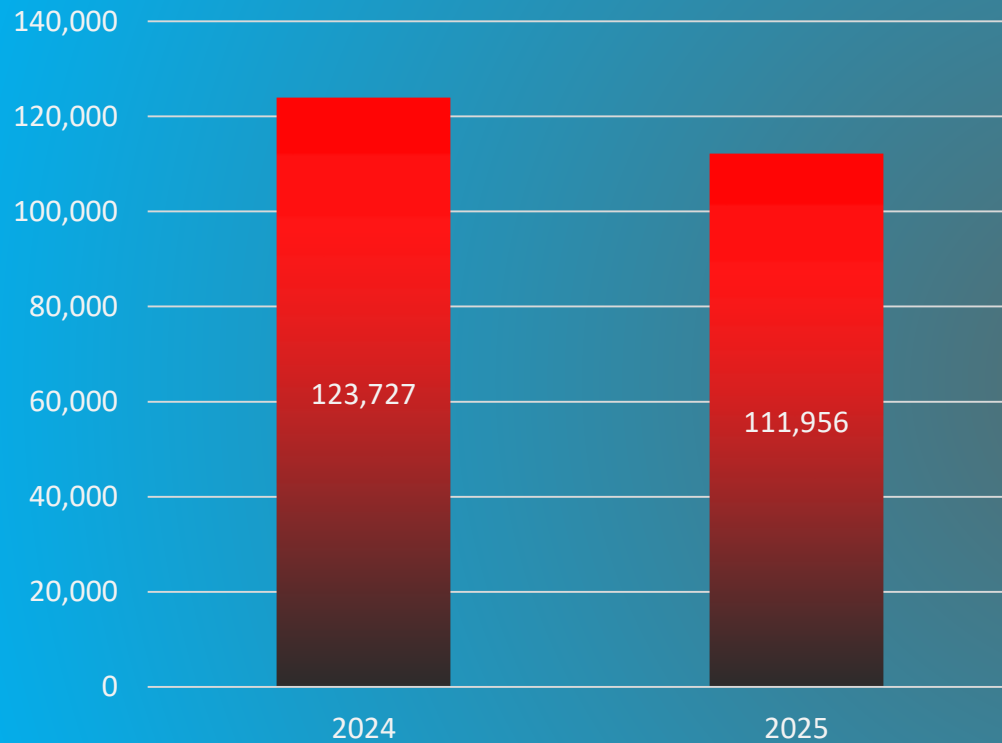

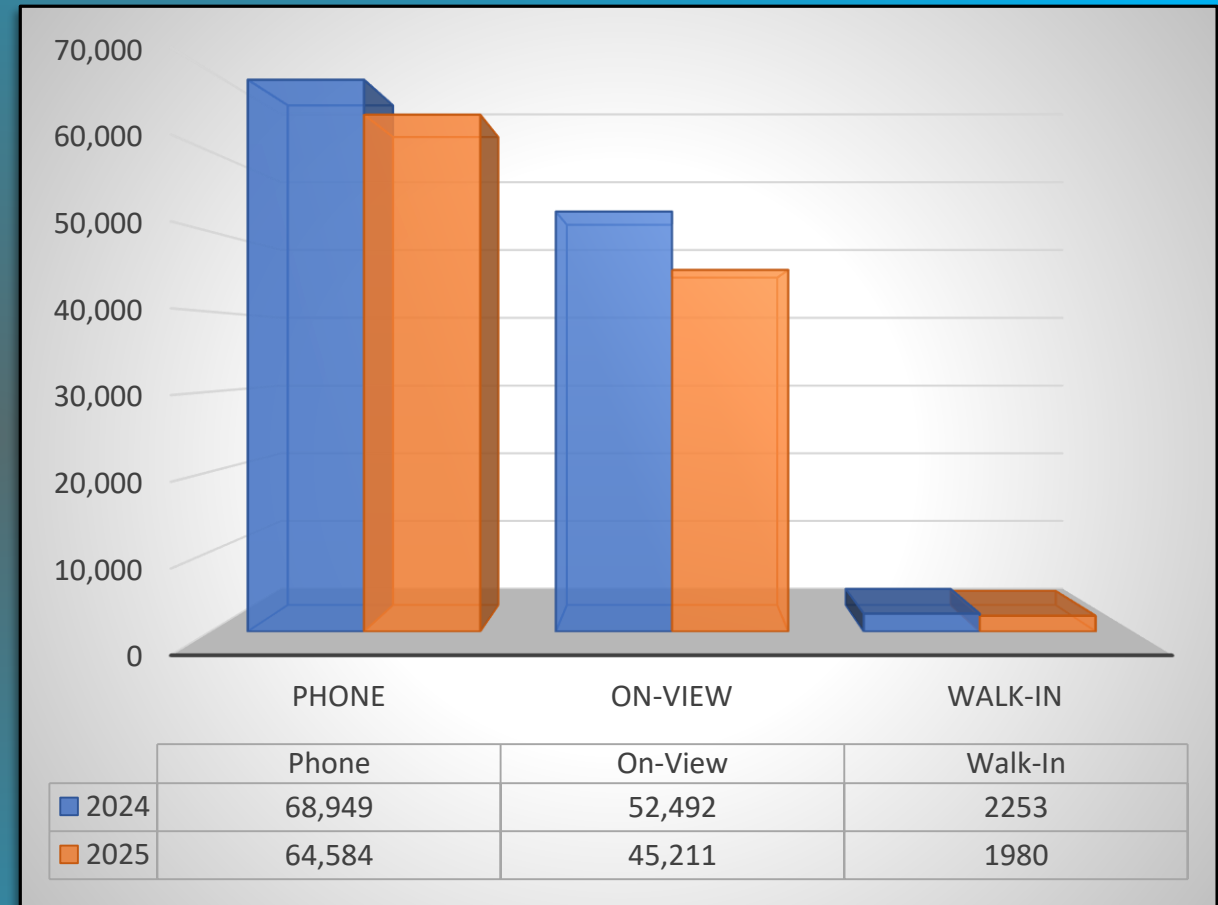

Calls for Service

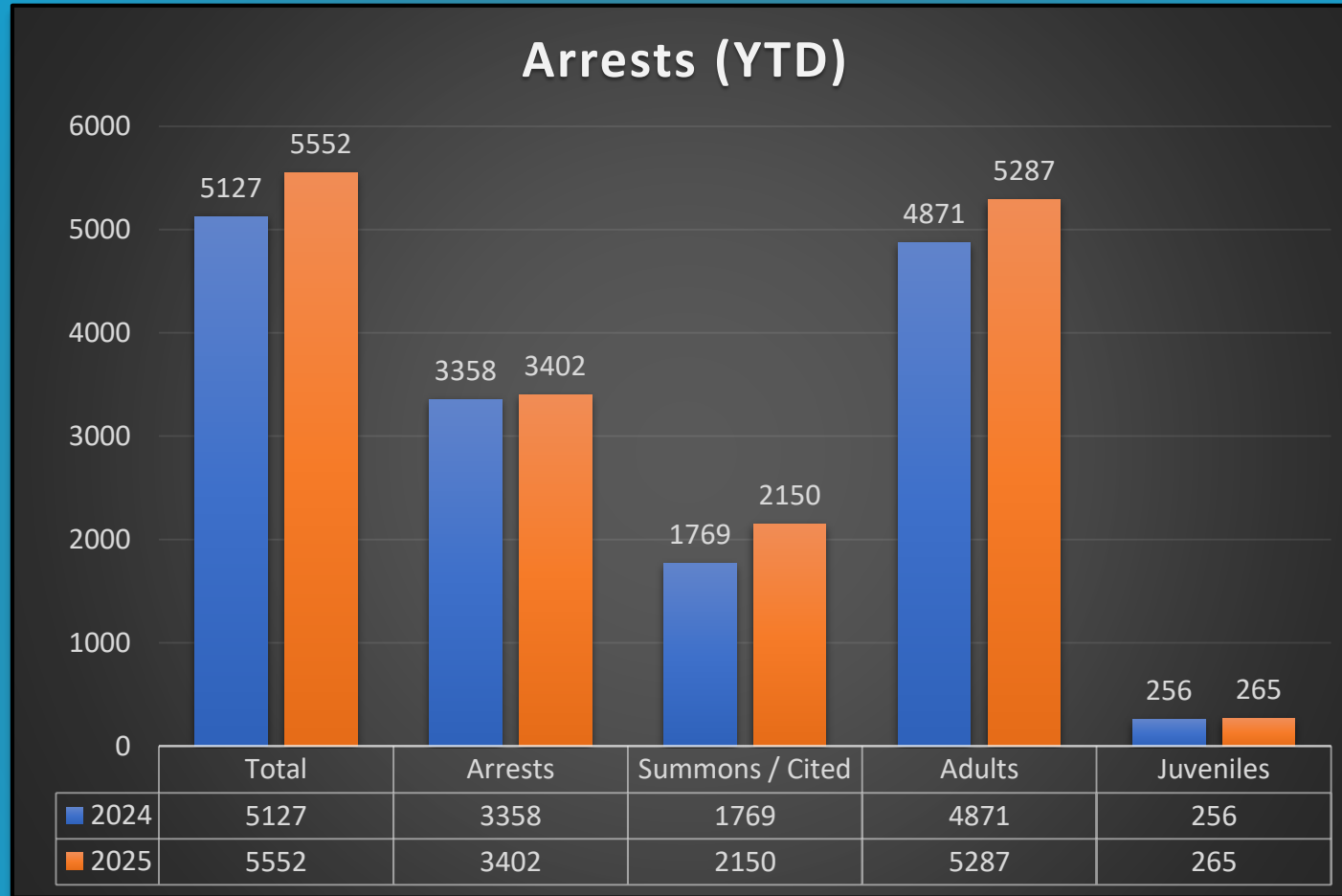
CFS (Year to Date Comparison)

The below is calls for service beginning at 8:00 PM on December 31 and ending at 8:00 AM on January 1.

- 172 calls for service over the 12-hour period. This equals more than 14 calls per hour.
- 23 arrests for a variety of offenses including possession of CDS, assault, and disorderly conduct.
- Five of the arrests were for DWI.
- Four fixed posts the entire period- three hospital watches and one Code Blue watch at the Rescue Mission.
- Bravo Patrol shift officers held over to assist.

- **94.2%** of cases were responded to within 24 hours

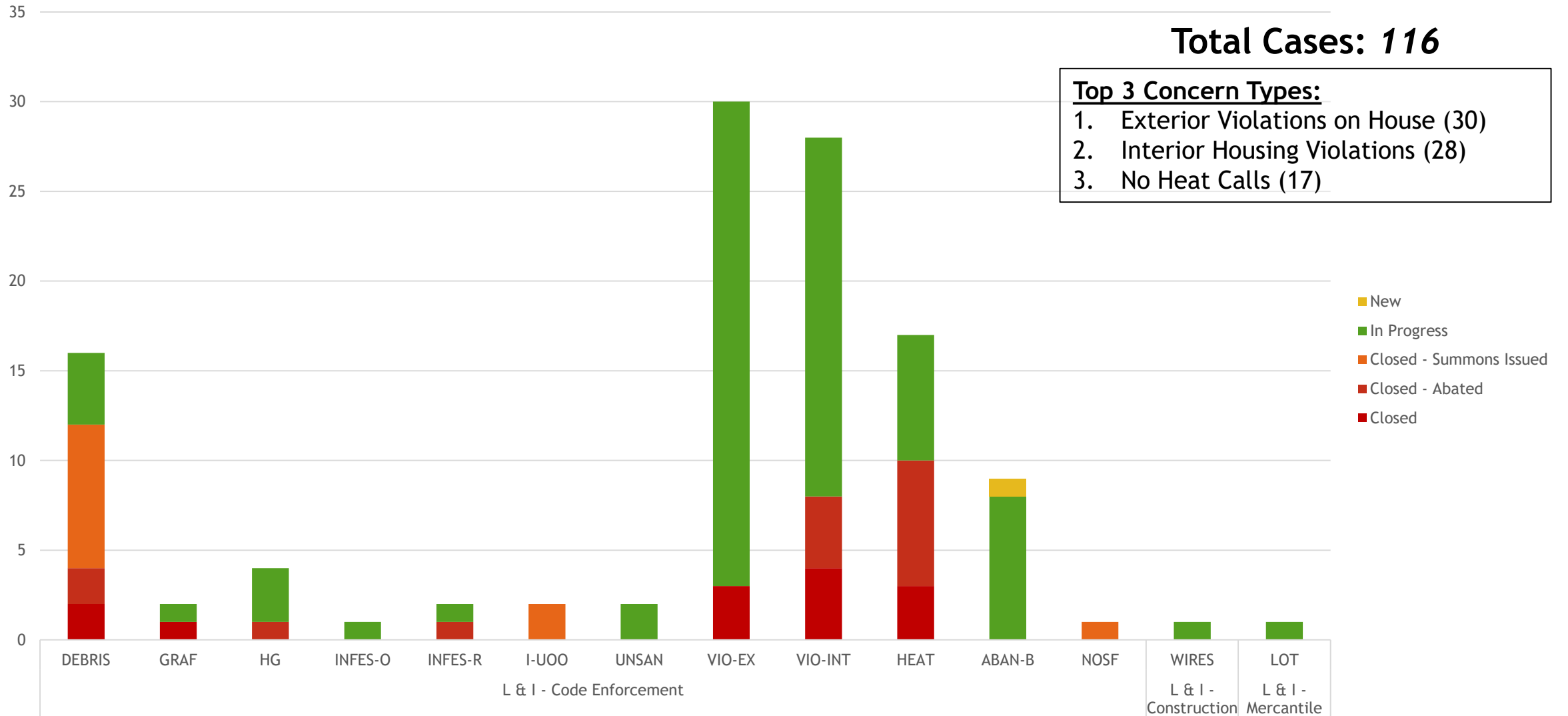
An additional **80** cases from prior periods were also closed for a total of **121** cases closed during this period

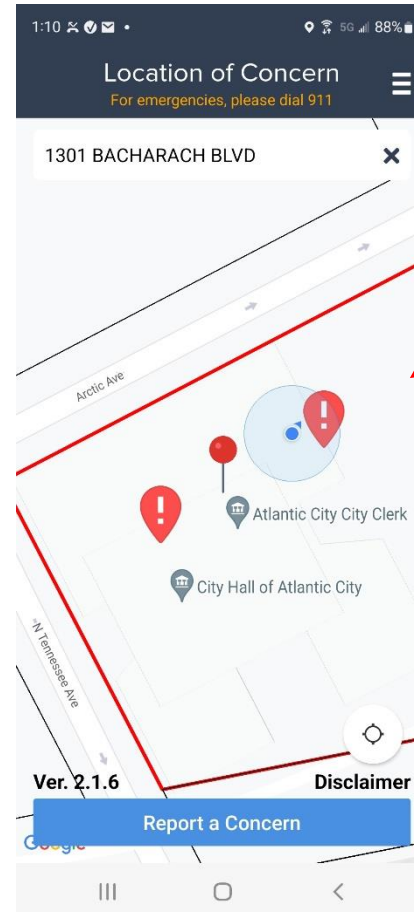

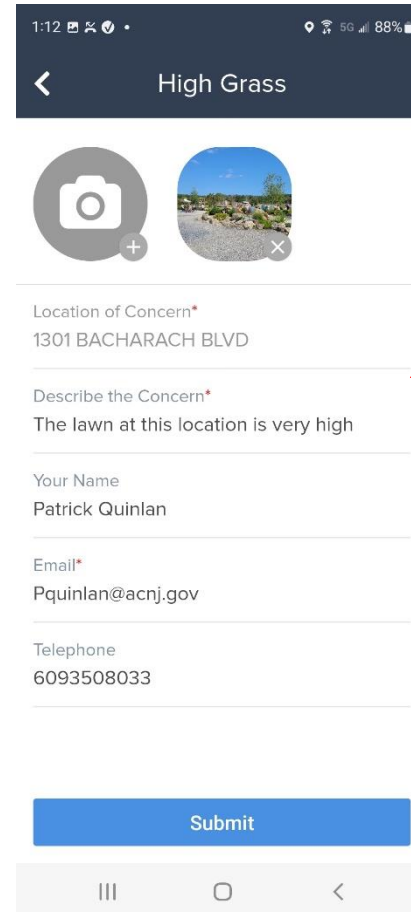
