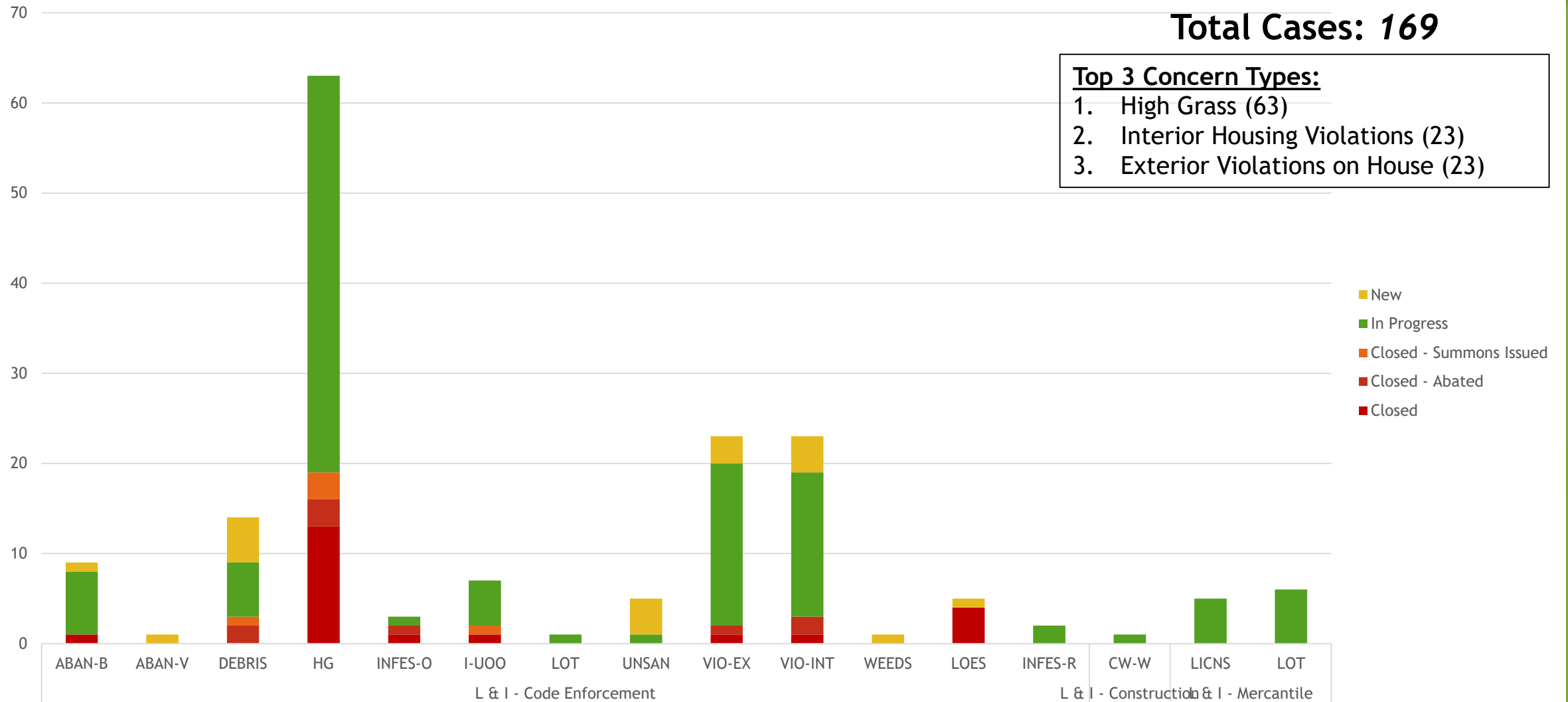
An additional **202** cases from prior periods were also closed for a total of **249** cases closed during this period

3. Exterior Violations on House (23)

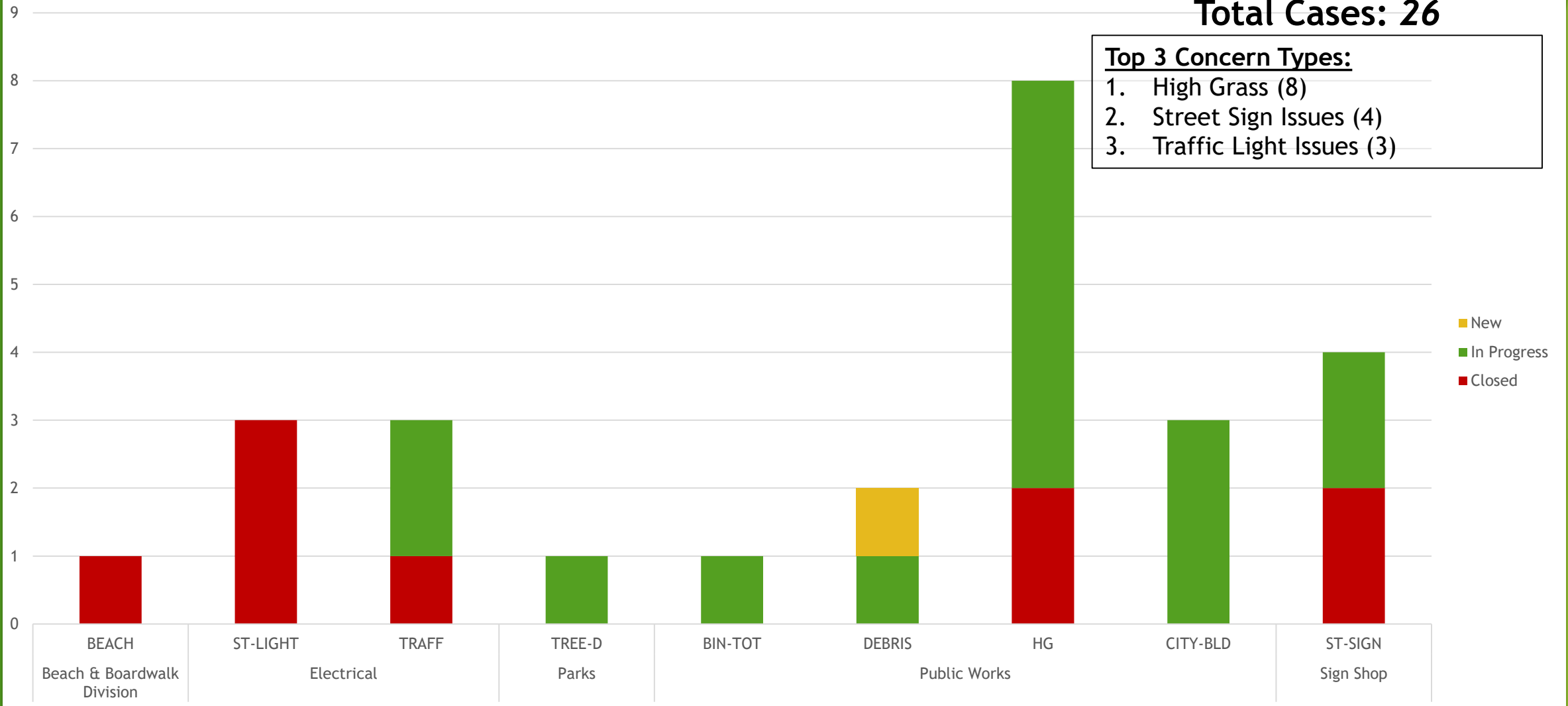


Public Works RAC Cases

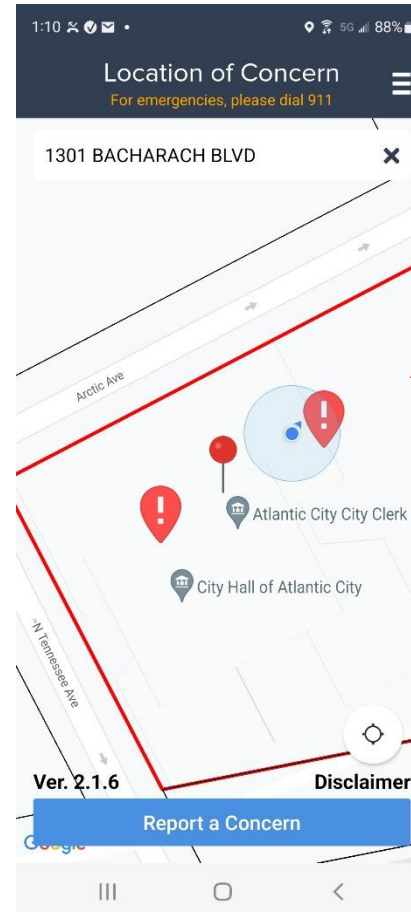

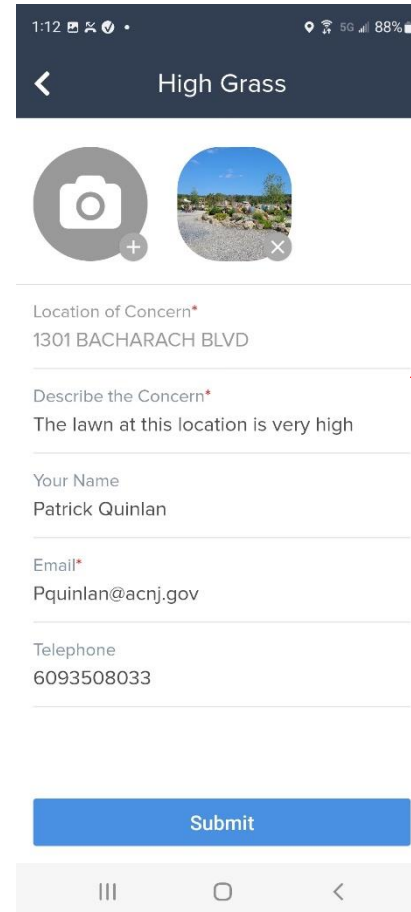
