Concern: Information regarding half-way houses allowed in neighborhoods



Response from Director Howard: As of July 16, 2025, the **Cooperative Sober Living Residences Ordinance/Ordinance No. 53-2025** was added to the Municipal Land Use Ordinance/Chapter 163/**§163-66.1 Cooperative Sober Living Residences**.

Purpose:

The Department of Community Affairs within the State of New Jersey has established a framework of licensing requirements and regulations governing the establishment and operations of Cooperative Sober Living Residences. The purpose of this section is to define, permit and regulate the occupancy of such Cooperative Sober Living Residences consistent with both the requirements set forth by the Department of Community Affairs and the City's Zoning and Land Use requirements.

Authorization:

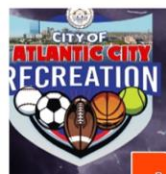
Subject to the standards hereinafter established and subject to the issuance of a Certificate of Land Use Compliance as hereinafter required, Cooperative Sober Living Residences **may occupy dwelling units within the City and are permitted in any zoning district where residential uses are permitted**. No cooperative sober living residence may commence operations until such time as it obtains a Certificate of Land Use Compliance from the Land Use Administrator, and obtains a **Class F** License from the Department of Community Affairs pursuant to Subsection D.

All Cooperative Sober Living Residences shall comply with all requirements and regulations set forth by and established by the Department of Community Affairs, including all conditions for the **Class F License** issued. Any violations of such requirements or regulations shall constitute a Zoning Violation enforceable by the City.

Certificate of Land Use Compliance required:

Any prospective applicant for a Class F license from the Department of Community Affairs to operate a cooperative sober living residence may obtain a certificate of land use compliance from the City prior to receiving a Class F license to include in its application. A certificate of land use compliance shall not be issued unless the prospective applicant can demonstrate that it will meet the requirements set forth in the governing regulations of the Department of Community Affairs.

No later than **20 days after receipt of its Class F License** from the Department of Community Affairs, the Cooperative Sober Living Facility shall provide a copy of the Class F license to the Land Use Administrator.

**RECOGNITION ON A JOB WELL
DONE**

Bravo 2 Patrol & VCU (Commanded by Lt. Howard Johnson & Sgt. Innocenzo Visceglia)

On August 10, patrol officers responded to a ShotSpotter alert on South Bellevue Avenue and discovered a single shell casing without a victim present. Footage captured by the AC Surveillance Unit played an essential role in identifying the vehicle, license plate, and suspect descriptions of those involved. Officer C. Campbell was able to supply real time location tracking of the vehicle utilizing the LPR system, which was ultimately located by patrol officers unoccupied. Shortly after disseminating this information to the department, patrol officers were able to locate three of the four occupants of the vehicle involved, while the suspected shooter remained at large.

During execution of a court authorized search warrant of the involved vehicle, VCU detectives located narcotics, jewelry and the suspect's belongings. Further investigation by detectives revealed that the vehicle was registered out of Allentown, PA. Detectives contacted Allentown PD who were able to provide still captured images of a male who closely resembled the suspect through bodycam of a recent officer interaction. This combination of information confirmed the suspect's identity.

As a result of the thorough investigation, charges were approved by the Chief Assistant Prosecutor, and the suspect was placed into NCIC as a wanted person with full extradition.

Alpha 2 Patrol, Bravo 2 Patrol & Criminal Investigations (Commanded by Lt. Jody Hersh, Lt. Howard Johnson & Lt. Michael Garofalo)

On August 19, patrol officers responded to a vehicle burglary at the Claridge self-park garage. Surveillance captured two suspects breaking through the rear window of a pickup truck and leaving with a large black gun case containing a rifle and ammunition.

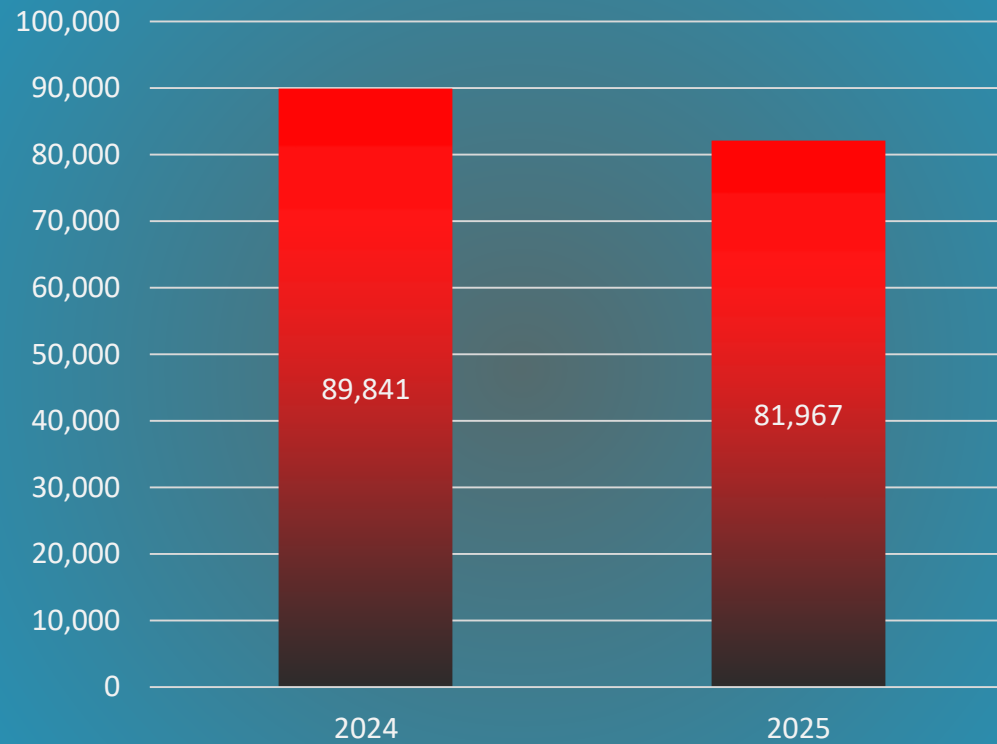
Using multiple surveillance cameras, detectives began to review surveillance coverage from multiple cameras leading to attempt-to-locate flyers containing the images and descriptions of the suspects. One suspect was quickly recognized and apprehended. Detectives obtained information on the whereabouts of the rifle which led to the execution of a court authorized search warrant at a residence. The rifle was located. Ultimately, three individuals were arrested for their involvement in this burglary.

Calls for Service Overview

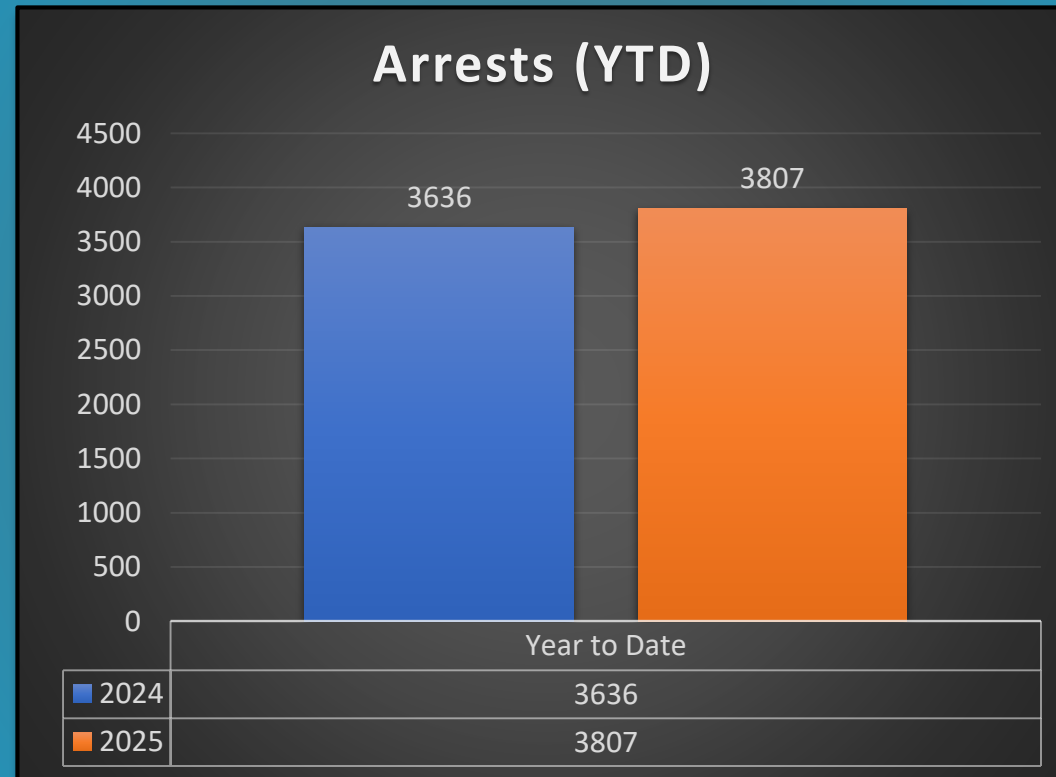

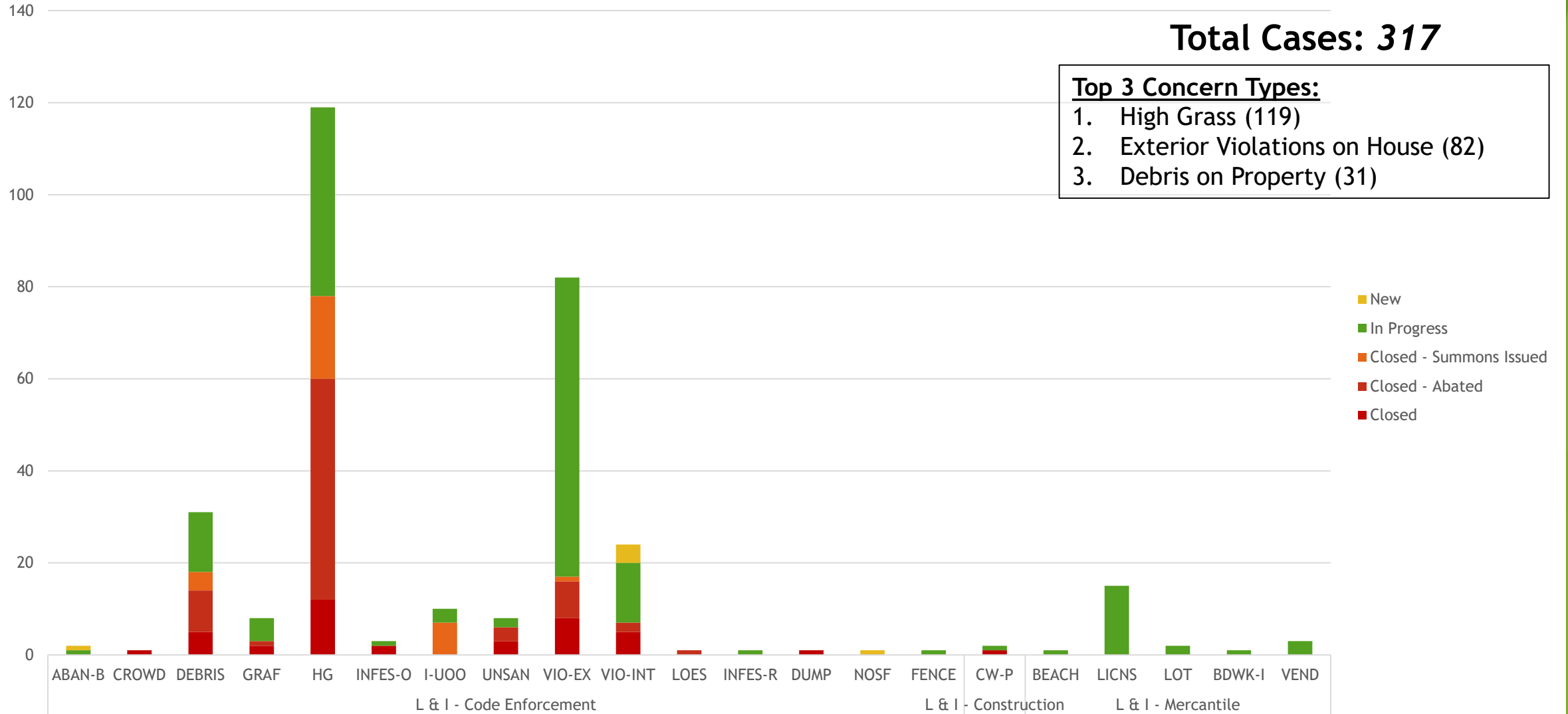
